Dual Grade I winner **Octave** (Unbridled's Song--Belle Nuit, by Dr. Carter) has been added to the Nov. 4 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Select Mixed Sale in Lexington. The

three-year-old filly, third in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Monmouth last Saturday, is being offered by Taylor Made Sales Agency as a racing/broodmare. Owned and raced by Jack and Laurie Wolf's Starlight Stable and Don Lucarelli, the grey won two legs of this year's Triple Tiara:

the GI Mother Goose S. and GI Coaching Club American Oaks. In the money in all 13 career starts, the Kentucky-bred won or placed in eight Grade I events and has amassed \$1,660,934 to date. "She has been the model of consistency and class since we first started her in 2006, always totally competitive at the highest level of racing," said trainer Todd Pletcher. Concerning the sale of the his star, Wolf said, "Don and I feel this is excellent timing to realize the full asset value of Octave. She has been nothing short of sensational for two full seasons." Octave will be catalogued as hip 112A among 180 head offered Nov. 4 at the Newtown Paddocks.

**SHUJOON LEADS THE WAY AT TATTERSALLS**

Two-time French Listed winner **Shujoon (GB)** (Sakhee) topped yesterday's pipe-opener to the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale in Newmarket when selling for 240,000gns to agent Dick O'Gorman. The three-year-old, offered for Rabbah Bloodstock from Andre Fabre's stable, is set to race in Saudi Arabia after O'Gorman fought off the attentions of Robbie Hennessy, whose father owns the Champion Hurdle winner Sublimity. "He's for a regular client in Saudi Arabia and was ideal for the racing there as he stays well, which no doubt appealed to the jumping buyers. His form was very good and he vetted well," said O'Gorman. **Cont. p3**

**ENGLISH CHANNEL TO HURRICANE HALL**

**English Channel** (Smart Strike--Belva, by Theatrical {Ire}), winner of Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Turf, will join the stallion roster at Hurricane Hall in Lexington for

2008. "English Channel is retiring perfectly sound," said Hurricane Hall president Ben Walden Jr. "What a privilege it is to offer breeders absolute soundness and a horse as physically correct as English Channel is. He is a world-class athlete." The Turf was English Channel's sixth Grade I victory. Racing for Jim and Terry Scatuorchio, the five-year-old chestnut also won the 2006 and 2007

renewals of the GI United Nations H. and GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. and the 2006 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. He was second in the 2005 Joe Hirsch and GI Secretariat, as well as the 2007 GI Sword Dancer Invitational and GI Manhattan H. He was third in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf. "English Channel is the best grass horse that I have ever trained and one of the best horses I have ever trained--period," commented trainer Todd Pletcher. On the board in 18 of 23 starts, English Channel won 13 times and earned \$5,319,028. A stud fee has not yet been announced.

**NEW TRAINER FOR LADY OF VENICE**

**Lady of Venice (Fr)** (Loup Solitaire--Lacewings, by Forty Niner), previously trained by suspended trainer Patrick Biancone, was transferred to Kieran McLaughlin's barn Oct. 24, while **Belgravia** (Mr. Greeley) and **Pauillac** (Mr. Greeley) will now be conditioned by Todd Pletcher. Campaigned by Martin Schwartz, Lady of Venice--winner of the GII Cash Call Mile Inv. S. and GIII Ouija Board Distaff in 2007--is slated to make her next appearance in the GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park Nov. 25. GIII Hollywood Prevue S. winner Belgravia--campaigned by Michael Tabor, Susan Magnier, Derrick Smith and Ahmed Zayat--and Tabor and Smith's Pauillac, who scored at Saratoga in July, will head to the Pletcher barn. A \$2-million F-T Calder purchase, Belgravia, who is currently in California, will be transferred to Pletcher's Hollywood Park barn.

