VASE IS DYLAN'S RACE TO LOSE

On an International rating of 128, Mrs. John Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) is the world's top-ranked horse currently in training and seems to have his foes over a barrel as the prohibitive favorite

in today's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Vase at Sha Tin Racecourse. The 2006 G1 Irish Derby winner has put together a phenomenal four-year-old campaign, with a quartet of Group 1 scores. After becoming the first horse to ever win consecutive runnings of the G1 Irish Champion S. at

Leopardstown in September, the bay colt went on to post a somewhat controversial victory in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe the following month. At his best over ground neither too quick nor too slow, he simply failed to handle the bog-like conditions when fifth in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 27. On paper, the Ballydoyle representative is many lengths better than this field, but his aborted trip to Japan has trainer Aidan O'Brien a bit on edge. "He's a very tough horse and has a great constitution," the Irish and British champion conditioner commented, "but we're playing catch-up in terms of fitness after the trip to Japan."

THRILLER IN THE JACKPOT

When the dust cleared at Delta Downs Friday night in the \$1-million GIII Boyd Gaming's Delta Jackpot S., a pair of youngsters proved inseparable in the photo finish and became graded stakes winners.

Zayat Stables' favored **Z Humor** (Distorted Humor) hit the wire together with longshot Woodford Racing's **Turf War** (Dixie Union), a full to G1 Travers S. runner-up Grasshopper.

Squeezed between the top two was local standout **Golden Yank** (Yankee Gentleman), a neck behind at the wire. A claim of foul by his rider was disallowed. Cont. p3

SUNRIVER SHINES BRIGHT IN TURF CUP

Trainer Todd Pletcher continues to win graded stakes races at a record pace and added another one to his trophy case with **Sunriver** (Saint Ballado) in yesterday's G1 Hollywood Turf Cup S. The full to champion Ashado was allowed to set easy early fractions of :25.92 and :50.20 and cruised home to a 2 3/4-length victory over the regally bred **Champs Elysees (GB)** (Danehill). "It looked like he was doing it the right way and the fractions were reasonable; he ran a big race," Pletcher said. "I didn't feel like the distance was an issue even though his record might indicate different. We felt like we could very well be on the lead, but we weren't intent on having it. I'm not really sure where he's going next, we have been pointing at this race for a while. With a horse like this, and the major stallion prospect he is and the pedigree he has, we were focused on getting him his first Grade I, so it was a big step for him. He will be racing again next year and he'll be staying in California. A possibility is the [GII] Gulfstream Park H. [Mar. 1]."

Last season Sunriver earned a spot on the Triple Crown trail following a solid third-place finish behind the ill-fated Barbaro in the GI Florida Derby. He followed with a neck victory in the GI Peter Pan S., then completed the trifecta in the GI Belmont S. The dark bay finished sixth, beaten 18 3/4 lengths, in the GI Jim Dandy S. in late July and was put away for the rest of the season. Following a pair of uninspiring efforts this spring,

including a well-beaten seventh in the GIII William Donald Schaefer H. at Pimlico May 19, Sunriver was switched to the turf. He quickly took to the green stuff, rattling off victories in a \$75,000 optional claimer at Belmont June 7 and the GI Bowling Green H. July 15 before dead-heating for fourth in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 11. He placed a game second in the GI Man o' War S. Sept. 8 and entered the Turf Cup off a sixth-place finish in the GI Pattison Canadian International S.

Oct. 21. Jockey Garrett Gomez has ridden Sunriver in each of his last five starts. "He's a really nice horse and he's a very versatile horse," Gomez commented. "He's a horse that's always going to be forwardly placed. He's never going to be far off the pace unless it's wickedly fast, and that makes

him double dangerous. The race that he got beat a nose [the Man o'War] was the best race on his form up until today. The form says he was in front, but he wasn't. I was laying third behind a wall of horses into the first turn. It's a pleasure to ride this horse. Hopefully, he can keep moving forward."

Z Humor broke his maiden like a good thing at Saratoga, then finished third in the GIII Sapling S. at Monmouth Sept. 2 and the GI Champagne S. Oct. 6. He was last seen finishing a well-beaten fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile while making his two-turn debut Oct. 27. Canadian invader Turf War graduated at Woodbine Aug. 18, then added the seven-furlong Swynford S. Sept. 15. Stretched out to a route for the GIII Grey Breeders' Cup S. last time Oct. 8, he could only manage a sixth-place finish as the 4-5 favorite. In this one, St. Joe (Trippi) led the way through fractions of :22.22 and :45.93, with Z Humor sitting a close second and Turf War trailing in 10th. With Garrett Gomez aboard, Z Humor gained the lead in the stretch, and was engaged by Golden Yank shortly thereafter as Turf War began to roll on the outside. The gritty Evening Attire, winner of the 2002 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup S. over Lido Palace (Chi) and Harlan's Holiday, went winless in nine attempts following a victory in Aqueduct's Stymie H. in March, but has held good company all season. A respectable fourth behind Political Force in the GI Suburban H. June 30, the nine-year-old reeled off consecutive third-place finishes in \$100,000 optional claimers at Saratoga in August, then completed the superfecta in the \$500,000 Massachusetts H. Sept. 22. Freshened following that effort, he resurfaced to place third in the GIII Stuyvesant H. at the Big A last time Nov. 17. With Edgar Prado aboard, he took his usual spot toward the back of the pack, and was all heart in the stretch to run down the pacesetter Barcola. Favored Hunting never threatened while third. "It's always neat when he wins," trainer Pat Kelly said. "He's competitive in races I never dreamed he'd be in at this age. If there's racing next year, we'll be here. I don't know what else we'd do with him."

