**NO MARE IS AN ISLAND**

Owner James Osborne of Little Rock, Arkansas, was surfing the net a few years ago when he hung 10 on a website and discovered a nice filly by Tabasco Cat for sale. Through bloodstock agent Mike Ryan, Osborne, who operates B. A. Man Stable, crossed the Ts, dotted the Is and was the owner of **Island Sand**. Yesterday, the filly he was able to purchase for "less than the stud fee of A.P. Indy" turned a handsome profit for Osborne, selling to Lincoln Collins, agent for Len Riggio's My Meadowview Farm, for a session-topping \$4.2 million at

the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. "We are just thrilled to death," Osborne commented outside Barn 15, which housed the one-headed Maynard Farm consignment. "It's very exciting. It's not quite as good as winning a Grade I race, but almost." And Osborne would know. After taking the Busanda S. in her first start for her new owner, Island Sand was turned over to trainer Larry Jones and managed runner-up efforts in the GII Fantasy S. and to Ashado in the GI Kentucky Oaks. That set the stage for her most important victory, when she rallied wide down the Belmont stretch and went on to a 1 3/4-length victory over Society Selection in the GI Acorn S. She followed with a third to Ashado in the GI Mother Goose S., but disaster nearly struck thereafter. "We sent her for a simple procedure to correct a breathing problem and she got an infection and we nearly lost her," Osborne explained. "It's been a long road from there to here." Island Sand added a win in the 2005 GII Delaware H. and retired with earnings of \$1,182,777. Bred to A. P. Indy last year, she produced a colt, and was sold carrying another foal by that leading sire. "It's been a pleasure being around her," Osborne said. "It's like losing a member of the family, but it is a business. We had fun with her and we wish them good luck with her." Osborne will retain the A.P. Indy colt.

**KINGMAMBO'S FEE SET AT \$250,000**

Lane's End Farm has announced that leading sire **Kingmambo** (Mr. Prospector--Miesque, by Nureyev) will stand for \$250,000, live foal in 2008. The 17-year-old stallion was listed as private in 2007 and had his book limited due to an arthritic condition, but is expected to cover a full book next year. He is represented by three Grade I/Group 1 winners this year in G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Light Shift, GI Pacific Classic victor Student Council and G1 Criterium International winner Thewayouare. "He stood for \$250,000 in 2007. Due to some health issues in 2006, we announced his stud fee as private," said Will Farish. "We were pleased with his progress in 2007, and are announcing his 2008 fee at this time." Mares in foal to Kingmambo were in great demand through Book 1 of Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale, with six of seven mares selling for an average of \$1,991,667; the seventh RNA'd for \$1.25 million, and Monday's \$10.5-million Playful Act (Ire) had slipped to the Lane's End stallion over the summer. When asked if those results played into the decision to announce the stallion's fee, Farish said, "The decision was made in advance of Monday's sale, and it's just where we felt it should be."

**Another Small Guy Shares in the Glory...**

Consignor Richard Maynard never shows up at Keeneland with many horses, but those that he does lead over have proven popular. In 2002, Maynard sold a Storm Cat half-sister to champion Chief Bearhart for \$2.8 million through the Doninga agency of David Mullins, while this past September, he sold a colt by Distorted Humor out of Stormy Bear--another Storm Cat half to Chief Bearhart--to John Ferguson for \$1.9 million. Yesterday's topper marked another successful transaction, and it was made that much sweeter by his friendship to James Osborne. "I've known Jim ever since he had hair, since I had hair," said Maynard, who bred and raised Island Sand. "She's a nice filly. It's always a pleasure to work with Jimmy and he deserved this." He admitted that Island Sand had her moments growing up. "She was a good filly, maybe a little hard to get along with, but you could put up with her," he said.

