**POET LAUREATE: DYLAN THOMAS
NAMED CARTIER HORSE OF THE YEAR**

Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) was crowned Cartier's Horse of the Year last night at an awards ceremony held at the Four Seasons Hotel in London's Mayfair.

Racing in Group 1 company every month from April to October, the bay won four top-level events--the Prix Ganay, the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S., the Irish Champion S. and the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe--and saw off fellow nominees **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}),

Ramonti (Fr) (Martino Alonso {Ire}), **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) for the title. He also claimed the Older Horse award, beating out Manduro and Ramonti as well as **Notnowcato (GB)** (Inchinator {GB}) and **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Dylan Thomas is slated to start in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 25 before entering stud for €50,000 at Coolmore in 2008. To date, he has earned £3,368,912 while winning 10 of 19 career starts.

Double Trouble...

Trainer Jim Bolger captured a juvenile double with Teofilo (Ire) and Finsceal Beo (Ire) last year. He successfully defended the former title when unbeaten **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) gained the Two-Year-Old Colt accolade. The handsome chestnut was perfect in five starts, including the G1 Darley Dewhurst S. and G1 National S. Among his rivals for the

title were **Fast Company (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), **Ibn Khaldun** (Dubai Destination), **Kingsgate Native (Ire)** (Mujadil) and **Rio de la Plata** (Rahy).

THUNDER GULCH MARE TOPS KEENELAND

It didn't take long for the highest priced offering of the afternoon to pass through the ring at Keeneland Wednesday. Consigned by Hartwell Farm, agent, **Thunder Bayou** (Thunder Gulch--Bayou Storm, By Storm Cat), in foal to Broken Vow, realized top price of \$180,000 during the 10th session of the November sale. Secured by Occidental Thoroughbreds, [hip 3392](#) is a half sister to stakes winner Bayou Breeze (A.P. Indy), and is a granddaughter of At the Half, dam of MGSW Lu Ravi. Winner of five graded stakes, including the GII Molly Pitcher BC S. and GII Cotillion H., Lu Ravi is the dam of Half Queen, responsible for champion two-year-old filly Halfbridled. Second highest price of the day was [Hip 3725](#), a 13-year-old mare by Miswaki, out of La Grandeza (El Gran Senor). Purchased for \$140,000 by Charlton Bloodstock Agency, the mare was consigned by Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services. In foal to Golden Missile, the bay is the dam of stakes winner and graded stakes placed Laredo; and Krisanova, runner up in the GIII Eclipse H. Early in the session, [Hip 3402](#), an unraced two-year-old filly by Unbridled's Song offered as part of the Eaton Sales consignment, brought a \$120,000 final bid from agent Olin B. Gentry. Out of the nine-year-old mare Trusty Lady (Deputy Minister), the gray is a full sister to Trendy Lady, runner up in the GIII Chicago H. and earner of \$162,066. The filly is from the extended family of multiple graded stakes winner Kassy Kim, daughter of GI Las Virgenes S. heroine Kool Arrival.

Business as Usual.

Business continued at a brisk pace during Wednesday's session of the November sale. For the 10th session, Keeneland sold 266 horses for gross receipts of \$6,295,500, down 0.6 percent from 2006 when 240 horses brought \$6,333,100. Average price of \$23,667 was down 10.3 percent from last year's average of \$26,388. A median figure of \$17,500 was down 12.5 percent from the \$20,000 recorded in 2006. "The clearance rate was very high, above 80 percent today," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "We saw strong domestic participation, which was supported by regional and emerging market buyers."

Boom Day for Ballydoyle...

Ballydoyle had further cause for celebration after **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) was pronounced top Three-Year-Old Filly and **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) took the Stayer title. Unraced at two, Peeping Fawn was second to Cartier finalist **Light Shift** (Kingmambo) in the G1 Oaks S. at Epsom, but claimed a four-race sequence encompassing the G1 Pretty Polly S., G1 Irish Oaks, G1 Nassau S. and G1 Yorkshire Oaks. Her half-brother, the Kingmambo colt Thewayyouare, concluded 2007 with a score in the G1 Criterium International Nov. 1. Yeats repeated as champion Stayer after posting victories in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup and G1 Irish St. Leger S.

Saleh Al Homeizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), the top Three-Year-Old Colt, was a finalist in the Horse of the Year category. The bay followed up his impressive G1 Epsom Derby score with a runner-up finish in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S., then defeated Dylan Thomas in the G1 Juddmonte International S. in August. Retired after an unplaced effort in Dylan Thomas's Arc, Authorized will stand for £25,000 at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket.

