## BIG THREE HEAD ECLIPSE FINALISTS

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA), in conjunction with the National Turf Writers' Association (NTWA) and *Daily Racing Form* (DRF), have announced the finalists for the 2008 Eclipse Awards, as voted on by members of each organization. The winners in each of the 11 Thoroughbred and five human categories will be announced at ceremonies to be held Monday, Jan. 26 at the Fountainebleu in Miami Beach. Stonestreet Stables LLC's, et al, **Curlin** (Smart Strike) took home a pair of statues at last year's awards, and is in line to add at least one more piece of hardware this year in the Older Male category. The reigning Horse of the Year, who closed his career with his lone off-the-board finish when

fourth to fellow Eclipse hopeful **Raven's Pass** (Elusive Quality) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, posted a trio of domestic Grade I wins in 2008, highlighted by his record-setting performance in the Jockey Club Gold Cup in late September. He also dismantled the competition in the G1 Dubai World Cup. IEAH Stables, Paul Pompa and Gary Tolchin's **Big Brown** (Boundary) joins Raven's Pass as a finalist for champion three-year-old and made his case with convincing wins in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. before losing his Triple Crown bid in the GI Belmont S. He added a victory in the GI Haskell Invitational S., becoming just one of two flat horses to post four wins at the highest level in 2008. **Good Night Shirt** (Concern) won five Grade Is over the jumps. The other flat horse to record four Grade I scores last season is Jerry and Ann Moss's **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}), who was undefeated in seven starts, capped by her success over **Cocoa Beach (Chi)** (Doneraile Court) in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie) and **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet) could join Curlin as repeat Eclipse winners. Though she failed to gain a spot in an intensely competitive three-year-old filly division, Indian Blessing rates a top chance in the female sprint category off her three Grade Is against her own age group. Midnight Lute made just two starts last term, but turned in another jaw-dropping performance to defend in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. ## THE CHOICE AGAIN AT MAGIC MILLIONS

Veteran owner Ron Croghan and astute trainer Kris Lees enjoyed a superlative spring with dual Group 1 winning sophomore Samantha Miss (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), and the pair wasted no time seeking another potential superstar when they secured lot 262, a son of the Danehill stallion, for a session-topping A\$620,000 Thursday at the Conrad Jupiters Magic Millions Yearling Sale. Out of the Warning (GB) mare Bal des Sirenes (Ire), the bay colt was offered by Craig Anderson's Amarina Farm. Lees saddled the youngster's 3/4-brother Britt's Best (Aus) (Danehill) to several stakes victories and over A\$500,000 in earnings.

"He was a very underrated horse, and he was a good, honest Group 3 horse," said Lees. "This horse is a better type as a yearling than what he was. He is a nice strong colt, athletic, well-balanced, and I thought he was one of the best colts of the sale." His third dam is Mill Princess (Ire) (Mill Reef), whose offspring include the likes of Last Tycoon (Ire). Craig Anderson said, "It was a good result; with the marked interest in the horse, we put a fair reserve on him and were hoping around that mark, maybe a little more." **Cont. p3**

