### MANDURO'S DAM ADDED TO TATTS

Tattersalls has announced that **Mandellicht (Ire)** (Be My Guest--Mandelaugue {Ger}, by Elektrant {GB}), the dam of champion **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}), will be offered at the forthcoming December Sale. Consigned by agent Ronald Rauscher, the 13-year-old will go through the ring as Lot **2289** Tuesday, Dec. 4. In foal to Monsun, the stakes-placed Mandellicht is carrying a full sibling to Manduro, whose career came to a premature end after he sustained an injury in the G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp Sept. 16. He was undefeated in five starts this year, achieving the rare feat of winning three consecutive Group 1 races over three different distances for owner Baron Georg von Ullmann and trainer Andre Fabre. Manduro

won 10 of his 18 starts with earnings of £1,037,461. He was champion two-year-old in Germany--when trained by Peter Schiergen--and ended his career as the highest-rated horse in the world with an official mark of 130. Mandellicht will be joined by two family members at the sale: daughter **Madura (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}), who sells as Lot **2195** and is also in foal to Monsun; and half-sister **Mandelhush (Ger)** (Alwuhush), who sells in foal to Monsun's son Shirocco (Ger) as Lot **2101**. Mandellicht's seven-year-old daughter Mandela (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}), a stakes winner and Group 1-placed, sold for \$1.4 million to Katsumi Yoshida last week at Keeneland November. The Tattersalls December Sale will kick off with yearlings Nov. 26, followed by foals Nov. 27-Dec. 1 and will continue with breeding stock Dec. 3-6.

### CARTIER AWARDS ANNOUNCED TODAY

The 2007 Cartier Racing Awards, European horseracing's equivalent of the Oscars, will be announced at a dinner held at Mayfair's Four Seasons Hotel in London this evening. There are eight equine categories--Horse of the Year, Top Older Horse, Top Stayer, Top Sprinter, Three-Year-Old Colt, Three-Year-Old Filly, Two-Year-Old Colt and Two-Year-Old Filly. This year's Horse of the Year nominees are **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill), **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}), **Peeping Fawn (Danehill)** and **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}). Winners from each division are decided by an established method, involving a combination of points achieved in pattern races, the views of racing journalists on Cartier's Racing Panel and votes from readers of *Racing Post* and *The Daily Telegraph*. The awards were established in 1991 to recognize excellence in the racehorse and, in addition to the eight equine awards, the Cartier/Daily Telegraph Award of Merit will be presented to the person who has done most for European racing and/or breeding either over their lifetime or within the past 12 months. Former winners include Henry Cecil, David and Patricia Thompson, Prince Khalid Abdullah, John Magnier, His Highness The Aga Khan, Peter Walwyn, the Head Family, Frankie Dettori, John Dunlop, Francois Boutin and Lester Piggott.

**RAGS TO RICHES TO RACE IN 2008** Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy), sidelined since September with a hairline fracture in her right front pastern, is expected to return to trainer Todd Pletcher's Hollywood Park barn in December, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "We don't have a firm shipping date, but we hope to have her here next month," Pletcher told *DRF*. "She's coming back. There is no

question about it." Odds-on to earn an Eclipse Award, the flashy chestnut captured four Grade I races this year, including a historic score over likely Horse of the Year Curlin in the GI Belmont S. in June. She missed the summer and raced once more, finishing second in the GI Gazelle H. Sept. 15 at Belmont. Her injury was detected the next day, and she was sent to Ashford Stud in Kentucky

to recuperate. "She's still recovering and we'll do another set of X-rays shortly," Pletcher added. "We have to play it by ear. She's just resting. The first six weeks was stall rest."

**MCPEEK SUING MIDNIGHT CRY** Trainer Ken McPeek has filed a lawsuit in Louisville, Kentucky, against jailed Midnight Cry Stable principals William Gallion and Shirley Cunningham, according to published reports. McPeek contends that he is owed a 5-percent commission--\$175,000--on the February sale of an 80-percent interest in GI Breeders' Cup Classic and GI Preakness S. hero **Curlin** (Smart Strike). According to the lawsuit, McPeek signed an agreement in 2002 with Tandy LLC, the parent company of Midnight Cry, which would give him a 5-percent commission on purchases and sales of horses, as well as two lifetime breeding

rights to horses that entered stud upon retirement. McPeek bought the big chestnut for \$57,000 on behalf of Midnight Cry as a yearling at Keeneland September in 2005; Midnight Cry sold an 80-percent interest in the colt to Stonestreet Stables, Padua Stables and George Bolton for a reported \$3.5 million after his impressive debut victory at Gulfstream in February. Jess Jackson's Stonestreet and Bolton bought out Padua's interest in the colt last week. McPeek's lawsuit also cites Grade I winner Einstein (Brz) as another runner he selected for Midnight Cry.

