Epona Bloodstock landed the seven-year-old mare **Dhamma**, a daughter of Broad Brush from a top family of the famed Niarchos breeding operation, for a session-topping \$520,000 yesterday at the Keeneland November sale in Lexington, Kentucky. Representatives of Epona, sitting just below the press box, did battle with Coolmore's Paul Shanahan, who finally relented on the Lane's End consignee. An agent from Epona who declined to be identified offered, "She's from a beautiful family, and she's really a gorgeous mare." The agent said that Dhamma was for Denis Brosnan, who owns Croom

**'WHIMSY' LOOKS SERIOUS IN MRS. REVERE**

**Bit of Whimsy** (Distorted Humor) will be looking for her third graded-stakes victory in just her seventh outing today in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill. The big chestnut, who dead-heated with Rutherford in the GIII Sands Point S. at Belmont in June, ran second by 3/4 of a length to the ill-fated Alexander Tango (Ire) in the GI Garden City S. Sept. 8 before breaking through with a 2 1/4-length triumph in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland Oct. 13 in her most recent trip postward. Trainer Barclay Tagg flirted with the idea of capping off her season with the \$500,000 GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Nov. 25, but opted to keep his charge with her peers for now. "[The Mrs. Revere is] the last race of the year for straight three-year-olds," Tagg explained. "The Matriarch is only a mile, and I think she is better suited for this distance [a mile and a sixteenth]. It is less money, but it is still a Grade II, and I have another filly for the Matriarch in Dance Away Capote." The Mrs. Revere has attracted a full field of 14, including last-out stakes winners **Bel Air Beauty** (Smart Strike) and **Cat Charmer** (Storm Cat).

**Sierra Picks Up a Madre...**

Ed and Sharon Hudon had long been involved in racing and breeding Thoroughbreds in California, but it wasn't until they moved to Kentucky about four years ago that they took their operation to the next level. The Hudons purchased Chase Farm in Kentucky and, after renovating the property, built up a broodmare band numbering around 30. Operating under the named Sierra Farm, the Hudons added another mare to their stable yesterday with the purchase of hip 1586, the stakes-winning Honour and Glory mare **Honour Colony**, for \$330,000. The five-year-old was consigned by Three Chimneys Sales. Honour Colony banked \$209,268 on the track and raced as recently as Oct. 21, when she ran fourth in the Summer Prom S. at Hawthorne. She was catalogued as a racing or broodmare prospect, but Ed Hudon confirmed that Honour Colony's racing days are over, and that she'll be retired to the breeding shed. What made Honour Colony an exciting prospect? "I liked her pedigree, and her second dam in particular," explained Hudon, referencing Honour Colony's grandmother Oceana (Northern Dancer). Oceana is a full-sister to Canadian champion Northernette and to English and Irish champ Storm Bird. She is also the granddam of graded-winner Indian Ocean and of Honour Colony's half-sister, the graded-winner Lindsay Jean (Saint Ballado). Talking about her physical attributes, Hudon continued, "We knew she toed in a little bit, but we were willing to overlook that. But other than that, her conformation is pretty nice." The Hudons purchased Honour Colony on the advice of Kris Stuebs's Kris S. Bloodstock, as well their farm manager, Alicia Earlywine. Team Sierra mentioned Bernardini as a possible mate for Honour Colony. "We'll breed her right, for sure," said Hudon, who added that Sierra breeds to both race and sell. The Hudons ran an aluminum company in California, Sierra Aluminum, before Ed sold the company to his employees and retired to Kentucky. He still sits on the Board of Directors of Sierra Aluminum. Sierra Farm currently has several horses in training with Jimmy Corrigan.

**Striking Gold...**

The sale of Honour Colony represented a handy score for Scott Goldsher, who'd claimed her for \$62,500 in mid-June. At the time, Honour Colony was a six-time winner who had cleared her allowance conditions, but who had failed to add any black-type to her resume. That's when John Hamilton, a member of Three Chimney Farm's bloodstock services team, noticed she was entered in an optional claimer at Arlington Park. "My partner at Three Chimneys, Jason Litt, and I keep an eye on all the claiming races across the country for fillies and mares running for, say, \$30,000 and up," Hamilton explained. "It's pretty rare that I see something that's worth her claiming price as a broodmare, but with this filly, I was like, 'Wow, that's a lot of page.' So I called up Scott and said, 'You've gotta go claim this filly--I don't care what she looks like.'" Goldsher, a Chicago-area businessman who had dabbled in a few partnerships, wisely took the advice. A month later, both men looked pretty smart when, in her first start after the claim, Honour Colony won the \$100,000 Lady Canterbury Breeders' Cup S. "She was a light, sort of flighty type of mare, and we shipped her up there to find a softer spot for her," said Hamilton. "The trainer, Mack Robertson, really took his time with her and got her settled down." Honour Colony added a pair of thirds in stakes events before being sent to Kentucky for this sale. With Goldsher already out on the claiming price from Honour Colony's purse earnings, yesterday's \$330,000 price tag was especially sweet. "You know, sometimes you have to step into the batter's box," said Hamilton. "Once in a while, you'll hit a home run." Asked what he was doing to celebrate, Hamilton said, "I'm going out to dinner with Goldsher. He's buying."