Stefan Friberg's **Natagora (Fr)** (Divine Light {Jpn}) garnered the Two-Year-Old Filly award. The grey granddaughter of Sunday Silence capped 2007 with a victory in the G1 Cheveley Park S. Her other scores for trainer Pascal Bary included the G2 Prix Robert Papin and the G3 Prix du Bois.

Ronald Arculli's **Red Clubs (Ire)** (Red Ransom), winner of the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup, collected the Sprinter award. The four-year-old may contest the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 9 before entering stud in 2008 at Tally-Ho in Ireland for €12,500.

In addition to the eight equine awards, which were established in 1991 to honour excellence in the racehorse, the Cartier/Daily Telegraph Award of Merit is presented to the person or persons who has/have done most for European racing and/or breeding either over their lifetime or within the past 12 months. This year's recipient is the Niarchos family, whose involvement in racing has spanned over 50 years and has resulted in tremendous success in races around the world, having bred or owned the winners of 121 Group/Grade 1 contests. Their famed colors were flown by Light Shift in 2007.

The equine awards were decided by a combination of points achieved in pattern races, the views of racing journalists on Cartier's Racing Panel, and votes from readers of *Racing Post* and *Daily Telegraph*.

Also possible for the nine-furlong test for older horses is **A.P. Arrow** (A.P. Indy), **Diamond Stripes** (Notebook), **Helsinki** (Distorted Humor), **Fairbanks** (Giant's Causeway) and **Going Ballistic** (Lite the Fuse).

QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS SUBJECT OF

INQUIRY Quarantine protocols at the Eastern Creek facility in Sydney were inadequate, the Federal Government inquiry into how Equine Influenza (EI) came into Australia heard on Tuesday. The first witness in the inquiry, which is expected to last a month, was James Gilkerson, senior lecturer in veterinary microbiology and head of the Equine Infectious Diseases Laboratory in the Faculty of Veterinary Science at the University of Melbourne. Gilkerson gave evidence that a sub-clinically affected horse was the most likely carrier of EI into Australia and added the most likely scenario for the virus escaping quarantine was via human transmission from people handling the stallions at Eastern Creek. "I think if there were adequate post-arrival quarantine procedures in place, the outbreaks wouldn't have occurred, would they," Gilkerson said under cross-examination. "[Quarantine] either prevents it or it doesn't prevent it. If it doesn't prevent it, then it's inadequate," he said. He added it was possible to have a horse that was vaccinated, but was in fact infected and shedding the disease but showing no clinical signs.

Encosta de Lago Cleared...

Gilkerson explained the first reported case of EI was "the index case" and that horse was Encosta de Lago (Aus), but that Coolmore's flagship Australian sire was probably not the horse that brought the disease into Australia. "It's not necessarily to say that that's the horse that was first infected; it's just the horse that was first recognized as being infected," Gilkerson explained. "In fact, it's highly likely that Encosta de Lago was not the first horse infected; he was the first horse to show clinical signs of disease." Counsel assisting the inquiry, Tony Meagher SC, asked why the 15-minute test was not used before horses got off the plane. The inquiry heard that a highly effective nasal swab test, known as the Directigen test, that was used in the Hong Kong 1992 outbreak, was not used in Australia. The inquiry is headed by recently retired High Court Judge Ian Callinan, whose brief is to review all the evidence and report to Federal Agriculture Minister Peter McGauran on the likely cause of the incursion and what measures are needed to maintain the integrity of Australia's quarantine system. He has wide-ranging powers under the Quarantine Act 1908, which allows him to subpoena witnesses and hold public hearings. The inquiry will examine the circumstances that contributed to the outbreak of EI in Australia and any need for strengthened procedures and processes to make sure the highest standards of biosecurity are maintained for horses in post-arrival quarantine. Upper Hunter Valley Stud representatives, including Tom Magnier of Coolmore and Adrian O'Brien, assistant stud manager at the Jerry's Plains property, are expected to give evidence at the inquiry. "The early witnesses will include Julian Cornter, who is the Sydney flight operations manager of International Racehorse Transport; John Sunderland, the stud manager of Darley Stud, Australia; Martin Story, who is the financial controller for the Arrowfield group," Meagher said. "Each of these people attended the airport when these horses arrived--some once, some more than once."

