**BURNING BUSH**

**Bushwacker** (Outflanker) had to do things the hard way in the early going of Sunday's GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood Park. Blazing the way through crisp opening splits of :22.1, :44.3 and :56.05,

the gutsy five-year-old had dig deep in the stretch, but managed to find more late, fending off **In Summation** (Put It Back) by 3/4 of a length, with even-money choice **Greg's Gold** (Lake George) a neck back in third. "I thought he was clearly the best horse in the race," said trainer William Currin. "My prediction was, if he

could get a comfortable early quarter-mile, they would have to catch me, and they couldn't catch me. He's one hundred percent sound, he always has been, and I hope he always will be. The Sunshine Millions Sprint is in the picture, and from there, maybe Dubai." Seemingly poised for better things following a runner-up effort to eventual juvenile champ Declan's Moon in the 2004 GIII Hollywood Prevue S., the bay failed to win in five starts during his sophomore year. Third in his 2006 debut in the Sunshine Millions Sprint at Gulfstream, he collected a pair of wins at the allowance level later in the season--at Hollywood in May and Del Mar in August. Out of the money in his first three starts this term, Bushwacker found the front going 6 1/2 furlongs in his latest--a \$100,000 optional claimer here Nov. 10--and held on for a length victory. Granted an almost identical trip this time, the Florida-bred maintained a comfortable cushion over 2-1 **In Summation** until the head of the stretch, and although drifting out in the drive, the 6-1 shot was able to bag his first graded stakes victory. A catalogued filled with plenty of star power could rival last year's seven millionaire transactions as the 2007 Tattersalls December Mares sale gets underway today at 9:30 a.m. Today and, in particular tomorrow, promise to be the two show-stopping days with highlights set to include the Sangster family dispersal that last month saw G1 Fillies' Mile winner **Playful Act** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) make a record-breaking \$10.5 million at Keeneland. With **Playful Act's** dam **Magnificent Style** (Silver Hawk) withdrawing from the sale after suffering a stone bruise at home, her winning half-sister **Distinctive Look** (Ire) (Danehill)--in foal to **Galileo** (Ire)--picks up the baton and is offered as [lot 2232](#). GI **Diana S.** and GI **Beverly D. S.** winner **Angara** (GB) (Alzao), who was bought privately after she was led out unsold at \$2.2 million at Fasig-Tipton in November 2005, is catalogued as [lot 2242](#) with a February **Montjeu** (Ire) cover. Meanwhile [lot 2235](#), the 15-year-old **Francfurter** (GB) (Legend of France), is the dam of GI **E.P. Taylor S.** winner **Fraulein** (GB) (Acatenango {Ger}), although she is believed not in foal to a **Holy Roman Emperor** (Ire) (Danehill) cover.

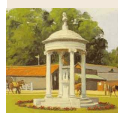

Immune to Gloom, a half-sister to stakes winner Dirge (Lord Avie), was multiple stakes placed on the racetrack and sold yesterday as a broodmare prospect. A total of 133 horses sold yesterday for \$782,800. The average fell 9.9 percent to \$5,886 and the median fell decreased 18.9 percent to \$3,000. The sale continues today at 10 a.m. with weanlings, yearlings and horses in training offered.

Third in the With Anticipation S. facing males and open competition at the end of the month, she tired to fifth in the grassy Miss Grillo S.--another open stakes--at Belmont Sept. 30. Moved back to the main track and shortened up to six furlongs, she dismantled a field of Empire-breds by 11 1/4 lengths at the Big A Nov. 7 and was moving back into stakes competition here as the public's odds-on pick. Always in control, she opened up a big lead leaving the far turn and was kept to task down the lane under pilot Alan Garcia. "She stumbled a little bit at the break, but once she got the lead she was so comfortable," said Garcia. "She's one my of my favorites. I've been aboard her for all three of her wins now. When she lost the With Anticipation [third] she was the only filly in that race. She's really nice." Added Phil Scott, assistant to winning trainer Tony Dutrow, "She's a great filly to be around. She comes over here and does her job. She always gives you a hundred percent. The boss had her doing great. She's had two hard races in a row; we'll give her a little break. Now we know she can 'dirt.' We have a lot of options for her next year."

Light Tactic came into this as the least experienced member of the field, but showed that she's a filly with a bright future with her third win in four career starts. Albert Fried Jr.'s homebred opened her account at Saratoga Aug. 17, winning by an easy 3 3/4 lengths despite acting up several times before the race.

Awarded a 90 Beyer for the effort, she matched that figure in her next, a driving 4 3/4-length tally facing open allowance foes at Belmont Sept. 19. Light Tactic disappointed in her first stakes try, running seventh at 8-5 odds in the restricted Iroquois H. at Belmont Oct. 20, but was favored returning in this spot. Racing wide in the early stages, she was aimed toward the inside in upper stretch, found a lane and lengthened away impressively.
