LIFE IS SWEET IN EL ENCINO

Life is Sweet (Storm Cat), a full sister to champion juvenile filly Sweet Catomine, powered to the lead in upper stretch and put away favored **Country Star** (Empire Maker) at midstretch before drawing clear to a 2 1/2-length triumph in yesterday's GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita. Life is Sweet was allowed to settle off the

pace as longshot **Czechers** (Indian Charlie) cut out fractions of :23.16, :46.47 and 1:10.52. As the pacesetter began to tire, a swarm of challengers materialized. Country Star took a slim lead in upper stretch, but was soon overwhelmed by Life is Sweet, who took charge with author-

ity and drew clear to the wire. "I was back a little further than I wanted to be going to the first turn," explained winning rider Garrett Gomez. "Down the backside, my filly was off the bridle, nice and relaxed. At the half mile pole, I was looking for someone to follow, but it seemed like no one was moving forward. Going to the three eighths, I decided to follow [Jose] Valdivia [aboard Ginger Pop] and he was about five or six lengths in front of me. By the eighth pole, she had inhaled the whole field and she stayed on her left lead, so she's still learning. It's nice to know there's more left in the tank." **Cont. p2**

Game Face (Menifee) returned to the track and distance of her seven-length win in last year's GII Old Hat S., and came away with a confident 2 3/4-length triumph in yesterday's GIII First Lady S. at Gulfstream Park. The 7-5 favorite recovered from a slow start to stalk pacesetter **Any Limit** (Limit Out) through frac-

tions of :22.63, :45.69 and :57.90. She took charge in upper stretch and quickly put the result beyond question as she easily strode clear to complete the six furlongs in 1:10.57. "The field went off fast and I just stayed back waiting for my chance," explained winning jockey John Velazquez. "I let

them go because I knew sooner or later she was going to respond. She loves races like this--coming off the pace. When I really asked her to give me more around the turn, she did the rest." Winning trainer Todd Pletcher added, "We've been looking forward to running her in this race for some time. We knew from last year that she loves the track. I was a little concerned when she got pinched back a little at the break, but she was able to get clear on the outside and ran her race."

Life Finds Southern California Air Sweet

While racing in the East for trainer Bill Mott, Life is Sweet became a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ with a nine-length maiden win over the Belmont lawn in October 2007, but she had made just five starts since. She took a Gulfstream turf allowance last winter before a fourth-

place effort in the GI Ashland S. Back on the turf, she ran second in the Apr. 26 Calder Oaks and had not been seen since a runner-up effort in the May 31 GII Sands Point S. The Wygod homebred was making her first start for trainer John Shirreffs in the El Encino. "I think we got her a little after Pomona

[last September], I'm not sure," Shirreffs said. "She just had regular training. She's such a nice filly, she just really came around well. Marty [Wygod] wanted to try her out here, so he brought her out [from the East Coast]. Santa Anita has such a nice program for four-year-old fillies. The [Feb. 15 GII] La Canada would be next [if she's OK]." Sweet Catomine's first foal is a three-year-old filly by A.P. Indy named **Sweet Thoughts**. Sweet Thoughts has been working steadily at Hollywood Park for her debut. Sweet Catomine's A.P. Indy foal died in 2007 and she was barren in 2008. She was bred to Unbridled's Song last year.

After winning the Old Hat last January, Game Face was second behind Bsharpsonata (Pulpit) in the Mar. 2 GII Davona Dale S. before winning the May 3 GIII La Troienne S. at Churchill Downs. She went to the sidelines after running third in the GI Acorn S. in June and returned to take a Nov. 15 Churchill allowance last time out. "There wasn't anything specifically wrong with her when we stopped on her after the Acorn last year, but she had had a pretty steady campaign already by that time," trainer Todd Pletcher said of the long layoff. "Naturally, we're glad to have her back and we'll look at the next one [GIII Hurricane Bertie on Feb. 15]. I think this [sprinting] is her best game, and we'll look at races up to a mile for her."

PISTOL PETE PREPS FOR SUNSHINE CLASSIC

Jorge Periban will be looking to upset the field in next Saturday's Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park when he saddles **Pistol Pete Afleet** (Northern Afleet). Periban claimed the four-year-old last May, but the bay has yet to win a race for the Southern California-based trainer. "He hasn't won since I claimed him for \$80,000," Periban admitted. "But he's been close and he jumped the rail and got hurt when I claimed him. He needed a couple months to recover, but he's been doing well since." Most recently, Pistol Pete Afleet was seventh, beaten 4 1/2 lengths, in the Dec. 26 Gill Sir Beaufort S. "In his last race, he had a little trouble, but we're going to be OK," Periban continued. "I know he'll be a longshot in the Classic, but that doesn't bother me. I just need luck." Pistol Pete Afleet turned in a five-furlong work at Santa Anita Sunday in 1:00.40. A winner of two of 15 starts, Pistol Pete Afleet was second in last year's War Chant S. at Hollywood and in the Pomona Derby. Others possible for the Classic: **Macho Again** (Macho Uno), **Atoned** (Repent), **Delightful Kiss** (Kissin Kris), **Dry Martini** (Slew Gin Fizz), **Hey Byrn** (Put It Back) and **Palladio** (Lycius).

