**FULL FIELD FOR PELLEGRINI**

A full field of 24, headed by G1 Estrellas Classic hero **Fairy Magic (Arg)** (Southern Halo), will go to the gate

for today's G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini at Argentina's San Isidro. Four-year-old Fairy Magic bids for his fourth consecutive score victory, and his third straight in Group 1 company. A conditions winner going a mile June 16, he was 3/4 of a length in front of **Honey Nov (Arg)** (Romanov {Ire}) in the 2000-meter Classic June

30, and comes into this 2400-meter test off a 1 1/2-length tally in the G1 Gran Premio Palermo Nov. 10. The chestnut, now six-for-nine lifetime, drew post 16 in the Pellegrini. He takes on last year's champion older horse **Latency (Arg)** (Slew Gin Fizz). The Classic winner in 2005 and second in 2006, six-year-old Latency was third in this year's edition of the event, but rebounded with wins in the G1 Gran Premio Peru July 29 and the G1 General San Martin Aug. 20. **Star Plus (Arg)** (Alpha Plus {Arg}), second by a neck in that 1800-meter test, will opt for today's co-featured G1 Gran Premio Joaquin S. De Anchorena at a mile. The field for the G1 Gran Premio Internacional Felix De Alzaga Unzue at 1000 meters includes undefeated **Lady Sprinter** (Orientate), who made it six in a row in the G1 Gran Premio Maipu Nov. 10. **Fields, p3-4**

**SENATE PASSES EQUINE EQUITY ACT**

The version of the Farm Bill that included the Equine Equity Act yesterday was passed by the U.S. Senate on a vote of 79 to 14. The EEA would reduce the capital gains holding period for horses from two years to one, and accelerate and make uniform the depreciation for racehorses over a three-year period. The House of Representatives had earlier passed a version of the Farm Bill, and the House and the Senate are expected to work out a final draft during the first quarter of 2008. "We appreciate the Senate's quick and decisive action on this important piece of legislation that modernizes the tax code with respect to equine industry investments," said Alex Waldrop, president and CEO of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. "I would like to particularly thank Senator McConnell for his leadership and Senator Lincoln for providing bi-partisan support." Senators Mitch McConnell (R-KY) and Blanche Lincoln (D-AR) co-sponsored the EEA.

**CAN HISTORY REPEAT IN THE STARLET?**

Two years ago, trainer Christopher Paasch sent out the lightly regarded Diplomat Lady in the G1 Hollywood Starlet S. The filly had run 10th in the G1 Del Mar Debutante S. and was making her two-turn debut, but she outfinished Balance to post the upset at 39-1, putting her name in the record book as the longest-priced winner of the race. Paasch is back this year with **Foxy Danseur** (Mr. Greeley); the filly also failed to make an impact in the Del Mar Deb, but she came back to break her maiden at Oak Tree and was second in the Anoakia S. before stretching out to lead every step in the Sharp Cat S. over track and trip Nov. 17. "If I had my druthers, I would like to see her three, four or five lengths off the lead, but I'll leave that up to [Tyler Baze]," Paasch said. "At least I know she'll get the distance." **Cont. p2**

Also going turf to Cushion is GI Del Mar Debutante winner **Set Play** (Van Nistelrooy), who was third in the Nov. 24 GIII Miesque S. in her grass bow.

She had to overcome a slow start and a wide trip in her U.S. bow, the Nov. 11 GII Long Island H., but got up for a handy score. **Herboriste**, second to **Oh Deanne O** going 10 panels in a Belmont allowance in September, is perfect in two starts at this trip. She captured a Keeneland allowance at 12 furlongs in her latest try Oct. 18. Oh Deanne O tired to be seventh after setting the pace in her most recent outing, an optional claimer on a yielding Aqueduct course Oct. 25. G1 Chilean Derby heroine **Eres Magic** comes into this off a second in the Oct. 21 Dowager S. at Keeneland.