### Sam-Son Strikes Smartly...

The Samuel family's Sam-Son Farm is known more for the powerhouse performances of its homebreds on the racetrack than success in the auction ring, but the farm enjoyed a notable sales triumph at Keeneland yesterday. Through bloodstock agent Patrick Lawley-Wakelin, Sam-Son purchased the mare **Deaconess Bonnie** (Pulpit), in foal to champion sprinter Orientate, for \$60,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale. Going through the ring again yesterday, Deaconess Bonnie attracted a final bid of \$155,000 from Corner Woods, agent. Her Orientate weanling colt followed her into the ring and brought \$165,000. The catalogue page was boosted by the accomplishments of Deaconess Bonnie's half-brother Diabolical (Artax), winner of this year's GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. and second in the GI Carter H. According to Lawley-Wakelin, Sam-Son's appearance as a Keeneland November seller was precipitated by prevailing market conditions and doesn't indicate a major change of direction for the operation. "Everything worked out very well [with Deaconess Bonnie]," Lawley-Wakelin said. "The pedigree jumped up there with Diabolical. I loved that she was in foal to Orientate [last year]; I think he's a very underrated sire and the foal was outstanding." Deaconess Bonnie sold in foal to Officer, but the original intention was to breed her to the Sam-Son-bred and raced Smart Strike. "We had a number of shares in Smart Strike," explained Lawley-Wakelin. "When he was originally bought off the Samuels, Lane's End asked us to stay in for 'x' amount of shares--which is quite significant. Today we still have all those shares. Because of the phenomenal success of Smart Strike, and with his stud fee inching up and Sam-Son having a small broodmare band with a number of mares from his immediate family, we are starting to look at going back into the market...with the possibility of buying mares to send to him." Smart Strike's popularity and a strong market have given Sam-Son some unique opportunities. "The traditional way for us to buy is through the yearling sales, but this year we've sold two mares tremendously well," Lawley-Wakelin said.

"One was a stakes winner and group placed, the other was stakes placed, but both were by Smart Strike, and that is the reason why we sold them," Lawley-Wakelin added. "We will possibly come back into the market and buy the odd mare or two with the specific look at possibly breeding to Smart Strike. Clearly, because the fee for Smart Strike is \$150,000 and he's been tremendously well received even at that fee, we're going to try find mares that are appropriate, with the view of possibly including them in the broodmare band for Sam-Son and, if not, to possibly reselling them." But don't expect a huge influx of Sam-Son horses on the market. "This just a little experiment that we suggested to [Sam-Son President and General Manager] Tammy [Samuel-Balaz]," the bloodstock agent continued. "We saw that there was an opportunity in the market last year, thinking that the market would move forward, and it has gone beyond our wildest dreams. It is definitely a seller's market. That is an issue for us. We've got a dilemma because we're possibly trying to buy one or two mares for Smart Strike, but the other side is we've sold very well in the market. We're very pleased with what we've sold." Lawley-Wakelin and Sam-Son also added to the broodmare band Thursday at Keeneland with the purchase of the mare **Not for Turning** (Deputy Minister) for \$180,000.



### McLovin Sighting?

The *TDN* was unable to confirm a McLovin sighting at the Keeneland November Sale yesterday. The star of this summer's hit "Superbad" was reportedly on the grounds examining "breeding stock," and signed the ticket for 1528, a weanling colt by Eurosilver--Ellzey for \$35,000, but efforts to reach the elusive Lothario were unsuccessful. Stay tuned.

