About an hour before his stablemate held up her end of the bargain in Louisville, Stuart Janney's **Hunting** (Coronado's Quest) kicked off a memorable Daily Double for trainer Shug McGaughey to win yesterday's GIII Stuyvesant H. as the 9-1 longest shot in a field of six. Taken back to second last as **Barcola** (Old Trieste) took the field along on the front end, Hunting saved ground while being patiently handled by jockey Alan Garcia. **GOFFS MARATHON KICKS OFF TODAY**

Goffs Bloodstock Sales's week-long November Foal and Breeding Stock Sale gets underway today, with an extra opening session due to the unprecedented level of entries. Nearing the close of a highly successful year for the Goffs/DBS partnership, the auction is split into five days of foals followed by three days of broodmares and fillies. Last year's standard will be hard to match, with the foal turnover up by 32 percent on 2005 and the average increasing by 20 percent; the broodmares and fillies' sessions witnessed a 17-percent rise in the average.

This year, a format change will see the 1,283-strong foal catalogue split into Parts One and Two, with 545 lots selling today and tomorrow, and the remainder going through the ring Tuesday to Thursday.

The 800-plus broodmares and fillies on offer will be sold Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The auction has received a fillip over the past 12 months, thanks to the exploits of some relative bargains headed by **Myboycharlie (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}). Now owned by Coolmore, the Tommy Stack-trained colt showed what €13,000 can buy when taking the G1 Prix Morny and G3 Anglesey S. and finishing third in the G1 National S. Others to advertise have been the G1 Nunthorpe S. hero and G1 Prix de l'Abbaye runner-up **Kingsgate Native (Ire)** (Mujadil), purchased for a mere €28,000 two years ago; **Red Evie (Ire)** (Intikhab), who added this year's G1 Lockinge S. and G2 Hungerford S. to her already impressive haul and cost just €50,000 back in 2003; €26,000 purchase **Elletelle (Ire)** (Elnadim), winner of the latest renewal of Royal Ascot's G2 Queen Mary S.; and top sprinter **Tax Free (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), who continues to prove that the €16,000 paid for him five years ago was money well spent. For many buyers, this will provide the first opportunity to get their hands on the progeny of Alamshar (Ire), Antonius Pius, Azamour (Ire), Doyen (Ire), Dubawi (Ire), Footstepsinthesand (GB), Motivator (GB), Oratorio (Ire), Rakti (GB) and Shamardal. Amongst the broodmares and fillies are the customary drafts of His Highness The Aga Khan's Studs, Abbeville and Meadow Court Studs, Airlie Stud, Ballymacoll Stud, Castlemartin Stud, Irish National Stud, Moyglare Stud, Darley, Juddmonte Farms, Derrinstown Stud and Swettenham Stud. Sixth in a restricted stakes on the GI Belmont S. undercard June 9, Criminologist improved further at the Spa, taking a third-level allowance by a head Aug. 9 prior to a 3 1/4-length success in the Aug. 29 Perfect Sting S.

Northern California-based McCann's Mojave, owned by Santa Anita director of publicity Mike Willman, was headed in deep stretch of yesterday's GIII All American S., but, in his typically gritty style, counterpunched from the rail and posted a narrow victory. The bay went on a three-race winning streak last winter, capped by a 33-1 boilover success in the \$1-million Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park. A good fourth to Lava Man in the GI Santa Anita H. in March, the blaze-faced bay was fifth to Laywer Ron in the GI Oaklawn H. the following month. He bled badly when last of eighth in the GIII Berkeley S. at this track June 2, earning a lengthy vaction. He returned to action in the GIII Morvich H. down the hill at Santa Anita Oct. 27 and ran with credit, finishing a length adrift of the winner in fourth. Never far from the front here as favored Buzzards Bay (Marco Bay) cut out the running, he drew alongside that rival turning into the stretch. A 6 3/4-length maiden winner going this track's one-turn mile Apr. 11, Hunting was second in a May 13 allowance at Belmont before being put up to a victory at Belmont June 21. Sixth in the July 30 Saratoga allowance won by subsequent GI Travers S. runner-up Grasshopper, the chestnut was fourth in one-mile tests back at Belmont Sept. 14 and Oct. 8. He punched his ticket to his first stakes engagement with a good-looking allowance win going two turns in the Monmouth slop Oct. 26, but was lightly regarded, being the only non-stakes winner in the field. Still, trainer Shug McGaughey was happy to take his chances. "He's been doing pretty good," the conditioner commented. "His last race was a good race. Third to compatriot Admire Moon (Jpn) in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. in March, **Daiwa Major**, the defending champion of this event, was a determined neck winner of the G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo June 3. Rested off a 12th to Admire Moon in the G1 Takarazuka Kinen June 24, the six-year-old was third at odds-on in the G2 Mainichi Okan Oct. 7 and most recently 10th, placed ninth, in the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) three weeks later. **Company** has looked strong in a pair of starts in 2007, returning from a nine-month absence to win the 1600-meter G3 Sekiya Kinen at Niigata in 1:31.8. He was most recently third in the Tenno Sho. No foreigner has ever won this race and it is up to Team Valor and Gary Barber's **Becrux** to try to change that. The winner of the 2006 GI Woodbine Mile prepped for the overseas test with a third in the GI Morvich H. down the hill at Santa Anita Oct. 27. Ryan Moore has the call for trainer Neil Drysdale.

**KEENOV NEARING THE WIRE** Saturday's third-last session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock sale showed no signs of letting down, as double-digit increases were posted for the session versus a year ago. The average of \$10,613 represented a 38.2 increase from last year while the median increased by 37 percent. "It was yet another outstanding day with double-digit increases," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "There are a lot of people still here and a lot of activity." The sales arm of Three Chimneys consigned the top two horses yesterday. Hip **4701**, the four-year-old filly Forest Image (Forestry) was hammered down to the Robert Dawe Agency for a session-topping bid of \$77,000. Offered in foal to Albert the Great, the dark bay is a half-sister to GI Strub S. winner Victory Speech (Deputy Minister) and a full sister to Euro Code, a stakes winner of \$246,190. As agent for Fair Way Equine LLC, Three Chimneys sold a filly from the first crop of Medallist (Touch Gold) for \$67,000. Whisper Hill Farm signed the ticket for hip **4771**, a daughter of Marianna's Girl (Dewan), making her a half to five stakes winners, including GSWs Marastani and Christine's Outlaw. Selling continues today at 10 a.m.