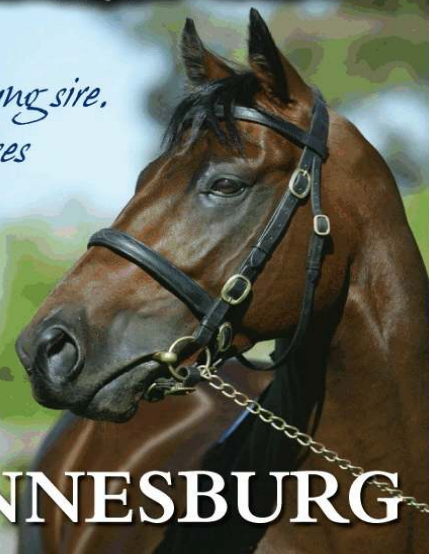

**No Doubt About It...**

The second-highest price of the day was the A\$600,000 given by Darley for lot 310, another Redoute's Choice colt. Baramul Stud offered the bay out of Cannyanna (Aus) (Canny Lad {Aus}). Darley's Trevor Lobb said the operation was delighted to be able to snare the youngster for what he considered to be a very reasonable price. "We thought he was one of the best colts of the sale," Lobb noted. "On the sale, he's great value. He's athletic, he's by a top stallion and is out of a great mare." Baramul owner Gerry Harvey was pleased enough with the result, but thought the market was fickle. "You're really selling them on pedigree a bit, but at the end of the day, if they are not the right type you can't get any money for them," said Harvey. "I've got Redoute's Choices that I can't sell, but if you get the right type--last year I got A\$2.2 million for one. This one, to my way of thinking, was every bit as good as those selling for one or two [million]." Harvey continued, "Given what we are seeing in markets around the world, I came in probably fearing things would be down anywhere from 25 to 45 percent. Obviously, the opening day sales were unbelievable. Things slowed down today; I know just from the horses I sold the prices are well down on where they have been. I had horses going for what I would have thought was 50 percent less than they may have sold for last year. But you have to look at the big picture, and when you take that into account, being down 15 to 20 percent is a much better result than what we first thought we might see."

Sydney-based bloodstock agent James Bester snared the top-priced filly of the day, a daughter of Danehill Dancer (Ire), for A\$550,000. Lot 238 is out of Ambers Halo (Aus) (Don't Say Halo), whose first foal, an Elvstroem (Aus) colt, was also purchased by Bester. "She's my filly of the sale," Bester said. "She's got good size, scope and strength. She's very athletic. She's got a good forearm and gaskin, a very good walk and length of hip." As expected, the sale average steadied during a day of brisk trade. The averaged declined to A\$137,650 compared to the A\$150,420 at the opening two sessions in 2008, but the clearance rate improved slightly from day one. "In recent years it has been very difficult to purchase quality fillies for less than A\$200,000, and I was very excited when I was able to purchase [for A\$100,000] a stunning filly by the champion sire Flying Spur (Aus) out of a Melbourne metropolitan winner. She will go to David Hayes."

"[Syndication company] Star Thoroughbreds secured a Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) for A\$60,000, and late in the sale a pass-in was picked up for A\$35,000, so you don't have to have a big roll of cash! You just have to have advisors who have done their homework. The papers are constantly telling us of the gloom and doom, but at the Gold Coast it certainly is anything but. The horses are here and so are the buyers, there are quite a few overseas buyers from Asia," --trainer Gai Waterhouse

"Last year was very expensive worldwide, so if the market is down 45-50 percent, it will put a lot more people in the market that normally can't afford a horse. Every year there are always new buyers coming into the industry. This year will be no different, especially if they think there are going to be some bargains. If you find one, let me know." -- Bart Cummings

"This is a buyers' market for sure. A few of the breeders are concerned about the depth of the buyers' bench, and I think those concerns are well-founded. The world economy is in a pretty perilous state, and that is inevitably having an impact." --trainer Anthony Cummings

A half-brother to MSW Kaphero (Aus) (Danzero {Aus}) and Princesa (Aus) (Danehill) as well as SP Keeneland (Aus) (Danehill) and Wasimah (Aus) (Danehill), this colt has been among the most popular on the sales grounds. He was the second-highest-priced weanling last year when knocked down for A\$630,000 as part of the Swettenham dispersal at Magic Millions

in June. "He is a magnificent colt and he is considered to be the best colt in the sale by many good judges," said Widden's Antony Thompson. Kapchat herself was purchased for A\$225,000 by Kieran Moore Bloodstock at the Inglis Broodmare sale last year, and her Danzero (Aus) filly fetched A\$240,000 at

the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. Swettenham Stud last year purchased a major interest in Kaphero (Aus) with a view to standing him at the Nagambie property in North East Victoria this spring. "We bred him from one of our most successful families," said Swettenham's Adam Sangster. "Swettenham Stud has purchased three quarters of Kaphero, while his longtime owners will retain the other quarter for his future stud duties." Kaphero, a A\$340,000 yearling at Magic Millions in 2005, is expected to target the G1 Lightning S. Jan. 31 for trainer Leon Corstens.

