DECLARATION OF WAR

Most of the attention on the GI Champagne S. at Belmont centered on the rematch between **Majestic Warrior** (A.P. Indy) and **Ready's Image** (More Than Ready), but the race turned out to be about just one horse: **War Pass** (Cherokee Run). Unbeaten in two starts, War Pass took the lead coming out of the gate and never looked back as the two favorites finished sixth and eighth, respectively. "It was a tremendous effort," said trainer Nick Zito, winning his fifth Champagne trophy. "We'll try to take it as easy as we can the next three weeks [until the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile]. He should run well at Monmouth. Hopefully, things will work out. If not, we still have this big race here--the Champagne." DO NOT GO GENTLY

While the stats suggest that the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere is one for the three-year-olds, **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) has never been one to let protocol stand in his way, and the Ballydoyle bruiser enters the ring in a fierce mood at Longchamp today. Ruthlessly campaigned this term, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's flagbearer was off the blocks in April and has contested a race at the highest level in every month since. Unstoppable in the G1 Prix Ganay here Apr. 29, G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 28 and Sept. 8 G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown, he enters this clash with the sophomores with the tide of history against him. While three-year-olds Lammtarra, Dancing Brave and Mill Reef completed the King George-Arc double in the same season, it's been 39 years since an older horse achieved the feat. The last was Ballymoss (Ire), who recorded the first of Vincent O'Brien's three Arc victories during the reign of the first Ballydoyle empire. Success for Dylan Thomas would be special for those involved as the ultimate tribute to his late great sire Danehill, and would be a welcome diversion for Kieren Fallon away from his legal troubles. **Arc cont. p15-16**

'WICKED' WIRES HIS RIVALS

Unbeaten **Wicked Style** (Macho Uno) had a few strikes against him going into the GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland yesterday. The front-running colt had drawn post 12 for his two-turn bow on a surface that had been troublesome for early speed in previous Polytrack meets. But Wicked Style didn't need any excuses. The Ashbrook Farm colorbearer was pressed early before shaking loose in the lane for a 3 1/4-length score as **Slew's Tiznow** (Tiznow) chased throughout. "Most everybody takes back here, but with this colt I knew I had a chance to do it [go for the lead]," said winning rider Robby Albarado. **Cont. p3**

War Pass Wires Champagne Field cont.

Purchased by Robert LaPenta for \$180,000 at Keeneland September, War Pass was withdrawn from this year's Fasig-Tipton Calder Sale and sent to Nick Zito instead. The dark bay debuted with a hard-fought success at Saratoga July 28, then added a sharp, 5 1/2-length score in a Spa allowance Aug. 26. Both of those wins were at six panels, but War Pass had put up four straight bullet works since, and Nick Zito wasn't worried about stretching him out to this one-turn mile. "I wasn't concerned about the distance," he admitted. "The sire is [1994 sprint champion] Cherokee Run, and he's by [1982 Travers winner] Runaway Groom." Sent off as the third choice here, War Pass went straight to the lead, opening up a five-length advantage after a :22.87 opening quarter. He rolled through the turn and kept on going, finding the wire safely in front of the rallying Pyro despite a final quarter in :25.88.

Even-money Majestic Warrior, breaking from the rail, was well positioned before giving way turning for home. "He actually put me in the race," said rider Garrett Gomez. "I was where I wanted to be. But at the half-mile pole, I was out of horse. From then on, he just struggled. He's got me scratching my head." Trainer Bill Mott, whose other entrant--Z Humor--finished third, added, "I guess we'll have to get a good look at the horse and see what's going on."

Wicked Style kicked off his career with a hard-fought score going 6 1/2 furlongs at Arlington July 21. He stretched out to a one-turn mile at the Chicagoland oval for the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 1 and withstood a stiff challenge from Riley Tucker to become the first graded winner for his sire Macho Uno, the champion two-year-old of 2000. Despite drawing the far outside, Wicked Style came away running, was allowed to stroll through a half in :49.64 and kept on going, punching his ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 27 at Monmouth in the process. "The 12 hole did not bother me that much. "[Jockey] Robby [Albarado] had a lot of confidence in him," said winning trainer Rusty Arnold. "At Arlington, he got passed on the rail and came back and not too many two-year-olds can do that."