## LEAR'S PRINCESS OUT OF F-T NOVEMBER

West Point Thoroughbreds President Terry Finley announced Monday that Grade I winner **Lear's Princess** (Lear Fan) will not sell at Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky Select Fall Mixed Sale in Lexington Nov. 4. Instead, the three-year-old will be pointed toward a 2008 racing campaign. "We are going to keep her and freshen her up for a four-year-old campaign," Finley told *Blood-Horse*. "I like that idea. The partners didn't want to sell. She didn't

show up in the Breeders' Cup, partly because of the [sloppy] track and the competition also played a big part. She has had a lot thrown at her the last six months. With the prospect of going into her four-year-old year, you've got to be excited." The filly, who won the Sept. 15 GI Gazelle S. over GI Belmont S. heroine Rags to Riches, will winter with trainer Kiaran McLaughlin at Palm Meadows Thoroughbred Training Center in Florida. Another West Point campaigner--**Dream Rush** (Wild Rush)--owned by a partnership including Lewis Lakin and John Sikura, will be sent through the ring at Fasig-Tipton Nov. 4. Trained by Rick Violette Jr., the winner of the GI Test S. and GI Prioress S. finished fifth in her latest start in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Monmouth Park Oct. 26. West Point's **Irish Smoke** (Smoke Glacken), who finished 12<sup>th</sup> in the GI BC Juvenile Fillies, was slated to sell at Fasig-Tipton, but a final decision on whether the filly will go through the ring has yet to be finalized. "We have to evaluate selling her and get some feedback from the partners," Finley told *Blood Horse*. "We will keep all our options open. She's a Grade I winner, and they are not easy to come by." **Awesome Gem** (Awesome Again), third in GI BC Classic, will remain in training with California-based trainer Craig Dollase for a five-year-old campaign.

## SCORPION OUT OF MELBOURNE CUP?

**Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), rated a 12-1 chance for the G1 Melbourne Cup Nov. 6, is in serious doubt for the Flemington race after pulling up lame yesterday. "Scorpion did his first bit of fast work [yesterday] and the lads were pretty happy, but this afternoon he appears to be lame, and we have spoken to [trainer] Aidan [O'Brien]," Coolmore's Tom

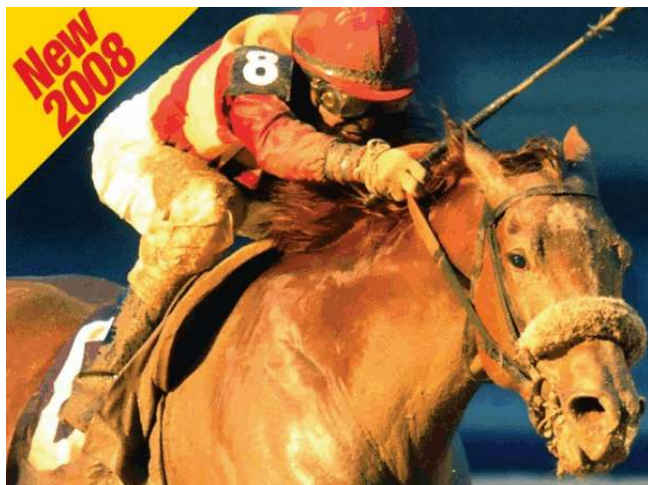

Magnier confirmed. "Scorpion is being X-rayed this evening and we will know more in the morning. Aidan is coming down [en route from Los Angeles to Australia] [Tuesday] and we'll take it from there. We just have to hope now." As the highweight at 58.5 kilos, Scorpion would carry the number 1 saddlecloth in the Melbourne Cup. The five-year-old, winner of the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 1, was a last start second to Yeats (Ire) in the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh Sept. 15. Overall, Scorpion was six wins and four seconds from 15 career starts for earnings of \$1,744,153.

## MACHO UNO TO ADENA SPRINGS KENTUCKY

Frank Stronach's **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull--Primal Force, Blushing Groom {Fr}) will relocate from Adena Springs South in Ocala, Florida, to the farm's Kentucky satellite location. The nine-year-old stallion, who stood for \$12,500 in 2007, will be available at a fee of \$20,000, live foal, for the 2008 breeding season. "Macho Uno exemplifies the best of our racing and breeding programs, and he deserves the opportunity to take up residence in Kentucky alongside his half-brother, Awesome Again," said Stronach. "He won the premier two-year-old race in the world [2000 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile], was a graded stakes winner and Breeders' Cup contender every year he raced. His first crop firmly establishes him as a stallion with a future." With 12 juvenile winners to date, including Grade I winner Wicked Style, Macho Uno's first crop has amassed \$946,444.

