**WEATHERING THE STORM AT MONMOUTH**

The sun was shining on Monmouth Park last Saturday, and there are nothing but clear skies in the forecast this Sunday, but it looks like the umbrellas will be out in force over the two days of the Breeders' Cup

World Championships. The blacksmiths will have their work cut out making sure that every runner is equipped with the proper footwear, there is little that trainers can do other than make educated guesses as to how their charges will handle the off going. Todd Pletcher does not believe the give in the ground will be a benefit for GI Turf runner **English Channel** (Smart Strike). "I don't think soft turf is going to help him at all, but the course here is not cut up," Pletcher said. "They haven't been running on it, and the races are off the turf [Thursday]. We'll have to wait and see how the course plays." GI Distaff hopeful **Lear's Princess** (Lear Fan) has never raced in the mud, but Kieran McLaughlin is not worried. "She has won on Polytrack, on turf and on dirt," said McLaughlin. "She can run over anything, so I say 'let it rain'." Carl Nafzger, who saddles **Lady Joanne** (Orientate) in the Distaff and **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Classic, isn't ready to make any predictions as to how his charges will perform if the track is muddy. "Ask me on Saturday [night]" Nafzger said. "I will know the answer then."

**DIXIE CHATTER, ATILA'S STORM OUT OF CUP**

Breeders' Cup hopefuls **Dixie Chatter** (Dixie Union) and **Attila's Storm** (Forest Wildcat) have both been declared from Saturday's championship card. Dixie Chatter, a leading contender in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile after winning the GI Norfolk S., was withdrawn from the race with an elevated temperature. "He had a little temperature last night and still this morning," explained trainer Richard Mandella. "It ain't what we came here for, but we've seen this movie before. We've got to err on the side of caution. Hopefully, he'll be able to fly back [to California] Monday." Attila's Storm, aiming for his third straight appearance in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, was withdrawn from the race with an ankle injury. "He has some filling in [his left front ankle] and was a little sore this morning," explained trainer Richard Schosberg. "The digital X-rays didn't show us anything. It's nothing major, but he's not 100 percent. We are the protectors of these horses, and there's no way I could even consider running him. It's unfortunate."

### DYLAN THOMAS CONTINUES TO IMPROVE

"He's an amazing horse, really," trainer Aidan O'Brien said of G1 Arc de Triomphe winner **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill). "Every race he's bounced out better than the one before. He seems to be in good form." That can

only be bad news for the other seven starters in tomorrow's G1 Breeders' Cup Turf. The four-year-old is a six-time Group 1 winner and has been keeping top company since his juvenile season. "He just keeps getting stronger and stronger, physically and mentally," O'Brien said. "He's been an amazing horse. Since he's been two, he's done that, he's

come forward all the time." In eight starts this year, Dylan Thomas has won the Arc, the G1 Prix Ganay, G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. and G1 Irish Champion S., and he was second in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup S., G1 Prince of Wales's S. and G1 Juddmonte International S. "We've never had a horse like this one," O'Brien said. "He's run in Group 1s every month of the year. He got beat in three races and, in my own mind, I could have seen reasons for how he could have won the three. That's a very special horse. With each month, every week he's come forward and forward and forward. He's just turning into the ultra-professional." O'Brien is confident Dylan Thomas, whose namesake was born on Oct. 27, 1914, is ready to run a big race as the 7-5 Turf favorite. "You don't know what's going to happen until you run the horse, but we're very happy with where we are at this stage."

### NASHOBA'S KEY SETTLES IN

**Nashoba's Key** (Silver Hawk), contesting in the F&M Turf, got her first look at Monmouth Park Thursday morning after being flown east from California Wednesday. The California-bred, undefeated in seven starts, appeared alert and curious as she peered out of a stall in Barn 6 before jogging on the main track under exercise rider Tony Rubalcava.

Nashoba's Key was also accompanied by foreman Gustavo Benitez and Gary Parker, a friend of trainer Carla Gaines. "She's exceptionally content," Parker said of the filly with a reputation of being nasty. "Usually she tries to bite your arm off. She's like a kid at Disneyland looking at all the rides going around." Nashoba's Key, who has never

raced outside California, was aboard a plane for the first time and appeared to arrive in good order. With rain in the forecast for today and tomorrow, Nashoba's Key will be making her first start over a soft turf course. However, Parker did not seem worried about the surface after the filly displayed versatility in winning over firm turf and two brands of synthetic, Cushion Track and Polytrack. "We think she can win over anything," said Parker. Gaines and owner/breeder Warren Williamson were scheduled to fly in from California Thursday night.

