**FULL FIELD SET FOR SM CLASSIC**

A full field of 12--with an additional three runners on the also-eligible list--have been drawn for Saturday's Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park. Sure to get some play come race day is Hobeau Farm's **Delightful Kiss** (Kissin Kris), runner-up in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs before coming home an easy winner most recently of the mile GIII Hal's Hope S. over the Hallandale oval Jan. 3. The versatile five-year-old, who started at on eight different tracks in as many starts last term, also proved adept on the synthetic surfaces, collecting victories in the 12-furlong GIII Turfway Park Fall Championship S. and GIII All American H. at Golden Gate. Calvin Borel gets the call. Also drawing a full field is the the six-furlong Filly & Mare Sprint, which has lured a pair of Grade I winners in **Mistical Plan** (Game Plan) and **Dearest Trickski** (Proudest Romeo). The former, who galloped to an easy victory in the GI Princess Rooney H. at Calder last July, tired late to be sixth after setting the early pace in her most recent start in the seven-furlong GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga Aug. 24, but should appreciate the drop back to six panels. Javier Castellano will be aboard the five-year-old for the first time Saturday. Dearest Trickski will try and defend her title in the race, which was contested at Santa Anita in 2008. The former claimer, who was purchased by Frank Stronach for \$650,000 at Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky November sale, scored in the GI La Brea S. in 2007 before adding graded wins in last year's GII A Gleam H. and GIII Rancho Bernardo H. The five-year-old mare will be accompanied by Rene Douglas this weekend. **Fields cont p2**

At four, Artiste Royal (Ire) closed out his European campaign with a score in the G3 Prix la Coupe at Longchamp before heading to the U.S. On the board in six of seven starts in graded stakes company stateside, including the GI Hollywood Turf Cup, the bay finally broke through with a Grade I win when winning the GI Clement L. Hirsch H. over this course and trip in October. Showing his usual consistency, he added a victory in the GI Charles Whittingham H. last June then came back after a layoff to be second in an 8 1/2-furlong allowance at Golden Gate Nov. 21. The Irish-bred closed out the year with an 11th in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 14. "He was boxed in. He never got to race, and when he got back to the stables, he didn't even drink a glass of water," explained trainer Neil Drysdale. "They never even gave him a bath." As for his thoughts on yesterday's race, Drysdale added, "I didn't expect him to be that far back. Garrett said he settled really well for him. That's where he found himself. He came home well. # The second coming...

Memories being short, I should perhaps remind you of Dehere's achievements. He owed his Eclipse Award to five wins from seven starts as a juvenile, when he became the first horse since 1916 to complete Saratoga's graded stakes treble of the GII Saratoga Special, GIII Sanford S. and GI Hopeful S. Another juvenile Group I victory came Dehere's way when he took the Champagne S. by four lengths.

Dehere went on to take the GII Fountain of Youth S. over 1 1/16 miles, to confirm his position as a leading contender for the Kentucky Derby. Although his Fountain of Youth opponents included Go For Gin and Holy Bull, Dehere was good enough to win despite stumbling out of the stalls and grabbing a quarter. Sadly Dehere's career was ended soon afterwards when he fractured his off-hind cannon bone during a workout....

After five seasons [at stud] in Kentucky, he was transferred to Japan for six seasons, starting in 2000.

In his excellent book, "Thoroughbred Stallions," Tony Morris had the following to say of the late, great Mr. Prospector:

"His stock come in all shapes and sizes, and they come with physical faults which most judges would regard as unacceptable in the progeny of any normal stallion. They are plain about the head, they have crooked legs--many, like their sire, turn their off-fore out--and they have small feet."

In the circumstances, breeders could be forgiven for having qualms about inbreeding to Mr. Prospector, but some were inevitably tempted to try to reinforce the influence of this remarkable stallion. After all, how many stallions achieve more than 15-percent stakes winners (especially after starting out in Florida, as Mr. Prospector did), and how many can boast an AEI of 3.99?

One of the first stallions to enjoy marked success with inbreeding to Mr. Prospector was his grandson Mr. Greeley. The first crop by this son of Gone West was headed by El Corredor, a Cigar Mile winner inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector. Then, three crops later, Mr. Greeley came up with the accomplished juvenile Whywhywhy, who is also inbred 3x4.

Interestingly, both these sons of Mr. Greeley are doing well enough to suggest they have a long-term future.

El Corredor has already matched Mr. Greeley's feat of siring a Grade I winner in each of his first three crops, in the process showing the versatility which is becoming essential in today's industry. The Hill 'n' Dale stallion first sprang to prominence as the sire of the high-class filly Adieu, who raced exclusively on traditional dirt.