Walden, Jr.'s Hurricane Hall in Lexington, and Walden's been busy of late purchasing broodmare prospects for his new sire. Walden has been shopping on behalf of Brad Kelley's Kelley Farms Racing, which joined with Hurricane Hall to purchase a majority interest in English Channel after his retirement. Walden acquired a pair of mares yesterday, led by hip 1682, a flashy Grade I-winning daughter of Avenue of

Flags, **Notable Career**, who was knocked down for \$400,000. "We liked this mare because she's got a lot of Seattle Slew to her--she's by a son of Seattle Slew," Walden explained. "She's big, strong, with good bone. English Channel's not a big horse, but he is a very attractive horse. He's 15.2 hands, so we have been looking for mares with some size." Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency consigned the nine-year-old Notable Career, whose biggest victory came in the GI Oak Leaf S. in 2000. She also won that year's GIII Landaluce S. on her way to banking \$327,855. Notable Career had the pedigree to go with her race record: she's a 3/4-sister to MGISW General Challenge and MSW Western Hemisphere. Thus far during the

November sale, Walden has bought an impressive 17 mares for a total of \$4,360,000, an average \$256,470. "Most" of those mares are for English Channel, said Walden, who added that the plan called for Kelley to both race and sell the resulting offspring. "The common theme of the mares we've bought is

that there have been a lot of good racemares," said Walden. "There are a lot of graded performers. He was a racehorse--a really, really good horse--and we're just trying to complement that with nice, big racemares."

**Another Buy Low, Sell High...**

In keeping with the 'Buy Low, Sell High' theme of the day, Notable Career's sale was a case of things going just right for her connections. Last January, Spencer and Sherri Plummer took a chance and purchased Notable Career for \$90,000 at the Keeneland January Sale, despite the fact that the Speightstown foal that she had been carrying was aborted before the sale. The gamble paid off. The Plummers put Notable Career in foal to Giant's Causeway this spring on an early Feb. 21 cover, and hoped that folks would notice that Notable Career's 2006 foal by the Coolmore stallion had been purchased by Demi O'Bryne for \$370,000 at last year's September Sale. Whether or not that helped fuel the bidding yesterday remains unknown, but for the Plummers, it was a notable success.

**Bittersweet Sale for Nursery...**

A quick look at the buyer's guide and it becomes clear very quickly that **Probable Storm** (Tabasco Cat) has been a very productive mare since being purchased by Nursery Place for a client for \$100,000 at the 2004 Keeneland November Sale. She produced a foal the following spring by Aptitude which sold for \$75,000 as a yearling. Her next foal, a colt by Pulpit, was purchased as a yearling by pinhooker Murray Smith for \$385,000 at this year's Fasig-Tipton July Sale. And yesterday, both Probable Storm and her weanling filly by Saint Liam were offered up by Nursery Place. Selling as hip 1706, Probable Storm, in foal to Aragorn (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), brought \$220,000 from Foxtale Farm, while Bill Warren purchased her filly for \$130,000. Sadly, the man who originally purchased Probable Storm wasn't able to enjoy much of her success. Robert Hagopian, a California-based client of Nursery's who was returning to the racing game after a long absence, was diagnosed with cancer not long after her purchased Probable Storm and several other mares. He died this spring. "He had a real passion for racing," said Nursery Place's John Mayer. "He got out of the business about 20 years ago and was just getting back in. I had purchased for mares for him. But he loved his family, so hopefully this worked out a little bit for them."

**Tommy Town Gets Its Babe...**

**Babe Hall** (El Corredor), selling as a broodmare prospect, brought \$400,000 from Tommy Town Thoroughbreds during Friday's session of the Keeneland November sale. The four-year-old filly was third in this year's Gill Las Flores H. In 16 starts, she was on the board nine times and won three races, earning \$162,272. Babe Hall, out of Storm Teal (Storm Bird), is a half-sister to stakes winner and graded stakes placed Gold Storm (Seeking the Gold). "She

has a beautiful body, she was a good racehorse and she's got a good pedigree," Tommy Town's Tom Stull said of his newest acquisition. Stull added that he was not surprised by the spirited bidding for Babe Hall. "I thought she'd bring anything between \$300,000 and \$600,000, but you never know at this sale. I've been here since Wednesday and, I'll tell you, it's bad. We've bid on 10 or 12 and have gotten a weanling and now two mares." In addition to Babe Hall, Tommy Town purchased a Lion Heart weanling filly for \$100,000 and the mare Sea Poppy (Forestry) for \$75,000. As for mating plans for Babe Hall, Stull said, "We'll have to go home and study." Babe Hall was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent. Her dam is a full to GSW & G1SP Stonehatch, and is a half to Paul Mellon's GISW Danger's Hour (Coastal). Babe Hall's third dam is the Crozier mare Prides Promise, the ancestress of graded performers such as Carson City, General Meeting, Dixie Dot Com and Summertime Promise.

