

COOLMORE SIRES DOMINATE FIRST SESSION

It was a case of honors shared between Montjeu (Ire) and Galileo (Ire) after a formidable opener to the Goffs Million Sale yesterday, which witnessed colts by both

stallions selling to Coolmore's Demi O'Byrne for €650,000 apiece. As his son Authorized (Ire) prepares for his biggest test in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, Montjeu was the main man again and was responsible for two of the top three colts and the top-priced filly during a solid first ses-

sion. Denis Brosnan's Croom House Stud consigned hip 117, a half-brother to recent Chester maiden winner Red Blooded Woman. The pair is a out of Maskaya, a half to triple stakes scorer Modeeroch (Ire), 2002 G1 Cheveley Park S. third Danaskaya (Ire) and Chinese Whisper (Ire). The latter is also a son of Montjeu and was third in last year's G1 Gran Criterium for Ballydoyle before placing in both the G3 Prix la Force and G3 Prix de Guiche this term. "He's a very nice horse and a typical Montjeu," O'Byrne said. "There was lots to like about him, he's closely related to a good horse and he comes from a good family." Just nine lots earlier, Ballylinch Stud's full-sister to the aforementioned Chinese Whisper provided the 1999 Arc hero with a clean sweep when selling to Herbage Stud for €320,000. It was late on when O'Byrne matched his earlier purchase when seeing off the competition for Clare Castle's hip 175, a Galileo three-parts brother to 2003 G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Fidelite (Ire), whose page includes 1995 G1 Irish Derby hero Winged Love (Ire). "He's a grand sort and you'd find it hard to find a nicer horse," was O'Byrne's glowing commendation. "He's from a good family and the sire is flying." **Goffs cont. p2**

Heavy Hitters...

Aside from purchasing the session-topping duo of colts, O'Byrne also took home another son of Montjeu who is closely related to the 2005 G1 Epsom Derby runner-up Walk in the Park (Ire). Hip 187, from the draft of Lady O'Reilly's Castlemartin Stud, is a grandson of 1997 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Classic Park (GB) and was purchased for €575,000. Making it a top five for Coolmore stallions, O'Byrne went to €420,000 for hip 66, a son of Sadlers Wells offered by Paul Shanahan's Ashtown House Stud. He is a half to the dual listed winner Katiykha (Ire), already the dam of this year's impressive Leopardstown maiden scorer Katiyra (Ire). "The sire is still the best," his buyer commented. "He had a good winner of the Beresford S. yesterday and had the G1 Fillies Mile winner on Saturday. This colt was just a very nice sort and he wasn't bad value." O'Byrne's spending spree also included Corduff Stud's hip 185, a grey son of Johannesburg whose pedigree includes Dancing Brave and fetched €275,000; and a half-sister to the group scorer Social Harmony (Ire) from the first crop of One Cool Cat. Consigned by Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud as hip 82, she hails from the Moyglare family of Go and Go (Ire) and was secured with a bid of €230,000. Interrupting the County Tipperary operation's whitewash was the sole Elusive Quality colt in the sale, who was consigned by Pat O'Kelly's Kilcarn Stud as hip 96. No doubt spurred on by the electrifying performance of Raven's Pass in Sandown's G3 Solario S., Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell operation went to €310,000 for the colt from the family of Giant's Causeway and this year's G2 Cherry Hinton S. scorer You'resothrilling.

Domestic Dabblings...

Irish trainer Jim Bolger, who has enjoyed spectacular results from yearlings bought at this sale over the past two seasons, surprised nobody when paying €435,000 for a son of Galileo. No introduction is required to the Coolcullen success story with progeny of that sire, with Teofilo (Ire), New Approach (Ire) and Fillies' Million heroine Lush Lashes (Ire) creating their own fairytale.