Heatseeker was placed first via disqualification in a Hollywood allowance June 30, then finished fifth in the GII San Diego H. July 21. Making his final start for trainer Bobby Frankel, the chestnut crossed the line second in the Windy Sands H. Sept. 3. Transferred to Jerry Hollendorfer, he notched an \$80,000 optional claimer at the Oak Tree meeting Oct. 8, then finished a close seventh in the grassy GIII Morvich H. last time Oct. 27. Not given much respect by the Hollywood faithful here, Heatseeker was seventh through fractions of :23.53 and :46.83. With Michael Baze aboard, he rallied five wide into the lane, gained the lead in deep stretch and outkicked Racketeer to the wire. Favored Ravel was caught in traffic for most of the stretch and had to settle for fourth. "Fortunately I had a nice outside trip and was able to wait and wait and wait," Baze said. "They all bunched up in front of him and he was just dragging me along, waiting to go."

DALASYLA TOPS DAY ONE Arqana's Deauville December Sale yesterday set the stage for fierce competition for choice mares, with His Highness the Aga Khan's three-year-old filly **Dalasya (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) bringing €570,000 to top the first breeding-stock session. Consigned as hip 180, the half-sister to Daliapour (Ire), from the immediate family of Darshaan (GB), was the subject of intense scrutiny all afternoon, but it was John Warren who prevailed after a battle with Anthony Stroud. Just two lots earlier, the five-year-old mare **Winning Sequence (Fr)** (Zafonic) was knocked down to BBA Ireland's Michael Donohoe for €480,000. Haras de Bouquetot's winning half-sister to this year's G1 Prix Saint-Alary heroine Coquerelle (Ire), from the family of Roi Normand, Trampoli and Luth Dancer, is in foal to Marju (Ire). "She will go straight to stud in Ireland for an existing client," Donohoe explained, adding, "You need some money to buy into these families and it isn't easy finding a better pedigree and conformation than this." BBA Ireland showed their strength with a pair of €250,000 purchases late in the session. The first was Haras du Logis's five-year-old mare **Trading Places (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who is a half to the dams of Rail Link (GB) and Linda's Lad (GB) and is in foal to Hurricane Run (Ire). The second was four-year-old **Exotic Mix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), from the draft of Haras des Capucines. A half to 2002 G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner Spinola (Fr), she is in foal to Verglas (Ire).

Khumba Mela Attracts Attention...

As expected, 12-year-old **Khumba Mela (Ire)** (Hero's Honor) proved popular. It was Meridian International who won the day, going to €450,000 for Haras du Mezeray's multiple stakes winner. Her first foal is listed winner Madhya, and she also produced this year's Listed Criterium du Bequet hero and thrice group-placed juvenile Wilki (Fr). Carrying to Cape Cross (Ire), she is bound for the prestigious Ecurie des Monceaux establishment in Normandy. Buyer Henri Bozo said, "We know the family very well, [but] I paid a little more than I thought. There is a lot of speed in the pedigree and the mare is proven already." Hugo Lascelles Bloodstock later snapped up Haras de Saint Pair's four-year-old filly **Antibes (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), who hails from one of the most prolific Wildenstein families. Covered by Verglas (Ire), the winning half-sister to group scorer Australie (Ire) is out of a half to Arcangues and Agathe, the dam of Aquarelliste (Fr) and Artiste Royal (Ire). She was secured for €360,000. A short time later, McKeever St Lawrence stepped in for Haras des Capucines's three-year-old filly **Tropical Glamour (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who is in foal to Dalakhani (Ire).