### The Time is Now...

Group 3-placed juvenile **Dubai Time (GB)** (Dubai Destination) will be sent to trainer David Hall's stable in Hong Kong after being knocked down to Alastair Donald yesterday for 220,000gns. Donald, of the Kern Lillingston Association, outbid agent Willie Leung for the colt. "He will quarantine in December before heading out to Hong Kong in January," said Donald. "He has the pedigree to be a better three-year-old and improve with a bit more distance." Several purchases are bound for the U.S., including three-time winning juvenile **Mr Keppel (Ire)** (Royal Applause {GB}), a half-brother to GII Oak Tree Derby winner Devious Boy (GB) (Dr Devious {Ire}). Agent Jamie McCalmont paid 155,000gns for the colt on behalf of Tommy Town Thoroughbreds. Doug O'Neill will train the Irish-bred. Progressive juvenile **Ghetto (GB)** (Auction House) will be trained by Jeff Metz in California after selling to agent Gordian Troeller for 145,000gns. "He's for Class Racing Stable and he'll hopefully go for the GIII Generous S. at Hollywood Park in late November," said Metz. A client of John Stuart's Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services--bidding via Joe Miller of Kern Lillingston's Lexington office-- paid 115,000gns for stakes-placed three-year-old **Ransom Captive** (Red Ransom). "She will race for them and then hopefully be a good broodmare. Her price was really half for racing and half for her residual value, and she'll be a bargain if it all works out," said Miller. ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Jupiter Pluvius had struck only eight days previously on yielding ground in a six-furlong Curragh maiden and displayed admirable versatility on this quicker surface, and over this extra panel, to underline his Classic potential. Despite the misgivings of connections surrounding his readiness to win at first asking, the bay overcame the odds to record a cozy neck success. In a move typical of Aidan O'Brien's approach to his juveniles at this phase of the season, he was backed up here and faced a stern test against a deep cast. Breaking well to stalk the early pace, he needed room on the final turn and was switched wide at the top of the stretch as Amended (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}) ran through the rails as things got tight on the inner. Unleashing a spell of acceleration inside the final quarter, Jupiter Pluvius cut down Billyford in the final 150 yards and was comfortably holding Famous Name's wide rally. In doing so, he was providing Ballydoyle with win number six since 1999, including the eventual G1 2000 Guineas hero Footstepsinthesand (GB) three years ago. "He had always worked nicely, but I didn't think the softish ground at the Curragh would be in his favor," jockey Seamus Heffernan said.

"He had had little hold-ups as well, so he wasn't actually in full work, but just half-speeding and ticking over. So we knew he was nice, but he showed his class at the Curragh and was probably nicer than we thought. I fancied him today on good ground in a true-run race and he's a progressive type who is extremely genuine. I was impressed with him today, as it was a strong field with plenty in there with chances." Jupiter Pluvius was produced by a winning full-sister to SW & MGISP High Heeled Hope (Salt Lake) and has a weanling half-brother by Successful Appeal selling at next week's Keeneland November sale as hip [1342](#). # PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Winners of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, of course, have a notoriously bad record in the Kentucky Derby. That is until Street Sense came along to show that it isn't impossible for a colt to dominate his generation over 1 1/16 miles in the fall and over 1 1/4 miles a little over six months later.

But will the latest Juvenile winner, the admirable War Pass, prove another exception to the rule? His connections clearly think he's capable of following in Street Sense's footsteps, as the unbeaten colt is apparently heading to Florida to prepare for the Triple Crown races. But what does his pedigree tell us?