**Parting With Adoration Sweet Sorrow for Amermans...**

**Adoration** (Honor Grades) gave California owners John and Jerry Amerman their biggest thrill in racing in 2003, winning the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff before a partisan crowd at Santa Anita. Four years later, the eight-year-old mare, carrying a colt by leading sire Smart Strike, provided the couple with their biggest bang in the sales ring after she was knocked down to Coolmore's John Magnier for \$3.1 million. "She's a good-looking mare and a good race mare," the typically understated Magnier commented following the sale. He was not surprised by the final price. "That's the market. What can you say?" he said. The Amermans acquired Adoration through bloodstock agent Bob Feld off a daylight maiden victory in 2002, and she went on to take graded stakes on the dirt and turf that season. Winner of a minor stakes at Del Mar in the summer of 2003, the bay was put up to third in the GII Lady's Secret BC S. prior to her 40-1 upset in the Distaff. She was never worse than third in five starts in 2004, winning the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H., the GII Fleur de Lis H. and the GIII Arlington Matron H. She retired with earnings of \$2,051,159 and is the dam of a yearling colt by Empire Maker and a weanling filly by Ghostzapper, both of which the couple are retaining. For the Amermans, parting ways with Adoration brings some mixed emotions. "It is a very bittersweet thing," explained Jerry Amerman. "She was really good to us. We know that she's going to a good place and we know that they'll take good care of her. But it's very hard, especially when you get attached to the horse. I hope it's a Kentucky Derby winner she's carrying. The market seemed to be very good and strong and we were just hoping it would stay that way." The Amermans had more success later in the session, selling MGISW **Spoken Fur** (Notebook) to Southern Equine Stables for \$1.65 million. The seven-year-old mare is in foal to Smart Strike.



**Fleet Indian Sold Privately...**

Owner Paul Saylor reached an agreement late Monday night to sell 2006 Eclipse Award-winning distaffer **Fleet Indian** (Indian Charlie) to Frank and Laura Jane Lyon's Summer Wind Farm, according to Taylor Made Farm's Mark Taylor. While unwilling to disclose a purchase price, Taylor said it was a number "just underneath the original reserve." Fleet Indian, who suffered a serious ankle injury during the running of the 2006 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, was led out of the ring unsold during Monday's opening session after bidding on the mare, in foal to Storm Cat, stalled out at \$3.9 million. "At the end of the day, Paul decided to come down just a bit, and it was very important to him that Fleet Indian be sold to people who care about their horses," Taylor said yesterday afternoon by phone. "The Lyons just love their horses and Paul is comfortable that she is in good hands and that she'll stay in this country." Saylor, part of the ownership group that sold Ashado for a then-Keeneland record \$9 million at the 2005 November sale, reinvested some of his profit into Fleet Indian at the 2006 KEEJAN sale, going to \$290,000 for the New York-bred daughter of Hustleeta (Afleet). Trained by Todd Pletcher, Fleet Indian won her first six starts in Saylor's blue and pink silks, including the GI Personal Ensign H. and the GI Beldame S. She retired with 13 wins from 19 starts and earnings of \$1,704,513.



**Lemonade for Horton Family...**

Racing has always been a family affair for the Hortons. Brothers Willis and Leon, and their respective sons Cam and Terry, have been in the game for years, and two years ago enjoyed success on racing's biggest stage for three-year-old fillies when their **Lemons Forever** (Lemon Drop Kid) came storming down the long

