'PERFECT' FOAL TOPS TATTS FINALE

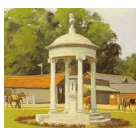
Tattersalls' December Foal sale concluded in Newmarket last night with turnover of 28,684,600gns, down 1 percent from 2006, while the 36,541gns average dropped 6 percent and the 20,000gns median fell

by 9 percent. The clearance rate made a more dramatic decline, from 82 percent last year to 61 percent this time around. The top price of yesterday's session came early in the day when agent Dwayne Woods paid 240,000gns for lot 1446, a Green Desert 3/4-sister to G1 Fillies' Mile and G1 Falmouth S. heroine Simply Perfect (GB) (Danehill). The dark grey daughter of Hotelgenie Dot Com (GB) (Selkirk), bred by Derek and Jean Clee, was consigned by Catridge Farm Stud. "It's a top-notch pedigree, and she's very much like her sister," said Woods, buying for an unidentified client. "She's been bought to race, and everything was right about her--there haven't been many real quality fillies like her this week."

Romance is Diane Wires the Bayakoa cont.


Romance is Diane didn't do much running in her career opener last July, but shrugged that off when she got back to running in the fall. The dark bay rattled off three straight victories, including the Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies at Oak Tree and a 14-1 score in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. last December over this track and trip, and looked to be on to bigger and better things. It didn't quite work out that way, though. Senji Nishimura's

California-bred failed to fire in her next three outings, finishing seventh to Rags to Riches in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 10 and eighth in the China Doll S. on grass Mar. 3. A return to the Hollywood Cushion Track didn't work, either, as she never factored and wound up eighth in the Melair S. for state-breds Apr. 29. Freshened up afterwards, Romance is Diane missed by a neck when third in the Fleet Treat S. at Del Mar July 22, and was second in the Torrey Pines S. going a mile at the oceanside oval Sept. 2. The three-year-old came back with a resounding 6 1/4-length tally in the Cal Cup Matron Nov. 3, and looked to be dangerous with her free-running speed here as the third choice to Grade I winners **Sugar Shake** (Awesome Again) and **Tough Tiz's Sis** (Tiznow). Breaking from post four, Romance is Diane bounced away in good order under Michael Baze and went up to set the pace while racing a bit off the rail, putting up splits of :22.82, :45.39 and 1:08.96. The 8-5 chalk Sugar Shake gave chase along the fence, but began to back up heading into the far turn, leaving Tough Tiz's Sis as the main threat entering the stretch. The front-runner dug in to dismiss that fellow sophomore and made it to the wire a length in front despite drifting out a bit. Darley's **Grain of Truth (GB)** (Gulch) made a bold move turning for home, but flattened out in the lane to finish fourth. Sugar Shake, who had previously done her best running on the front end, became discouraged and faded to finish last in the five-horse field. "I tried to put her on the lead, but that number four just had too much speed," said rider Rafael Bejarano. "There was nothing I could do. At the half-mile pole, I didn't have much horse. She just completely stopped."

given some time to regroup after finishing sixth--beaten 1 3/4 lengths--in the Ft. Lauderdale H. at Gulfstream Jan. 6. He resurfaced June 2 at Delaware and attempted to wire the field, but was caught near the wire and settled for second by a neck. Runner-up to Silver Tree

next out in the Caesar Rodney H. over the same course July 15, he finished fourth in the GII Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga Aug. 25 after showing the way for much of the race. The six-year-old never saw the lead in his latest, the Robert F. Carey Memorial H. Sept. 29 at Hawthorne, and wound up seventh. Sent off as the third choice here, Ballast skimmed the hedge in seventh early under Kent Desormeaux. He shifted out a few paths turning for home, weaved his way through traffic, hit the front in deep stretch and held sway late. "I can't tell you what happened in his last race," said David Rock, assistant to winning trainer Graham Motion. "That just wasn't him, and you can throw that one out. He's been unlucky on a couple of other occasions. He should have won the race at Delaware [the Caesar Rodney], but had a very rough trip. He was very brave today coming through between horses."