**531, f, Encosta de Lago (Aus)--Larrocha (Aus), by Danehill**  
*Consigned by Emerald Thoroughbreds*

Bill Benson's operation will offer this full sister to G2 Wakeful S. winner Rocha (Aus). She is out of Larrocha, heroine of the G1 SAJC Oaks and a full sister to G1 VRC Derby winner Blackfriars (Aus) and GSW Manton (Aus), as well as SWs Waterford Road (Aus) and Lions Gate (Aus). This youngster is a A\$680,000 pinhook from the Swettenham dispersal at Magic Millions last June, and her looks certainly match her page. Her second dam is G1SP and outstanding producer Kensington Gardens (Aus) (Grosvenor {NZ}). At the Inglis Broodmare Sale last year, Larrocha herself sold to Tom Magnier for A\$1.375 million. She has an Encosta de Lago filly at foot and was bred back to that Coolmore sire. The Guy Walter-trained Rocha was last seen finishing a gallant fifth to Samantha Miss (Aus) in the G1 VRC Oaks Nov. 6.

Last year, Merlene's More Than Ready colt, now named Feared, sold to Patinack for A\$325,000. "He is a beautiful, big, strong colt with tremendous presence," Coolmore's Peter O'Brien reported. "He has been well received. He is out of one of the best racemares in Australia, and we are extremely hopeful he will sell well."

shipped to Oaklawn Park for that track's GIII Southwest S. Feb. 16. As for Wednesday's move, the first of the new year for Old Fashioned, Jones told the *Form*, "He just stretched his legs. He went really nice."

## Big Drama On Track for Holy Bull...

Big Drama (Montbrook), who swept the Florida Stallion Stakes series at Calder, then ventured outside the Sunshine State to take the GIII Delta Jackpot S. Dec. 5, is being pointed towards the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 31. "He's been a distance twice and for right now we want to keep him at two turns," said trainer David Fawkes. "I'm going to keep him at home at Calder to train for the race, keep everything the same. [Eibar] Coa will ride him back." Owned and bred by Harold Queen, Big Drama has won five straight since finishing third in his July 12 bow at Calder.

"She was a great filly, both as a broodmare and a race horse. She rates up there with the top, the very best fillies I ever had. She was very difficult to train. She had a mind of her own. She wanted to do it her way. She would only go the wrong way (on the track to train). Even then, she'd stop. When she worked, you'd have to work her out of the gate, because she wouldn't do it otherwise. You could put her with five horses, and she would bolt and prop. She'd break off, but she was liable to make a right turn. It was very sad. It's like losing a kid. She was one of the greats of all time."

**Return of the King in Emotional Win:**

Yesterday's second race was not your ordinary \$40,000 claimer. The victory was of terrific significance to the family of James Ortega, a Thoroughbred owner and one of nine people murdered in what has become known as the Christmas Eve "Santa Claus

Massacre" in Covina, California, about 20 minutes east of Santa Anita. Always within striking distance beneath Martin Pedroza, the seven-year-old gelded son of Wolf Power (SAf) came running through the stretch and was up for a 3/4-length victory. "I feel like I just won a \$5-million race,"

the winning rider commented. "I've known the family for a long time. I wanted so much to win this race. It gave me chills." None of the Ortega family was on hand to witness the race. "It would be much too emotional for them to be here today," said trainer David Bernstein. A number of family friends were in attendance, however. Return of the King was the last horse in the stable of the late James Ortega, 52, and was left to his son, James Edward, in a trust. The chestnut will now be sold,

Bernstein said. Ortega was the brother of Sylvia Pardo, whose former husband, Bruce, stormed into the family home dressed as Santa Claus and shot nine people dead before turning the gun on himself.

**A WORD ABOUT BRIS SPEED RATINGS...**

**BRIS Speed Ratings** accurately represent how fast a horse has run. Like other popular speed ratings, BRIS Speed Ratings are based on the final time of the race and, most importantly, include an accurate "track variant" (which measures the speed of a racetrack on a specific day.) Unlike other speed indicators, the track variant is derived by an objective, computer-precise method rather than the subjective opinion of one handicapper. The highest BRIS Speed Ratings (110 and up) will usually only be achieved by the best stakes horses. And, of course, older horses will typically run faster than their younger counterparts. A 2-year-old might win a stakes race with a 95 BRIS Speed Rating or may become a champion with a rating over 100.
