**CITRONNADE BLOSSOMS IN DAHLIA**

"It was a walk in the park," jockey David Flores said after piloting **Citronnade** (Lemon Drop Kid) to an easy win in yesterday's GII Dahlia H. at Hollywood Park. The Stronach homebred filly broke sharply from the outside in yesterday's 12-horse field and Flores guided her to the lead along the hedge. Loose on the front end through moderate fractions of :24.35, :48.62 and 1:12.47, Citronnade had plenty left for the stretch run and kicked clear to a two-length victory over the late-closing **Black Mamba (NZ)** (Black Minnaloushe). "I could see in the paper that nobody had her kind of speed," Flores explained. "Being on the outside, I wanted to take advantage of the position and just go before I got to the first turn and hopefully get an easy lead. The pace was very comfortable and when it was time to go at the quarter pole, I chirped to her a couple of times and it was all over." During a five-race win streak, Citronnade won the GII San Gorgonio H., GII Santa Ana H., GI Gamely S. and GII Beverly Hills H. The streak ended with a fourth-place effort in the Aug. 11 GI Beverly D. S. and the four-year-old filly had not been out since finishing second behind Nashoba's Key in the Sept. 29 GI Yellow Ribbon S. Sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the chestnut is coming off a win over the Churchill turf in the Nov. 24 Grand Canyon H. Todd Pletcher's three Futurity hopefuls worked yesterday. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Referee** (Distorted Humor) covered five furlongs in :59.60. **John and Bev Passerello:**

We are Thoroughbred breeders with mares at Stoneleigh Farm in Paris, Ky. In response to the recent TDN survey, we believe that future Breeders' Cup World Championship event days should be limited to tracks which race on artificial surfaces. We have partnered with others with regard to the ownership of racing Thoroughbreds and have had horses race on dirt, turf and artificial surfaces in Kentucky and Ohio. We strongly believe in the excellent care and treatment of all Thoroughbreds. We have observed our horses having a better condition following races on artificial surface tracks and also having less injuries than on dirt tracks. We are in favor of future Breeders Cup World Championship event days being limited to tracks with artificial surfaces.

**ALIYSA (BRZ) (f, 4, Music Prospector--Angra Dos Reis {Brz}, by Purple Mountain)** captured the G3 Grande Premio Jacutinga in her native Brazil in April of 2006 before concluding her run in South America with a runner-up performance in a Group 2 event. She went missing for nine months before returning in Dubai, where she ran third in the G3 Al Shindagha Sprint in late January and then 10th in a valuable allowance in February. Moved to trainer Todd Pletcher's barn, Aliysa was sent off favored in her U.S. bow, a Belmont allowance in July, but could do no better than a lackluster fifth. An improved fourth in a Monmouth sprint in August, she tired to be third in a grassy Meadowlands test Nov. 1 and was returning to the main track, and to routes, at prohibitive 4-5 odds here. Ferrell Juvenile Fillies over seven-eighths Nov. 10.
