### 'KITTEN' GIVES FRANKEL HIS 8th MATRIARCH

At some point, winning it has gotta get boring, right? Ah, maybe not. Still, Bobby Frankel has made the GI Matriarch S. a nearly banal exercise of dominance over the last decade. The Hall of Fame conditioner captured his fourth straight and unprecedented eighth overall renewal of the one-mile Matriarch at Hollywood Park yesterday after Ken and Sarah Ramsey's homebred **Precious Kitten** (Catienus) stormed home a clear-cut victress over favored **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon).

Precious Kitten's winning time of 1:33.63 established a new stakes record. Frankel's other Matriarch winners are Price Tag (GB) ('06), Intercontinental (GB) ('04), Heat Haze (GB) ('03), Starine (Fr) ('01), Happyanunoit (NZ) ('99), Ryafan ('97), and Wandesta (GB) ('96). ### Quite a Kitten...

A one-time member of the Dale Romans barn, Precious Kitten was put under Bobby Frankel's care last fall and has been no worse than second for the Hall of Famer, with the lone exception coming in her latest, a

troubled eighth-place effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. Before that, Precious Kitten had collected a win the GIII Gallorette H. in July before taking her first Grade I in the John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar Aug. 4. She made it two straight over that course in the GII Palomar Breeders' Cup

H. Sept. 1, then ran Vacare to a half-length in the GII First Lady S. at Keeneland Oct. 6. The dark bay lost all chance when a rival blew the turn in the Breeders' Cup, and it was a measure of Frankel's confidence in the filly that he kept her in training this season for this. Under regular jockey Rafael Bejarano, Precious Kitten was quickest into stride, but, as Live Life (Fr) came charging hard in search for the lead, was wisely taken off to track that longshot pacesetter through :23 3/5, :47 1/5 and 1:10 3/5 splits. Precious Kitten roared off the far turn to take control with Wait a While in close pursuit, but left no doubt about who was best on the afternoon with a sparking turn of foot down the stretch. Precious Kitten sped the final furlong in :11.49 and stopped the clock for the one mile in 1:33.63, which shattered Heat Haze (GB)'s stakes record of 1:34.43, set in 2003.

"I knew that number five [Live Life] was going to be on the lead, but I didn't want to let her get an easy lead and slow the pace," explained Bejarano. "When she passed me going to the first turn, I just let her go and put my filly close to her. When that other horse [Wait a While] came up to her, I had a lot of horse left."

Bejarano's ride impressed the connections of Precious Kitten. "When he saw that filly [Live Life] come out Rafael just took a hold, he was smart," said Humberto Ascanio, assistant to Frankel. "He knew where that filly was going and he was going to stay behind her and relax. We'll be back for the Winter Meet at Santa Anita."

### Wait a While a Strong Second...

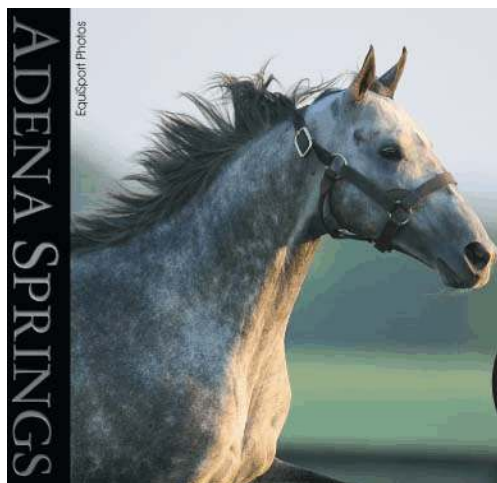
Sitting several lengths off a modest pace and traversing a distance that's perhaps not her ideal, Wait a While ran hard down the lane and lost little in the runner-up performance. "She ran well--like she always does--and maybe it was just a little short for her; she'll probably do a little better in a mile and an eighth," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "Precious Kitten kind of got the jump on us at the top of the stretch, but she ran well. She'll stay here we'll look at Santa Anita for something for her." Likewise, the closer Lady of Venice (Fr) saw the pace scenario play against her and could do no better than third. "We had a good trip," said jockey Julien Leparoux. "She was relaxed and did everything good, but she just couldn't get there."