**DYLAN THOMAS TO JAPAN CUP** G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) is among five overseas acceptors for the G1 Japan Cup

Nov. 25 in Tokyo. The four-year-old, slated to enter stud at Coolmore in 2008, is coming off a fifth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf over dirt ground at Monmouth Park Oct. 27. In addition to his Arc triumph, the bay won the G1 Irish Champion S., G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. and G1 Prix Ganay this season. Trainer Aidan O'Brien told *Racing Post*, "It looks like Dylan Thomas will be going for

the Japan Cup and Johnny Murtagh will ride. He seems to be fine after his trip to America, where the going went against him. With a bit of luck, things will work out between now and the race." Other European acceptors for the Japan Cup are **Halicarnassus (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), **Papal Bull (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Saddex (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). The only American representative is slated to be **Artiste Royal (Ire)** (Danehill), a six-year-old trained by Neil Drysdale.

**DALVINA TO REMAIN IN U.S.** **Dalvina (GB)** (Grand Lodge {GB}), winner of the GIII Long Island H. Nov. 11, will remain in the United States and continue her racing career with trainer Graham Motion.

According to Motion, the winner of Newmarket's Pretty Polly S., who previously campaigned for Edward Dunlop, arrived at Fair Hill Training Center in Maryland Nov. 12. "I have not trained horses for the Stones before, but I know Ed Dunlop quite well and that was the connection that resulted in me getting the filly,"

Motion told *The Blood-Horse*. "She had been keeping very solid company in Europe, so her win [in the Long Island] wasn't a big surprise, except for the fact she won as easily as she did." Motion indicated that the chestnut would make her next start in the GII La Prevoyante H. at Calder Dec. 15. "Provided she is doing well, we will run in the La Prevoyante," Motion added. "We'll give her a break after that and point her to the nice races next year with, hopefully, the Breeders' Cup our year-end goal."

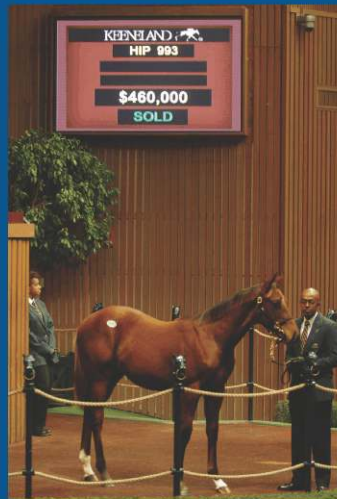

**WINSTAR COLT TOPS TUESDAY AS KEENELAND ACHIEVES RECORD GROSS** Much as Spring at Last topped last year's corresponding session, a colt from the consignment of WinStar Racing, agent led all receipts yesterday at Keeneland November. **Go Swiftly** (Gone West), a two-year-old colt who had placed twice since the catalogue was printed, including a runner-up effort on the grass at Churchill Nov. 3 ([video](#)), brought a bid of \$250,000. Allen Iwinski signed the ticket on behalf of a partnership. A half-brother to SW Paiota Falls, the bay was produced by Dance Swiftly (Danzig), a full sister to champion Dance Smartly and a half to leading sire Smart Strike. Midway through yesterday's ninth session of the 15-day auction, Keeneland eclipsed its previous record gross of \$317,666,000, set in 1999. At the end of trading Tuesday, a total of \$321,774,400 had been spent on 2,141 horses. The cumulative median remains unchanged at \$65,000 compared to last year, but the cumulative average has increased 9.2 percent to \$150,292 from \$137,585. "We are delighted to break the record with six days left in the sale," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "This is a very cosmopolitan sale, and the strength of foreign currencies against the U.S. dollar has made it even more attractive to international buyers."

The day's top mare was **Full Flavor** (Smart Strike), a four-year-old in foal to Canadian champion Wando (Langfuhr) who sold for \$150,000. She was purchased by the South African stud L'Ormarins from the Lane's End draft. The chestnut, twice a winner at three, is a half-sister to GSW Knockadoon (Dixieland Band) and SW Play the Corners (Silver Deputy). **Keeneland Coverage cont. p5**

What did you think of the new two-day Breeders' Cup format, and what changes would you suggest to further strengthen the event going forward ?