stretch at Churchill Downs to upset the GI Kentucky Oaks at 47-1 odds. If their share of the \$1-million purse, and whatever win tickets they might have cashed, was the cake, then the icing came yesterday when R.J. Bennett, on behalf of Charles Fipke, purchased Lemons Forever as a broodmare prospect for \$2.5 million. "I'm just honored to own a horse that won the Kentucky Oaks," Fipke said of the Eaton Sales consignee. "She'll be bred to [Fipke's stallion] Perfect Soul (Ire). The Sadler's Wells cross with Kingmambo has just been great, plus there's quite a lot of speed in the family." Fipke, who was flanked by Bennett and advisor Jack Werk, added, "Physically, she's the most awesome mare in the catalogue. She's a 16.2 [hand] mare, perfectly correct and extremely well-balanced." By Lemon Drop Kid, a son of Kingmambo, Lemons Forever was purchased by trainer Dallas Stewart for \$140,000 as a yearling in 2004. A fast-closing third in the GIII Bourbonette BC S. over Turfway's Polytrack last year, she then gave the Hortons and Stewart, who retained a five-percent interest in the filly, their biggest winner to date with her board-illuminating Oaks victory. Lemons Forever added a third in the GI Alabama S. and an allowance victory on the Churchill lawn this year before being retired. While parting with Lemons Forever is tough, the Hortons said it was the right decision for them. "We're more into the racing part of it," said Cam Horton. "We had a few broodmares, but we decided that wasn't the direction we wanted to go." Originally from Arkansas, the Horton family is in the homebuilding business. Their corporate office is in Texas. "That's where most of us were for a while, but now we've all scattered out," said Cam, who now calls Missouri home. The Hortons currently have about 10 horses in training, all with Stewart, who was among the first to congratulate Fipke. "She's a really sound, great mare," Stewart told Fipke. The Hortons, who race as Horton Racing Stable, have been friends with Stewart since they had runners with D. Wayne Lukas. "At that time, Dallas was his assistant and was thinking about going out on his own, and I said, 'Well, if you do, you know you've got our horses,'" said Cam. "I asked him about costs and what new tack would cost. He told me and I wrote him a check and said, 'Now just go train horses.' We've been real good friends."

Elbaaha-mbug...

For a second consecutive year, Elbaaha (GB) (Arazi) failed to sell, despite attracting a high seven-figure bid. The dam of G1 Dubai World Cup and G1 Juddmonte International S. hero Electrocutonist was first offered for sale at the 2006 KEEJAN sale in foal to Montjeu (Ire), only to be led out unsold at \$1.175 million. The buyers that failed to pull the trigger in January were made to pay at this sale a year ago, when her Montjeu colt realized a final bid of \$2.7 million, a North American record for a weanling. In foal to Storm Cat, Elbaaha was sent through the ring again yesterday, but bidding stalled at \$1.95 million. She will not see the sales pavilion again. "I just don't get it," said Shack Parrish, whose Indian Creek agency consigned the mare on both occasions and was also responsible for the sale of the Montjeu colt. "This is it. She won't be back. Now we'll just have to sell the foals." Elbaaha is also the dam of SW and GSP Grigorieva (Ire) (Woodman).

**Gains for Gainesway...**

The sales arm of Gainesway Farm had a successful afternoon, consigning a seven-figure mare as well as the second highest-priced foal during the session. The first of those to go through the ring was hip 365, the four-year-old filly **Be My Queen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who was carrying a foal by Gainesway's increasingly popular stallion Mr. Greeley. A half-sister to champion and G1SW Imperial Beauty (Ire) (Imperial Ballet {Ire}) from the family of MGSW & MG1SP Midnight Line, Be My Queen was purchased by bloodstock agent Larry O'Byrne for \$1.9 million. The son of Coolmore advisor Demi O'Byrne, Larry signed the ticket in the name of M L Bloodstock for a group in England he declined to reveal. "It's a lovely pedigree," Larry O'Byrne offered. "She's in foal to Mr. Greeley, who's been a top sire this year. Sadler's Wells is the best broodmare sire there is at the moment. She's got all the credentials and I wish the people back there all the luck. I thought she was one of the best mares in the sale." O'Byrne is one who believes firmly that this is the time to buy, especially for overseas customers. "One of the reasons a lot of the Europeans are over here is the Sterling is great against the dollar," he commented. "I'm not surprised the market is the way it is because of that. The quality of mares that went through yesterday and have gone through today, I'm not surprised the market is so strong. Keeneland has done a fantastic job and this is where it's at." About two hours later, Gainesway consigned a weanling filly by Giant's Causeway--Fly North (Pleasant Colony), which was purchased by Demi O'Byrne for \$800,000, who was buying out his foal-share partner, the filly's listed breeder Payson Stud. The March foal is a half-sister to champion and G1 Kentucky Oaks winner Farda Amiga. "I love the sire and I love the family," O'Byrne said. "Her sister was very good. I think she looks very much like her mother." Added Gainesway's Michael Hennon, "Giant's Causeway has been a tremendous stallion. Here's a half-sister to a champion; she has tremendous residual value as a broodmare and she was knocked down to a top judge."