This time, Bolger will seek to work some magic with Croom House Stud's colt, who is out of a half to the sire Majorien (GB) and the 2000 G2 Prix de Malleret scorer America (Ire), the dam of this year's G2 Prix Noailles third Spycrawler. "He's a nice prospect,"

Bolger said. "To use a cliché, he ticked all the

boxes." Fellow Irishman Dermot Weld, who has a very smart Classic prospect on his hands by Invincible Spirit (Ire) in the G2 Debutante S. scorer Campfire Glow (Ire), was intent on securing another of the Irish National Stud resident's daughters yesterday. Offered by Camas Park, hip 79, who cost a mere €12,000 at the November Foal Sale here, is from the immediate family of the graded stakes scorer Gone for Real and was knocked down to the Rosewell House conditioner for €270,000. "I had to battle hard to get her, but I'm partial to Invincible Spirit fillies for obvious reasons," he explained. "She's a lovely quality filly who should hopefully make up into a nice two-year-old. She has been bought for Dr Ronan Lambe." Weld also paid €250,000 for hip 155, a son of Indian Ridge (Ire) closely related to the group scorer Tahreeb (Ire) consigned by Norelands Stud and €240,000 for hip 75, a son of Danehill Dancer (Ire) out of a half to Catchascatchcan (GB). That top-class mare has produced Antonius Pius and Weld has high hopes for the offering from David Nagle's Barronstown Stud. "He's a quality sort who looks like a racehorse and will hopefully make up into a smart juvenile," he said. Tommy Stack's County Tipperary-based stable has enjoyed a momentous year thanks to Myboycharlie (Ire) and Alexander Tango (Ire) and the legendary figure's son and assistant Fozzy signed for hip 152, a Johannesburg colt from the draft of Flash Conroy's Glenvale Stud. Out of the 1995 G1 Cheveley Park S. third Najiya (GB), his second dam is a full sibling of Last Tycoon (Ire) and he fetched €255,000.

Fiscal Fillies...

Early in the session, Michael Jarvis was on hand to purchase hip 9, a daughter of Johannesburg out of a sister to the listed-placed Ballydoyle fillies Showbiz (Ire) and Shangri La (Ire). The second dam is a full sibling of the 1988 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Trusted Partner, also the dam of the high-class Dress to Thrill (Ire)

and 1993 G1 Moyglare Stud S. third Low Key Affair. The Newmarket-based conditioner paid €230,000 for the in-demand offering from Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud. "I thought that she was a very striking filly with great movement and a good walk," he said.

"She's been bought on behalf of an established

client." That price was matched later in the afternoon for hip 59, a daughter of Juddmonte's red-hot Dansili (GB) from Mark Dwyer's Oaks Farm Stables. Out of a sister to the listed winner Campo Catino (Ire) from the family of Thatch, Bachelor Duke and Soldier Hollow (GB), the April-foaled filly was knocked down to Adrian Nicholl of BBA Ireland. Nicholl also paid €300,000 for Glidawn Stud's hip 154, another daughter of Invincible Spirit who is a full-sister to the dual listed scorer and G2 German 1000 Guineas third Bahama Mama (Ire). She represented a pinhooking triumph in difficult times for Gerry Burke, as he bought her as a foal at Tattersalls for only

52,000 guineas in December. Four lots earlier, Cahermorris Stables' daughter of Pivotal (GB) from the family of King's Theatre (Ire) and High Estate (Ire) was snapped up by Joe Broderick's Clonmel-based Newtown Anner Stud for €260,000. Despite the buoyancy of the opener, the average of €107,914 dipped by six per cent and the median of €70,000 was down by nearly seven per cent. Selling continues today at 11am. SPECIOSA SET FOR SUN CHARIOT Pam Sly indicated that last year's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Speciosa (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) is likely to contest Saturday's Kingdom of Bahrain Sun Chariot S. Heading the 15 remaining entries at the five-day stage for the at Newmarket mile contest, the four-year-old has been off the track since finishing sixth in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 4 and is more likely to take up the Newmarket option than ship to Longchamp for the G1 Prix de l'Opera the following day. "I'd like it if Speciosa ran at Newmarket in the Sun Chariot S.," her trainer said yesterday. "She's entered in the Prix de l'Opera, but I'm hoping she will go to Newmarket because she does like it there. It's a stiff mile with a good climb." Among her rivals is likely to be Michael Ryan's 2007 G1 English and Irish 1000 Guineas winner **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) a trio from Cheveley Park Stud headed by the G1 Matron S. scorer **Echelon (GB)** (Danehill) and Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's G1 Falmouth S. victress **Simply Perfect (GB)** (Danehill). Newmarket's Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser yesterday predicted good ground for the three-day Cambridgeshire meeting. "We have had some light rain so far today and the forecast is for nothing particularly heavy over the next couple of days," he said. "If the forecast rainfall is correct, that will merely maintain the status quo with the ground."

