The way you are graduated at Deauville Aug. 15 before annexing the Sept. 21 Listed Criterion de Lyon. In possession of the same steamrolling manner of his famed sibling, he used his winning momentum in his first serious test, the course-and-distance G3 Prix Thomas Bryon last time Oct. 13. Settled in behind the early leaders here, the blaze-faced bay was switched inside at the top of the stretch and struck the front at the quarter pole. Joined and headed by Hello Morning on his outer, he battled gamely to regain the advantage in the final 75 yards and was pulling away again at the line. "That is it for the season and I'd imagine that next year, he will be more of a mile-and-a-quarter or mile-and-a-half horse," his trainer continued. "He is unlikely to contest any of the Guineas races, but that will all be decided in due course with his owner."

The Tin Man Retired cont.

The Tin Man made his career debut late in his three-year-old season and, just over a year later, posted his first Grade I win in the Clement L. Hirsch Memorial S. He won just one of nine subsequent appearances over the next two seasons, but returned from a near 15-month absence to win consecutive starts followed by a \$1-million pay day for his runner-up effort to David Junior in the 2006 G1 Dubai Duty Free S. He ran the table in three subsequent starts, taking the GII American Invitational H., the GI Arlington Million and the Hirsch. He earned just short of \$2 million last year. Sidelined eight months and readied for a nine-year-old campaign, The Tin Man defeated a field including GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Kip Deville in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 28. He closed out his career by finishing second in the American H. June 30, the Aug. 11 Arlington Million and the Oct. 6 Hirsch but emerged from his latest effort with a bit of body soreness and underwent tests, which revealed possible damage to an ankle and resulted in the exploratory procedure. The Tin Man retires with a record of 31-13-8-2 and earnings of \$3,663,780.

Marching will attempt to become the eighth AAMI Vase winner to capture the Victoria Derby in the last 10 years. Third in the G1 Caulfield Guineas Oct. 13 behind boom colt Weekend Hussler (Aus), Marching notched a dominant win in the AAMI Vase last Saturday from fellow Derby contender **Kibbutz**. He is set to become the first Derby winner for Woodlands Stud since Arena (Aus) in 1998. He will also potentially be the last Group 1 winner for the powerful duo of John Hawkes and Bob Ingham, with Hawkes ending his tenure as trainer for the nation's most powerful owner/breeder combination in December. Marching has continued to firm in ante-post betting for the Derby after drawing barrier two and the Hawkes camp is beaming with confidence after the colt worked smartly Thursday. The David Hayes-trainee Kibbutz flashed home from the rear late in proceedings in the AAMI Vase to finish 2 1/4 lengths behind Marching and will be well suited on Flemington's spacious track. Another runner bound to feel at home is trainer Danny O'Brien's **Villain**, who found himself too far back at Caulfield in the G3 Norman Robinson in his last appearance. A A\$150,000 Inglis Easter graduate, Villain--out of the Group 1 winning Brief Truce mare True Jewels (Aus)--is by Carnegie, the sire of 2001 Derby winner Amalfi (Aus).

D-DAY FOR MISS FINLAND Trainer David Hayes is adamant that five time G1 winner **Miss Finland (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) will not take her place in Tuesday's G1 Melbourne Cup unless she produces a mighty effort in Saturday's G1 Mackinnon S. "If she doesn't run like Let's Elope (NZ) or Empire Rose (Aus), then she won't start in the Melbourne Cup and we will turn her out," Hayes insisted. The conditioner indicated that the bay would wear a norton bit Saturday. "It gives her something to think about, it's a bit of a change," Hayes said. "It helps horses that tend to pull--I believe she has been too aggressive in the first 400 metres of her races," Hayes said, adding he had successfully employed the same tactic with Cup winners Jeune (GB), At Talaq and Beldale Ball. **Haradasun (Aus)** (Fusaichi Pegasus) is worthy favorite for the G1 Mackinnon after an enormous effort when forced to lead before finishing third in last Saturday's G1 Cox Plate. The bay meets similar opposition with a significant difference--the absence of the two that beat him home in the Moonee Valley feature, El Segundo (Aus) and Wonderful World (Aus). Haradasun, a dual Group 1 winner over a mile, has raced five times this campaign, consistently but without a win, but part-owner Frank Tagg indicated that there would be a change in tactics for the four-year-old, who will be accompanied by Damien Oliver in the Mackinnon. "His best runs have come from behind, but that wasn't the way the [Cox Plate] unfolded," Tagg explained. "We had to lead and he was left a sitting shot. It's an important race for him as it will probably map out his autumn campaign in terms of distance."