**Mambo-ing With the Stars...**

It isn't so often that Sheikh Mohammed's bloodstock advisor John Ferguson buys weanlings, but yesterday he made his second notable exception of the sale. Ferguson, who went to \$700,000 for a Dynaformer--Mandela (Ger) weanling filly during the first day of selling, yesterday snatched up hip 363, an impeccably bred Kingmambo--Because (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) colt, for \$950,000. It was the top price for a weanling on the afternoon, and the second-highest-priced weanling in Book 1, behind Monday's \$1.7-million Pulpit--Madcap Escapade filly. "He was very strong foal and showed himself off very well, and he's by a great sire from what's obviously a fantastic cross with Sadler's Wells," Ferguson commented. "It's an interesting family, because it is made up of predominantly fillies, and as a result the pedigree is full of top, top fillies." The top distaffers Ferguson referred to include three full sisters to Because: Quarter Moon (Ire), highweighted in Ireland at two and winner of the G1 Moyglare S.; Yesterday (Ire), winner of the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas; and All My Loving (Ire), who was third in both the G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Epsom Oaks this year. Because herself went through Keeneland's ring just one year ago, and was knocked down to agent Hugo Lascelles for \$2.8 million while carrying hip 363. Daylesford Stud is the breeder of the colt. Ferguson said his new purchase would now go to Darley's Raceland Farm in Kentucky to relax and grow, but would likely be sent to Europe to begin his racing career. "I would think so, being by Kingmambo, as they tend to go much stronger on the turf than dirt," Ferguson said. Eaton Sales consigned hip 363.

**You Go Girl...**

Howard and Sondra Bender's **Promenade Girl** (Carson City--Promenade Colony, by Pleasant Colony) was the sort of racehorse anyone would like to have: consistent, tough and, on the right day, able to compete against some of the best fillies in the country. Produced by a half-sister to GISWs Another Review and No Review and a full to MGSW Dance Colony, she also boasts a pedigree that most breeders find desirable. That helped spur a spirited bidding yesterday that was won by Bob Greenbaum, who landed Promenade Girl for \$1.125 million. Greenbaum signed the ticket as Thoroughbred Advisory Group Inc. "It's for a group of guys in the New York area who are starting up a new venture," Greenbaum explained, adding that his clients would rather go unnamed. "It will be primarily a commercial venture, but they may also race out of the mare. They're looking to build a quality broodmare band that they can breed to top stallions." Greenbaum said the men have been involved in the business for some time, but were trying to upgrade their stock. Promenade Girl, who was consigned by Eaton Sales, agent, could be sent to either A.P. Indy or Kingmambo. The five-year-old, who was bred by the Benders, won eight of 21 races and missed the board just five times in her career. Her biggest win came over Round Pond in last year's GII Molly Pitcher BC H. at Monmouth Park. In all, she won five stakes races and banked \$678,990. The Benders purchased Promenade Girl's dam, Promenade Colony, for \$480,000 at the 1998 Keeneland November sale. They resold the mare at this year's January sale, in foal to Smart Strike, for \$200,000.