**Doug Cauthen, President & CEO, WinStar:**

I really liked the Breeders' Cup expansion to a two-day format, as the Breeders Cup board sought to create an "Oaks/Derby" type of following. Over 25,000 people braving the weather suggests that if the racing is good, people will come. The additional races were legitimate additions to a championship weekend, and had instant impact in the bloodstock market. Corinthian's win in the Dirt Mile surely impacted his value and stud fee in a positive way, so the market stated in economic terms that the race really mattered. I also particularly liked the addition of the two-year-old turf race, as it drew a diverse and international field and gave owners and trainers a big target to aim for. **Cont. p6**

### Two Weanlings Hit Six Figures...

A pair of weanlings broke the six-figure barrier during yesterday's session. Early in the day, hip **3099**, a colt by Indian Charlie, was purchased for \$140,000 by Ben Glass as agent. The March-foaled bay, consigned by Mr. and Mrs. Wayne Lyster's Ashview Farm, was produced by the Hennessy mare Cheri Chardoneigh, a half-sister to GSW Fifth Overture and SW & GISP Gold From the West. Dan Issel, who bought Cheri Chardoneigh as a yearling for \$90,000 at the 2001 Keeneland September Sale, bred this youngster. The second-highest priced weanling was hip **3357**, a colt from the first crop of GISW Purge (Pulpit). Purchased for \$100,000 by Circle of Misfits, the bay hailed from the Three Chimneys consignment. He is out of the Favorite Trick mare Subterfuge, a daughter of champion Smart Angle and a half-sister to MGSW Houston. His dam was purchased by Chad Schumer, agent, for \$90,000 at this venue two years ago. As for strengthening the event, I am a fan of basing the event at one regular location, in order to grow the two-day format into a community event. The Oaks/ Derby tandem probably wouldn't be what it has become without the community's pride and support of the event. It's Derby "week" in Louisville, not just Derby weekend--and every radio station, restaurant, hotel, and business promotes it that way. That sort of community support and involvement won't likely materialize without continuity of the event in one location. I understand that there are many compelling reasons to rotate the event throughout the country, so I'd throw out a possible compromise of every fourth year at a regional location, but that's the arbitrator in me talking.

Right now, the Breeders Cup Friday races serve as a tasty appetizer to the Saturday feast, and like the Oaks/ Derby, each day will have its rightful place. It's ideal for TV with the Friday "promo," and seems to fit the ESPN schedule well. I also salute the move to ESPN, as with bottom scrolling and bundled web coverage and promotion, it's great exposure to teched-up and stats-minded sports (and sports betting) fans...and that's just the market racing must finally begin to reach and teach. But I'd caution

Thoroughbred racing to be careful not to dilute the product with any unnecessary races. The beauty of the Breeders Cup is in its matchups, first-meetings between great horses from across the U.S. and across the globe, and best of all, 3-year-olds late in their season proving their mettle against older horses. I wish harness racing would take the cue on that front!

**THE NOVEMBER SALES: INCHING FORWARD**

After the first nine days of selling--Fasig-Tipton Sunday and eight days (first four Books) at Keeneland--through the close of business Monday, a total of 1,980 horses had sold for \$365,610,100 and averaged \$184,652. Last year at the same juncture, there had been 2,083 sold, for a total of \$354,937,400, and an average of \$170,397. The number sold is down 5 percent; the gross is up over \$10 million, or 3 percent; and the average is up 8 percent over 2006.

As we reported last week, the first three days (Fasig Sunday plus Keeneland Book 1) were up 8 percent in gross and 13 percent in average over 2006, including the new record \$10.5-million mare, Playful Act. However, Books 2 and 3 saw four straight days of declines in gross, though on two of those days, the average was up over 2006. Overall, Books 2 and 3 were down 8 percent in gross, but with 6 percent fewer horses sold, the Book 2-3 average was down just 2 percent, from \$112,937 in 2006 to \$110,876 this year. The first three days were up nearly \$17 million in total sales; the next four days were off by nearly \$10 million.

There was a double-digit rally on Sunday and Monday, with Book 4 up 15 percent in gross and 18 percent in average. Though this reversal in trend, partly fueled by buyers from far-flung countries as well as U.S. regional markets, was welcome, overall the six days of Keeneland Books 2-4 saw 5 percent fewer horses sold for 4 percent less money, but therefore posting a nominal 1-percent gain in average from 2006. Unlike the September sales, when the top declined and the rest of the sale was up, in November so far the top was up, and the rest of the sale has been marginally down. Partially this can only reflect what it is in the catalogues, and certainly the consensus 'on campus' has been that the sales have been consistently strong "for what's in the books," a subject discussed last week.