When Daytona stepped into the ring as hip 93 at Doncaster's Lincoln Handicap Sales on Mar. 21 earlier this year, he could boast one win and two runner-up tries in three starts, all on the Polytrack in Britain. Who would have thought the gelded chestnut would have to

ship to America to find his preferred surface? As it was, Daytona, initially a €360,000 Goffs Orby yearling, easily topped the Lincoln sale at 56,000gns, yet still looks like a bargain after capturing his first Grade I race yesterday. Put under Dan Hendrick's care this spring, Daytona was a bit slow

to come around, winning in his third U.S. start at Del Mar July 20. He ran third in a division of the Aug. 31 El Cajon S. in his stakes debut two starts later on Del Mar's main track, but returned to the turf with aplomb in his latest, romping by 4 1/4 lengths in the Gil Oak Tree Derby at Santa Anita Oct. 13.

**Pedal to the Metal...**

The co-second choice, along with Bold Hawk, to heavily favored Nobiz Like Shobiz, Daytona was put on the lead by jockey Mike Smith, and the pair cruised through sensible :24 1/5, :48 and 1:12 1/5 fractions. Left with plenty, Daytona kicked away in upper stretch and had the measure of the running-on Medici Code. "I was scared they were going to move early on him down the backside and, when they didn't, I knew it would be tough to get him," said winning trainer Dan Hendricks. "I just wanted Mike to have him comfortable, whether he's first or third. Mike knows this horse; he rode him to a T." Despite Daytona's success on turf, Hendricks said his charge might return to the main track. "We're not sure what the game plan is, but we are going to look at the Strub series, maybe put him on Cushion Track for those two races and see how he handles it," he said. "He did well at Del Mar on the Polytrack, although Cushion is a little different. We'll see how he handles it." Nobiz Like Shobiz, meanwhile, raced wide before fading to eighth. "Actually I didn't really have an excuse," said jockey Javier Castellano. "Usually he explodes when I ask him. Unfortunately, not today." Admire Moon, coming off a disappointing sixth-place effort in the Oct. 28 G1 Tenno Sho Autumn, rebounded to cap an impressive season, and racing career, with his third Group 1 victory. The bay colt won the G1 Dubai Duty Free in March and added the G1 Takarazuka Kinen in June. The win was the first JRA victory for Darley Japan, which acquired Admire Moon last summer, while trainer Hiroyoshi Matsuda became the first trainer to win both the Japan Cup Dirt and the Japan Cup. Matsuda won the Japan Cup Dirt in 2004 with Time Paradox (Jpn). Admire Moon sat a ground-saving fifth in the early going as Chosan (Jpn) (Dance in the Dark {Jpn}) set a moderate pace. As much of the field rallied wide, Admire Moon snuck through an opening on the inside turning for home and accelerated

to a clear lead before gamely holding off the strong late rallies of Pop Rock, Meisho Samson and Vodka (Jpn) (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}). "He was coming off an unlucky defeat in his last start [in the Tenno Sho Autumn], but we just carried on towards his next start and he responded well," Matsuda said of the winner. "After making a good start and rating in a good position behind a pace that was neither fast nor slow, I thought that he may have made his move at the stretch too early, because he has often been beaten that way. But he held on well to the very end this time." Winning jockey Yasunari Iwata's inside move may have proved the difference in the close finish. "Most of the jockeys avoided the inside track," Iwata explained.

Iwata continued, "I took advantage of the opening and was able to save ground, which worked perfectly for us. I have been racing here since last year, but this is my first graded win and I think this will give me confidence in my future rides." Admire Moon will now be transferred to Hokkaido to begin his stud career. "We had acquired Admire Moon with the idea that he was a 2000-meter specialist," explained Darley Japan representative Chikara Takahashi. "But, as I wanted Admire Moon to end his career on a good note, which could make a difference to potential breeders and owners, I discussed with the trainer the possibility of running over 2400 meters. My gut feeling was that he would be able to handle the extra furlongs, so we put off his retirement to this day. ## Tattersalls December Sale Yearling Sale - Nov. 26