The first relevant aspect of his pedigree is that he's by Cherokee Run, winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint as a four-year-old in 1994. This alone could set the alarm bells ringing about War Pass's prospects of staying a fast-run mile and a quarter, but nothing is ever quite straightforward in Thoroughbred racing. A few other stallions which featured in the GI BC Sprint have made an impact on the Triple Crown. Smile, winner of the '86 Sprint after finishing second a year earlier, ranks as the broodmare sire of Smarty Jones, winner of the first two legs of the Triple Crown, even though he was by another sprinter Elusive Quality. And Gulch, the 1988 winner, sired Thunder Gulch, hero of the 1995 Kentucky Derby and Belmont.

It could also be in War Pass's favor that Cherokee Run was no one-dimensional speedster. To my eye the stallion isn't built like the conventional sprinter and he wasn't bred like one either. *cont. p6*

His sire Runaway Groom had won two legs of the Canadian Triple Crown, both over 1 1/2 miles, before heading south to take the GI Travers S. over 1 1/4 miles, so Cherokee Run was clearly worth trying around two turns. He justified the opportunity by being beaten only half a length in Prairie Bayou's GI Preakness S. and he later won the GII Dwyer S. over nine furlongs.

However, he also demonstrated that he possessed plenty of speed as a three-year-old, notably equalling Keeneland's seven-furlong record in the GIII Lafayette S. (18 days before he won the mile GIII Derby Trial). His connections must have concluded that there were greater opportunities for Cherokee Run up to a mile, rather than beyond, as he never tackled more than a mile in nine starts at four. He showed his appreciation by gaining Grade I & II victories over six furlongs.

With a background like this, I should be able to report that Cherokee Run has proved similarly versatile as a stallion, with a wide mix of winners to his credit, but his strong suit has proved to be speed--and precocious speed at that. War Pass was his fifth challenger for Breeders' Cup honors and the previous four all contested either the Juvenile or the Juvenile Fillies. He came closest to success with Chilukki, runner-up to Cash Run in the 1999 Fillies, and Kafwain, who chased home Vindication in 2002. He was also represented by Yonaguska, a disappointment in 2000.

It is interesting to chart the future careers of these three. Chilukki's graded victories as a mature filly were gained over a mile (in record time) and 1 1/16 miles, whereas Kafwain gained his only graded win at three over seven furlongs. Yonaguska pursued a sprinting career, notably winning the Fall Highweight H. over six furlongs. The Darley/Jonabell stallion is also responsible for such fast performers as Dream Run and Indian Flare.

Even Sir Cherokee, Cherokee Run's winner of the Illinois Derby over 1 1/8 miles, later dropped back below a mile to win the Ack Ack H. Zanjero has shown a measure of stamina, with the GIII West Virginia Derby over 1 1/8 miles among his wins, but his stamina was no doubt bolstered by having a GI Belmont S. winner, A.P. Indy, as his broodmare sire.

So is there any staying blood in the bottom half of War Pass's pedigree to help him as the distances lengthen? The answer is probably not. His dam Vue was placed in a couple of stakes as a three-year-old, one over six furlongs, the other over a mile, and five of her six starts came in sprints. With Mr. Prospector as her sire and a Hoist The Flag mare as her dam, Vue has the distinction of being bred along the same lines as Prospectors Delite. This remarkable mare won the Ashland S. and Acorn S. at around a mile before developing into an exceptional broodmare. All five of Prospectors Delite's foals became stakes winners, with Mineshaft and Tomisue's Delight both becoming Grade I winners. Both these Grade I winners stayed 1 1/4 miles, but they too had their stamina boosted by having A.P. Indy as their sire. **cont. p7**

**CORINTHIAN'S FEE SET AT \$40,000** Corinthian (Pulpit--Multiply by Easy Goer), winner of last Friday's inaugural \$1-million Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile and the GI Metropolitan Mile H., will stand his initial season at Gainesway Farm in Lexington for a fee of \$40,000, live foal. "Top milers make top stallions," said Gainesway President Antony Beck. "Our established stallion and champion miler Cozzene, winner of the inaugural Breeders' Cup Mile, is passing the baton to our newest stallion, Corinthian." Beck added, "With his win in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, Corinthian has established himself as a force to be reckoned with. He is a superior individual, a very athletic, well-bred stallion prospect." The four-year-old Corinthian, who raced for Centennial Farms, was trained by Jimmy Jerkens and retires with six victories from 12 starts and earnings of \$1,267,273. He is a half-brother to graded winner Desert Hero and hails from the family of top stallions Sadler's Wells and Nureyev.