SADDEX ON SONG Stall Avena's G1 Rheinland-Pokal winner **Saddex (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) will look to book his ticket to Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe when working this morning. Trainer Peter Rau confirmed that regular rider Torsten Mundry will be on board for Longchamp's mile-and-a-half showcase. "He will run in the Arc and we hope things go to plan," Rau told *PA Sport*. "It's a tough race, but he is a very good horse. He is fit and well and will work on Tuesday morning, before going to Paris on Saturday. His regular jockey, Torsten Mundry, will ride him--he knows the horse very well. I think if it comes soft, it will fit in well with the horse."

RANGER COULD BE ON WEEKEND DUTY Michael Tabor, Susan Magnier, Derrick Smith and Joseph Allen's **US Ranger** (Danzig) could stage a quick return to the track in Saturday's G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp, trainer Aidan O'Brien announced yesterday. Following his smooth 3 1/2-length success in Sunday's Listed Waterford Testimonial S. at The Curragh, the sophomore could be asked to back up in the seven-furlong contest. "He's in the Foret at the weekend and we'll have a look later in the week and see how things are going with him," he told the *Racing Post*. "He was good all right on Sunday and did it well. He's a very nice horse and we were all very happy."

MONMOUTH PARK ANNOUNCES BREEDERS' CUP INFO Monmouth Park yesterday announced the schedule for its four-day Breeders' Cup Week meet, which runs from Wednesday, Oct. 24 through Saturday, Oct. 27. Monmouth has carded 12 stakes in addition to the 11 Breeders' Cup stakes. That includes one graded event, the GIII Pegasus S. for three-year-olds, which is typically held at the Meadowlands but which this year will be contested on Saturday as part of the Breeders' Cup undercard. Joining the Pegasus on the early card are the \$200,000 Select S. for



three-year-olds and the \$200,000 Miss Woodford S. for three-year-old fillies. On Friday, the card will feature the \$250,000 Epitome S. for two-year-old fillies; the \$250,000 Favorite Trick S. for two-year-olds, and the \$250,000 Inside Information S. for three-year-old fillies. The three races will be run prior to the three Breeders' Cup World Championships events scheduled that day: the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, with a 4:20 p.m. post; the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile with a 4:55 p.m. post, and the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint, with a 5:35 p.m. post.

Breeders' Cup Week kicks off on Wednesday with a 10-race card highlighted by a pair of stakes, while Thursday's 10-race program will be topped by a quartet of stakes. From Wednesday through Friday, the parking gates will open at 10 a.m., and admission gates will open at 10:30 a.m. Betting windows open at 11:30 a.m., with first post at 12:30 p.m. On Saturday, the parking gates open at 8 a.m., and admission gates open at 9 a.m. Mutuel windows open at 10 a.m., with post time for the first race at 11 a.m. The first Breeders' Cup race, the Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, will go off at 12:30 p.m. On Wednesday and Thursday, admission will be \$5 for the grandstand and \$10 for the clubhouse. On Friday, general admission is \$10 for the grandstand and \$15 for the clubhouse. Admission on Saturday must be pre-purchased and can be done by visiting www.breederscup.com.



AUSTRALIAN EQUINE INFLUENZA UPDATE

JAPAN STALLIONS STUCK IN AUSTRALIA Japanese stallions **Jungle Pocket (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}) and **Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), caught up in the equine influenza quarantine in Australia, will not be allowed to stand at stud in New Zealand. Jungle Pocket will instead cover mares at the Victorian-based Hollylodge Thoroughbreds. Zenno Rob Roy will also stand the remainder of the beleaguered Australian breeding season in Victoria at the Independent Stallion Station. Both stallions were released on Monday from the Spotswood quarantine station in Victoria, but the New Zealand Equine Health Association (NZEHA) has banned both of them from entering New Zealand. Zenno Rob Roy, who has repeatedly tested negative to the equine influenza virus, was to have stood at New Zealand's Java Thoroughbreds. He will stand at A\$14,000, including GST.