### DECEMBER YEARLINGS SELL TODAY

Tattersalls' 10-day December Sale gets underway this morning with a 281-lot yearling catalogue featuring a number of youngsters that have either appeared, or had been scheduled to be offered, at previous sales this year. One of the standouts looks to be Lot [229](#), a late addition to the catalogue. The unnamed Sadler's Wells colt, now a half-brother to two winners, made 280,000gns when knocked down to Citywest Inc. at the October Yearling Sale, but was returned having been incorrectly catalogued. Originally offered by breeder Bob Lanigan's Tullamaine Castle Stud, he reappears in John Troy's consignment. The next offering through the ring, Lot [230](#), is a Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) half-brother to three black-type performers consigned from Jockey Hall Stud. The yearling was withdrawn from the October Sale. Many of the highlights are expected to come in quick succession, with Lot [233](#) looking sure to show a big advance on the €1,800 she made at Goffs in February. The Imperial Ballet (Ire) filly is a half-sister to this season's G1 Prix Morny winner Myboycharlie (Ire) and is consigned from Michael Hillman's Castledillon Stud. Lot [239](#) is an Indian Ridge (Ire) (Ahoonora {GB}) colt who was knocked down to Dermot Weld for €250,000 at the Goffs Million Sale and is offered--as he was on that occasion--from Harry McCalmont's Norelands Stud. Gone West's only representative is Lot [240](#), a colt out of Mill Guineas (Salse) consigned from Denis and Joan Brosnan's Croom House Stud. Mill Guineas was purchased carrying the colt for \$550,000 at the 2006 Keeneland January Sale. Lot [216](#), consigned from Ciaran Conroy's Glenvale Stud, is a full-brother to four-time Group 2 winner Septimus (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Lot [55](#)--an Acclamation (GB) half-brother to G1 Cheveley Park S. second Dhanyata (Ire)--is expected to fare well when appearing from Ballyhampshire Stud. "Demand for quality commercial yearlings has been strong all year and this is a catalogue full of quality," noted Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George yesterday. **SECOND BEST GOFFS NOVEMBER**

A strong week's trade at Goffs' November Sale drew to a close at the auction house's Kill base yesterday with final figures showing the second-highest set of results in the sale's history. However, the eight-day sale closed as it began, with a low clearance rate of under 42 percent blighting final-day trade. The top lot during the final session was Skehanagh Bloodstock's hip [1925](#), Babola (Ire) (Grand Lodge), who sold to Agence FIPS for €62,000. Offered in foal to Aussie Rules, the four-year-old is out of Princesse Bilbao (Fr) (Highest Honor), a half-sister to G1 Grand Criterium second Bernebeau (Fr). "The oft-quoted [soccer] cliché, 'A game of two halves,' is quite apt when summing up the last eight days trade at Goffs' largest ever sale, both in terms of numbers and sales days," opined Chief Executive Henry Beeby. "One half could be defined as the quality end of the market, which was intensely strong for both mares and foals, with the other consisting of the lesser lights that did not catch the imagination of the buyers to the same degree."

Beeby continued, "The beginning and end of the sale illustrated the stark reality of the increasing numbers of Thoroughbreds being born year on year and many breeders have really felt the effects for the first time. The contrast in the central five days of the sale was palpable as we enjoyed a trade of consistent strength, with bids flying for those that appealed. The foal market got better and better, culminating in a truly spectacular session of trading on Thursday, whilst the mares' trade set off at a cracking pace on Friday, continued through Saturday before slowing somewhat today. However, the enduring appeal of Goffs meant we were able to welcome huge numbers of overseas buyers to Kildare Paddocks, headed by significant buying groups from both India and Turkey. Our heartfelt thanks to them for their perennial support and also to Irish Thoroughbred Marketing for their invaluable assistance in all the organisation that goes in to such visits. Our sale totals may have fallen short of the records set last year, but we are far from despondent as they represent the second-best figures in the sale's history and are the result of sustained interest over the last eight days. Our thanks, as ever, for the wonderful support from our vendors and the participation of the many, many purchasers we have been privileged to welcome from home and abroad." This year's three-day renewal of the broodmares and fillies section failed to surpass last year's two-day equivalent, falling 5 1/2 percent short of the 2006 gross. The victory of **Daaher** (Awesome Again) in Saturday's GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile at Aqueduct was another highlight in what's been a very good year for trainer

Kieran McLaughlin. It was the conditioner's seventh Grade or Group 1 victory in 2007. Included in that tally is reigning Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg)'s win in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March and Lahudood (GB)'s victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf last month. "It's hard to believe,"

McLaughlin said yesterday. "We won our first Grade I in this country just last May [2006] with Invasor [Pimlico Special], and we've got seven this year." The McLaughlin barn did suffer a couple of setbacks, most notably when both Invasor and June's GI Stephen Foster H. winner Flashy Bull were forced into retirement by injuries this summer. "There were some negatives, but you can't dwell on that," said McLaughlin. "With me, the glass is always half full. We're always working hard, trying to improve and looking ahead. It was disappointing losing Invasor and Flashy Bull, but horses like Lahudood and Lear's Princess [winner of the GI Gazelle S. in September over Rags to Riches] really stepped up for us. Daaher did the same yesterday and I think he's a great stallion prospect when his racing career's over." Daaher, a full-sibling to GISW Spun Sugar, is tentatively scheduled to follow in Invasor's footsteps, with the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park in February and a race on the Dubai World Cup card on tap.
