WAR PASS TO LANE'S END

Undefeated two-year-old **War Pass** (Cherokee Run--Vue, by Mr. Prospector), who likely clinched the Eclipse Award with his decisive victory in the

Oct. 27 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, will head to Lane's End to stand stud at the end of his racing career. "We are extremely pleased to have entered into an agreement with Robert LaPenta on War Pass and are looking forward to seeing this talented colt return to the track," said Lane's End's Will Farish. "I believe he will make a great addition to the Lane's End station roster when he is retired."

Perfect in four starts for trainer Nick Zito, the GI Champagne S. winner has earned \$1,397,400 to date. The \$180,000 KEESEP graduate is a half-brother to GI Spinaway S. heroine Oath.

SCHIAPARELLI JOINS GODOLPHIN

Schiaparelli (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}--Sacarina {GB}, by Old Vic {GB}) will race in the royal blue of Godolphin in 2008 after Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum's operation snapped up the multiple Group 1 winner. Having raced in the colors of Stall Blankenese made famous by his full-brother Samum (Ger), he followed success in last year's G1 Deutsches Derby with a trio of top-level scores this term in the G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf in July, Cologne's G1 Preis von Europa in September and the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club at the San Siro the following month. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford confirmed to the *Racing Post* that the ex-Peter Schiergen-trained chestnut will be aimed at a starting point of the Dubai Spring Carnival. "He will arrive in Dubai shortly and then he'll be aimed at the G1 Sheema Classic and other races after that," he told the trade daily. "He's a nice horse and he's done exceptionally well in Germany--let's hope he can now move on to the international stage."

During Friday's session, 230 horses were sold for gross receipts of \$3,935,400. The average was up 30 percent to \$17,110 and the median increased 40.6 percent to \$11,250. "Overall, this was a very solid session, out-grossing day 11 last year," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "There is still a lot of money here." A total of 2,896 horses have sold for \$336,627,500 through yesterday's session, up eight percent from last year. The cumulative average is up 6.7 percent and the median is up 7.1 percent. November 18, 1972...Two-year-old **Secretariat** capped his Horse of the Year season with a 3 1/2-length in the Garden State S. The winner's share of the purse \$179,199, the most Secretariat ever won in a single race.

November 18, 1979...Jockey **Laffit Pincay Jr.** picked up his 4,000th career victory aboard Gladiolus in the eighth race at Aqueduct.

November 19, 1995...Jockey **Russell Baze** became the first rider to win at least 400 races a year for four consecutive years, riding Royal Boutique to victory at Golden Gate Fields.

Pellegrino, who hit the board in three Group 1 races in Argentina in 2002, didn't race at all in 2003, but captured the GI Hollywood Turf Cup after moving to North America for his 2004 campaign. The dark bay was unproductive in 2005, finishing out of the money in all seven starts, but rebounded to take the GIII Fifth Third Elkhorn S. and the Chief Bearhart S. last year. Proving he could still get it done at the age of eight, he added Woodbine's Singspiel S. to his resume in June, and put his name in the track's record books with a course-record-setting score here. The veteran was rebounding after four straight losses in Canadian stakes company. Never far from the lead, Pellegrino closed ground on the far turn, took control at the quarter pole and rolled under the wire a decisive winner.

LOTS ON THE LINE IN TRIALS

There is plenty to play for this afternoon at Sha Tin Racecourse, where a pair of preps for the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Races are to be contested. Locally based horses have perennially fared well in the G1 Hong Kong Mile, and today's G2-HK Mile Trial features **The Duke (Aus)** (Danehill), the defending champion of the Mile, who is making the penultimate start of his career. "We've made the decision to retire him after International day," trainer Caspar Fownes confirmed. The Mile Trial marks the return to action of **Vengeance of Rain (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), last year's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic hero, who is making his first start since going down to Viva Pataca (GB) in the Hong Kong Champions and Chater Cup June 3. Connections are realistic in their expectations for this tightener.

"All I want for him is to have a good, solid blow and finish well," trainer David Ferraris said of the reigning Hong Kong Horse of the Year. The seven-year-old was victorious in the 2005 G1 Hong Kong Cup and was third to Pride (Fr) in his title defense last year. The Mile Trial also includes G1 Champions Mile winner **Able One (NZ)** (Cape Cross {Ire}); and **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan), a domestic Group 1 winner in March and three-for-six over Sha Tin's metric mile. The G2-HK International Sprint Trial has attracted the top three short-track horses, including defending G1 Hong Kong Sprint champ **Absolute Champion (Aus)** (Marauding {NZ}). But he'll have to deal with **Sacred Kingdom (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}), six-for-seven in his career, including a last-out victory in the Oct. 1 G3-HK Sha Tin Sprint Trophy. "The horse is in great form," said trainer Ricky Yiu. "I've got a good jockey and I'll leave it up to him now." Gerald Mosse has a return call. Also in the field is **Medic Power (NZ)** (Bertolini), who rattled off six consecutive victories in the 2006/2007 season and returned to action with a third in the G3-HK Premier Bowl H. Oct. 21.
