In winning for the 11th time in 27 career starts, In Summation was taking his batting average to .500--five wins from 10 appearances--over synthetic surfaces. **ASMUSSEN, GOMEZ, ZAYAT AMONG LEADERS**


Steve Asmussen, Garrett Gomez and Ahmed Zayat's Zayat Stables LLC head the lists by North American earnings of leading trainer, jockey and owner, respectively, according to year-end statistics released yesterday by Equibase Company LLC. Asmussen and his associates made a record total of 622 visits to winner's circles all over the country while amassing earnings--in North America--of \$24,253,247. A second list including results from the Dubai World Cup show Asmussen with earnings just shy of \$28 million. Trainer Todd Pletcher finished a distant second in earnings, his runners winning 208 races for purse money of \$13,784,586. Gomez, who rode three winners on Wednesday's program at Santa Anita, fell a bit more than \$10,000 short of the all-time earnings record set by Jerry Bailey, finishing the season with 214 winners which earned \$23,344,351. Gomez was well clear of Rafael Bejarano, who posted 266 wins and earnings of \$16,439,729. Horses carry the blue and yellow silks of Ahmed Zayat won 116 races from 740 starts and earned \$6,883,902 in 2008. Runner-up was Stronach Stables, with 114 wins and \$6,677,124. Among horses, **Big Brown** (Boundary) led with North American earnings of \$3,576,700, followed by **Raven's Pass** (Elusive Quality) with \$2,700,000 and the undefeated **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) with \$2,090,580. Factoring in earnings from the Dubai World Cup, **Curlin** (Smart Strike) was the leading money winner with \$5,294,000.

**NYRA, TVG FAIL TO STRIKE A DEAL** As the 2009 racing season began yesterday, the signal from New York's Aqueduct Racetrack was available only to viewers of HorseRacing Television (HRTV), as officials at the New York Racing Association (NYRA) announced that it had failed to strike a simulcast agreement with the Television Games Network (TVG). "We are disappointed to announce that NYRA has been unable to reach a simulcast agreement for 2009 with TVG at this time," NYRA President and Chief Executive Officer Charles Hayward said in a release. "Regrettably, we are unable to send our signal to TVG and their contracted parties TVG-Yonkers and TRNI beginning today. We will continue to work diligently to finalize an agreement and hope to do so in the very near future. We sincerely regret the inconvenience to TVG's account wagering customers."

**CHURCHILL SIGNAL TO ADW PLATFORMS**  
Churchill Downs Incorporated (CDI) will be able to offer advance-deposit wagering on races at its flagship track after reaching an agreement with the Kentucky Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (KHBPA) and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association (KTA). The deal ends a dispute over revenue splits that prevented the track from offering its product on ADW platforms throughout 2008. The Churchill signal will be available on TwinSpires.com, CDI's ADW platform, and additional ADW companies during the track's Spring Meet, which runs Apr. 25-July 5, but terms for distribution to those companies have not yet been finalized. "We are pleased to have reached a mutually acceptable resolution with Kentucky horsemen on this issue," said Steve Sexton, executive vice president of CDI and president of Churchill Downs. "The real winners today are our customers, who finally will be able to enjoy access to Churchill Downs races when live racing resumes in the spring." Horsemen, seeking a larger share of the revenue from handle, had blocked the signal in 2008. "We are pleased to have reached a resolution," said the Rick Hiles, president of the KHBPA. "We believe the agreement will bring great benefits to our horsemen, and will promote Kentucky racing throughout the country."

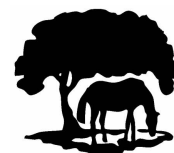

On the occasion of his official 10th birthday, **Bullish Luck** (Royal Academy--Wild Vintage, by Alysheba) took one final turn of the Sha Tin paddock as he enters retirement as the second all-time money earner in Hong

Kong history. Bred in Kentucky by Max and Isabel Morris, the bay was unsold as a Keeneland November weanling in 1999, then was a 50,000gns yearling at the 2000 Tattersalls October sale. He made eight starts in Europe racing as Al Moughazel for a pair of wins and two additional placings before his export to Hong Kong, where he gained a reputation as an

outstanding middle-distance horse with a lethal finishing kick. Bullish Luck won five times at the highest level, including back-to-back scores in the Champions Mile. His nose victory in the 2005 running came at the expense of legendary stablemate Silent Witness (Aus) (El Moxie), who came into the race undefeated in 17 career starts. Following his successful title defense, he was sent to Japan, where he defeated Japan's best milers in the G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo. Bullish Luck made four starts in the Hong Kong International Races, finishing an unlucky second by a nose to Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in the 2004 G1 Hong Kong Cup over 2000 meters. He made one start during his career over a dirt track and ran with credit in the 2006 G1 Dubai World Cup, staying on to be third behind U.S. Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg) (Candy Stripes) and Premium Tap (Pleasant Tap). He capped his career with a battling fifth, beaten just over four lengths by Eagle Mountain (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), in the 2008 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 14. "Bullish Luck was one of the most competitive horses ever," said Bill Nader, executive director of racing for the Hong Kong Jockey Club, told South China *Morning Post*. "To compete favourably against top class horses at his advanced age was absolutely remarkable. I'd like to congratulate trainer Tony Cruz and owner Wong Wing Keung for a horse that produced some of the greatest memories in Hong Kong history." Trained throughout his Hong Kong career by Tony Cruz, Bullish Luck retires with a record of 62-12-7-8 and earnings of \$7,851,461.
