HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE

Godolphin's **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}) had covered himself in glory this season, winning a trio of the most important Group 1 races over a mile in England and finishing runner-up in two others. Some scoffed at the notion of entering the five-year-old for yesterday's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup over 10 furlongs, but the striking bay put pay to those naysayers, holding off a late surge from 3-10

Viva Pataca (GB) (Marju {Ire}) to take the richest event of the International meeting by a half-length. A bit rank early from the box seat in third as **Royal Prince (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) set a sedate pace from **Shadow Gate (Jpn)** (White Muzzle {GB}), Ramonti was given his cue turning for home and burst away before digging in to hold the late rally of Viva Pataca. A claim of foul by the connections of the runner-up for interference in the stretch was ultimately denied. "He's one of the bravest horses I've ever ridden," said Frankie Dettori, winning his third Cup and second for Godolphin. "To win four Group 1s in a season is a fantastic effort. He stays in training and there's a lot to look forward to."

MILE WIN IS ALL GOOD

Locally based favorite **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan) was steered wide into the Sha Tin stretch, hooked up with Godolphin's **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best) at the furlong grounds and outslugged his younger rival for a short-head victory in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile. The victory was especially sweet for trainer Andreas Schutz, in just his second year in Hong Kong. "He was a very important horse for me in my first season last year and this win is very important for my future as a trainer here," he said. DINO WINS VASE AS DYLAN FALTERS

Graduating to Godolphin Blue...**

Second in the 2400-meter G1 Derby Italiano in 2005, Ramonti has raced predominantly at the mile since, racking up victories in last year's G1 Premio Vittoria di Capua and the G2 Premio Ribot before making a favorable impression at last year's International Races, finishing a pacesetter third in the G1 Hong Kong Mile. Purchased by Sheikh Mohammed's operation for his five-year-old season, he debuted with a runner-up effort in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. May 19, but bounced back to land the G1 Queen Anne S. at the Royal meeting June 19. Ramonti found the line a head better than Excellent Art (GB) in the G1 Sussex S. Aug. 1, but fell to Darjina (Fr) in the G1 Prix du Moulin Sept. 9. Under consideration for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile after besting Excellent Art in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., he was given a bit of a break and was geared up for this.

The Garden Spot...

A bit difficult to handle for Dettori and eager all the way up the backstretch, Ramonti advanced three wide at the quarter pole, his every move tracked by Viva Pataca. He hit the front in upper stretch, shifted in a bit nearing the eighth pole, but covered his final two panels in a sharp :22.50 en route to the narrow victory. His jockey was effusive in his praise afterwards. "It was his first time over 10 furlongs and he was a bit keen because of the slow pace, but when I set him alight, I knew it would take a very good one to get past him," said Dettori. "He's one of the best." Added Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford, "There are so many more options open to him

now he gets a mile and a quarter. All credit to Saeed [bn Suroor, trainer], because this was the right track to come to test him at this trip." It was the 150th Group 1 win worldwide for Godolphin.

Godolphin nearly landed its second big prize of the afternoon with Creachadoir, but Good Ba Ba, sent off the tepid 5-2 favorite by the wagering public, tagged him late to give the locals a second consecutive victory in the event. An HK\$1.7 million graduate of the 2004 Hong Kong International Sale, Good Ba Ba has steadily climbed through the ranks in Hong Kong, defeating last year's Mile runner-up Armada (NZ) in the Chairman's Trophy, a domestic Group 2, last March. Fifth to Able One (NZ) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G1 Champions' Mile the following month and a creditable seventh in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June, the bay was runner-up to Down Town (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}) in the G3-HK Sha Tin Trophy

H. Oct. 21. That set him up nicely for the G2-HK Mile Trial Nov. 17, when he rolled home a cozy neck better than Floral Pegasus (Aus) (Fusaichi Pegasus). Andreas Schutz insisted that Good Ba Ba would have more to give on the big stage and that he did. As expected, Kongo Rikishio (Ire) (Stravinsky) led from his inside draw, as Good Ba Ba was tenderly ridden three from the rear by jockey Olivier Doleuze. The Japanese raider covered his opening 800 meters in a comfortable :48.30 and still had his pink blinkers in front after six furlongs in 1:11.90. Creachadoir, midfield and covered up to the stretch, angled out and let down generously for Frankie Dettori, but Good Ba Ba was coming with his run and the two hooked up at the eighth pole. Strides nearly synchronized and jockeys full board, Good Ba Ba was just able to get the better of his younger rival to give Hong Kong back-to-back wins in the Mile. "We had a good gate in the middle and I was able to ride him as quietly as I like to," Doleuze explained. "The thing with him is not to hit the front too soon. He has such great acceleration and he gives you everything in the finish just like he did there. He's probably the best miler I have ever ridden." Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford was pleased with the effort of the runner-up and said Creachadoir could return to Hong Kong for the G1 Champions' Mile Apr. 27. Darjina finished a gallant third after being tightened up inside Creachadoir in the final furlong. "I wish I could have started her run a little sooner, but we had to wait and when she got out she took a little time to get balanced, but then ran on really well," said rider Christophe Soumillon. The three-year-old filly remains in training for 2008 and could be tried over longer trips, the Princess Zahra Aga Khan stated. Excellent Art (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) galloped along at the back of the pack and was one-paced late, finishing eighth. He is to be retired to stud, according to trainer Aidan O'Brien.