***A Good Day at the Office...***

As the marathon Keeneland November sale marched on with its fifth session Friday, Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell stated, "I thought it was a very good day at the office." For the first five days of the 15-day auction, Keeneland has sold 1121 horses for a total of \$271,446,500. The average of \$242,147 is up 10.7 percent from a year ago, while the median is down 3.8 percent to \$125,000. For the session, the average was up 4.8 percent to \$89,937, while the median remained even at \$65,000. "It was still a very solid sale from start to finish, with a strong mix of buyers internationally and domestically," Russell said. "The mare market has been exceptionally strong. I've talked to several domestic buyers today who are very frustrated, and to several international buyers who are very frustrated. But the good news is that both of them said they were going to stay around and keep on trying." The strength of this year's market continues to be young broodmares. "The mare market has been very strong," confirmed Russell. "Young mares with good race records--the race record has definitely become a very important component of buying, then after that the pedigree. But the race record has driven up dramatically." The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

In addition to being a Breeders' Cup trivia answer, the blaze-faced brown mare carved out an impressive career in subsequent seasons, capturing the GI Kentucky Oaks, GI Hollywood Oaks, GI Santa Susana S. and GIII Las Virgenes S. at three. She also ran second in the GI Alabama S. and third in the GI Gazelle H. in 1985, and was the runner-up to Horse of the Year Lady's Secret in the 1986 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. In all, Fran's Valentine compiled a record of 34-13-4-5 and a bankroll of \$1,375,465. She RNA'd for \$290,000 as part of the Scheib dispersal in 1995 at Barretts, but was acquired privately by Strawbridge in time for him to be the co-breeder of her 1993 Dayjur filly, With Fascination. That filly captured the G3 Prix de Cabourg and placed in a pair of Group 1 events at two in France. Fran's Valentine's 1995 foal by Relaunch proved to be her best, by far. With Anticipation, a nearly white gelding, carried Strawbridge's colors to victory in five Grade I races and ran second in the 2002 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, earning over \$2.6 million. Fran's Valentine's final foal was With Honour, a 2003 gelding by Honour and Glory.

At the Keeneland November sale yesterday, the first two mares in foal to first crop covering sire

**BASSETT HONORED WITH PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD**

James E. (Ted) Bassett III, former chairman of the board of Keeneland and a decorated World War II veteran, has been awarded the Department of the Navy Superior Public Service Award. It is the second-highest civilian award and recognizes significant contributions by a civilian to the Navy, Marine Corps or entire Department of the Navy. Bassett will receive the award in recognition of "significant contributions and unflagging support of the United States Marine Corps for 64 years." After enlisting in the Marine Corps in 1943, Bassett rose from private to first lieutenant, leading a rifle platoon in combat during the battle of Okinawa, where he was wounded. He participated in the mainland Japan landings and was discharged in 1946. Bassett has hosted three Marine Corps University Foundation fundraisers and worked closely with the President of the Marine Corps Heritage Foundation, as a member of the "Founders Group," which advanced the projects of the Foundation, most notably the National Museum of the Marine Corps. He received the coveted U.S. Marine Corps's Semper Fidelis in April 1990. Since 1992, Bassett has hosted the annual Marine Corps Birthday Breakfast at Keeneland. Most recently, he assumed the duties of Chairman, Marine Corps Coordinating Council, Kentucky. "I am deeply honored to receive this award from the Corps," said Bassett. "It is a classic example of Marine Corps 101--taking a nobody and trying to make a somebody out of him." Bassett has been associated with Keeneland for almost four decades, serving as president from 1970 until 1986, chairman of the board from 1986 until 2001, and Keeneland trustee from 1993 through 2006. He continues to serve as a member of the Keeneland board of directors.

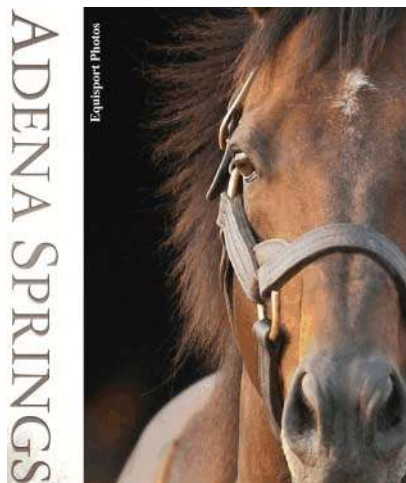



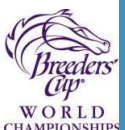