### NEW EQUIPMENT FOR ALL MY LOVING

**All My Loving** (Sadler's Wells), who is slated to contest Saturday's F&M Turf, will be equipped with blinkers for the 1 3/8-mile event. Third in her latest start in the Listed Finale S. at The Curragh Oct. 21, the bay wore blinkers when ninth as the favorite in the Oct. 6 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp, but did not have them on in last Sunday's race. "Even last week she was third and we thought she might win," said trainer Aidan O'Brien. "[Seamus Heffernan], who rode her, just felt she was very idle, very lazy. That's why we put the visor on her, to sharpen her up." O'Brien added, "We're coming and she was entered. She's going to be retired to stud after this. We've got nothing to lose with here. She's a big, sound filly."

**TIMARWA BOUNCES BACK FROM MINOR SETBACK**

Trainer John Oxx was in attendance Thursday morning as jockey Michael Kinane gave The Aga Khan's **Timarwa (Ire)** (Daylami {Ire}) a canter on the Monmouth Park turf course. "She had a little setback when she arrived, a colic Monday morning, but she was better by the afternoon," Oxx related. "We restricted her food for 24 hours. She looks a little light, but she's not doing any work here and she's improved day by day. "It's the first time it's happened to me, but I hear the charters where they ship a lot of stallions around they often have a problem with colics. She's never had one before. Oxx continued, "She's very consistent. She won her last [G3 Denny Cordell Lavarack S., Oct. 5] and got boxed in the one post before that over [Irish Stallion S. at nine furlongs, Aug. 19]. She'll like the step up to [11 furlongs]. Her form is just behind the best, and we're hoping with the step up in distance and this ground, if she produces her best form she could run a respectable race," he added. "This track is what we call 'yielding' at home [Ireland], so we could take a little more rain, but not like what she was running on in the Irish Oaks...that was bottomless. As for the four-year-old's future, Oxx added, "She's going to Kentucky to be bred after this, so this is a last fling."

**STOUTE TIGHTENS SCREWS ON JEREMY**

Sir Michael Stoute's hope for a fourth Breeders' Cup victory--**Jeremy** (Danehill Dancer {Ire})--was on the Monmouth Park turf course for a blowout Thursday morning under jockey Frankie Dettori. "He just did a quick, two-furlong sprint," the charismatic Italian reported after dismounting from the four-year-old. The clockers caught the half mile move in :53 seconds with the dogs well out from the rail. "The ground is on the slow side of good," said Dettori. "If it's like this on Saturday, it will be fine for everybody. I was on the outside of the track this morning and the bends are very sharp, but apart from that, it's no different to any other American track. The bends are well cambered. I'm not going to make a prediction, but the horse seems to be in good order and we'll give it a go. It's the Breeders' Cup...it's always tough."

**WYGOD IN FOR BREEDERS' CUP**

The California wildfires came within a half-mile of his home in Rancho Santa Fe, but owner/breeder Martin Wygod was able to make the cross-country trip for the Breeders' Cup. Wygod will be represented GI Sprint runner **Idiot Proof** (Benchmark) and GI Mile hopeful **After Market** (Storm Cat). "I flew into New York City late [Wednesday] night and will be at Monmouth [Friday] morning," Wygod said, adding, "We could use some of this rain in California." As for his nerve-wracking experience on the West Coast, he said, "We evacuated three days ago. I slept in a beach house in Del Mar. We put four families into it. Eight houses burned in Rancho Santa Fe, the closest five blocks away." Wygod moved four riding horses from his estate to the fairgrounds at Del Mar, and 20 racehorses from San Luis Rey Downs Training Center to Fairplex Park in Pomona. "The winds fanning the fires were blowing at 50 miles an hour," he explained. "I couldn't take a chance with the horses at San Luis Rey. I've never seen anything like this. I saw the pictures on television and got every horse away as far as possible. A lot of people are going to need a lot of help."



**SUCCESS LONG IN THE MAKING FOR JONES**

Trainer Larry Jones has become a household name this year thanks to the exploits of Classic hopeful **Hard Spun** (Danzig), but his success has been a long time in the making.

Jones was a commercial farmer in Kentucky, growing corn tobacco and soy beans and raising cattle and hogs when he first entered racing as an owner in 1980. Two years later, he took out his trainer's license.

"I thought I could train as well as my trainer was," Jones explained.

Jones felt his experience with show horses provided him with enough knowledge to train racehorses, but he did have one concern.