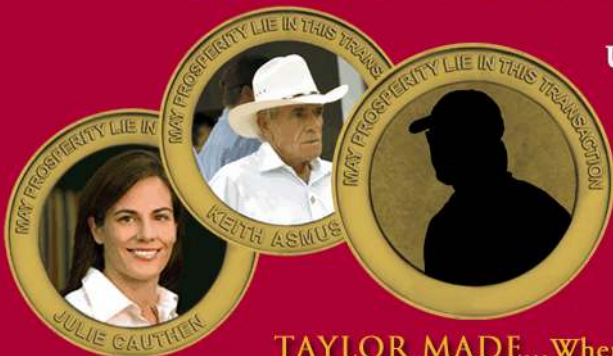
as she's doing well, we'll probably keep her in training," Dan Hall, bloodstock advisor to owner Frank Stronach, told the publication. "That's the way we're leaning right now." Never worse than third in her eight starts in 2007, the Florida-bred daughter of Nappelon (Bold Revenue) became a

leading candidate for year-end honors with a six-length victory in the G1 Go For Wand H. at Saratoga July 28 and a 3/4-length success in the G1 Ruffian H. at Belmont Park Sept. 8. She lost some of her momentum when she was third at even money in the G1 Beldame S. Sept. 30, but likely clinched an Eclipse with her narrow score in the Distaff. Ginger Punch could make her 2008 debut in the Sunshine Millions Distaff Jan. 26. The series is the brainchild of Frank Stronach.

Purchased by agent Aiden Murphy as a jumping prospect, Lot 1351 had been secured by his trainer Tim Walford privately for just 9,250gns 12 months ago. "He's for an existing owner with Philip Hobbs," said Murphy after outbidding agent Anthony Stroud, who had been shopping for the Dubai Carnival at the sale. "We've been looking all week and this was the first one that we really wanted to go for. He's a good-looking horse that vetted well and could improve further." Part-owner Walford, who was delighted with the sale, said. "Today was the sale of the century! It's a pleasure to sell one when you know there is absolutely nothing wrong with him--he's got loads of potential, which a lot of the others haven't got. I'm a trainer, but also a dealer and you have to sell to make a profit sometimes." Phillip Hobbs, who secured the closing session's sale topper, also bought three-year-old **Hibiki (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) for 120,000gns as hurdling prospect. Lot 1528, two-year-old **Sporting Art** (Doneraile Court), is heading back to the U.S. after New York agent Steve Young, accompanied by British adviser Jamie McCalmont, saw off California trainer Jim Cassidy when the colt made 220,000gns. Young was acting for California owners Jon and Sarah Kelly.

At the conclusion of yesterday's session, Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony expressed satisfaction with trade at this year's sale despite a decrease in turnover to 23,293,200gns, a three-percent fall over 2006. Average dipped by 10 percent to 24,519gns, while the 11,000gns median fell by 15 percent. "The Autumn Horses in Training Sale has made remarkable progress in recent years and after the huge rises last year it would have been no great surprise if this year's renewal had fallen a little short," Mahony said. "The turnover, however, has all but matched last year's wide margin record of almost 24,000,000 guineas. The key to the sale's continuing success is the extraordinary diversity of the buyers and this week has been no exception with buyers from every continent in the world all making significant contributions. The growing profile of the Dubai International Racing Carnival is another factor which has added a new dimension to the top of the market and we look forward to seeing plenty of the higher profile lots from this week, including the 520,000-guineas sale topper Yellowstone, making their presence felt in Dubai next year. In total, we have had 44 lots break the six figure barrier this week and while prize money levels in Britain remain a concern it is encouraging for owners to know that there is still very much a vibrant international demand for quality horses in training." Book 4 of the October Yearling Sale takes place at Tattersalls today.

MILL RIDGE CUTS FEES Mill Ridge Farm has announced that **Gone West** (Mr. Prospector) will stand for \$85,000 next year, down from \$125,000 in 2007. The 23-year-old stallion is represented by Grade III winner Istan this year as well as five additional stakes winners. He sired the co-highest priced colt at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, a 1-million guineas son of Myth to Reality (Fr). "We believe breeders will realize the potential of Johar and the great value of Gone West," said Bayne Welker, Mill Ridge's Director of Stallion Marketing and Sales Development. Welker also noted Gone West's reputation as a sire of sires, with sons such as Mr. Greeley, Elusive Quality, Proud Citizen, Grand Slam, Zafonic and Zamindar. Mill Ridge also stands **Johar** (Gone West), whose first foals will reach the races in 2008. The eight-year-old's fee will be \$12,500 next season, down slightly from his 2007 fee of \$15,000. Welker added, "Johar's foals were so nice we had our best response ever in 2007, with 110 mares in this third year." Gone West's terms are live foal, stands and nurses, while Johar will be live foal, due Nov. 1.

