July 7--the five-year-old may have had excuses when trailing that pair in York's G1 Juddmonte International S. on his last start Aug. 21. "Hopefully, he didn't give his very best form last time, as he got a very deep overreach coming out of the stalls," explained trainer

Sir Michael Stoute. "Good ground is ideal, but if it is a little softer that won't inconvenience him. He just doesn't want it rock-hard, as he is heavy-topped with some mileage." Stoute is seeking his third Champion trophy, having saddled Pilsudski (Ire) in 1997 and Kalanisi (Ire), who upset Montjeu (Ire) in 2000. **Cont. p6-7**

DERBY WINNER ARRIVES SAFELY

Jim Tafel's **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) arrived at Monmouth Park early Friday morning. The G1 Kentucky Derby hero was vanned over from Churchill Downs. He is scheduled to breeze Tuesday. "He shipped well and he looks great," trainer Carl Nafzger said. "Barring any unforeseen circumstances, he'll breeze Tuesday morning." Last season's G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner heads to the Classic following a second-place finish to **Hard Spun** (Danzig) in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic S. at Turfway Sept. 29.

SHORE DO WORKS

Shore Do (Include), who is pre-entered in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile and the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, worked five furlongs in 1:02 at Monmouth Park yesterday. He galloped out six furlongs in 1:15. "It was exactly the way we wanted him to go," trainer Chuck Peery said. "I think getting here early and having a work over the track will help us out on Saturday. I really didn't want him to do more than that. Don't squeeze the lemon dry." Shore Do was last seen finishing third in the G1 Norfolk S. at Oak Tree Sept. 30.

JAZZY TUNES UP FOR F&M SPRINT

Team Valor's **Jazzy (Arg)** (Mutakddim), heroine of the GII Gallant Bloom H. Sept. 22, prepped for the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint with a four-furlong workout in :48.45 at Belmont Park Friday. "She worked wonderfully and finished up nicely," trainer Mark Hennig said. The inaugural F/M Sprint figures to set up well for the stretch runner. "You don't know how the track will play at Monmouth in the fall," Hennig continued. "Obviously, during the summer, it's very tough to come from far back."

MCLAUGHLIN DUO BREEZE AT BELMONT

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin sent out Breeders' Cup hopefuls **Lear's Princess** (Lear Fan) and **Lahudood (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) for breezes at Belmont Park yesterday. Lear's Princess, off since annexing the GI Gazelle S. over GI Belmont S. heroine Rags to Riches Sept. 15, covered four furlongs in :50.04. "She looked good [Friday] morning," McLaughlin said of the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff pre-entrant. "She was well within herself, and now she'll just gallop into the race." Lahudood prepped for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf with a five-furlong workout in 1:00.14. "She's very keen in the mornings," McLaughlin said of GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. victress. "You would think Lear's Princess is running on the turf and Lahudood on the dirt."


CORINTHIAN LOOKS READY FOR DIRT MILE

Corinthian (Pulpit), winner of the prestigious GI Metropolitan H., worked a sharp six furlongs in 1:11.75 over the Belmont Park training track yesterday. The Centennial Farms' colorbearer heads to the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile following a pair of disappointing efforts in the GI Suburban H. June 30 and the GI Woodward S. Sept. 1. "He looked strong all the way," trainer Jimmy Jerkens said of Friday's workout. Corinthian will ship to Monmouth Monday. "When he ships, he gets all keyed up because he thinks he's running that day," Jerkens continued. "This way he'll have plenty of time to settle, and we'll get to school him in the paddock a couple times if we want."

Godolphin's **Ibn Khaldun** (Dubai Destination) will skip the inaugural \$1-million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in favor of the G1 Racing Post Trophy S. at Doncaster Oct. 27, according to published reports. The chestnut colt posted a victory in the G3 Autumn S. at Ascot last out Oct. 13. Regular rider Frankie Dettori, however, will be at Monmouth for the World Championships.

