## GEMSWICK PARK GLITTERS IN OLD HAT

Gemswick Park (Speightstown), sent off the 9-2 fourth choice in the field of seven, needed to produce her best effort to eke out a nose victory over favored **Elusive Heat** (Elusive Quality) in yesterday's GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream Park. Settled just behind Elusive Heat, who carved out crisp opening fractions of :22.17, :44.92, and :56.94, the Eugene Melnyk homebred made her move in the stretch and soon collared the even-money choice, who hung on gallantly along the inside. Meanwhile, 7-2 chance **Frolic's Dream** (Smoke Glacken) closed with authority from the outside, and while the three fillies ran gamely to the wire, it was Gemswick Park who out-gunned the pair for the win. *cont. p2*

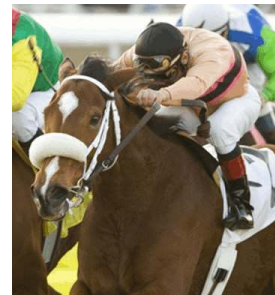

## TIZFIZ SIZZLES IN SAN GORGONIO

Frontrunner **Tizfiz** (Tiznow) made the most of modest early fractions to collect her first graded stakes victory in Sunday's GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita. Unhurried through early splits of :24.96, :50.27 and 1:14.54, the five-year-old bumped up her game another notch in deep stretch and bested **Marzeline (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) by a nose at the wire. **Solar Miss** (Malibu Moon), also near the front in the early going, hung on for third, beaten a half length. MGSW **Valbenny (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}), sent off the 2-1 choice, was at the back of the pack early and mounted a mild rally late to be fourth. Conditioned by Richard Mandella in 2007, Tizfiz managed to score going a mile over this turf course in October before tiring late to be fourth in stakes company at Hollywood while trying this distance a month later. Seventh in her 2008 debut in a 6 1/2-furlong sprint on the Polytrack at Del Mar Aug. 23, the Kentucky bred was claimed for \$50,000 in her next start after winning going a mile here Oct. 4. Runner-up to **Jibboom** (Mizzen Mast)--subsequent winner of Saturday's GIII Monrovia H.--in a Hollywood allowance Nov. 2, Tizfiz was all out to account for the **Queen O Green H.** at Turf Paradise Dec. 6. *cont. p2*

on all boosters for her next start and airing by 6 1/2 lengths going six panels in an off-the-turf event at Belmont Sept. 14. Third behind Sky Diva and Persistently in the mile GI Frizette S. Oct. 4, she showed good early speed, but had to settle for second in her latest

start in the GIII Tempted S. at Aqueduct Nov. 2. Given a brief breather for her return, the filly needed every ounce of reserve to collect her first graded stakes victory. "From the three-sixteenths pole on down it was a smooth one," said winning rider Johnny Velazquez. "I couldn't ask for more. I felt a little pressure but, like I said, she responded at the three-sixteenths and we were able to finish. Once we got going, I didn't have any problems. This horse has a bright future ahead." The filly is the second graded stakes winner for her sire Speightstown, who accounted for his third overall stakes winner Saturday when Haynesfield won the Count Fleet S. at Aqueduct. According to winning trainer Tom Albertrani, Gemswick Park will remain among the sprinting ranks for the time being, although he did not rule out a switch in surfaces for the upcoming season. "We tried to stretch her speed out a little farther than she probably really wants to go in the Frizette and Tempted," explained Albertrani. "I'm not sure what's next. **‘PIONEER’ WORKS BULLET AT SANTA ANITA**  
 GI CashCall Futurity winner **Pioneer of the Nile** (Empire Maker), partnered by Garrett Gomez, worked five furlongs in a bullet :58.40 at Santa Anita Sunday in preparation for the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at 1 1/16 miles Feb. 7. “He went a little faster than we wanted, but good horses will do that,” trainer Bob Baffert said. “It looked like he was galloping out there.” The winner of two of five starts, the Zayat Stable runner has amassed \$544,200 in earnings to date.

**NOT ON THE SAME PAGE TO FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**  
**Notonthesamepage** (Catienus), winner of Saturday’s Spectacular Bid S. at Gulfstream, is expected to make his next start in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 28, according to trainer Wesley Ward. “He’s doing great this morning,” said Ward. “I always like to give horses some time after a big run. That was a big run [Saturday]. The Fountain of Youth will be great for him at a mile.” Campaigned by Ken and Sarah Ramsey, the homebred, who suffered from respiratory bleeding last season, lost three straight stakes to close his juvenile campaign, including a last-place finish in the 1 1/16-mile GI Breeders’ Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 4. Having put those issues behind him Saturday, he rolled to an 8 1/4-length victory under jockey Elvis Trujillo in 1:08.48, missing the track record for six furlongs by .02 of a second. “I’d always thought of him as a really good sprinter,” said Ward, “But once he got those problems behind him, he’s just started training so well. The Fountain of Youth lets us stretch him out and see how far he wants to go.”

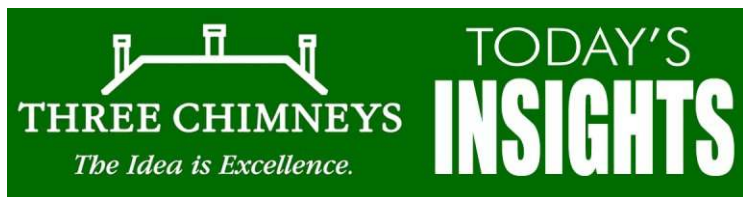

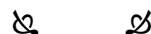