Downs. Trained by Bobby Frankel, the five-year-old, who has hit the board in five Grade/Group I events, finished ninth over the water-logged turf in her latest start in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Monmouth Oct. 27. "We're just trying to get a graded stakes win out of her,"

Frankel told *Daily Racing Form*. "If she wins, we'll definitely retire her and even if she gets beat, she'll still probably be done." Winner of the Listed Prix de Rose de Mai and runner-up in the G1 Prix de Alary and G1 Prix de Diane Hermes in 2005, the bay was third in last term's GI Diana S. and GI Gamely BC S. In three starts this season, the Irish-bred was runner-up to My Typhoon (Ire) in the GI Diana S. July 28. Julien Leparoux will ride Argentina, who has been allotted highweight of 120 pounds for the nine-furlong test.

FINALE FOR WILL HE SHINE IN DEFRANCIS

Grade II winner **Will He Shine** (Silver Deputy) is expected to make his final career start in the six-furlong GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash at Laurel Park Nov. 24. The half brother to GI Belmont Futurity winner Cuvee, who will retire to stud at Ro Parra's Millennium Farms in Lexington, will stand for \$6,500, live foal guaranteed. Winner of the GII True North H. at Belmont in June, the five-year-old worked five furlongs in 1:01.3 at Churchill Downs Tuesday. "I am extremely pleased with his workout [Tuesday] and he'll make a good showing in the DeFrancis Dash," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "He'll have a light half mile next week."

GRAND COUTURIER TO MISS JAPAN CUP

GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. winner **Grand Couturier (GB)** (Grand Lodge {GB}) will miss an intended date in the G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Nov. 25. Scheduled to depart for Japan Nov. 13, the bay failed to make the trip after a 'minor ankle issue' was detected. According to trainer Robert Ribaud, the colt will spend the next few months recuperating on a Ocala-based farm before rejoining his string at Gulfstream Park.

BC STARS LIKELY TO BYPASS CHURCHILL STAKES

Robert LaPenta's **War Pass** (Cherokee Run), victorious in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Monmouth Park Oct. 27, and Brereton Jones' **Proud Spell** (Proud Citizen), runner up in the GI BC Juvenile Fillies, head their respective list of nominees for Churchill Downs' GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and GII Golden Rod S., but are expected to bypass the 1 1/16-mile events. The pair of juvenile stakes races will be the centerpiece to Churchill Downs' closing-day "Stars of Tomorrow" card on Saturday, Nov. 24. War Pass, who also scored in the GI Champagne S. earlier this fall, is currently stabled at Churchill with trainer Nick Zito, who has three additional horses among the total of 32 nominated to the race. Most likely to represent Zito in the Kentucky Jockey Club is **Cool Coal Man** (Mineshaft)--also owned by LaPenta--who won an allowance race over this track; and Four Roses Thoroughbreds' **Anak Nakal** (Victory Gallop), second in the GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct. Also nominated are Ashbrook Farm's **Wicked Style** (Macho Uno), winner of Keeneland's GI Lanes End Breeders' Futurity; GIII Iroquois S. winner **Court Vision** (Gulch); and **Slew's Tiznow** (Tiznow), runner-up in the Breeders' Futurity. Leading the ladies division is Proud Spell, who trailed only dominant winner Indian Blessing in the BC Juvenile Fillies after opening her career with three consecutive victories. Trained by Larry Jones, Proud Spell is expected to bypass the race that drew 26 nominations. Lewis Lakin's **Pure Clan** (Pure Prize), winner of the GIII Pocahontas S. is expected to run in the Golden Rod for trainer Bob Holthus. Pure Clan is undefeated in three starts.

CATIENUS RETURNS TO KENTUCKY

Catienus (Storm Cat--Diamond City, by Mr. Prospector) , who previously stood at Doc and Suzie O'Cain's Highcliff Farm, will stand the 2008 season at Kenneth and Sarah Ramsey's Ramsey Farm in Lexington. His stud fee has been set at \$10,000. The 13-year-old stallion is the sire of Precious Kitten, winner of the GI John C. Mabee H., GII Palomar H. and GIII Galorette H., and Dawn Of War, upset winner of the 2005 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. Overall, Catienus has sired 17 individual stakes winners and 27 stakes horses, with eight stakes winners and more than \$4.9 million in 2007 earnings.