The versatile Purim ran third by 3/4 of a length over course and distance to Grade I winners Kip Deville and Showing Up in the GII

Maker's Mark Mile Apr. 13. Yesterday, the five-year-old earned his first top-level prize by outbattling Cosmonaut to the wire. While Purim is Breeders' Cup Eligible, and a Shadwell Turf Mile score is a "Win and

You're In" race, it remains to be seen whether E.J. Sukley's homebred will take his place in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Monmouth Oct. 27. "I am not one of those guys to run just to run," winning trainer Tom Amoss said. Amoss has saddled a pair of Breeders' Cup starters, upsetting the 1994 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff with One Dreamer and finishing sixth in the 2004 renewal of the same race with Indy Groove.

As a three-year-old in 2005, Purim captured the GIII Arlington Classic on turf. He added the GIII Razorback H. over Oaklawn's dirt last year, and kicked off 2007 with a victory on the lawn at Fair Grounds. After the Maker's Mark, the dark bay was unplaced in a pair of graded events, but had a confidence-boosting score in Arlington's John Henry S. Sept. 16. Dismissed here at 20-1, Purim was content to race in sixth in the early stages, then went five wide turning for home as Cosmonaut hit the front. He reeled in that rival and edged ahead in the shadow of the wire to give rider Jamie Theriot his first Grade I as well. "We had a perfect trip--I never had to steady," Theriot said. "I got him to relax and settle. 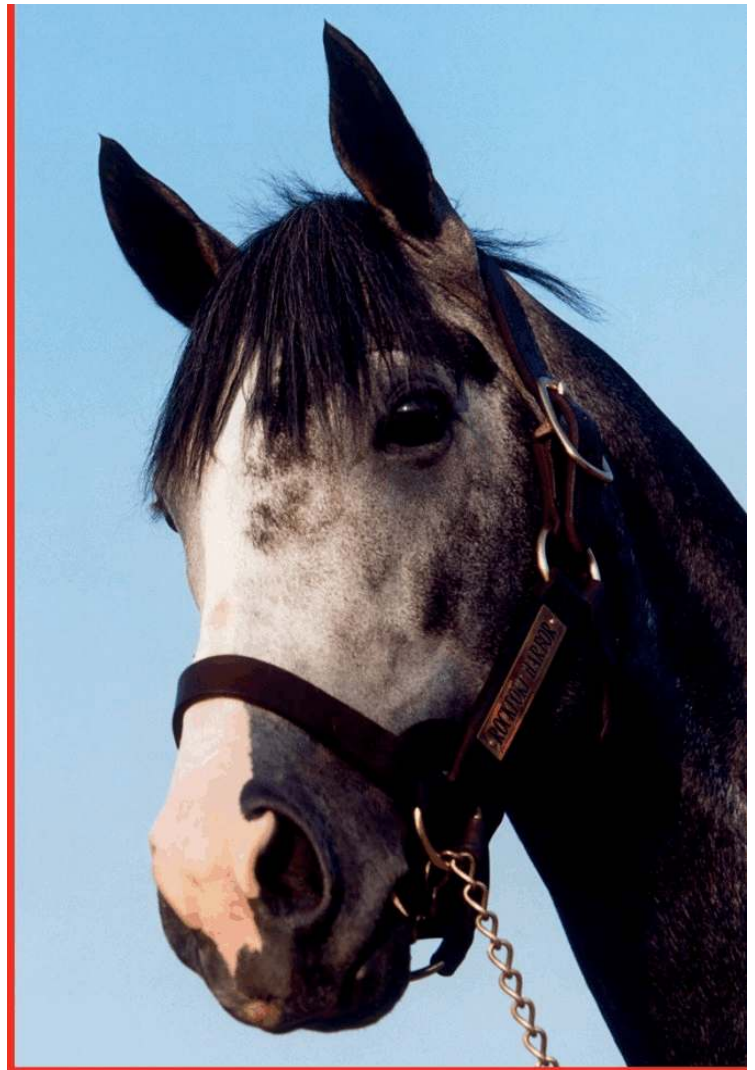

He hadn't won a race since capturing the G3 La Coupe at Longchamp in June of 2005, but Artiste Royal was ready to get his picture taken yesterday. The bay shipped across the Atlantic after his Group 3 success and was sent off at 7-2 in the 2005 edition of the GIII Arlington H., but never factored and finished sixth. Sidelined for nine months after that start, he had a solid seven-race campaign last year, earning three seconds and three thirds while racing exclusively in graded company. The Irish-bred came closest to victory