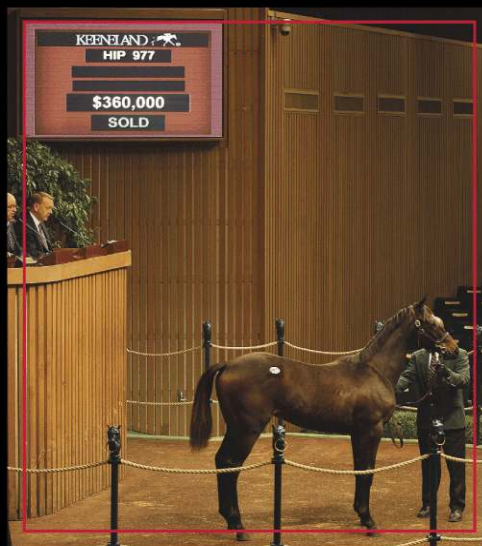

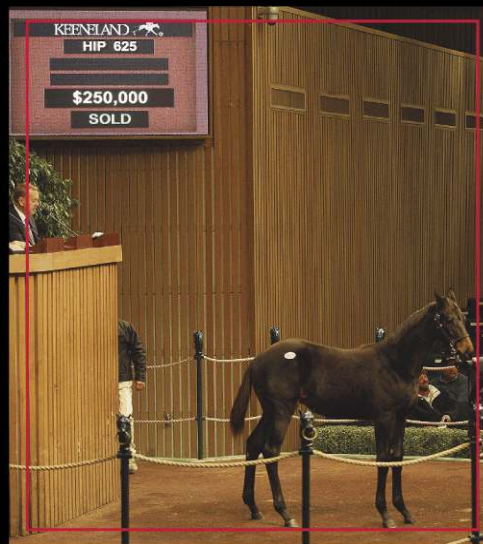

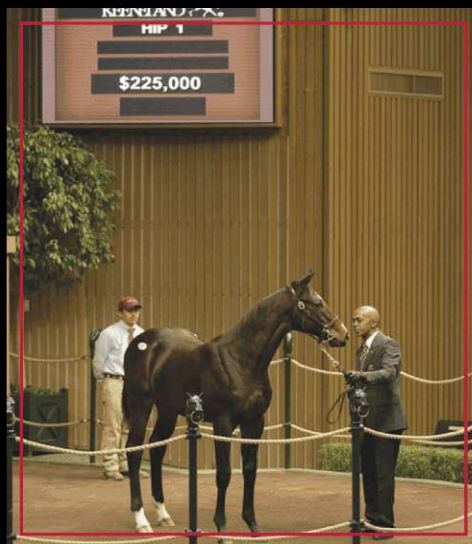

Races are not run on paper, and while the connections of Dylan Thomas's rivals pay him all due respect, they are not shying away from today's challenge. Each of the eight previous winners of the world's richest turf sprint was bred in Australia, and that looks unlikely to change this afternoon. Sacred Kingdom has won seven of his eight career appearances and made light work of last year's record-setting Sprint hero **Absolute Champion** when recording a 2 3/4-length win in the G2-HK Sprint Trial Nov. 17, eased down in the final 50 meters. Anything close to his time of 1:07.5, a new course record, would make him extremely tough to go past.

Officials at the Hong Kong Jockey Club were thrilled with the results. "That was a fantastic sale," said the Club's Chief Executive Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges. "It reflects owners' confidence, both in the sale and in Hong Kong racing. We are now looking forward to tomorrow and perhaps Good Ba Ba, Scintillation (Aus) or The Duke (Aus) will win or run well to boost the reputation of this sale even more."

KEEP AUCTION RAISES \$4 MILLION The Kentucky Equine Education Project's stallion season auction, held Friday night at the Hyatt Regency Patterson Ballroom in Lexington, raised approximately \$4 million for the organization. Topping the live auction was a season to Distorted Humor that brought \$300,000. A season to A.P. Indy was next at \$255,000, and a season to Smart Strike sold for \$155,000.



Overbrook donated a season to Storm Cat, and it was sold privately via telephone for \$300,000. "It was the biggest stallion auction, I believe, that has ever been held in the world," said KEEP Chairman Brereton Jones. "The quality was wonderful. It was so exciting to have the people unite with us, and that's what last night showed. All but a very, very few farms participated with either all or a substantial number of their stallions and that, of course, is what made it so special." About \$2.5 million was bid during the live auction, with an additional \$1.5 million in seasons being sold during the silent auction. "We still have some that did not sell and will be put in the inventory," Jones added. "They are still very marketable." KEEP will use some of the funds to push for the passage of a tax equity bill that would ensure that all agricultural industries in the state are on a level playing field when it comes to taxation; and to get the gaming amendment through the general assembly and onto the ballot, to allow the people of Kentucky to decide whether legalizing gaming at racetracks and other designated locations. "We have team leaders in every county, and more than 11,000 members across the state," Jones explained. "That gives us the power we need to get on the television and the radio and get these things accomplished."

FALLON FACES NEW CONTROVERSY

Kieren Fallon was acquitted of all charges at the Old Bailey Friday, but the way is not yet clear for the champion jockey to get his career back on track. Fallon reportedly tested positive for a prohibited substance following his win on Myboycharlie (Ire) in the Aug. 19 G1 Prix Morny at Deauville and faces the prospect of a lengthy ban if the B sample confirms that positive test. His solicitor Christopher Stewart-Moore said yesterday, "I can confirm that the story is true, but it is a matter we are dealing with together with France Galop and it is something we are not able to comment on." If the B sample is positive, Fallon could be handed a suspension of 18 months, as he has already served a six-month ban for testing positive for a metabolite of a prohibited substance in France in June 2006. The Irish Turf Club would reciprocate the ban, leaving him unable to ride in his native country.
