"Oaks? She's going to be the next Kentucky Derby winner." That was jockey Rafael Bejarano's response after being asked about what 2008 might bring for

Country Star (Empire Maker), who turned in a resounding performance yesterday in the \$431,500 GI Hollywood Starlet S. while setting a new track record. Bejarano may come down from cloud nine today, but he was aboard the Stonerside homebred when she opportunely broke her maiden in her second start,

the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 5. "You can't even compare her win in Kentucky with this one," Bejarano added. "There's no comparison. SEALY HILL: CANADA'S HORSE OF THE YEAR

For the second straight year, a three-year-old filly was honored as Canada's most outstanding Thoroughbred.

Sealy Hill (Point Given), first or second in seven of her eight starts in 2007, followed in the hoofsteps of Arravale and was named the Sovereign Award winner as Canada's Horse of the Year Friday night at the Westin Harbour Castle in Toronto.

Owned and bred by Eugene Melnyk and trained by Mark Casse, the dark bay also received the award as champion three-year-old filly and champion female turf horse. She became the first winner of Canada's Triple Crown for fillies after taking the Woodbine Oaks, Bison City S. and Wonder Where S., and was second in the GII Canadian S. and GI E.P. Taylor S. Sealy Hill is the fourth sophomore filly to earn the Sovereign Award as Horse of the Year in the last 16 years. In addition to Arravale, Alywow in 1991 and Dance Smartly in 1994 earned the title.

Big Week for LANGFUHR
PARADISE DANCER is GSW #5 in 2007 for Langfuhr
AMAZING SPEED won her third stakes this year on Dec. 8.

A STAR IS BORN Always highly regarded--both for her athletic ability and pleasant demeanor--by trainer Bobby Frankel, **Country Star** made her debut at on the turf at Belmont Sept. 20, rallying past another Empire Maker filly, Mushka, to claim second behind Backseat Rhythm ([video](#)). That maiden has redefined what "key race" means: Backseat Rhythm went on to run second and third, respectively, in the GI Frizette S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies to likely champion Indian Blessing, while Mushka posted a highly impressive score in the GI Demoiselle S. Frankel opted to not waste anyone's time by running Country Star in another maiden special, and instead shipped her to Keeneland's Polytrack for the GI Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 5. Sent off at 8-1, the pretty filly swept eight wide in the lane to become the first Grade I winner for her freshman sire (by Unbridled). She was kept in the barn rather than vie for the Breeders' Cup, and flew to Hollywood early in November.

Sent off at even-money, Country Star bobbed a bit at the break, but recovered to race in the two path as **Spritely** (Touch Gold) and **Time Reveals All** (Pulpit) sparred through splits of :23.38 and :46.25. Bejarano guided the favorite towards the outside on the far turn and

she entered the lane full of run. After taking the lead midstretch, Country Star pricked her ears, but kept moving towards the wire with her stride still smooth. "I was surprised she went so wide, but I guess [Bejarano] didn't want to get in any trouble," Frankel commented after the race. "It looked like he asked her and she took off, and then he was pulling her up at the end. She's great to be around, easy to train and she does everything 100 percent." Frankel added, "This one might be something special. We'll probably point to some races in May; I haven't made any plans yet. She might run in the [GI Santa Anita Oaks [Mar. 8]; maybe one more race before then."

Rings a Bell...

Bred in Washington, Rings a Chime (Metfield) brought just \$26,000 in 1998 as a yearling in her home state, but fared quite well when sent to the big time. In addition to a triumph in the GI Ashland S., the dark bay ran second in the GI Kentucky Oaks and third in the GI Las Virgenes S., bankrolling \$606,315 along the way. She RNA'd for \$975,000 that fall at Fasig-Tipton, but was purchased by Stonerside for \$800,000 at the 2002 Keeneland January Sale. Though she slipped that season, Rings a Chime's second foal for the McNair operation was a Storm Cat

colt who brought \$3.1 million from Demi O'Byrne at the 2005 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. Country Star is her third foal. After failing to get in foal for 2006, Rings a Chime produced a Storm Cat colt in 2007 and was bred back to Giant's Causeway.

the twilight of her five-year-old season. Previously based with Tim Woolley at Fair Hill, the Pennsylvania-bred began 2007 with a third in the Dahlia S. at Laurel in April before scoring in the Politely S. at Monmouth May 27. She ran Karen's Caper to a half-length when second in

the GIII Eatontown H. at the Jersey Shore June 16 before closing out her tenure under Woolley with a success in the Mrs. Penny H. at Philly Park July 28. Redaspen didn't face the starter again until Dec. 1, when she rallied for third in the GIII My Charmer H. going nine furlongs over this course. Away alertly under Eddie Castro while stretching out significantly, the granddaughter of Danzig was content to save ground near the back of the pack as Oh Deanne O (Dynaformer) set a tepid pace of :49.15 and 1:13.83. Favored Dalvina found herself shut off as she attempted to mount her challenge in the lane, but Redaspen bided her time, surged through when an opening presented itself and made it to the wire safely in front of the ex-European Green Girl and Dalvina. "The owners were considering retiring her, but this race was coming up, and a personal friend of ours recommended sending her to us and taking a shot," said winning trainer Rebecca Baker, saddling her second winner from just 10 starters this year. "We ran her going shorter [in the My Charmer] and she ran well. She never had been this distance before, but Eddie rode her perfect and she got a great trip. Fifth to Dave (Ends Well) in the 11-furlong GII Red Smith H. Nov. 10 at Aqueduct, the Florida-bred was forced to steady in the nine-furlong GIII Tropical Turf H. Dec. 1 over this course and wound up seventh, beaten 3 3/4 lengths. The 2005 G1 Estrellas Classic hero, Latency was named the champion older horse and champion miler in Argentina in 2006 after putting up a record of three wins and two seconds from his five starts. The runner-up in the Classic last year, he was third behind Fairy Magic (Southern Halo) in that event this season, but came back to take the G1 Gran Premio Peru July 29 and the G1 General San Martin Aug. 20. He was making his first appearance in nearly four months here, but that didn't stop him from making it three Group 1 wins in a row. Rated off solid fractions, Latency began his move as Candy Gift grabbed the lead at midstretch, then powered past that rival and easily held off Puchet as jockey Julio Mendez merely showed him the whip in the final yards. Mendez was embraced by his fellow riders after the race, and Queen's "We Are The Champions" played over the loudspeakers as Latency returned to the winner's circle. [Click here for the replay.](#)

A conditions winner in July, Star Plus had to settle for second while facing group company in his next three starts. The bay colt was beaten a neck by Pellegrini hero Latency (Arg) in the G1 General San Martin in August, then came up a length short in the Group 2 event in September before hitting the line 3/4 of a length adrift of Secretario Plan in the Oct. 7 G1 Gran Premio San Isidro. Jockey Pedro Robles opted to take Star Plus off the pace through splits of :22.90, :45.36 and 1:08.21 yesterday. Robles waited until deep stretch to unleash the colt, driving him to the front in the final yards as he turned the tables on Secretario Plan. Star Plus is a son of the Mr. Prospector stallion Alpha Plus, a listed winner in France who was produced by SW & MGSP Danzante (Danzig), herself a half-sister to Skywalker.
