NO SHORE THINGS IN BREEDERS' CUP XXIV

The world's best Thoroughbreds have assembled for the 24th running of the Breeders' Cup World Championships, but not one of the 90 horses entered for today's eight races rates as a slam dunk.

Not **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr), the 5-2 morning line favorite in the \$5-million Classic. The GI Whitney H. and GI Woodward S. hero must convince the public that he can reproduce his Saratoga form at this track and that he can relax enough to stay today's 10-furlong distance with other speed signed on. **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Travers S. victor, enters the race in top form, but will his late-running style play well over a traditionally speed-favoring surface? **Curlin** (Smart Strike) beat Street Sense in the GI Preakness S. and Lawyer Ron in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, but ran a subpar race when third behind **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) in Monmouth's GI Haskell Invitational S. in August and has to prove his agility around this tight-turning circuit. Ireland's **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, is the heaviest chalk on the morning line at 7-5, but horses victorious in the Longchamp feature are winless in four subsequent tries in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Sakhee (Ire) won the Arc and just missed in the 2001 Classic. **Nashoba's Key** (Silver Hawk) is perfect in seven career starts, but has never traversed the 11-furlong distance of the GI Filly and Mare Turf, nor has she faced a field with such depth. **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet) ran a hole in the wind to take the GI Forego S. in September, but how will he handle three-quarters of a mile and a gaggle of speedy foes as the favorite in the GI Sprint? **Excellent Art (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) is one of Europe's pre-eminent milers and has been installed the 3-1 favorite, but jockey John Murtagh will have to carve out a trip from the 12 hole in the GI Mile. **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy) is the slight favorite in the GI Distaff, but has seven other Grade I winners to beat, while the GI Juvenile and GI Juvenile Fillies have what appear to be beatable favorites in the form of **War Pass** (Cherokee Run) and **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie). Who will get the job done? Tune in and find out.

H. in March, and, more importantly, in the GI Metropolitan Mile H. at Belmont Park in May. His march to an Eclipse was derailed, however, with a pair of subpar performances, including a last-of-six effort in the GI Suburban H. at Belmont Park June 30 and a distant fourth-place finish behind Lawyer Ron in the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga Sept. 1. Arguably more than any other horse racing this weekend, Corinthian had a whole lot to prove and he did just that yesterday, demolishing an accomplished field in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile.

A Perfect Trip...

Gottcha Gold (Coronado's Quest) made the early lead, chased by **Wanderin Boy** (Seeking the Gold) and favored **Discreet Cat** (Forestry), who ducked out sharply on the turn in an effort to achieve a stalking position. In the meantime, Corinthian was enjoying the run of the race, glued to the inside before commencing a middle move nearing the far turn. Still inside around that bend, the chestnut was eased out at the quarter pole and put the race to rest in a matter of strides, strolling home a much-the-best winner. "Really terrific," said trainer Jimmy Jerkens, represented by his second Breeders' Cup winner (Artie Schiller, Mile, 2005). "He's been training great, but his last two races were sub par, so it was hard to get overly confident. [Jockey] Kent [Desormeaux] rode him beautifully. That was the plan, to try to tuck him in. Discreet Cat Fails to Fire...

Looking for his first win since taking last year's GI Cigar Mile, Discreet Cat was sent off the 3-2 favorite by the betting public. Well-placed for the opening six panels, the attractive bay colt had no answer for Corinthian's winning move and actually did well to be third. "I was having to work with him to get him off the bridle," said his rider Garrett Gomez. "He was a little keen with me. Once I got him outside, he was nice and relaxed and traveling well. About the half-mile pole when I needed horse, he just kind of stayed. I thought he was completely done. I just kept scrubbing away, and he hung on and run third for us.

Well-Traveled Mare Makes Good...

