### MAGNA ACQUIRES REMAINDER OF MJC

Magna Entertainment Corp. has exercised its options to acquire the remaining interest in The Maryland Jockey Club from Joseph and Karin DeFrancis for approximately \$18.3 million, plus interest. MEC first acquired its ownership position in MJC, which operates Pimlico Race Course and Laurel Park, in 2002. Under

the terms of that agreement, the option arrangements were scheduled to expire in November, 2007. "From the time we acquired control of MJC in 2002, we have intended to acquire the balance of the shares in the company," explained Frank Stronach, Magna's chairman and interim chief executive officer. "The acquisition of this remaining interest in MJC was specifically con-

templated in our recently announced Debt Elimination Plan, and reflects our intent to focus the business of MEC on our core strategic racetracks. MJC is a core asset of MEC, and while Thoroughbred racing in Maryland is currently facing many difficult obstacles, we remain optimistic that, with the assistance of other stakeholders, horse racing in the state can have a bright future." Under the terms of the acquisition arrangements, the DeFrancises will be leaving MJC in the near future, but Joseph DeFrancis will remain a director of MEC. "On behalf of my sister and me, I would like to thank Frank for the opportunities he has given us over these last five years," DeFrancis said. "We have both enjoyed working with MEC, and I look forward to continuing to contribute to MEC through my role on the board."

### DISCREET CAT READIES FOR VOSBURGH

**COMEBACK** Discreet Cat (Forestry) prepared for his comeback in Sunday's GI Vosburgh S. with a five-furlong work at Belmont yesterday in 1:00.84. It was the fourth fastest of 23 at the distance. The Vosburgh will be Discreet Cat's first start since suffering his first loss when last of seven in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup. After that loss, the four-year-old was diagnosed with a

severe throat infection. He returned to the U.S. in mid-May and has impressed Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "He's done well over the last six weeks," Mettee confirmed. "I really started noticing a change in him the last three weeks in Saratoga. Obviously, he's a top-class horse, and it's excit-

ing getting him back to the races." Mettee admitted to having some reservations about the Vosburgh's six-furlong distance. "I'd feel a little better if this race was 6 1/2 or seven furlongs, and it's a tougher field than you'd like to meet in the comeback race, but the Vosburgh is here and we've got him going again," he said. Discreet Cat, winner of last year's GII Jerome Breeders' Cup H. and GI Cigar Mile H., has captured six of seven starts and earned \$1,554,180. A good performance in the Vosburgh could set up Discreet Cat for a tilt at either the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint or the inaugural Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. "Saeed will get together with [owner] Sheikh Maktoum and the racing manager and we'll come up with a race we think is the best for him," Mettee explained. "Let's get through the Vosburgh first." Also expected for the Vosburgh are: **First Defence** (Unbridled's Song), **Fabulous Strike** (Smart Strike) and **Talent Search** (Catienus).

Unbeaten Codigo de Honor kept his perfect record intact and backed his solid favoritism with a smart front-running victory in the opening leg of Peru's Quadruple Crown series. Piloted by Argentine-based, Uruguayan-born Pablo Falero, the colt gained the lead shortly after the start and drew off in the stretch to score his third straight win in as many starts. It was his first success at the highest level, following visually impressive maiden and allowance victories, that were won by the combined margin of 33 1/4 lengths. Tomcito closed belatedly, but ran out of ground. Peru's perennial leading trainer, Chilean-born Juan Suarez, saddled the top three finishers. Originally named Mineroclasico, Codigo de Honor is the fourth winning foal from as many starters for the stakes-placed winning mare Miner Classic.

**STELLAR LINE-UP SET FOR QEII** Reigning champion **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill) is among a cast of 15 entries for Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. As expected, **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar) was supplemented for Ascot's £200,000 feature at yesterday's confirmation stage. Princess Zahra Aga Khan's filly is set to be joined by **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}), who will bid to gain revenge for his defeat in the Sept. 9 G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp, where George Washington completed the trifecta. "Ramonti's well and he's very consistent," commented big-race jockey Frankie Dettori. "He has won two Group 1 races and has two seconds in Group 1s, but it's the same again as we've got George Washington, the great filly [Darjina] and Excellent Art. You can set your clock by him, as you know he's going to run a big race, and I'm looking forward to riding him on Saturday." Dettori believes the Godolphin colorbearer has a strong chance of making up the two-length Prix du Moulin deficit on Darjina. "I think Ascot's tailor-made for him, as it's a nice stiff mile," he said. "Longchamp is a very quick straight and I was a bit vulnerable to the filly's turn of foot. It'll be a different ball game at Ascot, as it will be more of a test of stamina; it will be more of a true mile." **Vital Equine (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}) is another representative of the Classic generation, and trainer Eoghan O'Neill is hopeful the G1 2000 Guineas runner-up can return to form after enjoying a summer break. He has been on the shelf since running sixth in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 26. "He's fine and bouncing, his preparation's been nice and smooth and we've had no hold-ups with him," O'Neill revealed. "He'll do his last bit of work in the morning and we'll see how the ground is for Saturday. We made a plan earlier in the year and we've stuck by it. He ran a great race in the Guineas, but it was just too quick for him at The Curragh. He just doesn't pick up on firmer ground, as he hits it pretty hard, and if he can get the ground he wants on Saturday it will be a big help to him."