**Clearance Rate a Telling Sign...**

For the opening two days of trade at Keeneland November, gross receipts have already eclipsed the \$178-million mark. That's an increase of 19 percent over last year's Book 1, during which 11 fewer horses were sold. The cumulative average is ahead by 7.3 percent, while the median shows a decline of 9.1 percent. The most impressive statistic thus far, however, is the not-sold rate, which has remained under 20 percent. "The clearance rate is unbelievable, especially in the 'select' part of the market where people tend to value their horses higher," commented Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Eighty percent of the horses are selling. That tells us that people are realistic about the horses' values." Russell is equally impressed with the overall performance of the market. "Going into the sale, we knew there were several horses that were collector's items; they don't fall under any commercial guidelines at all and they definitely brought collector's item prices," he stated. "The rest of it comes down to the value that the Europeans perceive here because the dollar is so weak. They are buying with 50-cent dollars and buying top-quality horses, but it's not costing them as much. I think that has driven it up."

Efficient, winless in six starts since last year's G1 Victoria Derby triumph, flew under the radar in the pre-race calculations for the Melbourne Cup, but the grey gelding produced a stunning late burst of speed to snatch the Cup from Purple Moon and brave sophomore Mahler. He is the first Victoria Derby winner to take out the Melbourne Cup the following year since Phar Lap (NZ) accomplished the feat in 1930. Efficient was an impressive Derby victor and was entered for the 2006 Cup, but high-profile owner Lloyd Williams opted to scratch on race day and return this year. Reunited with jockey Michael Rodd for the first time since the Derby, he settled in the middle of the pack early. Rodd bided his time as Tungsten Strike (Smart Strike) and Mahler, attempting to become the first three-year-old since 1941 to win the Cup, set a genuine tempo in front. He rolled past the leaders inside the final furlong and fought his way home. "I'm back on the horse that put me in the spotlight, and he's done it again, and it is taking a while to sink in," said a jubilant Rodd. "It was a long way down that straight, but I was confident I was going to get there." Efficient's connections decided to shake things up before the Melbourne Cup, with a change of equipment and an unorthodox training regiment leading up to the race. "We decided to take the blinkers off and to wake him up a bit," Lloyd Williams explained. "He had a very hard gallop on Tuesday morning, and then we put him over hurdles to wake him up."

Purple Moon's trainer Luca Cumani said he could return for the 2008 Cup. "I had my heart in my mouth, but then I saw that horse coming from a long way out and I knew we were probably going to get caught," Cumani said, adding, "The winner won the Derby last year and he's entitled to win a big race. Unfortunately, it was today, [but] to come all this way and run well and to be the best of the internationals is great. He's not a bad horse either. He may be back." Ballydoyle conditioner Aidan O'Brien was pleased with the brave run put in by Mahler and indicated the colt could also be back. "He looks the type that will appreciate running further," O'Brien said.