J'ray began 2007 with a pair of New Orleans wins, the GIII Bayou BC H. Feb. 24 and the Marie Krantz Memorial H. Mar. 25. After a 3 1/2-month break, the chestnut was second in the Dr. J. Penny Memorial H. July 4 at Philly Park, but couldn't hit the board in a pair of New York-bred outings, the Yaddo H. at Saratoga Aug. 18 and the Ticonderoga Oct. 20 at Belmont last time. Leaving those memories of the Empire State behind her, the Lawrence Goichman homebred settled near the rear as favored Bayou's Lassie showed the way. J'ray ranged up four wide turning for home, hooked up with the chalk and outgunned her late for her second graded win of the year. Goichman was on hand to accept the trophy. "We found that she doesn't handle soft turf, and we think the weights have been a problem a couple of times," he offered. "They asked her to carry 124 pounds in the Yaddo at Saratoga, and no filly had won that race with that much weight since the 80s. She's a tiny filly, and weight is a problem."

the son of the Second Set (Ire) mare Ailette (GB) will be reoffered next year. Trainer Jim Bolger, who has excelled with the progeny of Mr. Greeley, acquired a choicely bred filly by that son of Gone West out of Civility Cat (Tale of the Cat). Eamonn Reilly of BBA Ireland bid 200,000gns for lot 1593, whose dam had been acquired for 340,000gns carrying this foal. The chestnut appeared from Tom

Gaffney's Churchtown House Stud. "The filly is for Jim Bolger and one of his existing owners, and will go to his Redmondstown Stud in Wexford until she's ready to go into training," Reilly said. "She's the only foal he has bought this week, and reminded us particularly of Finsceal Beo (Ire)." Agent Mags O'Toole fought off trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias to land a Sadler's Wells half-sister to GSW Maharib (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}) for

210,000gns. The daughter of Diali (Dayjur) was consigned from Felipe Hinojosa's Chevington and Loughtown Studs as lot 1647. The gross, average and median all decreased for the Foal Sale. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented, "Last year's December Foal Sale set new records across the board with an average price up a

massive 34 percent and turnover also in uncharted territory up 24 percent. This year's Foal Sale has all but matched those extraordinary figures, with turnover and average second only to 2006. To a large degree this week's foal trade has mirrored the yearling market, with demand at the top of the market as strong, if not stronger, than ever. The number of foals making 200,000 guineas or more has exceeded even last year's total, and competition for quality, commercial foals has been intense throughout the five days. The one statistic, however, which does not compare well with last year is the percentage of lots sold and, with the huge numbers catalogued, it has been evident that the market has been unforgiving for foals which fell short of the stringent standards set by the pinhookers." **Tatts cont. p6**

Accomplishment: McNair's Stonerside Stable, which he operates with his wife Janice, enjoyed two big homebred stakes winners on Saturday, Nov. 24. The juvenile colt Cowboy Cal (Giant's Causeway) won the Laurel Futurity by 6 1/2 lengths, while the two-year-old filly Sea Chanter (War Chant) won Hollywood's GIII Miesque S.

Birthdate: Born in 1937 in Tampa, Fla., and raised in Forest City, N.C.

Family: Wife Janice, four children and 12 grandchildren.

Current Residence: Houston, Texas.

Primary business: An accomplished businessman, McNair owns the NFL's Houston Texans. McNair was awarded the NFL's 32nd franchise in 1999; the team began league play in 2002.

What's been your biggest accomplishment in racing? Oh boy. Well, the homebred who has been the best performer for us has been Congaree. He was an outstanding racehorse and was one of the best milers we've seen in the past 10 years or so. But in terms of breeding, we've bred some horses who were sale toppers. The year before last, we had, I think, three sell for over \$3 million in the same year. And being the co-breeder of a Kentucky Derby winner is up there. We jointly owned Angel Fever, who was the dam of Fusaichi Pegasus.

How many horses do you own? About 250 or so. We've got about 85 broodmares. Most are in Kentucky, but we've got about 10 or 15 mares down in Texas, at Lane's End's place.

Favorite vacation spot? We have a beachfront home on Kiawah Island in Charlestown, South Carolina. We love the beach, and the kids and grandkids love it. And we love the farm in Kentucky, but that's a working farm. And so, invariably, we wind up working there and it's not a vacation!

Favorite meal? There's not much I don't like. But I'd say a good veal chop. That's hard to beat. And I like wine--red wines, the cabernets especially.

Favorite music? It's mainly easy listening for me. Some country and western, and some of the soft rock--I'm not a hard rock guy.

Tough question: would you rather win a Kentucky Derby or a Super Bowl? [Laughs] Oh, I'd take either one--I'd love to have that choice. The odds are probably in favor of me winning a Super Bowl. At least you're limited to 32 teams. Both are lofty goals, but goals we aspire to. **For complete interview with McNair, click [here](#).**

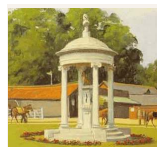

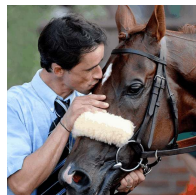