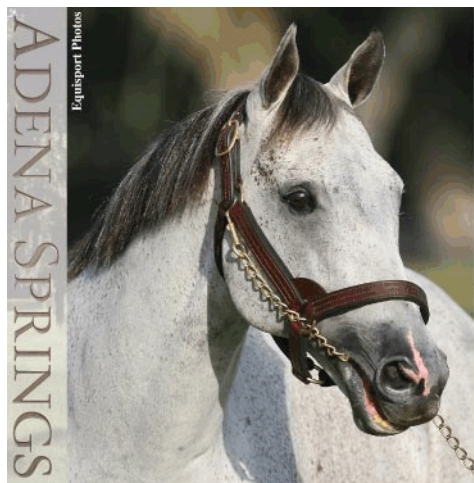



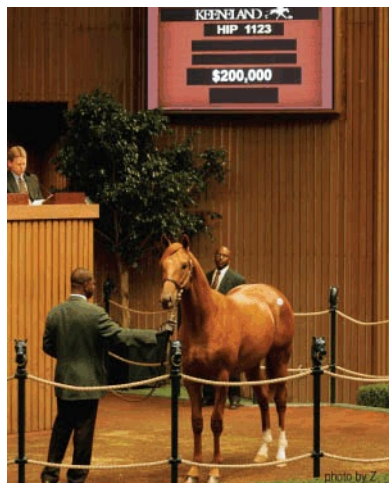

HAWKES ENDS CROWN LODGE RUN Record-breaking trainer John Hawkes officially ended his 15-year tenure at the helm of powerful Crown Lodge racing stables on Sunday. Hawkes won a total of 82 Group 1s for the Ingham family-owned operation and sent out 3,760 winners of more than A\$165 million. Hawkes sent out two-year-old Confounded (Aus) for a runner-up finish at Cranbourne as his final starter for Crown Lodge. He has won nine Sydney trainers titles and three in Brisbane. In the 2000-01 racing season, Hawkes set a new Commonwealth training record of 334 winners. He will launch a new two-state training operation from Nov. 17 with sons Wayne and Michael. Plans are eventually to have 40 horses in work in Melbourne and a similar number in Sydney. Longtime assistant trainer Peter Snowden will take the reins at Crown Lodge. Hawkes singled out Octagonal's (NZ) win in the 1995 G1 Cox Plate as the highlight of his stint with the Ingham family. "That day was a standout," Hawkes said. "We bought him as a yearling and took him to the top. He was the first really good horse I had for them. I have absolutely no regrets, just a lot of memories of the great success I had at Crown Lodge, particularly with the best horses I've trained, Octagonal and Lonhro (Aus), and I've enjoyed working with the Inghams." Of his plans for the future, Hawkes added, "We hope to have a permanent stable facility at Flemington soon, but I'm lucky that I have 20 boxes on the track we can move into immediately. In a very nice gesture, Gai Waterhouse made those boxes available to me, and I have to thank her for that."

MISS ANDRETTI HEADS TO QUARANTINE

Five time Group-1 winning mare **Miss Andretti (Aus)** (Ihtarim {Ire}) has entered Sandown quarantine where she will spend two weeks before heading to Hong Kong as Australia's only representative in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin Dec. 9. Miss Andretti, who won the G1 Age Classic at Flemington last Saturday, is expected to clash with Hong Kong's three best sprinters--**Absolute Champion (Aus)** (Marauding {NZ}), **Medic Power (NZ)** (Bertolini) and **Sacred Kingdom (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus})--in the sprint feature.

ROGERSON RESIGNS FROM TEAM WILLIAMS

Graeme Rogerson has officially resigned as trainer for Lloyd Williams over his role as trainer for the high-profile Melbourne-based owner and over provocative comments he made in his acceptance speech after the Williams-owned Efficient (NZ) won the G1 Melbourne Cup last week. Racing Victoria chief steward Des Gleeson has ordered Rogerson to attend an inquiry on Monday regarding public comments made regarding Gleason himself, and also to explain his role in the Williams operation, with both Williams and his son Nick Williams giving every indication they are in fact training Williams-owned horses. Two days after the Melbourne Cup, Rogerson said: "I think Lloyd knows I've had a gutful. Nobody was supposed to know, but Lloyd and I are going to have a meeting on Nov. 16. It will be quite sad actually." Stewards previously held an inquiry into arrangements at the stable. John Sadler applied for, and was immediately granted, a trainer's licence and will assume the role of trainer for the stable.