Einstein Works Towards Donn:

Einstein (Brz) (Spend a Buck) prepped for the Jan. 31 GI Donn H. with a five-furlong move at Gulfstream yesterday in 1:03. The six-year-old was sixth in last year's Donn. A multiple Grade I winner on turf, Einstein has been off since winning the GI Clark H. over the Churchill main track, but trainer Helen Pitts-Blasi knows her charge will be challenged over the Gulfstream dirt. "He loves Churchill Downs," she said. "He skips over that track. It's a different kind of surface [at Gulfstream]. It's sandier and deeper and he doesn't get over it as well." Pitts-Blasi is already impressed with all Einstein has accomplished. "He's six years old and still sound, thanks largely to running on the turf most of his life," she said. "Grass racing has been much easier on him. The win in the Clark already helps him as a stallion. He's proven himself and proven what he is: a sound, hard-running horse."

Karlsson to Ride at Gulfstream:

Inez Karlsson, a finalist for Eclipse champion apprentice rider, will escape from the sub-zero temperatures in Chicago and ride at Gulfstream Park until Hawthorne opens in March. "I didn't want to stay too long up there," Karlsson explained. "It was getting cold and it was time to get out of town." A 26-year-old native of Sweden, Inez was the leading apprentice by earnings in 2008. She knows she'll face tough competition at Gulfstream.

"I've got a long way to go, but if you're going to learn how to ride, this is the place to be," she commented. "These are the best riders in the world and it's a completely different ballgame down here. I know how tough this is. Some places I can go in a race and follow a guy on the inside when I know he's going to drift and open the rail. There are no guys like that here. That rail isn't going to open every time." **GPX report cont. p2**

SEBRING, STABLEMATES PREPARE FOR RE-

TURN S MG1SW **Sebring (Aus)** (More Than Ready) finished second in an 800-meter trial at his home track Jan. 16 to prepare for his final campaign. The winner of last year's G1 Golden Slipper S. and G1 AJC Sires' Produce S. quickly took the lead in the trial, but tired in the final 150 meters to finish second to Baci Amore (Aus) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who stopped the timer in :47.60. "Sebring got tired in the last 150 meters, but [jockey] Blake [Shinn] never knocked him about," said trainer Gai Waterhouse, who has the early favorite for this year's Glass Slipper in **More Joyous** (More Than Ready). "[Sebring is] bigger, more focused, and he definitely needed the trial," added Waterhouse, who said the chestnut will trial again Jan. 30. She and syndicate manager Antony Thompson will then map out autumn plans for the colt. The A\$130,000 Magic Millions yearling has been syndicated for A\$30 million and will stand at Widden Stud next spring. Sebring is part of a trio of Waterhouse trainees who are training towards a return to the races. The mare **Tuesday Joy (Aus)** (Carnegie {Ire}), unraced since her Melbourne Cup campaign was aborted when she bled from both nostrils in the G1 Turnbull S., also ran in the same trial as Sebring. Meanwhile, sophomore filly **Amelia's Dream** (Redoute's Choice {Aus})--whose 124 Timeform rating was highest among two-year-olds last season--is set to commence "light work." The 6 1/2-length winner of the 2008 G2 Silver Slipper S. has not competed since suffering a medial sesamoid fracture to her left foreleg. "The injury has been X-rayed and scanned at Randwick Equine Centre," Waterhouse said. "She passed all the tests and Dr Chris O'Sullivan said he could hardly detect the area of the injury as the recovery was so good."



RACE CLUBS MUST CHANGE DATES TO RECEIVE GOVERNMENT FUNDS The New South Wells government body Events NSW will provide A\$10 million to support the Sydney Autumn Carnival over the next four years, but on the condition that the city's principal clubs will move to fixed dates rather than having key races revolve around the Easter holiday. "Events NSW did a complete and independent assessment, and it was pivotal to any funding that there was a fixed format for dates," said the organization's Chief Executive Peter V'Landys. Easter Saturday has traditionally been Derby Day at Randwick, but the movement of the holiday has caused problems with a crowded calendar. In recent years, the Sydney carnival has conflicted with a similar event in Melbourne, which ends in March, and also with the early Brisbane winter carnival races. Norm Gillespie, chief executive for the Australian Jockey Club--which hosts racing at Randwick--was disappointed that the organization has been forced to relinquish many of its Easter race days. "We are supportive of our racing carnival gaining higher profile and delighted it is at last recognized as a signature event on the Sydney events calendar," Gillespie told the *Australian Associated Press*. "However, we believe it could have been achieved without losing the important link between Easter Saturday and Royal Randwick." The AJC will host Derby Day on Easter Saturday in 2010, but will have to wait until 2020 to host the race on that day again.

ROSTOVA, REAL SAGA EARLY FAVORITES

FOR BLUE DIAMOND **Rostova (Aus)** (Testa Rossa {Aus}) and **Real Saga (Aus)** (Tale of the Cat) have been installed as the A\$5 opening co-favorites for the G1 Blue Diamond S. Feb. 21 at Caulfield. Winner of the Listed Schiavello S. at Flemington, Rostova sold for A\$80,000--half the price tag trainer Steve Richards expected--at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale. "I went back and had another look, I thought I must have missed something," said Richards, who thinks Rostova might be the best horse he has "put a saddle on." Real Saga, trained by John Hawkes, won the Breeders' Plate Oct. 9, then returned to win a trial Jan. 9.