Despite well-publicized concerns about his fitness level and the toll a long campaign might have exacted on him, Dylan Thomas was pounded into 7-10 favoritism for the Hong Kong Vase, but in the end, it was the well-traveled Doctor Dino who came home best to post a mild upset. A Group 3 winner in France in 2006, connections have focused their attentions outside the European continent this season. His first start of the year did come in France, where he could not match

strides with Dylan Thomas and finished third in April's G1 Prix Ganay. On just three weeks' rest, the chestnut ventured to Singapore's Kranji Racecourse and he ran with credit again, staying on for third behind Shadow Gate (Jpn) in the G1 Singapore Air-

lines International Cup May 20. Spelled a bit off that effort, Doctor Dino was put on a plane for Chicago and the G1 Arlington Million Aug. 11. Third in that blanket finish, he finally hit paydirt in the G1 Man O'War S. at Belmont Park four weeks later, besting Sunriver by a head. In his most recent appearance, he was badly hampered at the quarter pole in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20, but still managed a third-place effort. Sent off the third betting choice to Dylan Thomas here, Doctor Dino broke well from an inside gate and landed close to the early pace, set by Viva Macau (Fr) (Sendawar {Ire}). The frontrunner was joined by the German mare Macleya (Ger) (Winged Love {Ire}) as they turned up the backstretch and Doctor Dino was eased back to a more midfield position while scraping the paint. In the meantime, Dylan Thomas and John Murtagh were further back in the field and the contest appeared wide open as the raced to the head of the lane. At that point, Christophe Soumilon took Bussoni to the front and it appeared for a few strides that he might be able to see off the competition. But Doctor Dino, deftly maneuvered off the fence and four off the rail in the drive, closed in with massive strides, overhauled Bussoni and held Quijano in the final run to the wire. "We've always had positive vibes about him this week but you need luck in running and things didn't look too good early in the straight," admitted winning trainer Richard Gibson. "But when you have the likes of Olivier Peslier riding for you then you don't worry. We had become sick of running well in big races around the world but in the last two months he has won two Group 1s and since, this was his first time over a mile and a half, who knows what's next?" For Dylan Thomas, the race marked the end of an otherwise terrific year. "It's the end of long hard season and he got caught in quarantine for a long time," trainer Aidan O'Brien commented. "He was as big as a bull and, although we tried, we couldn't do too much about it. He's probably the best horse we've had and 's a great credit to all the lads who've kept him sound."

In 2003, Silent Witness (Aus) won his eighth consecutive start to claim the mantra of the world's leading sprinter. With one blemish on his record, Sacred Kingdom is only slightly less successful at this point of his career, but with his dominating victory over a talented

field in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint, the four-year-old is destined to become an international superstar. Perfect in five starts to begin his career, Sacred Kingdom was not quite ready for stakes competition and endured his only defeat to

date when fourth in domestic Group 3 competition May 24. Put away with an eye on the 2007/2008 season, the bay won the G3-HK Sha Tin Sprint Trophy H. up the Sha Tin straight Oct. 1 and established a new track record in winning the G2-HK Sprint Trial Nov. 17, clocking 1:07.5 in defeating Absolute Champion by an eased-down 2 3/4 lengths. Longshot Royal Delight showed the best speed while tracked by Singapore's Why Be (Aus) (Success Express) and Miss Andretti (Aus) (Iltiram {Ire}), the second favorite who was hustled along early by jockey Craig Newitt. Last year's winner Absolute Champion found a good spot just behind the peloton while a bit further back, Sacred Kingdom was waiting to pounce beneath Gerald Mosse. Royal Delight led them into the stretch, but Absolute Champion shifted out and looked to be on his way to successfully defending his title. Those dreams were snuffed out nearly as quickly, as Sacred Kingdom came to him leaving the eighth pole and went on to win with breathtaking ease. "He has proved he is one of the best sprinters in the world; maybe the best now," said trainer Ricky Yiu, who won the inaugural Hong Kong Sprint in 1999 with Fairy King Prawn (Aus). "I was a little worried at the top of home. Gerald said the same. He was looking for a gap, but when it came 300 meters out, he took it and showed the turn of foot that we expected. It would be nice to take him overseas at some point, but there are big races to go for in Hong Kong first." The disappointment of the race was Miss Andretti, who fought her jockey every step of the way and right out of the race, her first around a right-handed bend. "She could not get across from her wide gate and she got her head up early in the race," Newitt said. "She just struggled this way round. She was on her Melbourne 'left' leg all the way and was never comfortable."