when finishing third, a half-length behind The Tin Man, in last year's running of this race. He followed up with a second in the GIII Carleton F. Burke H. in October before ending the season by filling the show spot in the Dec. 9 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. Artiste Royal had blinkers on during his last four appearances of 2006, but made a belated 2007 debut sans the hood in an optional claimer at Del Mar Sept. 2 and was steadied late en route to yet another third-place finish. Sporting head gear once again yesterday, he stalked the pace while racing off the fence early. The 5-1 chance engaged 3-5 chalk The Tin Man at the top of the lane, got his head in front at the eighth pole and edged clear. Looking ahead, trainer Neil Drysdale said, "We hope this horse will be invited to the Japan Cup [G1, Nov. 24]. That's what's in the cards. 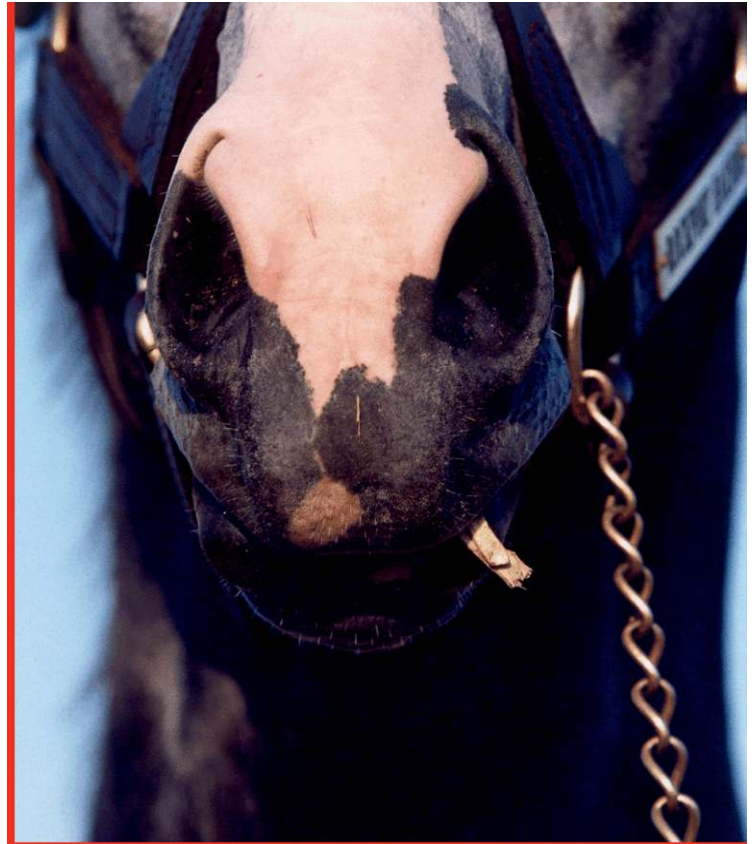

Majestic Roi arrived on the scene when beating Indian Ink (Ire) in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury Apr. 21, but sidestepped the Classics, then finished second in the G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly June 3 in her comeback. Seventh behind old foe Indian Ink in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22, the chestnut ran fifth in the G3 Oak Tree S. at Goodwood next time Aug. 3, and she endured a troubled trip when a last-out fourth in the Listed Sceptre S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. Unconsidered by the majority of punters for this return to the highest level, she proved her doubters wrong as she pounced late for a career high. Majestic Roi was reserved in seventh along the rail off a solid pace set by Speciosa (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), and eased nearer the front rank from halfway. Pushed along with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining, she would not be denied under a determined drive and collared Nannina in the dying strides. "The key to this filly is she needs a very good pace, and she got that today courtesy of Speciosa," revealed jockey Darryll Holland, who curtailed a losing run of 43 rides at the track with the win. "She really deserved that, as she's been running in top-class company most of the year. We got a bit close [to Nannina], but she was very brave at the finish. [Trainer] Mick [Channon] told me she wasn't an outsider, and to ride her as if she was the best filly in the race." Runner-up Nannina will retire to the paddocks after another commendable effort. "She ran a blinder and that's her last race," said trainer John Gosden. "I've never had her looking so well or eating so well and she's been in tremendous form. She's won the G1 Fillies' Mile as a two-year-old, the G1 Coronation S. as a three-year-old and the G2 Windsor Forest S. at four. There's not many fillies who do that." For owner **Baron Georg von Ullmann**, the emotions were hard to keep at bay. "He is my baby," the Baron said. "He is such a pleasure to be around, and this is nice compensation for the injury to **Manduro**. I thought after he won so easily last time we should give it a go, as he was doing so well and we had nothing to lose. I don't know what we will do with him now--this is really a dream come true."