**2 My Rachel Horse Chestnut (Saf) Prado 5-1**

The chestnut didn't start until she was four, and didn't start showing stakes-level ability until tried on grass this year. In her last, she raced outside and lost to a jump-up winner in a performance that was better than it looked, and since she has a very solid pattern, there is no reason to expect her to run worse now. In fact, after a down period at Saratoga and Belmont, Pletcher's horses have recently been firing with a vengeance, so she might even be ready for a new top. With an inside draw going three turns, this one is a strong contender.

**3 Green Girl (Fr) Lord of Men (GB) Desormeaux 4-1**

The mare showed moderate ability in Europe before improving in her first American start, a good performance concealed by a wide trip. She bounced from that big effort last time, but, with good time into this, is about 50/50 to return to her top now. With an inside draw, that would make her a strong contender here.

**4 Jive Dynaformer Nunez 20-1**

She is too slow to compete here, and there is no reason to expect an explosion.

**5 Dalvina (GB) Grand Lodge Velasquez 3-1**

The three-year-old was another that showed moderate ability in Europe, but she exploded last time with the addition of Lasix to take the GII Long Island H. easily. A repeat of that effort would make her one of the contenders, but it's the only effort of her life that would and there's a good chance she will bounce, all of which makes her a vulnerable favorite.

She put in three straight efforts this spring and summer that would be good enough to make her very strong here, before getting a four-month layoff. So her last a) was her first start after coming off a layoff; b) her first try after shipping north/south; and c) a race where she encountered trouble, twice. There is every reason to expect her to improve significantly now and though she's never been this far, she's a strong contender.

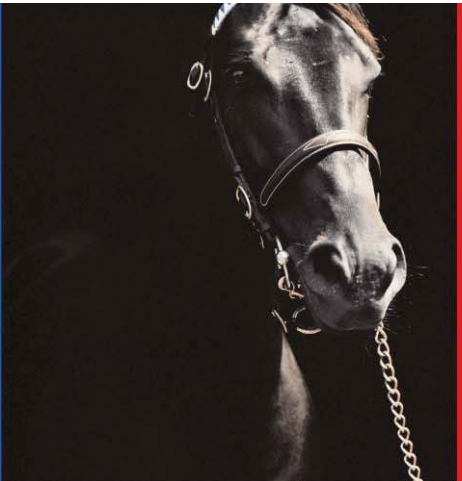

# DURABILITY A.K.A. LAWYER RON



*"In an era when the number of starts per runner has declined dramatically, to hit an all-time low, **durability is becoming all the more important in a potential stallion.** Lawyer Ron left no questions unanswered about his soundness during a three-year career which saw him face the starter 26 times, including 10 times as a two-year-old. He has some pretty tough individuals among his immediate ancestors.*

**Langfuhr** competed 11 times as a three-year-old and 23 times in all, and showed that he had inherited an ample measure of the durability displayed by three of his four grandparents.

**Northern Dancer** was born as late as May 27, but that didn't stop him racing nine times as a juvenile and his victory in the Kentucky Derby came on his 15<sup>th</sup> start--16<sup>th</sup> if you include an exhibition race in Florida. Those starts were packed into a 10-month period, so Northern Dancer was as tough as he was talented.

**Pas de Nom**, Danzig's dam, raced 42 times over four seasons.

**Briartic**, Langfuhr's broodmare sire, raced at least 13 times in each of his first four years on the track, ultimately retiring as a veteran of 63 races.