Success on Many Levels...

Attendance was up for the 2007 International Races meeting and the day's turnover soared to over HK\$1 billion (\$128,289,009). "This had to be the best ever international day's racing that we have staged," commented Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges, chief executive of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "The atmosphere was tremendous and on the track, the highlights included what must be considered a world champion in Sacred Kingdom (Aus) and great battles between Ramonti (Fr) and Viva Pataca (GB) in the Cup and our sale horse Good Ba Ba winning the Mile against Creachadoir (Ire)." Adding further luster to the program, jockey Douglas Whyte, for seven years running the leading rider in Hong Kong, won his 947th career race in the country, breaking the previous record held by current trainer Tony Cruz. "It's been an amazing run," the South African commented. "It's taken 10 1/2 years and to be honest, I never dreamt I would achieve something like this when I started out. But as I've got closer to the record, it became a goal of mine to beat it. To finally do it is quite sensational."

Midway through the second session at Deauville, hip 338 sparked considerable interest as a half-sister to four stakes winners, most notably 1994 GI Yellow Ribbon S. heroine Aube Indienne (Fr) and 2001 G3 Prix Vanteaux winner Mare Nostrum (GB). She is also a half to the dams of the smart Sensible (Fr) and 2006 G3 Gladness S. scorer Common

World and has both Flying Spur (Aus) and Encosta de Lago (Aus) in her extended family. Jambu was purchased by Bertrand le Metayer Bloodstock for Australian breeder Roger Langley, who later revealed that she would be headed to his Poternick Farm. "This purchase will upgrade my broodmare band and it is a very commercial page," he said. "The strength on the dam's side is unbelievable, and the fact that Flying Spur and Encosta de Lago are on the same page is a factor." Later on, it was a mare from His Highness the Aga Khan's prized draft which proved the main draw, but the mare wound up being bought back. Hip 444 is the six-year-old **Dalataya (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a half-sister to Daylami (Ire) and Dalakhani (Ire) in foal to Cape Cross (Ire). Charlie Gordon-Watson saw off Horse France's Robert Nataf as the bidding rose to the million mark, but refused to go beyond €1.1million, so she will rejoin the Aga Khan's formidable ranks.

"She is from a very good family and the dam has already produced Clodovil, who is off to a good start as a stallion--she is also in foal to Azamour, who is an interesting sire himself," he said, before revealing that she will be one of the first bred to Dylan Thomas (Ire) in 2008. Azamour is also the covering stallion for hip 382, another proven broodmare from the Aga Khan's legions. Vadsa Honor (Fr) is now almost 15, but she still holds considerable sway as the dam of the promoted 2001 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois winner Vahorimix (Fr), as well as the listed winner and group-placed Vadalix (Fr). Bruno Ridoux of Pegasus Farms outlasted his competition at €300,000 to secure the mare, whose immediate family includes Val Royal (Fr) and Valixir (Ire).

Both her dam Saxon Maid (GB) and granddam Britannia's Rule (Ire) are stakes winners, while she is a half to the dam of the 2005 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up Fauvelia (Fr). Of the foals, the French Bloodstock Agency came out on top when securing hip [325](#), a daughter of Darley's newblood Shamardal, also from the Bernesq draft. The half-sister to the 2005 G3 Prix d'Aumale scorer Sirene Doloise (Fr) was knocked down to Jean-Pierre Deroubaix's organisation for €130,000. Despite another impact on the clearance rate, which was down to under 70 percent for the second session, the average of €37,751 showed a healthy increase of 41 percent on its 2006 equivalent, while the median of €20,000 was up by a third. Overall, the average is up by 11 percent on last year. President Eric Hoyeau was taking positive signals from the trends. "The first part of this year's Deauville Breeding Stock sale has confirmed the significant advances made in 2006 as the aggregate is very close to last year's record," he said. "The market has been selective, as it was in England and Ireland, with more horses sold in the upper levels, over the two days there were 17 horses sold for €200,000 or more compared with 10 in 2006, but with a lower percentage of those offered selling. It is satisfying to see the range of buyers present and active with purchasers from all over Europe, Australia, New Zealand and Brazil." Selling continues today at 11am. 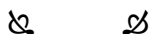