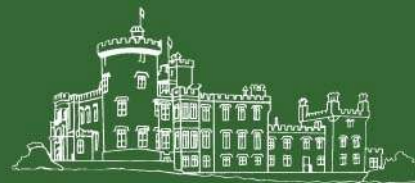

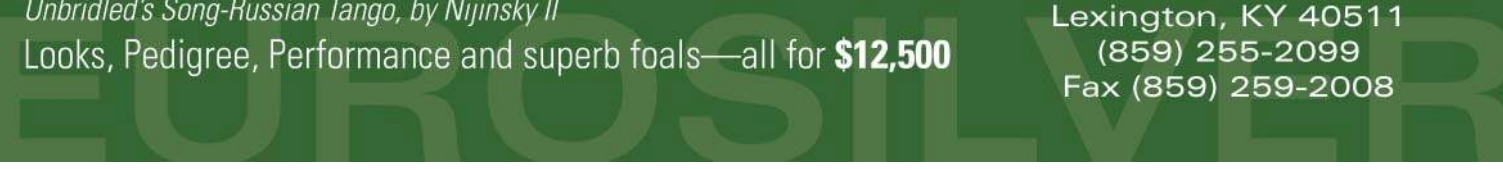

the bay captured a Churchill allowance Nov. 3. "He loved the track," said Zito, a two-time winner of the GI Kentucky Derby. "I couldn't believe the way he went over it. He was nice in Delaware, but he was better here the other day." Robert LaPenta's colt may make one more start this year. "He can run in either [GII] Kentucky Jockey Club [Nov. 24 at Churchill] or the [GII] Remsen S. [the same day] in New York," Zito added. "I have another horse that I am going to point, **Anak Nakal** (Victory Gallop), so I have

to make up my mind if I want to run both or one." Anak Nakal, owned by Four Roses Thoroughbreds, was the runner-up in the GIII Nashua S. Oct. 28 at Aqueduct last out. As for LaPenta's War Pass, the unbeaten colt is taking it easy following his front-running success in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 27. "I might take him out this weekend and jog him around a little bit, let him take in the sights and see the Twin Spires," Zito said. "I am just letting him down now. He needed a break. He ran hard." Zito will spend the winter mapping out plans for his Derby hopefuls. "That is the easiest thing in the world. You've got a million places to go," Zito said. "There are so many preps before the big dance and so many options." Winner of the Derby in 1991 and 1992, Zito saddled five runners in the 2005 Run for the Roses, but the best he could do was a seventh with Kinsman's favored Bellamy Road. "Now the big dance is different," Zito continued. "You hope you have as many as you can. The more chances you have, the better you are. You see now what happens; you could have nine and it doesn't matter. That would be the least of our problems, but they have to keep going forward. Every step is harder...I'd like to get that third Derby. I thought we had a really good shot with Mr. Steinbrenner's horse and a few of the other horses we had, but it didn't work out that way."

Jockey Mark Guidry, who rode the 5,000th winner of his career in May, will hang up his tack after the races at Churchill Downs Saturday. The 48-year-old, a native of Lafayette, Louisiana, has won

5,042 races and \$100,818,985 in purses to date. He will begin the six-day Racing Officials Accreditation Program Wednesday at the University of Louisville. "I think it's just time [to retire]," Guidry said. "It is time for another chapter in my life and I am looking forward to it. I hope I can get a good job somewhere. I think I have a lot to offer. I have been through it all on the race-track and hopefully, that will be my calling." He added, "I had a great career and I appreciate all the opportunities that were given to me all these years. That will be missed, but that is why a steward is a good thing for me, because I will be able to come see my peers and be a part of the game and give something back." Guidry won the 2006 GI Kentucky Oaks on Lemons Forever (who sold for \$2.5 million at KEENOV yesterday). He also took the 2005 GI Santa Anita Derby with Buzzards Bay, and was honored by his fellow riders with the 2006 George Woolf Award. "I am grateful I am going out on my own terms and in one piece," Guidry said. "I guess that's all you can ask."

MORE PLAUDITS FOR FALLON

Trainer Sir Michael Stoute became the latest to speak in defence of Kieren Fallon in the race-fixing trial at the Old Bailey. The multiple British champion trainer was called upon to help pull apart Fallon's ride on The Queen's Daring Aim (GB) in a Newmarket maiden in July 2004, which saw large bets placed on her to lose foiled after she was nursed to success. "It was a brilliant ride," Stoute said. "She was not helping him." He went on to praise another of the six-time champion jockey's ride on Krynica, who won at Pontefract in June 2004. "It is beautiful horsemanship--and she was not very good," he added. When asked whether he felt money or winning motivated Fallon during his spell as first jockey at Freemason Lodge, Stoute answered unequivocally, "While he was with me, it had been the pursuit of winning." The court also heard tapes of the questioning of Fallon by the City of London Police, during which he answered a probe about the potential to fix a race. "It is impossible," he had said. "Horses have minds of their own. My riding has never been questioned."
