“MAJOR” PLAYER IN MILE CHAMPIONSHIP

Once again stamping himself the champion miler in Japan, **Daiwa Major (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence) yesterday held off the late charge of **Super Hornet (Jpn)** (Rodrigo de Triano) to win the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto for the second straight year. The chestnut kicked off 2007 with a third-place finish in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. in March, then returned home and, after a break, captured the June 3 G1 Yasuda Kinen. Back on the bench after finishing 12th in the Oct. 28 G1 Takarazuka Kinen, he was third in the Oct. 7 G2 Mainichi Okan,

but was once again off the board when stretched to 2000 meters for the Oct. 28 G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn). Back at his best distance yesterday, Daiwa Major broke sharply, but settled just off the leaders early. He gained ground on the final bend, took the lead at midstretch and was all out as Super Hornet closed late. **Becrux (Ity)** (Glen Jordan {GB}), the lone foreign contender, was far back early, angled outside on the turn and dashed off his final three furlongs in :34, but ran out of real estate and finished eighth.

COUNSELLED TOPS KEENELAND SUNDAY

The three-year-old stallion prospect **Counselled** (A.P. Indy) topped Sunday's 14th session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. The dark bay colt ([hip 5166](#)), out of champion juvenile filly Countess Diana (Deerhound), sold for \$80,000 to Dr. Oscar Benavides, agent, and was consigned by Cardinal Stables. A \$900,000 KEESep yearling, Counselled won twice from nine starts. Cardinal Stables claimed the colt for \$40,000 from a maiden win at Churchill in June. Through 14 days, Keeneland has sold 3,267 horses for a total of \$340,203,700. The average is up 4.2 percent to \$104,133, while the median remained constant at \$35,000. During yesterday's session, the average rose marginally, to \$8,475, compared to last year's corresponding session and the median was up 15.4 percent. The sale's final session begins today at 10 a.m. **Stats p2**

Heavy favorite Tomcito, a Northern Hemisphere Kentucky-bred two-year-old colt by leading second-crop sire Street Cry (Ire), solidified his superiority over Peru's best Southern Hemisphere three-year-old colts and fillies with a late rush in the closing meters of the third leg of Peru's Quadruple Crown series. Impressive 9 3/4-length winner of the series' second leg, the G1 Clasico Ricardo Ortiz de Zevallos Oct. 20 and a fast-closing second in the G1 Clasico Polla de Potrillos (Peruvian 2000 Guineas) Sept. 23, Tomcito showed tremendous acceleration in midstretch to inhale the powerful Haras Rancho Fatima entry of Fortanyo and Faraqueen en route to an impressive victory. Stakes winner Fortanyo, ridden by Peruvian-born and Argentine-based jockey Jacinto Rafael Herrera, overhauled stablemate and Group 1-winning filly Faraqueen--who surrendered an open-lengths lead in the stretch--for second. Betania (Per) (Domingo), heroine of the G1 Clasico Polla de Potrancas (Peruvian 1000 Guineas), finished eighth in the field of 10. A visually impressive winner of three of his first four starts by a combined 35 3/4 lengths, Tomcito is trained by Peru's perennial leading trainer, Chilean-born Juan Suarez.

TRADE FAIR COLT TOPS GOFFS OPENER


A colt by Tweenhills' new stallion Trade Fair (GB) was the focus during the opening session of the Goffs November Foal Sale yesterday when selling for €50,000. A highly talented runner for Khalid Abdullah, the dual Group 3-winning stallion received an instant boost to his reputation at stud when the well-travelled agent Bobby O'Ryan made his presence felt at the Kill venue. Consigned by Cooneen Stud, hip [189](#) is out of listed winner Aswhatilldois (Ire) (Blues Traveller {Ire}). "I thought that he was a cracking foal," O'Ryan said. "He's got a great walk and he's just a very good individual. He's been bought on behalf of Rob Lloyd Racing and will be kept to race." Another first-crop sire, Coolmore's Antonius Pius, earlier caught the eye of pinhookers Lynn Lodge Stud. From the draft of Coilog Stud, hip [79](#) is out of Persian Flower (GB) (Persian Heights {GB}) and is a half-brother to the 1999 G2 Cherry Hinton S. third Flowington (Ire). He was knocked down to Eddie O'Leary's operation for €40,000. "He's a lovely colt and he's by a very talented racehorse," O'Leary commented. "Antonius Pius is a very good-looking horse himself and he's getting some fine foals." Late in the afternoon, Moat House Farm secured the session's highest-priced filly when paying €37,000 for Miltown Park Stud's hip [242](#), a daughter of Tagula (Ire) out of Fabuco (Ire), a sister to stakes-placed Connemara (Ire) and Presentation (Ire). Cooneen Stud, which consigned the topper, also paid €32,000 for hip [192](#), a filly from the first crop of another ex-Juddmonte performer in Camacho (GB), who was runner-up in the G3 Jersey S. two years ago and is on the roster at Morristown Lattin Stud. Mary Davison's Catherinestown Stud Farm consigned the filly, who is out of a half-sister to listed scorer Fair Cop. On a day marred by a 38-percent clearance rate, the average of €9,251 still represented an increase of eight percent on 2006.