'KEY' WORKS AT SANTA ANITA

Breeders' Cup hopefuls **Nashoba's Key** (Silver Hawk), **Bordonaro** (Memo {Chi}) and **Greg's Gold** (Lake George) turned in workouts at Santa Anita yesterday. Nashoba's Key, unbeaten in seven career attempts, posted a five-furlong move in 1:00.80. Pre-entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, she was last seen annexing the GI Yellow Ribbon S. Sept. 29. "It was a perfect work," trainer Carla Gaines said. "She doesn't need to do a lot. She's in good shape and ready to go." Bordonaro, fourth in the GI Ancient Title S. Oct. 7, geared up for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with a five-furlong move in :58.80. Greg's Gold completed six furlongs in 1:10.80. The Ancient Title runner-up is also pre-entered in the Sprint. "He did it very easy," trainer David Hofmans said of Greg's Gold. "He finished up well and that's his last work. He'll run in the Breeders' Cup off of that work."

Taking on champion Dreaming of Anna in the Sept. 8 GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington, the bay held her own, completing the trifecta at odds of 13-1. Overlooked a bit here, she raced in fifth through fractions of :48.66 and 1:13.36. With Mark Guidry aboard, Bel Air Beauty rallied five wide and took it convincingly.

Having signed off his last campaign with a head second to stable companion Stage Gift (Ire) in this race 12 months ago, the chestnut put in a respectable effort on his first subsequent start when third behind Kirklees (Ire) in Goodwood's Listed Foundation S. last time Sept. 26. He raced prominently throughout the early stages here and was narrowly in front with three furlongs remaining. The five-year-old found more when challenged by the barn's favored Blue Ksar and Mashaahed on either side in the final yards. "Windsor Knot came out of his Goodwood race well and I was very pleased with his performance," said Saeed bin Suroor. "He battled well, and deserved towina Group 3." It will be a case of *deja vu* as Jim Bolger saddles the unbeaten **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) 12 months after winning this prize with the star-crossed Teofilo (Ire). Like that eventual champion, New Approach has Leopardstown's July 28 G3 Tyros S. and The Curragh's Aug. 25 G2 Futurity S. and Sept. 16 G1 National S. already in the bag.

He claimed the scalps of the subsequent impressive G2 Beresford S. victor Curtain Call (Fr) and G2 Coventry S. hero Henrythenavigator on the first occasion, while Godolphin's **Rio de la Plata** (Rahy) and the G1 Prix Morny hero Myboycharlie (Ire) were left trailing in his wake on his latest outing. His front-running style suggests a possible vulnerability, but his conditioner is quick to downplay that significance. "We are not worried about the pace," Bolger told *sportinglife.com*. "He doesn't have to lead, it doesn't matter to us how the race is run. He is the best I've seen of the two-year-olds." Rio de la Plata has since taken Longchamp's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere Oct. 7, and a decision on his participation will be left to the last minute.

"We don't want the ground to be soft for Rio de la Plata, but he has come out of his last race at Longchamp very well," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "I was pleased with his work on Wednesday, and he looks fresh, happy and healthy. He's a very tough horse and always tries his best. This race will be very tough, against some very good horses, but we're looking for him to win."

Catherine Corbett and Christopher Wright's **Dark Angel (Ire)** (Acclamation {GB}) is treading the same path as Lujain, the last winner of the G1 Middle Park S. to attempt the follow-up here. Finding the extra stamina for this test has proved difficult, with Diesis (GB) the last to complete the double in 1982, but trainer Barry Hills has saddled three winners since Scenic (Ire) dead-headed in 1988. Mark Johnston, who scored with Shamardal three years ago, puts forward Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's eye-catching G2 Champagne S. winner **McCartney (Ger)** (In the Wings {GB}), a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆. He should appreciate the underfoot conditions, and his trainer is hopeful he can upstage the bigger names. "It looks a cracking race on paper and he should run a huge race," Johnston told *PA Sport*. "We haven't ducked the issue and it looks very tough; it couldn't look much tougher frankly, but he's very much entitled to be there. His Champagne S. win could not have been more impressive, and conditions look like being spot-on for him."

