WHERE THERE'S SMOKE...

West Point Stable and Lewis Lakin's **Irish Smoke** (Smoke Glacken) has yet to take a misstep in her brief career and looks to run her record to a perfect three-from-three in this afternoon's G1 Darley Alcibiades S. on opening day at Keeneland. The gray filly was a professional winner of her Aug. 2 debut at Saratoga and became the third individual Grade I winner for West Point in 2007 when she rallied to best **A to the Croft** (Menifee) by a convincing 3 1/4 lengths in the Sept. 2 Spinaway S. at the Spa. Produced by a full sister to 1998 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. winner Added Gold, Irish Smoke should be able to see out today's trip. **Morakami** (Fusaichi Pegasus) takes another crack at the top two this afternoon, having finished a non-threatening fourth in the Spinaway.

Trainer Rusty Arnold is looking forward to seeing his filly stretch out. "We will find out how good she is, but I would think she will love two turns," Arnold said. "She is not a sprinter. I am very optimistic she will run well." The dark bay, who bested **Sunday Holiday** (Sunday Break {Jpn}) in a Saratoga maiden Aug. 5, turned in a solid five-furlong work over the local Polytrack Sept. 29. **Grace Anatomy** (Aldebaran) ships in from California for trainer Doug O'Neill, who nearly took the 2004 Alcibiades with Sharp Lisa. Third to subsequent GSW More Happy in a Del Mar Polytrack maiden July 21, she earned a better speed figure in graduating at the Seaside Aug. 19 than did Irish Smoke for her Spinaway success. Grace Anatomy is owned in part by New York Mets catcher Paul Lo Duca. The Alcibiades is responsible for the winners of four runnings of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (Eliza--1992; Countess Diana--1997; Silverbulletday--1998; and Cash Run--1999). NOW FOR NATAGORA

With the spectre of Zambezi Sun (GB) looming in Sunday's Arc, Pascal Bary has an opportunity for a golden weekend as **Natagora (Fr)** (Divine Light {Jpn}) lines up for today's G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket. Stefan Friberg's grey enjoyed a winning spree in early

summer in the July 1 G3 Prix du Bois and G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 22, but that was brought to an abrupt halt by Myboycharlie (Ire) in the G1 Prix Morny. Rested since her second in that Aug. 19 Deauville heat, she returns to her own sex in a bid to gain a deserved Group 1 success. "She is very consistent and

has a lot of speed," Bary told *PA Sport*. "She ran very well at Deauville--she tried to make the running and was beaten by a very good colt. She had to do all the hard work, going from the post to the end. It is hard to do that at Deauville. At the moment, right now, she is the best two-year-old filly in France." **Cont. p2**

TAJ TEST

Today's G1 Shadwell Middle Park S. at Newmarket represents a speed test in which the later-developing types have a crack at the hardened juveniles from spring and summer. One of the less grizzled runners in today's open renewal is Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Tajdeef** (Aljabr), who earned a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** tag when recording a highly impressive five-length success in a six-furlong maiden at Newbury on debut Aug. 5. He appeared not to get the seventh panel of the Sept. 15 G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster last time, but reverts to a trip over which he could yet excel. "They tell me he's been doing well at home and, to be honest, I thought he didn't stay last time," the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Angus Gold told *PA Sport*. "He looked fast on his first outing, so the trip should suit him." **Cont. p3**

Sir Michael Stoute saddles Khalid Abdullah's **Visit** here in hopes of his third Cheveley Park winner since champion Marwell (Ire)'s triumph in 1980. After graduating impressively in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 29, the homebred was runner-up in the G2 Lowther S. at York last time Aug. 23. On that form, she holds the trio **Fleeting Spirit, Unilateral** and **Festoso**, who filled the next three places. The Searchers Syndicate's **Fleeting Spirit** has since won the G2 Flying Childers S. at Doncaster Sept. 14, while Prime Equestrian's **Unilateral** has captured Ayr's G3 Firth of Clyde S. Sept. 22. Ger Lyons brings the Jesse Club Syndicate's **Elletelle** back to Britain, where she took the June 20 G2 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot before finishing third under a penalty in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. on the July Course July 11. Third again in the G1 Phoenix S. on deep ground at The Curragh last time Aug. 12, she holds major claims back on a sounder surface. "The ground at the Curragh last time was basically unraceable for her--it was very heavy," Lyons said. "But she is such a quality filly that Johnny [Murtagh] thought he might win two furlongs out. Her weight is up 20 kilos, so she's in top shape, and the faster the ground, the better." Trainer Mick Channon won this with Seazun (Ire) in 1999 before Queen's Logic (Ire) followed up in 2001. He saddles Tim Corby's **Missit**, who booked her ticket with a five-length success in a Lingfield maiden last time Sept. 11. "We think she's a pretty good filly," Channon commented. "All of our fillies have been performing very well this year, but whether she's good enough to win a Group 1, we'll find out."