**Nearctic**, to whom Langfuhr is inbred 3x3, packed 47 starts into four years of action.

**No Vote on NYRA Franchise cont.**

According to the *Daily Racing Form*, NYRA CEO Charlie Hayward held a meeting with his company's employees Thursday where he revealed that NYRA has received several amendments to the original agreement with Gov. Spitzer which do not meet with their approval. "We got a document [Wednesday] night which we don't like," Hayward said. "It doesn't resemble the [memorandum of understanding with Gov. Spitzer] very well." The *DRF* reported that Hayward has objected to Senate majority leader Joe Bruno's proposal that the entire NYRA Board of Directors resign and that a state-appointed oversight board take over racing. There have been reports of a "handshake deal" being worked out among the various parties that would allow NYRA to continue racing after the franchise expires Dec. 31, but Hayward said Thursday Aqueduct will be shut down Jan. 1, 2008, if there is not an agreement in place. "As I said from the day I took this job, the oversight board can run racing, they just can't run it at Aqueduct, Belmont or Saratoga--it's our property," Hayward told *DRF*. "There is a scenario under which, if they really push that and they don't want to work with us, where we would retain our right. The state would be responsible for racing stopping. I think the possibility of that is low, but it really depends on how far they want to push this."

It was a yearling son of Came Home who proved the star turn at yesterday’s one-day auction, selling to Jerry O’Reilly for €48,000. Consigned as hip [1008](#), the Abbey Leix Stud Farm-consigned colt hails from a family rich in black type, with the notable dirt performers Polish Holiday and Lt Pinkerton on his page alongside the legendary Raise a Native. Of the broodmares, Abbeville and Meadow Court Studs’ hip [1166](#), **Symphony In Dee (Ire)** (Mozart {Ire}), was at the forefront. A half-sister to the useful Cheveley Park filly Shanghai Lily (Ire) and a close relative to the smart handicapper Eden Rock (Ire), she is in foal to the former’s sire King’s Best and proved popular in the ring. Paolo Garavel’s Westmeath-based TLT International prevailed in the end with a bid of €43,000. After a session which witnessed the same alarming drop in the clearance rate evident in most of the main winter sales, Beeby opined on the current state of affairs. “2007 has been an outstanding year for Goffs with many, many highlights,” he said. “To summarise the 2007 sales season, demand at the top of the market is thriving, the middle is surviving but everything else is struggling. The role of any sales company is to provide an outlet to sell the horses we are offered, but the sheer number of foals born in recent years has resulted in an increasingly palpable gulf between the upper and lower tiers of the market and a packed sales calendar resulting in some uncomfortable sales clashes. **Strike the Deal** (Van Nistelrooy), purchased out of last week’s Tattersalls December sale for 480,000 guineas, is to remain with trainer Jeremy Nosedo, who will steer the colt in the direction of the Dubai International Racing Carnival, according to *Racing Post*. “Strike the Deal’s new owner has very kindly asked us to continue to train him,” Nosedo told the *Post*. “His first target will be the [G3] UAE 2,000 Guineas [Feb. 14] and, depending on what happens then, we could return for the [G2] UAE Derby on World Cup night [Mar. 29].” Winner of the G2 Richmond S. in August and runner-up in the G1 Middle Park S. Oct. 5, the chestnut was last seen finishing a close fourth in the Breeders’ Cup Juvenile Turf Oct. 26.

**KINGDOM BEST IN WORLD--SORT OF Sacred Kingdom (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}), who posted the eighth victory of his nine-race career in taking last Sunday's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint, has been given a rating of 123, making him the fastest sprinter in the world in 2007. However, because he does not race in a jurisdiction where racing is held on a calendar-year basis, his name will not appear in next month's World Thoroughbred Racehorse Rankings. Racing takes place on a September-to-June schedule in Hong Kong. A ranking of 123 is the highest awarded in two years and equals the mark established by former Hong Kong legend Silent Witness (Aus). "Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International raceday was again a tremendous success, with top class horses producing superb performances in each of the feature events, including a sensational display by Sacred Kingdom in the Sprint," said Bill Nader, executive director of racing for the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "It's great that the world's leading sprinter is once again trained in Hong Kong and it's a remarkable achievement for such a lightly-raced horse to be on top of the world." Trained by Ricky Yiu, Sacred Kingdom is rated three pounds better than a quartet at 120, including G1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner **Benbaun (Ire)** (Stravinsky); **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet), the G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint hero; **Miss Andretti (Aus)** (Ihtiram {Ire}), victorious in the G2 King's Stand S.; and **Sakhee's Secret (GB)** (Sakhee), who took the G1 Darley July Cup.