"I had worked with horses all my life, showed horses, and all of that, so there was no reason that I didn't think I could train," he said. "I just didn't know if I had the time because I was farming full time. And I didn't know that I could donate all of my time to training horses, but thank goodness in the late '70s farming was so bad, there was no reason not to try."

Training in the early '80s for Jones was probably not much better.

"We struggled for many years," he confirmed. "I think the first year I was training horses, I made \$3,300, then \$7,500 the second year and \$11,000 the third. The fourth year, I kicked up to \$20,000 on the year--so we were on a roll."

Jones won his first stakes race with Capt. Bold in 1986 at Ellis Park, but the graded stakes didn't start coming for another 17 years. He trained 2003 GII Fantasy S. winner Ruby's Reception and 2004 GII Raven Run S. winner Josh's Madelyn before capturing his first Grade I victory when Island Sand won the GI Acorn S. in 2005. He has also trained 2006 GI Prioress Breeders' Cup S. winner Wildcat Bettie B and 2006 GII Nassau County Breeders' Cup S. heroine Hello Liberty.

**THROWING DOWN THE GAUNTLET**

*Front-running GI Champagne hero War Pass and the speedy maiden winner Globalization will hook up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and both trainers are set on sending their colts to the lead.*

**Trainer Nick Zito (War Pass-Juvenile):**

"I think we have no options but to just keep the same strategy. He's been undefeated going to the lead, so that's what we want to do. I think he's the fastest horse in the race and hopefully no one has a \$2 million rabbit in there. If they want to use their horses and set it up from some other guy coming from behind, so be it. But I don't think anybody has got his speed and if they test him, they're going to melt. He may melt, but they're going to melt, too."

**Trainer Rick Violette Jr. (Globalization-Juvenile):**

"I think we'll end up putting War Pass between a rock and a hard place. I'm not sure they want to go head-to-head with a 30-1 shot. They're going to have to make that choice."

"It was very lean and it was lean for a long time, but we've been very blessed and fortunate that things have turned around," Jones said. "We got a few people's attention that had some better horses, and they kept feeding us a few at a time and it's worked. It has done very well."

That success reached a crescendo this year with Hard Spun. Second in the GI Kentucky Derby and third in the GI Preakness S., Hard Spun won the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga and comes into the Classic off a victory over Street Sense in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic.

So it might seem that Jones is an instant sensation, but it has been a long while in the making.

"I've had some people tell me, 'You're a 27-year overnight sensation,'" Jones laughed. "It's been a long road, but it's been a gradual improvement all the time and it's been good."

And things could get better Saturday when Jones saddles Hard Spun as an 8-1 shot in the Classic.

The 13-year-old stallion will stand for \$2,500 live foal. Partner's Hero formerly stood at Northview Stallion Station in Chesapeake City, Maryland. "We are very excited to have a horse like Partner's Hero in Pennsylvania," said Castle Rock proprietor Peter Giangiulio. "He's the best stallion in Pennsylvania. He's for real--producing runners and graded stakes horses--and has the numbers to show what he can do." The seven-year-old stallion stood his first season this year at Double Diamond Farm. Sabre d'Argent won the 2003 G3 Rose of Lancaster S. and was third in the 2006 GIII Fort Marcy H. He is a half brother to Exchange Rate. "We are very excited about the addition of Sabre d'Argent to our stallion roster," said George Isaacs, general manager of Bridlewood. "With the proven success of his half-brother, Exchange Rate, and the huge influence that the legendary Kris S. had on the breed internationally, we feel he offers a tremendous opportunity to Florida breeders." Sabre d'Argent will remain at \$5,000 live foal for the 2008 season.

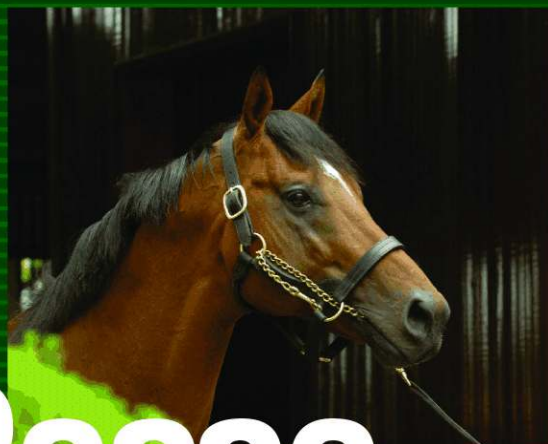