BALANCE RETIRED John and Jerry Amerman's **Balance** (Thunder Gulch--Vertigineux, by Kris S.) has been retired from racing following her sixth-place effort in last Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. "She'll go to Mill Ridge, but we have no studs lined up yet," said trainer David Hofmans. A dual stakes winner and runner-up in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. at two, Balance became the West Coast's best early-season three-year-old filly with wins in the GI Las Virgenes S. and the GI Santa Anita Oaks. Following a third in the GI La Brea S. last December, she bounced back to her best form to land the GII La Canada S. in February and the GI Santa Margarita H. in March. She was also placed behind Nashoba's Key in the GI Vanity H., GII Milady Breeders' Cup H. and GII Clement L. Hirsch H. Balance heads to the breeding shed with six wins and seven minor placings from 16 career starts and earnings of \$1,048,491.

CHURCHILL INTRODUCES NEW OVER/UNDER WAGER

The Churchill Downs fall meeting opens today with the introduction of the new "Over/Under" wager. For each race during the meet, the track will set a predetermined "Number," based on the size of the field, and handicappers will bet whether they believe the combined saddlecloth numbers of the first three finishers in that race will be over, under or equal to the preset "Number." Pari-mutuel odds will be calculated for each of the options. The takeout will be 16 percent. "It is an alternative for people looking for a relatively simple bet, but it can also be used by more sophisticated players to hedge their bets against a surprise horse disrupting particular exacta, trifecta or superfecta combinations," explained Tom Aronson, vice president for Churchill Downs Incorporated. The bet will initially be available on-track, and then at participating simulcast outlets. "It is a progressive roll-out," Aronson said. "The biggest challenge will be in the technology and the distribution. We will start out offering it only at the track, then we will progress to racetracks and other environments that have United Tote, then to those outlets that have other systems." The "Over/Under" will not be offered on races that have fewer than six individual betting interests. Refunds will be offered in the event of late scratches. "This is just the first step in getting better at introducing new things to the betting public," Aronson said. "Our first job is to make sure that, technologically, we can take the bet. The second is to make people aware of the bet when they come into the racetrack. We're not focused on a target demographic. The analogy would be a restaurant offering a new daily special. Everyone thinks positively about new menu options, even if they don't order them. But the specials won't sell if you don't tell people about them. We have to inform the betting public. From there, the bet stands on its own two feet or it doesn't. If it doesn't catch on, we have more things planned that will be increasingly challenging to the betting public."

IRS: NYRA OWES \$1.6B IN TAXES The New York Racing Association owes \$1.6 billion to the Internal Revenue Service to settle past tax obligations, according to published reports. IRS reportedly filed its notice with federal bankruptcy court in Manhattan in June, but the matter did not become public knowledge until this past week, when NYRA responded in bankruptcy court. NYRA claims that its true debt is less than one percent of what the government claims it is owed. Internal Revenue argues that NYRA failed to report gross handle--the amount wagered on and off track on its races--and instead offered the takeout, the track's portion of the handle, among other things. NYRA stated in its reply to the Court that the claim by IRS could have material consequences on the organizations retention of the New York racing franchise, which is set to expire Dec. 31. News of the IRS claim came out when representatives of Australian-based Capital Play, which is challenging NYRA for the franchise, alerted reporters.

TABCORP TURNOVER DOWN Wagering giant Tabcorp expects turnover will be down about A\$550 million by the time the industry recovers from Equine Influenza (EI) in early 2008, wiping A\$30 million of divisional profit before tax from its wagering division. The company said in a statement Oct. 31 that although it would weather the impact of EI because it was a "well diversified gambling and entertainment company", EI had slashed wagering turnover by A\$251 million since Aug. 25. Wagering turnover in New South Wales is down \$184 million, or 21%, and in Victoria \$67 million or 9%. Chief executive Elmer Funke Kupper said in the EI outbreak was not expected to delay his two-year turnaround strategy for the company, but it would hurt performance over the next six to 12 months.