Vue, to her credit, has matched Prospectors Delite's feat of producing a pair of Grade I winners, as her first foal, the Known Fact filly Oath, landed the Spinaway S. in 1996. Unfortunately Oath doesn't tell us much about War Pass's stamina potential as she raced only three times after the age of two and failed to win again.

Incidentally, the fact that War Pass is out of a Mr. Prospector mare will also cause a ripple of unease among his admirers. Another famous hoodoo, along with the so-called Breeders' Cup Juvenile jinx, is that no horse out of a Raise A Native line mare had succeeded in winning the Kentucky Derby until Barbaro--the son of a Carson City mare--came along in 2006. That statistic owed a lot to the fact that the Kentucky Derby has been dominated by the Raise A Native male line, especially the Mr. Prospector branch, and it wouldn't worry me if War Pass were by a more noted sire of staying horses than Cherokee Run.

As it is, I need more convincing that War Pass will still be the leader of the Classic pack on the first Saturday next May.

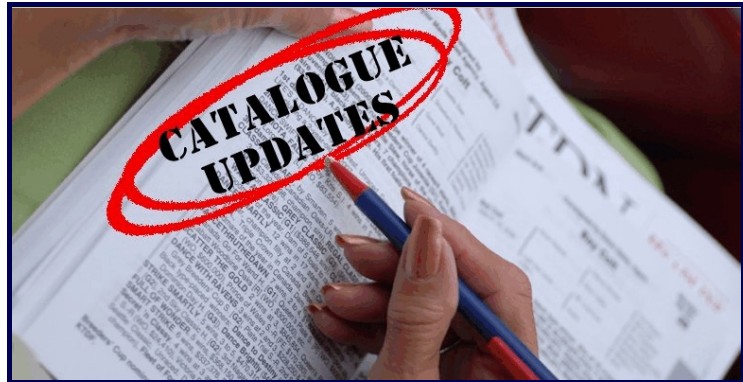

**EXPERT CASTS EYE OVER RACES**

One of Australia's leading stewards was called upon to pass judgement on the series of races under scrutiny in the unprecedented race-fixing trial at the Old Bailey. Ray Murrhly has analyzed the 27 races for the City of London Police, some of which the jury was able to watch during yesterday's session, with the official claiming that he would have called an inquiry into a total of 13 of them. While most of the races involving Kieren Fallon would have not raised any concerns according to Murrhly, he was clear as to his feelings about the notorious ride given to Ballinger Ridge (GB) when that horse was second at Lingfield in March of 2004. "I am in no doubt he should have won," he told the court. "It was a quite extraordinary ride. I do not think I have seen in my experience a horse ease down in that part of the race and it undoubtedly cost him the win." He also criticised the ride that Darren Williams gave to the eventual third-placed Legal Set (Ire) at the same track in December, 2002, saying, "He elected to stay behind the wall of horses." Of Fergal Lynch's ride on the Group 3 winner CD Europe (Ire) at Southwell in February, 2003, Murrhly concluded, "At no point do I see Fergal Lynch ask this horse to extend itself to its fullest." Fallon, Lynch and Williams are three of the six defendants charged with conspiracy to defraud between December, 2002 and August, 2004; the group also includes Shaun Lynch, Miles Rodgers and Philip Sherkle. All deny the charge, and Rodgers also denies concealing the proceeds of crime.

**DONCASTER MOVE FINAL FLAT SALE**

Doncaster Bloodstock Sales Ltd (DBS) yesterday announced that the Horses in Training Sale scheduled for Nov. 21-22 will be moved to Dec. 7 and renamed the December Horses in Training Sale. Managing Director Henry Beeby explained yesterday that the transfer avoids a clash with Goffs November and fills a blank day in the process. "This move has to make sense as it removes a sales-date clash that has frustrated some significant purchasers and vendors for some time, not to mention DBS," Beeby said. "We have tried to find an alternative for a number of years without success, and hope that this move answers the question."