**JULY CUP/AGE CLASSIC JOIN SPRINT CHALLENGE** Newmarket's G1 Darley July Cup and the G1 The Age Classic, run at Flemington's Spring Racing Carnival in November, have been added to the Global Sprint Challenge, creating a series of eight races in 2008. The Age Classic, which will be a weight-for-age event from next year, replaces the Australia S. The series kicks off as usual with the G1 Coolmore Lightning S. at Flemington in February. A bonus of \$1 million will be paid out to the connections of any horse that wins Group 1 Challenge races in three different countries, as well as competing in a qualifying race in the fourth country. The four partners in the Global Sprint Challenge--Ascot Racecourse Limited, Hong Kong Jockey Club, Japan Racing Association and Racing Victoria Limited--believe the changes to the structure will strengthen the series and encourage more European-trained horses to be campaigned within the Challenge. Ascot's head of public relations, Nick Smith, said, "The inclusion of the Darley July Cup is a welcome and natural extension to the existing series. The Global Sprint Challenge has quickly established itself and has added a new dimension to the Royal Meeting, with Miss Andretti becoming the third horse trained outside Europe to win at Royal Ascot in as many years. The record of the Australian-trained horses in the King's Stand S., especially this year when they filled three of the top four places, has been a significant contributory factor to the increase in quality of that race. We're delighted to be able to announce that the King's Stand will be run for £250,000 next year, and the Golden Jubilee S. will be run for £375,000." Leigh Jordon, director of racing operations for Racing Victoria, added, "To have a leg of the Global Sprint Challenge run during Victoria's prestigious Spring Racing Carnival is further proof of the growing status of the series and shows that the Spring Racing Carnival is a truly international event, which is growing every year."

### SALT LAKE FILLY TOPS KEENELAND

**MONDAY** A half sister to multiple Grade I winner Dream Rush topped yesterday's penultimate session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington with a final bid of \$122,000. [Hip 5163](#), by Salt Lake and out of Turbo Dream (Unbridled), was consigned by Lonnie Owens's Katalpa Farm, Agent V, and was purchased by Halvorson Bloodstock, acting on behalf of an Oregon-based client. Halvorson Bloodstock was also listed as buyer when the yearling sold for \$52,000 at the Keeneland January sale. Since the Keeneland catalogue was printed, Dream Rush won the G1 Prioress Breeders' Cup S. and the G1 Darley Test S. During yesterday's session, Keeneland sold 243 yearlings for an aggregate of \$2,630,500. The session average was \$10,825, up 32.9 percent from last year's corresponding session. The median jumped 52.2 percent to \$7,000. After 14 days of selling, 3,627 yearlings have fetched \$383,467,100. The cumulative average is down six percent to \$105,726, while the median is up 4.4 percent to \$47,000. The sale concludes today.

**PROVISO ASCOT BOUND** Juddmonte Farms' **Proviso (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), currently the ante-post favorite for next year's G1 1000 Guineas, will put her unbeaten record on the line in Saturday's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile at Ascot, it was revealed yesterday. "Notwithstanding the foot-and-mouth outbreak, which has got nearer to Ascot, the plan is to run Proviso in the Fillies' Mile," Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *Racing Post*. Proviso, who is trained by Andre Fabre, was a last-out winner of the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville Aug. 18, and is likely to face stiff opposition in the £200,000 contest. **Saoirse Abu** (Mr. Greeley), winner of the G1 Phoenix S. and G1 Moyglare Stud S., is also a likely contender if track conditions are in her favour. "The plan is she's going to Ascot unless the ground is too fast," trainer Jim Bolger told the trade daily. "She's very well in herself and Kevin [Manning] will ride her on Saturday. The step up in trip should suit, a mile is what she wants."

History, once again, is busily repeating itself, this time on the first-crop sire front. By some weird coincidence, America's table of first-crop sires is being led by a comfortable margin by Posse, whose sire Silver Deputy was the champion freshman sire of 1992, ahead of Gulch and Forty Niner. It's a similar story over in Britain and Ireland, where Acclamation holds a seemingly unassailable lead of over £400,000 over Oasis Dream and Choisir. Acclamation is also a son of a champion first-crop sire, as his sire Royal Applause defeated Choisir's sire Danehill Dancer to take the title in 2001.