The bay climbed the ranks after being claimed in her first start at five, beating \$40,000 platers in her first start under new management and taking an overnight sprint stakes in her second outing in the navy and gold colors. Maryfield hit the board in four of her next six starts, running second by a nose in the GII A Gleam H. at Hollywood and by two lengths in the GIII Seaway S. at Woodbine, before ending the year with a victory in the Very Subtle S. on the 2006 Breeders' Cup undercard at Churchill Downs in November. Her 2007 campaign did not start out so well--the rangy Canadian-bred was off the board in five of her first six outings this term--but she did overcome a troubled trip to take the Mar. 24 GII Distaff BC H. at Aqueduct. Eighth in the May 5 GI Humana Distaff at Churchill and fourth in the July 7 GI Princess Rooney H. at Calder, she finally broke through at the highest level when returning to New York to take the GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga Aug. 26. The veteran finished fast on the far outside to take that test by a nose, and she used the same tactics yesterday to rally her way into the millionaires' club. "I have to thank Elvis Trujillo," said O'Neill, winning a Breeders' Cup race for the third consecutive year (Stevie Wonderboy, 2005; Thor's Echo, 2006). It was the first-ever mount on Championship Day for Trujillo. "He rode her like he's won 20 Breeders' Cups already. He was so confident, so cool and so relaxed. This is a really a thrill." The top two finishers will now head to Kentucky to join the Taylor Made consignment for the Fasig-Tipton November sale Nov. 4

Speed Fades on Sloppy Track...

Dream Rush (Wild Rush) was made the 3-1 second choice and, despite the wealth of speed in the race, trainer Rick Violette Jr. and jockey Eibar Coa opted to send the three-year-old filly right to the front. With **La Traviata** (Johannesburg), the 2-1 favorite, tracking from second, she splashed through a quarter in :21.29 and a half in :44.19 and still had the lead as they dashed past the eighth pole. But the bay faded in the final furlong and finished fifth. "Forty-four flat, well, she can handle that," Violette said. "I just don't think she loved the track. Eibar said she just didn't give him the same feel as on a fast track. What are you going to do? It's an outdoor game. She leaves next week for Kentucky. She's going to be offered at the Fasig-Tipton November sale. You can buy her."

The inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf attracted a trio of horses from well-known and successful overseas outfits, including Aidan O'Brien, Jeremy Noseda and Dermot Weld. But in the end, it was **Nownownow** (Whywhywhy), a horse trained in this country, owned and bred by a Parisian and trained by his fellow countryman who stole the show with a perfectly timed last-to-first move from another

Dirt to Turf...

Nownownow made his debut over the Keeneland Polytrack Apr. 6 and acquitted himself well, running second to a talented filly in Yogi's splash of gold in a 4 1/2-furlong event. He rounded out the exacta in a start over the Churchill main track May 19, but was fourth in a similar event June 16 and the dirt experiment was history. Trainer Patrick Biancone chose an ambitious spot for the colt's turf bow, but he handled it with aplomb, charging home a three-length winner of the With Anticipation S. at Saratoga Aug. 31. He was most recently runner-up to **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) in Keeneland's Bourbon S. Oct. 7, but had no pace to run at that afternoon. Slowly away from the stalls, Nownownow was taken back to last and saved ground, as **Prussian** (Danzig), the 7-2 second choice, pulled his way to the front. Still on hold as the field turned for home, Nownownow followed the move of favored **Achill Island (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) on the turn, edged out six wide around that rival into the lane and was along in the final 50 yards for the victory.

CLASSIC - POWERED BY DODGE, \$5,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4m

Trainer Carl Nafzger said yesterday that this morning's weather will determine what he does with co-second choice and GI Kentucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}). "If the weather is real bad, I could 'shed' him," he commented, referring to having the horse simply walk the shedrow. "You don't want to come all this way and take a chance if you don't have to. I generally gallop my horses the day of a race." Nafzger is not the least bit concerned with Street Sense's ability to handle an off track. "This horse

will run on anything," he continued. "He ran well on that old track in Chicago that was about as bad as it could be last year before they put in Polytrack." Street Sense was third in the 2006 Gill Arlington-Washington Futurity in the slop. The Jim Tafel runner, who had a successful schooling session in the Monmouth paddock Thursday afternoon, is looking to become the fifth Kentucky Derby winner to take the Classic and the third to do it as a three-year-old.

Trainer Larry Jones had **Hard Spun** (Danzig) out for a one-mile gallop over the muddy Monmouth main track yesterday morning, one of the last times the conditioner will be aboard the colt, who is to enter stud at Darley next year. "It's going to be hard to see him go," Jones admitted. "I've been doing this all my life and horses like him don't just come along all the time. All your horses are special and you remember most of them, but he's very unique. He's the best thing I've ever laid hands on."