Jean-Claude Rouget sends across the latter, and the grey has solid claims on the best of his three-year-old form. Following his success in Longchamp's G3 Prix La Force Apr. 15, he split Lawman (Fr) and Shamdinan (Fr) when runner-up in the June 3 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly before beating the useful Spirit One (Fr) in Deauville's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano Aug. 18. Having added the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at the Bois de Boulogne last time Sept. 22, Literato is primed for a spot of international pillaging. "We have had this race as a target for some time, as this is the right race for him to try a Group 1," Rouget said. "Every time he runs, he comes from behind--he has fantastic acceleration. He has never run against older horses before and it will not be very easy for him, but we have nothing to lose. He gives his best every time and is a very courageous horse." Remarkably, Godolphin have yet to win this prize, but their recent acquisition **Creachadoir** could put matters right. Campaigned by Jim Bolger to finish runner-up in both the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 13 and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh 13 days later, he was off the board in the June 19 G1 St James's Palace S. on his last start for the Coolcullen conditioner at Royal Ascot. Off the mark on his first outing in the royal blue in the G3 Joel S. here Oct. 6, he needs to prove his stamina over this extra quarter mile. "There is a question mark about him staying the 10 furlongs, but Creachadoir worked well on Tuesday and he is in good form," Saeed bin Suroor commented. Henry Cecil, who saddled the fillies Indian Skimmer and Bosra Sham to win this in 1988 and 1996, respectively, relies on the Niarchos Family's **Multidimensional**. Injured when being trained for this race 12 months ago, the homebred had previously shown his prowess in winning the 2006 renewal of the Guillaume d'Ornano. He returned successfully off a long layoff in a conditions event at Newbury last time Sept. 22 and, after a subsequent gallop on this track, is as near to fever-pitch as his trainer can get him. "I'm very happy with him and the ground is perfect," Cecil explained.

"The only reservation I have is that he hasn't much racing experience against seasoned, hardened horses, but he stays and has a good turn of foot, so if he puts it together I think he'll run very well," Cecil continued. "I've been trying to catch a train with him all year, and I think I've got there."

Two winners have defied a penalty since 1998, and Cesare bids to overcome the extra burden this time. Following his success in Ascot's G2 Summer Mile July 14, he was runner-up to the subsequent G1 Matron S. heroine Echelon (GB) in the Aug. 25 G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood, and just over a length behind Ramonti (Fr) when fourth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. back at Ascot last time Sept. 29. "He had no luck whatsoever at Longchamp when taking on Group 2 company for the first time, but did not have a hard race and came home in very good order," Cumani explained. "He is in great form at the moment, fresh and well, so I am hopeful he can continue to progress in this better company." Jeremy Noseda relies on Arabian Gleam and Mac Love, first and fifth, respectively, in Doncaster's G2 Park S. last time Sept. 15. Of the former, his trainer commented, "This has been his aim since his win at Doncaster. He is in good order and, ideally, we would like good ground. He should be very competitive, but it will be tough for him carrying a four-pound penalty in a race such as this."

October 20, 1923...Zev, winner of the 1923 Kentucky Derby, defeated English hero **Papyrus**, winner of the 1923 Epsom Derby, in a \$100,000 match race at Belmont Park. The race, called the International Special, marked the first time an English champion was sent to the U.S. to race. Public interest was so great the race was broadcast on the radio--a first.

October 21, 1961...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** won the Jockey Club Gold Cup for a record 10th time, riding the great Kelso to victory at Belmont Park. Winner of the race in 1960 as well, Kelso went on to take the race in '62, '63 and '64, setting the mark for most consecutive victories in a stakes race.

To qualify as a 'B Runner' (third and fourth percent earners from runners), a horse needed to make about \$75,000 in North America in 2006, or GBP 30,000 in Britain/Ireland, or E40,000 in France. Category leader Precise End had the advantage of New York-bred purses and was snapped up by the Yoshida family to replace his sire, End Sweep, in Japan when the latter died. Danzig, Distorted Humor and Storm Cat are among the top seven sires in this category, but the two moderately-priced nuggets the figures unearth are Vinery's second-ranked Brahms (3.14), who stood for just \$8,500 in 2007; and the Irish National Stud's Verglas, who had his first Irish yearlings this year after a very successful start with his first four crops in France. Maryland's leading sire, Not For Love, is among the top 10 both for B Runner Index, and Number of B Runners. You don't see that very often. -Bill Oppenheim.

All post times in the TDN are listed as local time