In the aftermath of her success in the G1 Prix de l'Opera on this undercard 12 months ago, it was hard to conceive of **Mandesha (Fr)** (Desert Style {Ire}) enduring a four-year-old campaign without success at the top level. However, Princess Zahra Aga Khan's champion three-year-old filly looked less than straightforward when second in both the June 24 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 4. Following a third consecutive runner-up placing behind the now-retired Manduro (Ger) in the Sept. 16 G2 Prix Foy, she will be tried in cheekpieces in a bid to reignite the fire. She faces a stiff task, as only Urban Sea has broken the male deadlock since 1983, and no vanquished Prix Foy runner has triumphed since Subotica (Fr) in 1992.

The Outsiders cont.

Star Appeal (Ire) succeeded for Germany in 1975, and Stall Avena's June 3 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly and Aug. 12 G1 Rheinland-Pokal hero **Saddex (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) is no back-number. Jaber Abdullah's **Youmzain (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) was four lengths second to Dylan Thomas in the King George before a disappointing fourth in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden on his last outing Sept. 2, but trainer Mick Channon is taking a sporting view. "Last time on that fast ground things didn't go right and Richard Hughes said he wished he could have ridden the race again," Channon explained. "He hasn't had much racing and, if the others don't perform, he can pick up the pieces as he's in great heart." Last year's G1 Epsom Derby runner-up **Dragon Dancer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) belatedly broke his maiden in the Listed August S. at Windsor Aug. 25 before finishing third in the Prix Foy, and jockey Darryll Holland is not without hope. "He had lost his way since the Derby, but I thought he ran quite well in the trail last time," Holland said. "If he's in the first six, I'll be happy."

When we put them on him at Saratoga, he went that first half-mile in :46 3/5 and I was saying, 'Damn, [jockey Mike] Luzzi, slow down,' but then I realized it was just a different horse that day." McLaughlin opted to keep the Shadwell colt close to home. "We thought about running either here or in the [GII] Indiana Derby [at Hoosier], but we decided that the Jerome was a much more prestigious race," McLaughlin added. "He has great stallion value. We would love to keep going forward and get him a Grade I. If that doesn't happen this fall, hopefully, we'll have a real good four-year-old next year." **Vitruvius**, a half-brother to Corinthian, missed most of the spring and summer with a lingering skin problem. Though the dark bay lost his unbeaten record in his Sept. 1 return at the Spa, finishing second by a half-length to **Owners Manual**, trainer Jimmy Jerkens has been schooling the colt in the paddock in hopes of getting him to relax as he steps up in class. "The family has always been very strange," Jerkens said. "You can't really get a line on them because they always keep you guessing. I've got a full sister to Corinthian that'll just drive you berserk. Vitruvius is edgy, and his engine is always running."

It was Shadwell who had the final say yesterday, coming in with a high bid of €665,000. From the draft of Jean-Claude Rouget, the four-year-old was eighth in yesterday's G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp. He was the subject of intense demand before being knocked down to Laurent Benoit's organisation for €410,000. Two lots brought €280,000 yesterday. The first was Jean-Pierre Dubois' juvenile filly **Super Nana (Fr)** (Anabaa), a winning half-sister to 2003 G2 Prix Noailles winner and G1 Prix Lupin and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club runner-up Super Celebre (Fr), who was bought by Sean Tiernan's Peak Bloodstock. Dubai-based trainer Erwan Charpy went to the same level to secure the four-year-old colt **Doubnov (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}). Runner-up in the Listed Grand Prix du Sud-Ouest at Bordeaux-le-Bouscat last month for the Rouget stable, the grey is likely to be a player in the 2008 Dubai Spring Carnival. There was also a blast from the past in the sale, as hip 38, Michael Tabor's 2005 G1 Epsom Derby runner-up **Walk in the Park (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), was sold to Marc Semirrot for €195,000 following a disappointing recent try over hurdles. While the average of €122,429 did not suffer greatly, dropping just four percent thanks to the big-money purchases that highlighted the evening, the median of €80,000 represented a 30-percent decrease from last year. 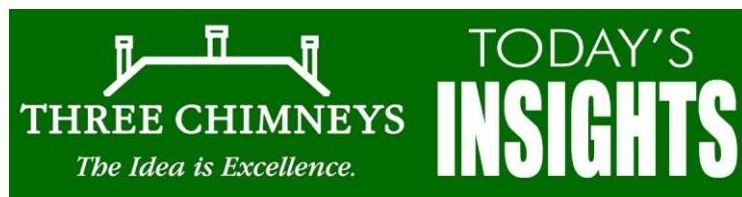