Tajdeef hails from the Barry Hills stable responsible for two winners of this prize, and Catherine Corbett and Christopher Wright's **Dark Angel** make up a strong duo from Hills's South Bank Stables in Lambourn. He got the better of The Searchers' **Strike the Deal** by a neck when in receipt of three pounds in Newbury's G2 Mill Reef S. last time Sept. 22. The latter had previously taken the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood Aug. 3 before finishing down the field in the Champagne, and trainer Jeremy Nosedá is hoping his toughness will count here. "He will be suited by the likely fast ground and is a good, honest and tough horse," Nosedá commented. "I expect him to run his usual solid race." **Sir Gerry** bids to add this Newmarket contest to his success in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 22. Royal Applause (GB), Amadeus Wolf (GB) and Balmont have all completed the double since 1995. Jeff Smith's **Dream Eater** defied an unfavorable draw when showing a sharp turn of acceleration to win Doncaster's Sept. 12 St Leger 2yo S. from **Achilles of Troy**. That colt represents the Aidan O'Brien stable successful with Minardi, Johannesburg and Ad Valorem since 2000. Dream Eater's trainer Andrew Balding believes the grey has earned his place in this line-up. "He's come out of Doncaster really well and has improved a huge amount as the autumn has come along," Balding explained. "He had a dirty scope before the Mill Reef and missed one piece of work, but he's pretty clean-winded, so that wasn't a problem, and his work has been really good since."

WHO WILL BE BRAVE?

Few races around the globe stir the turfiste's heart as much as the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and the winner of Sunday's 86th renewal will join an honor roll steeped in legend when entering the hallowed winner's circle as the shadows lengthen. Since its inception in 1920, the race quickly became established as Europe's end-of-season championship, and it's been staged over 12 furlongs of Longchamp's Bois de Boulogne track in each of its 85 previous incarnations.

Comrade (GB) took the inaugural running in 1920. Ksar (Fr), winner of the 1921 and 1992 renewals, became the first of six horses to earn a pair of Arc trophies. Marcel Boussac's Corrida (GB) became the first and only distaffer to claim the double when landing her second title in 1937. None have managed the feat since Alleged's second triumph in 1978, although 1984 winner Sagace (Fr) was denied a second victory in the stewards' room in 1985, a decision which still rankles in some quarters; Cadum (Fr) was the first disqualification in 1925. The post-war years moved to a higher plane when the Ugo Penco-trained Ribot (GB) claimed two wide-margin successes, in 1955 and 1956, and the enigmatic champion ultimately retired as the unbeaten winner of 16 races.

Epsom Derby hero Sea-Bird II (Fr) was a brilliant winner in 1965, and the official six-length winning margin is still considered a prudent estimation of his superiority. He, in turn, was sire of France's darling and dual Classic winner Allez France who bounced back from defeat the previous year and scooted to victory in 1974 as a nation held its breath. Indeed, fillies enjoyed a golden period of domination at the end of that decade, with Three Troikas (Fr), Detroit (Fr), Gold River (Fr), Akiyda (GB) and All Along (Fr) posting consecutive wins from 1979 to 1983. Urban Sea's 1993 score is the only female success--the last of 15--since then.

Andre Fabre is the winningest trainer with seven victories, and his brilliant 1997 scorer Peintre Celebre holds the race record time of 2:24.60. That victory is favored by the clock, but one performance of note remains engraved in the memory of those who witnessed arguably the best in recent times.

Dancing Brave, the 1986 G1 2000 Guineas winner who was denied victory in the G1 Epsom Derby, bounced back from defeat to post wins in the G1 Eclipse S. and G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., but reserved his landmark achievement for the autumn. His widest of wide surges to secure victory, in then-record time, came at the expense at one of the best fields ever assembled and included the winners of four Derbys--Shahrastani, Bering (GB) and Acatenango (Ger)--and a host of other Group 1 winners.

"Dancing Brave was my favorite, he has to be," commented trainer Guy Harwood. "He was an easy horse to train and I had no problems with him. He always did his work well and was a nice horse to handle." Harwood added, "The difference between him and other good horses I trained--such as Warning, Rousillon, To Agori Mou and Young Generation--was that Dancing Brave could do it at a mile and a mile and a half. He was a top-class horse at both distances, whereas the others were specialist milers, although very good milers indeed. It's a special talent. Nashwan was a great horse, as was Nijinsky, and you don't see their sort very often."