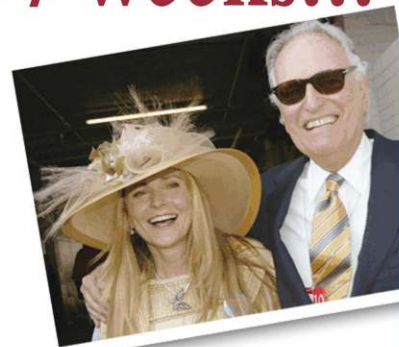

Next came Dominican, who shocked the future Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense in the Blue Grass S. on Polytrack. And then his third crop supplied that fine filly Backstreet Rhythm. Although Backstreet Rhythm handled dirt well enough to finish third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, she has since flourished on turf, notably taking the Garden City S.

Whywhywhy is also showing he can sire very good winners on all surfaces. His first big success came in the 2007 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, when Nownownow repelled the Irish raider Achill Island. Although Nownownow failed to win again on turf as a three-year-old, he looked very much at home on Santa Anita's Pro-Ride when he took the GII San Fernando S. three days ago. That San Fernando victory came just hours after Ikigai, another member of Whywhywhy's first crop, ran out an appropriate winner of the GIII Mr. Prospector S. on Gulfstream Park's traditional dirt track.

This versatility being shown by Mr. Greeley's stallion sons is hardly surprising, considering his own pedigree and achievements. With an American dirt horse as his sire and a brilliant European turf filly as his second dam, Mr. Greeley has an international pedigree and his eight Grade I winners divide equally between dirt and turf.

There was a time, of course, when Mr. Prospector's progeny had a reputation for being unsuited by European turf, but that theory eventually lost credence, thanks to the Group 1 victories of such as Kingmambo, Machiavellian, Distant View, Miswaki, Hello Gorgeous, Jade Robbery, Procida, Lycius, Ravinella, Ta Rib, Macoumba, Tera and Coup de Genie.

This extensive list, made up largely of French-trained horses, supports Tony Morris's suggestion (made well before all the evidence was in) that "it still seems that their feet do not take well to firm ground and undulating surfaces in England; they are happier on the constantly watered courses in France."

To return to Whywhywhy, it is interesting to look at the top-ranked males on the 2002 Experimental Free Handicap. The pecking order was as follows: Vindication was top with 126, followed by Toccet (124), Kafwain and Sky Mesa (both 122) and then Whywhywhy, Hold That Tiger and Icecoldbeeratreds (all on 119). However, it had been Whywhywhy who started favorite for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, on the strength of victories on the last three of his four appearances. Precocious enough to have made his debut in May, the Biancone trainee reeled off decisive victories in the GIII Flash S. over five furlongs, the GII Sanford S. over six and the GI Futurity S. over a mile. Unfortunately, Whywhywhy faded into 10th place in the Juvenile and his sophomore season also proved to be a distinct anti-climax.

Consequently Whywhywhy's fee was no higher than \$7,500 when he retired to stand alongside his sire for the 2004 season at Spendthrift. He has therefore done well to sire four stakes winners, including Nownownow and Ikigai, from a first crop of only 59 named foals. His second Spendthrift crop numbered only around 36 named foals, which will prove something of a handicap, and his third-crop juveniles, sired after Whywhywhy and Mr. Greeley were switched to Gainesway, also number fewer than 50.

However, his first yearlings were very well received in 2006, with several selling for more than \$200,000, and this translated into considerably increased demand for his services in 2007. He has more than 100 yearlings and is credited with covering 141 mares in 2008, after Nownownow's 2007 Breeders' Cup victory.

Whywhywhy's graded race double a month before the start of the 2009 season will surely guarantee him his third consecutive sizeable book, which is why I say he now appears to have a long-term future, even though his fee has rarely risen above \$7,500.

Nownownow has another link to Gainesway in that this colt's third dam, Riviere Enchantee, was a half-sister to Lypheor. This French Group 3 winner was sold to Japan after just one season at stud in Ireland, but that single Irish crop contained Tolomeo, winner of the 1983 Budweiser Million, and Royal Heroine, who lived up to her name in the 1984 Breeders' Cup Mile. Few stallions ever returned from Japan at that time, but Gainesway managed to return Lypheor to the West and he justified the move by siring several good winners before dying comparatively young.

Nownownow's second dam Aspalathus was also by a Gainesway stallion in Spruce Needles, a mile-and-a-half horse who acted on dirt and turf. The San Rafael winner's broodmare sire Exit To Nowhere--best known nowadays as a sire of jumpers in Europe--was a high-class miler. As Exit To Nowhere is a half-brother to Mr. Prospector's Group 1 winners Machiavellian and Coup de Genie, it is easy to see why one of his daughters would suit a stallion inbred to this great stallion. Ikigai, for his part, is inbred 4x5x4 to Mr Prospector.

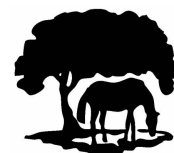