**Names in the News...**

The Instatistics tables run in today's edition (see p8) cover sales through the end of Book 4, Monday. Of sires with their first foals in 2007 which had two or more weanlings sell, Ghostzapper is way out in front, with two weanlings from his first crop averaging \$755,000. Heavily represented by the big Adena Springs reduction, he also had 16 in-foal mares average \$423,437. Rock Hard Ten has had eight weanlings average \$187,500, while dual Classic winner Afleet Alex has sold 16, averaging just under \$120,000.

Kitten's Joy had five average \$112,000, followed by Taylor Made's Forest Danger, who had 14 average \$107,857, and the ill-fated Saint Liam, whose seven sold averaged \$101,500. Bernardini, as noted last week, is also far in front of his contemporaries among sires with their first coverings (four or more sold), with 10 mares in foal to him averaging \$1.152 million. Bluegrass Cat (16, averaged \$310,000), First Samurai (20, averaged \$250,000), and Henny Hughes (16, averaged \$231,500) all proved popular. A total of 52 mares sold in foal to these three and averaged over \$250,000. Interestingly, of the top 10 sires with two or more weanlings sold, and the top 10 with four or more mares in foal, four stand at Darley. Lane's End stood three, but Saint Liam died after siring just one crop, which are now weanlings. Vinery and Claiborne have two each, but Coolmore's American arm, Ashford, has none. It's only a small skirmish, but in these sire crops at the moment, the score stands Darley 4 (including one of the two commercial stars, Bernardini), Coolmore 0.

**DICKINSON GIVES UP TRAINING FOR TAPETA**

Michael Dickinson will not apply for a trainer's license in 2008, in order to spend more time overseeing installation of his Tapeta Footings at locations around the world. "I need 100 percent of my time to concentrate on Tapeta Footings," Dickinson said in a statement. "I spent most of last winter overseas and 50 percent of my time this summer visiting Tapeta installations in five countries, which obviously leaves little time for training. I have been concerned for some time about the welfare of horses racing on unsuitable surfaces and really want to repay the horse in my own small way." Dickinson's patented synthetic surface has been installed at Golden Gate Fields, Preque Isle Downs and Fair Hill Training Center, as well as at Godolphin's training center in Dubai. Dickinson began his racing career in his native England as a steeplechase rider and trainer. He was the country's leading steeplechase trainer for three consecutive years. He started training in the U.S. in 1987 and among his more storied triumphs is the repeat success of Da Hoss in the 1998 GI Breeders' Cup Mile off a two-year absence. In 1998, Dickinson opened the 200-acre training facility Tapeta Farm in Maryland. In 2007, Dickinson has saddled 94 starters and 12 winners. His Marsh Side was second in the GII Northern Dancer S. at Woodbine in July. "In America, I am most proud of being runner-up in the Eclipse Training Award, to have received the C.V. Whitney Special Achievement Award and of building Tapeta Farm, from which I sent out eight Grade I winners in the first eight years," Dickinson said. "Including my riding and training careers in the Untied Kingdom and America, I have won a total of 1312 races and 151 stakes races, 85 stakes races being won in America."

**GILDED TIME TO BAR NONE RANCHES** Gilded Time (Timeless Moment--Gilded Lilly, by What a Pleasure), Eclipse Champion two-year-old of 1992, has been purchased by Bar None Ranches and will begin standing at stud at the Alberta farm in 2008. "We are extremely pleased with the acquisition of Gilded Time," said Mike

Vanin, manager of Bar None Ranches. "He is a very attractive animal and has been a fixture of the leading sire list. The response in our area to this horse is incredible. He has not even arrived and his book is already filling fast. We are seeing tremendous growth in our industry in Western Canada. With the proposed multi-

million dollar racetrack project in Alberta to be completed in 2009, this is an excellent time to bring a proven sire like Gilded Time to our region." During his championship juvenile campaign, Gilded Time was unbeaten in four starts, including the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, GII Sapling S. and GII Arlington-Washington Futurity. He was third in the 1993 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and retired with four wins in six starts and earnings of \$975,980. Gilded Time, who began his stud career in 1994, has stood his whole career at Vinery.