GREY GOOSE JUVENILE FILLIES, \$2,000,000, 2yo, f, 1 1/16m

Trainer Ron McAnally approaches the race full of confidence in Janis Whitham's **Izarra** (Distorted Humor), a granddaughter of two-time GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Bayakoa (Arg). "She does everything right," the Hall of Fame conditioner commented. "We schooled her in the paddock [Thursday] and she was just like an older horse. She has a lot of sense, unlike her grandmother." McAnally hopes that Izarra has a fraction of grandma's talent. "It was a battle with her grandmother, but she could run," he said. "This filly can run too." Izarra, coming off a narrow miss in the GI Oak Leaf S. Sept. 29.

The decision originally hinged on a scheduled gallop over the Monmouth turf course, but trainer John Shirreffs called an audible and sent out the four-year-old colt for a 1 1/2-mile gallop over the wet main track. "I thought about it and decided to stick with our routine," the conditioner explained, but cautioned, "It still all depends on the weather. If we get a whole lot of rain between now and the race,

he could still [scratch]. We very much want him to run, but we're not going to do something we think won't be in his best interests."

Some will be fast to toss undefeated **Wicked Style** (Macho Uno) from today's race, given that he drew the outside stall in this contentious field. Trainer Rusty Arnold would warn against such cavalier decision-making.

"I think he can win it," the conditioner said confidently. "I can tell you that he loves this racetrack. He will have no problem with the racetrack. You don't know how the race will play out. Things may not go your way. The best horse doesn't

always win. I have high hopes for tomorrow and into the future." While this will be Wicked Style's last start of 2007, Arnold wants everyone to pay attention next year. "Physically this horse hasn't developed yet," he offered. "He's a little immature looking and narrow. Mentally, he's way ahead. He's very smart, he likes what he does and he's great to be around. We're hoping that next year his body catches up to his mind and he puts the two together."

JOHN DEERE TURF, \$3,000,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/2mT

A word to the wise--don't forget about **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man), one of two prior winners of the GI Breeders' Cup Turf in this year's field. The eight-year-old gelding took the race in 2004 and came back two years later to be second by a half-length at Churchill last year. Showing he could still compete at the highest level this year, the dark bay took the GI Manhattan H. in June and ran third in the July 7 GI United Nations H. last time out. He also has an affinity for rain-soaked grass. "He loves this time of year, he loves turf like that," said trainer Graham Motion. "He's a happy horse." Better Talk Now comes off the longest layoff here, but the time off is not a concern for Motion. "He's always been a horse we've tried to campaign lightly, because he's such a light-framed horse," he explained. "He doesn't need a lot of racing. He runs his heart out every time he runs. I'm not even slightly concerned about the layoff. It's not an issue for me. I think it's to our advantage really."

EHV QUARANTINES CHURCHILL BARN A barn at Churchill Downs is under quarantine after a horse tested positive for equine herpes virus (EHV1). The Kentucky Department of Agriculture have ordered biosecurity measures in Barn 47, which houses horses trained by David Carroll and Al Stall Jr. The quarantine was ordered after a three-year-old trained by Carroll displayed symptoms of the disease Thursday. "The results of tests administered so far have confirmed an equine herpes infection with neurologic involvement," said Rusty Ford, the equine programs manager for the office of Kentucky State Veterinarian Dr. Robert Stout, DVM. "Those results suggest to us that we are dealing with an animal that has a low level of the virus in its system, and that works to our advantage. If that is the case, the infected horse would present a lesser risk of transmission of the virus to other horses in the barn or the general horse population." The quarantine is not expected to impact the Churchill Downs 21-day Fall Meet which is scheduled to get underway on Sunday.

The sale was originally slated for Oct. 28, but was postponed following the EI outbreak. "We had a lot of inquiries from all around Australia regarding the sale in its original date," explained Victorian director and auctioneer Peter Heagney. "The market told us that it is looking for horses and we were determined that we do everything possible to make it happen. So many people have been affected by the EI situation that we felt it imperative that we do what we can, support the industry, and ensure that the sale can take place."