Of course, Nashwan and Nijinsky never tasted victory in Europe's version of the Fall Classic. But when the curtain is raised at 4:40 p.m. on Sunday, the winner's name will join an honour roll which includes some of the finest runners in the history of the Turf.

DANETIME STANDOUT AT SPORTSMAN'S

Goffs had a more low-key feel yesterday as the Sportsman's Sale followed the high-pressure three days of the Million, but a son of Danetime (Ire) quickened the pulse again when selling for a record €240,000 during the first session. Vinesgrove Stud supplied the colt in question, and hip 699 had been the subject of intense scrutiny all day. After a battle with Kevin Prendergast, it was Bobby O'Ryan who stretched furthest for the May foal out of Optional (GB) (Prince Sabo {GB}). The mare is a granddaughter of the prolific stakes producer Mettle, a mare whose page includes Guys and Dolls (GB), a top-class juvenile of 2001. Danetime's progeny have enjoyed escalating success since his untimely death, with Myboycharlie (Ire) and Vital Equine (Ire) boosting an already growing profile this year when winning the G1 Prix Morny and finishing runner-up in the G1 2000 Guineas, respectively. "I've bought him for Dermot Weld," O'Ryan said. "He's a gorgeous horse, a really good individual with a good step to him. Unfortunately, they don't make Danetimes any more, and we've all seen what he can do." O'Ryan also purchased a daughter of the late Tally-Ho Stud resident for €60,000 from Tony O'Callaghan's County Westmeath operation. Hip [803](#), out of Almasa (GB) (Faustus), is a full-sister to the smart Viva La Diva (Ire) from the extended family of Ridgewood Pearl (GB). "She will be going into training with David Murray Smith for Rob Lloyd," O'Ryan explained. "She's a nice filly and looks like she could be a sharp two-year-old."

He Is Strong, He Is Invincible...

Later, Glenspring Farm's son of Invincible Spirit (Ire) proved popular due in no small part to the recent Newbury maiden success of his 3/4-brother Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}). Out of Tappen Zee (Ire) (Sandhurst Prince {Ire})--a half-sister to Classic-placed Cape Town (Ire)--he was secured by Ross Doyle of Peter Doyle Bloodstock for €80,000. "I've bought him on behalf of Richard Hannon Jr.," Doyle commented. "Paco Boy won his maiden well at Newbury and looks a smart two-year-old, and [this yearling is] by a good sire in Invincible Spirit. He's a nice horse and probably wasn't bad value." Invincible Spirit was also responsible for hip 650, a Monahullen Farm-consigned colt bought by Con Marnane for €65,000. "He's a fabulous horse and, for me, he was the nicest horse in the sale," the Bansha House maestro said. "I've already had a couple of decent Invincible Spirits, including Fleeting Spirit, who runs in the G1 Cheveley Park S. tomorrow." Hip 618, a filly from the first crop of Exceed and Excel (Aus) (Danehill), was the highest-priced filly of the session when selling to John Dewberry for €75,000. Consigned by Caherass Stud, she is out of Gujarat (Distant View), a daughter of the 1995 G2 Prix de Malleret heroine Privity from the Juddmonte family of Home Affairs (GB) and Price Tag (GB). The average of €19,667 dropped by 17 percent, while the median was down a quarter on last year's equivalent with one day to go. The 'first foals 1998' sire crop includes Smart Strike, Pivotal, and Unbridled's Song among the top 15 on this list; Distorted Humor, Awesome Again, and Wild Rush represent F2000 sires; and Successful Appeal and Cape Canaveral rank ahead of Montjeu, Giant's Causeway, and Sinndar among a strong group with first foals 2002. Other sire crop leaders among the top 15 include Monsun (1997), Unusual Heat (1999), Forestry (2001), and Galileo (2003).

JURY SWORN IN AT THE OLD BAILEY

Mr. Justice Forbes described the alleged race-fixing trial as "complex, but interesting" yesterday as 12 jurors were sworn in at the Old Bailey. After delays due to a burst water pipe in the courtroom and a process of culling the number of witnesses to be called, the four-month trial will begin Monday. "This is a complex and lengthy trial but it will be, as you will discover, a very interesting one," Forbes declared. "I do ask you to be patient while we prepare for this complex trial." All six defendants--the most high-profile of which is Kieren Fallon--deny conspiracy to defraud between December 2002 and September 2004 by interfering with the running of horses to ensure they lost races, defrauding Betfair online betting exchange punters and others putting money on the races.