There can be no doubt that the stallion performance of the weekend belonged to the unstoppable Smart Strike, who moved to the head of the general sires' list courtesy of his sensational sequence of Grade I victories from Fabulous Strike, English Channel and Curlin. For good measure, these wins were preceded by another stakes victory by the unbeaten juvenile filly Smarty Deb. If Smart Strike can maintain this momentum, he stands an excellent

chance of becoming only the second son of Mr. Prospector to take the title of champion sire, the other being Forty Niner.

You could say that Smart Strike's performance of siring Grade I winners over six, 10 and 12 furlongs on the same day encapsulates the brilliance and versatility of the Mr. Prospector line--Mr. Prospector himself being one of the comparatively few stallions to have sired winners of each of the Triple Crown events. And it isn't just in the U.S. that the line has flourished at Classic level, as the Derby is the only English Classic to have eluded the progeny of Mr. Prospector's sons, who have also sired winners of the first four French Classics. Kingmambo has been Mr. Prospector's greatest classic force in Europe, but there is no reason why Smart Strike--a good sire of turf performers--shouldn't ultimately prove as effective in Europe as his illustrious companion at Lane's End.

But, as I concentrated on Smart Strike's career after Curlin's victory in the Rebel S. earlier in the year, I am going to turn my attention to the female of the species, namely the Flower Bowl Invitational winner Lahudood. This daughter of Singspiel sports the colors of Shadwell Stable, recently carried with such distinction by Invasor and Jazil.

Shadwell doesn't have large numbers of horses in training in the U.S., but this season's batch include Makderah, winner of the GII New York S. and third in the GI Diana S. before being forced into retirement by a pastern injury. Makderah had originally been Shadwell's intended runner in the Flower Bowl, but Lahudood, who was twice beaten only a head at group level in France last year, was an appropriate substitute, as she comes from the same family as Makderah.

Lahudood's third dam is Height of Fashion, a champion filly acquired for a considerable sum from the Queen in 1982 while still racing. The consensus, if my memory serves me correctly, was that Sheikh Hamdan had paid over the odds. This view gathered strength when Height of Fashion, who was unbeaten in five starts for the Queen, suffered heavy defeats on her two appearances for her new owner. Phrases like 'laughing all the way to the bank' seemed applicable regarding the Queen, but subsequent years have shown that Sheikh Hamdan has very much had the last laugh (if you'll excuse the cliché).

Height of Fashion's most obvious achievement was to produce five stakes-winning sons, including three--Unfuwain, Nashwan and Nayef--who ranked among the very best middle-distance horses in Europe. While I would hesitate to describe Nashwan as an outright success as a stallion, he did sire six Group 1 winners, including Swain, Bago and Wandesta, and Unfuwain did even better, with eight Group 1 winners. Appropriately Unfuwain's top performers included Lailani, winner of the 2001 Flower Bowl.


It is too soon for Nayef to have followed their example, but the signs are certainly encouraging. His first-crop representatives include his daughters Spacious and Khotsi, who finished first and second in the G2 May Hill S., and his promising son Alfathaa was far from disgraced in finishing fifth, beaten only 1½ lengths, in the G2 Royal Lodge S. three days ago.

Only one of Height of Fashion's five daughters managed to become a stakes winner, with her Mr. Prospector filly Sarayir winning listed races at two and three. One of her wins came over 1¼ miles and both of Sarayir's full-sisters, Bashayer and Wijdan, earned black type over at least that distance before possibly proving better suited by distances around a mile. It is Wijdan who now ranks as the dam of Makderah, and it was Bashayer's winning Arazi filly Rahayeb who is the dam of Lahudood.

It would be nice to be able to say that the sale of Height of Fashion didn't have an adverse effect on the Royal Studs. After all, the Queen still had several well-qualified fillies from the family which had provided her with Height of Fashion's excellent dam Highclere, winner of both the 1000 Guineas and the Prix de Diane. Sad to say, most of this family's continued success has been for other owners, one exception this year being the Zafonic five-year-old Banknote, winner of a listed race in England and a Group 3 in Germany.

