DAYTONA SPEEDS TO SAN GABRIEL WIN

Daytona (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) has come into his own this fall with wins in the GII Oak Tree Derby and GII Hollywood Derby, and the three-year-old gelding kept the trend going with a front-running win against his elders in yesterday's GII San Gabriel H. at Santa Anita. Ridden by Mike Smith, Daytona exchanged opening salvos with **Lang Field** (Langfuhr) before taking control after a half mile. He carried a clear lead into the lane before holding off the late-closing **Proudinsky (Ger)** (Silvano {Ger}) for a 3/4-length victory. "I wanted to be on the lead, but the horse outside of me [Lang Field] out-broke me, so I had to wait with him," explained Smith, who was completing a weekend graded stakes double after winning the GI La Brea S. on Saturday. "When we got to the first turn, I just went on with him right into the turn and when we made the lead, he just threw his ears up and got into a rhythm. He's got such a high-cruising speed, he's really tough on the lead." Winning trainer Dan Hendricks has been impressed with his charge's development this fall. "This horse really matured after Del Mar and my assistant, Francisco [Alvarado] did a lot with him," Hendricks said. CANNONBALL RUNS AT CALDER

Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Cannonball** (Catienus) will look to start his sophomore season off with a bang in tomorrow's GIII Tropical Park Derby at Calder Racecourse. The New York-bred gelding, a maiden winner over the Belmont lawn in September, narrowly won the Oct. 21 King Cugat S. He returned just five days later to run a solid third behind Nownownow in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. "The way the Breeders' Cup was shaping up, I never thought we'd get into the race, which is why I ran him in the stakes in New York five days earlier," Cannonball's trainer Wesley Ward explained to *Daily Racing Form*. "If I had been sure we'd have been able to run in the Breeders' Cup, I would have passed that first race. And I believe if he hadn't been coming back on such short rest, he'd have won the Turf." The Ramseys won the 2004 Tropical Park Derby with subsequent turf champion Kitten's Joy. The nine-furlong event also launched the three-year-old campaign of Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro in 2006. The 12-horse field also includes Stonerside Stable's **Cowboy Cal** (Giant's Causeway). The dark bay colt is coming off a 6 1/4-length win in the Nov. 24 Laurel Futurity. Jockey John Velazquez has the mount for trainer Todd Pletcher. **Full Field p2**

The always-game Naughty New Yorker continued to edge toward the million-dollar mark with a late-rallying victory typical of the five-year-old. Winner of Saratoga's Saratoga Sunrise S. and Belmont's General Douglas Macarthur H. in August and September, the bay ran fourth as the favorite in the Empire Classic at Belmont in October. The winner of last year's GIII Red Smith H. ran one of the best races of his career to be third to Daaher and Midnight Lute in the GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile last out Nov. 24 and he was made the lukewarm favorite to successfully defend his title in this race. Well off the pace, he drove between rivals in upper stretch and ran hard down the lane to get up for the win. "He makes it tough on these New York-breds," said winning trainer Pat Kelly. "It's neat to win this a second time. Hopefully, he'll get some New York-bred awards this year. I'll probably nominate him and Evening Attire for the Aqueduct H. He's been on a good roll." Johnny Eves (Skimming), winner of the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S., will likely make his next start in the Jan. 12 GI San Fernando S. at Santa Anita. "I think we ought to take a look at it," confirmed trainer Jay Robbins. "He doesn't really ever get rank, and on this surface [Cushion Track], he might be able to carry his speed further." Jockey Danny Sorenson worked horses Saturday for the first time since he was injured in a training mishap at Hollywood Park last March.