Another link between Royal Applause and Acclamation is that they owed a substantial part of their lead to successes in richly endowed sales-linked races. Acclamation himself easily defeated a large field to take the £200,000 St Leger Yearling S. on his final juvenile appearance, and the wheel turned full circle this summer when his son Dark Angel took the £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. *Cont. p6*

I must admit to having mixed feelings about the rich sales-related races which are proliferating in Britain and Ireland. While they are a useful marketing tool, and help support the commercial sector of the market, they run the risk of giving an unbalanced view of the two-year-old scene. For example, Dark Angel collected a first prize of £187,000 while achieving a Racing Post rating of 99+ in the St Leger Yearling S. Compare that to the amounts earned--and the ratings achieved--by the winners of the same meeting's three juvenile group races. Fast Company, Sir Gerry and Nahoodh respectively received £23,000, £76,000 and £50,000 in achieving ratings of 107, 112 and 106. Acclamation's impressive prize-money total also includes a sum of nearly £200,000 collected by his son Hitchens in finishing second in the Goffs Million for colts and geldings.

I'm delighted to say, though, that Dark Angel has now shown that he, too, is worthy of group success, as he led throughout to defeat Group 2 winner Strike the Deal by a neck in the G2 Dubai Duty Free Mill Reef S. (with Berbice, another son of Acclamation, in third). In the process, he again emulated his sire Acclamation, who also achieved a Group 2 success (at the age of four, in the Diadem S.).

Acclamation represents another considerable success for the Cashman family's Rathbarry Stud, previously home to several other high-ranked new stallions, such as Alzao, Barathea and Tagula. His lack of a Group 1 success meant that Acclamation started his stallion career at only €10,000 in 2004, but it quickly became apparent that the Rathbarry team had a potential hit on its hands. Acclamation's first weanlings were in solid demand at the sales, and it was a similar story at the 2006 yearling sales, even though none of his youngsters sold for more than 90,000gns. As a 61,000-guineas purchase at Doncaster, Dark Angel was one of Acclamation's most popular sons, and he has proved an excellent buy.

Acclamation was bred to mature very quickly, as both his parents--Royal Applause and the Ahonoora mare Princess Athena--gained their first group success as two-year-olds at Royal Ascot in June. Royal Applause took the Coventry S., whereas Princess Athena landed the Queen Mary S., and Acclamation's second dam, Shopping Wise, was by Floribunda, another impressive winner of one of Royal Ascot's main juvenile prizes.

There's a temptation to think that horses which mature quickly will ultimately pay the price for possessing precocious speed. However, Acclamation's immediate ancestors--far from burning themselves out--trained on very well. Royal Applause proceeded to win the G2 Gimcrack S. and G1 Middle Park S. during an unbeaten juvenile campaign and returned to his best at four, when he was Europe's champion sprinter. Princess Athena went on to be placed at three and four in the G3 King George S. over Goodwood's fast five furlongs. In this tale of coincidences, Princess Athena's sire Ahonoora and broodmare sire Floribunda also contested the King George, winning in 1961 and 1979, respectively. Put another way, Acclamation's background is one of speed, speed and more speed, mixed with a degree of durability.

Acclamation's progeny wasted absolutely no time in demonstrating that they had inherited ample measures of their sire's speed and precociousness. Even before the Royal Ascot meeting in June, he had notched up 12 individual winners from a crop of 85 and the winners have continued to flow, to the extent that his total now stands at 20. No fewer than nine of his runners have earned black-type, with Dark Angel leading a team of four stakes winners.

Speed has been the dominant feature of his progeny, to the extent that 27 of their 30 victories in Britain or Ireland have been gained over five or six furlongs. The exceptions have been the useful Newly Elected, whose dam raced at up to 1 1/2 miles, and the mile winner Tamara Moon, who is out of a mare by the Arc winner Peintre Celebre.

In view of the parallels between Acclamation and Royal Applause, there is a fair chance that Acclamation will sire the occasional good winner beyond a mile. Royal Applause's stakes winners include Take A Bow, a Group 3 winner over 1 1/4 miles this year, and Ticker Tape, winner of the G1 American Oaks.

Six furlongs already suits Dark Angel better than five, but there's no guarantee that he will stay much further, as his second dam Night At Sea--another who contested the King George S.--gained her only stakes success over five furlongs. Incidentally, his third dam, Into Harbour, was a daughter of Right Tack, a dual Guineas winner whose sire, Hard Tack, was produced by Acclamation's fourth dam, Cowes. Hard Tack's best effort was a second--you've guessed it--in the King George S.