Height of Fashion's close relative Burghclere (by Busted, the grandsire of Height of Fashion) bred the Oaks second Wind In Her Hair, who in turn became the dam of the Japanese superstar Deep Impact. Burghclere is also the third dam of Jeremy, one of the best milers in Britain this year. Interestingly, the dams of Lahudood and Jeremy were both sired by the largely disappointing Arazi, who was considered an obvious option for mares from this family simply because he was by Blushing Groom, sire of the great Nashwan.

Coincidentally, Lahudood's family enjoyed further group success the day after the Flower Bowl when Sadler's Wells's son Ask put up quite an impressive display in the G3 Cumberland Lodge Stakes. Ask's second dam Highbrow, who produced two group winners for the Queen, was a half-sister to Height of Fashion.

This family can be big and rangy and it is easy to see

why Singspiel, a medium-sized quality individual, would be considered a suitable option for Rahayeb. Lahudood continues a fine run of success for Rahy's half-brother, whose total of 2007 stakes winners in the Northern Hemisphere runs into double figures. Singspiel's progeny are winning all over the place, pretty much as Singspiel

did in his own career. His progeny seem suited by American turf courses, and Lahudood follows such as Singhalese (Del Mar Oaks), Dark Islander (Oak Tree Derby), Funfair (Kelso H.), Three Degrees (Honeymoon H.), Singalong, Solva and Puppeteer. No doubt there will be plenty more Singspiels heading for the U.S. after this string of stakes winners.

Comparable Average Table...

I'm not entirely sure what happened with Awesome Again's 2006 yearling average, but one thing for sure--he's being taken seriously as a top-class sire now. There are a variety of reasons why a sire's yearling average can increase so much from one year to the next, the most likely being that their commercial profile looks a lot better. But sometimes they can just have undersold the previous year for reasons of fashion, which might have been the case with Dixieland Band. Not For Love looks like he's being taken seriously on a national level now, while Malibu Moon just keeps getting stronger and stronger commercially. Early prediction on 2008 leader in this category: new World Top 12 Sire appointee Smart Strike.

Multiple Table...

The less a sire stands for, the better their chances of achieving a good 'raw' multiple of yearling average times stud fee; conversely, the higher the fee, the more difficult it is. So it's no big surprise that seven of the top 10 on this list stood for \$10,000 or less in 2005; nor that seven stood in 2007 for more than they stood in 2005, and that the three who didn't stand for more are all sires with their first yearlings selling this year. This can also tell us a lot about sires which have 'got good'; Mr. Greeley stood for \$75,000 this year and will undoubtedly be over \$100,000 for 2008, and Distorted Humor went up from \$60,000 in 2005 to \$225,000 this year. So their averages must increase proportionally to sustain these high multiples.

Overall, numbers were down a bit from 2006 figures despite 62 fewer lots on offer. Average was down a modest 1.5 percent, from \$24,777 to \$24,399, while the median took a more substantial 13-percent hit, from \$11,500 last year to \$10,000. The sale continues today at 10:00 a.m.

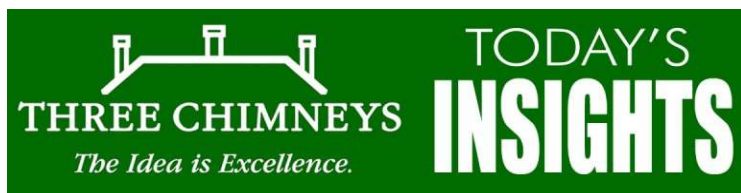

Agencies Propose Joint Rule to Implement Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act:

The Department of the Treasury and the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System yesterday announced the release of a joint proposed rule to implement the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act. The act prohibits gambling businesses from accepting payments in connection with unlawful Internet gambling, including payments made through credit cards, electronic funds transfers, and checks. The proposed rule would require U.S. financial firms that participate in designated payment systems to have policies and procedures that are designed to prevent payments being made to gambling businesses in connection with unlawful Internet gambling. Reacting to the proposal, Alex Waldrop, president and CEO of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, said in a statement, "These regulations are both complex and lengthy. We will begin the review process immediately and solicit industry input in the coming weeks through a series of informational meetings with our stakeholder groups."
