BYE BYE BIRDIE

Edmund Gann's **It's a Bird** (Birdonthewire) rallied from just off the pace to pull off a mild upset in yesterday's Sunshine Millions Classic S.

With Julien Leparoux aboard, It's a Bird sat close in second as Finallymadeit (Concerto) set fractions of :23.78 and :48.08. The dark bay gained command entering the stretch and powered clear in the stretch to score by 5 1/4 lengths over Dry Martini (Slew Gin Fizz). "I wanted Julien on the lead or close to it," trainer Marty Wolfson commented. "He doesn't like dirt in his face. When I saw the :48 half-mile, I felt pretty good. I've only had him six months and he's been wonderful for me. I don't have any immediate plans for him."

"I thought it was a very good work," trainer John Ward Jr. said. "He came on well at the end of it and really galloped out strong. Calvin was happy with it. If he's happy with it, I'm happy with it." Beethoven, a \$300,000 KEESEP yearling, was last seen annexing Churchill's GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in November.

The Bird is the Word...

It's a Bird closed out his tenure for Todd Pletcher with a fourth-place finish in an Arlington optional claimer last June. Transferred to Marty Wolfson, It's a Bird went on a three-race winning streak at Calder, including the Plagiarize S. Sept. 20 and the Gill Spend a Buck H. Oct. 18. He disappointed with a fourth-place finish behind Finallymadeit (Concerto) and Dream Maestro (Concerto) in the Carl G. Rose Classic H.

Nov. 8, then rebounded to complete the exacta in the Gill Kenny Noe Jr. H. Dec. 13. He improved his position last time in the Gill Hal's Hope Jan. 3 to finish sixth, beaten 4 1/2 lengths. It's a Bird was ridden by Julien Leparoux for the first time in the Sunshine Millions Classic. "We got the perfect race," Leparoux said. "There was almost no traffic, so he followed the plan pretty good. He broke good. He gave extra at the quarter pole. All I did was try not to lose the No. 1 horse [Finallymadeit], because he got off good. We kept it nice for him and he did the rest. He got stronger as the race went on. I took a look to make sure I was clear, but I knew we were in good shape."

Wild Promises made it six in a row with another good looking performance here. The bay won four straight stakes in Northern California, including the Luther Burbank H. at Santa Rosa in July and the Miss America S. at Golden Gate in September. Trainer Greg Gilchrist shipped Wild Promises to South Florida for the GIII My Charmer H. at Calder Dec. 6, and she delivered a one-length wire-to-wire tally. The Harry Aleo colorbearer ventured back west following the score, and prepped for this with three breezes at Golden Gate before returning to the Sunshine State. Placed in a stalking third through a half mile in :47.70, Wild Promises took over from Elusive Lady in the stretch and drew clear late. "What can you say, she just tracked them," Gilchrist said. "The race set up perfectly. I knew she didn't have to have the lead. I figured somebody would get anxious and it worked out pretty good. She loves the grass. I don't know what's next; we'll figure something out."

Soldier's Dancer rallied from the back of the pack to be second to War Monger (War Chant) in last year's Sunshine Millions Turf at Gulfstream, and took the show to California this term to take care of some unfinished business. The gelding was coming off wins in the P.T.H.A. President's Cup S. and GIII Miami Mile H. when he lost his rider in the restricted Bonnie Heath Turf Cup H. at Calder Nov. 8. He was favored in the nine-furlong GIII Tropical Turf H. at Calder Dec. 6, but lost the bob on the wire when second, and was looking to get back to winning ways here. The gray was once again at the back of the pack as the front rank got to the half in :47 1/5. Soldier's Dancer and Rafael Bejarano didn't get going in earnest until the quarter pole, but came flying down the middle of the course and ran down the hard-trying Presious Passion. "I love this horse," enthused Steve Vivian, assistant to his father, winning trainer David Vivian. "My father will tell you, this horse wouldn't be the horse he is without me. Leah's Secret was coming off the best season of her career and got 2009 kicked off the right way. Winner of the GII Lexus Raven Run S. at three, Leah's Secret was hammered down to WinStar for \$525,000 as a racing prospect at the Fasig-Tipton November sale in 2007 and rewarded that operation with a trio of graded wins last term--in Arlington Park's GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. in June, Churchill's GII Chilukki S. Nov. 2 and Aqueduct's GII Top Flight H. Nov. 28. Looking for her third straight as the lone horse under 6-1 here, Leah's Secret stalked off the front rank. About five lengths off up the backstretch, she inched closer going into the turn, split rivals while rallying wide and showed her class down the lane.

The victory pushed her career earnings well past the million-dollar mark. "She brought her 'A' game today," assistant trainer Mike McCarthy said. "A mile and a sixteenth is probably as far as she wants to go. She had plenty left in the tank today. She'll stick around here and possibly run one more time [in the GI Santa Maria H. on Feb. 14]. The filly's obviously gotten very good here the last few months. The plan was for her to be bred, but I'm not sure. I think they put their heads together and decided if she keeps on doing as well as she's been doing to keep her around for a little while longer." Beltene was an unraced juvenile when La Canada Stables purchased her for \$30,000 at Barretts November. Two months later, she's an undefeated stakes winner of nearly \$165,000. Beltene debuted a winner facing \$40,000 state-bred maiden claimers at Hollywood Dec. 11. She stepped up to win a starter allowance over trip and track Jan. 10 and was again taking a big jump in class. The 10-1 outsider raced along in mid-pack, wheeled into the stretch six wide and gamely chased down Hooh Why. Explaining why he unveiled Beltene for a tag at first asking, winning trainer Jack Carava explained, "She hadn't trained all that well when we first got her. But she gave us encouragement after that, and she's kind of stepped forward every race from there." Winner of the GI Del Mar Futurity in his juvenile finale, Georgie Boy returned at three to add the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 10 and GII San Felipe S. Mar. 15, but found himself subsequently sidelined with a hind-end problem. The homebred was a rusty fourth as the favorite in the Damascus S. on the Breeders' Cup undercard at Santa Anita, then finished a solid third in the GI Malibu S. last out Dec. 26 going six panels over this surface. A bit further back than usual here as Machismo cut out splits of :21.79 and :44.34, the dark bay got a dream run up the inside in the lane and finished up strongly to add another big win to his trophy case. "He's a very exciting horse and he's very close to all of us," said winning trainer Kathy Walsh. "[Owner/breeder] Mr. Schwary has been very patient and he's being rewarded now. It's great to have an owner who sits right there and says, 'Go for it.' The horse was a little rank the first part of it, but Garrett was able to get him back where he needs to be. My help back at the barn deserve a lot of credit, too. We've got a fantastic bunch of guys, and they do a great job." High Resolve made it two straight Sunshine Millions wins for trainer Greg Gilchrist and the estate of Harry Aleo following the exploits of Wild Promises (Wild Event) in the F/M Turf (see p3). The **"TDN Rising Star"** began her career with five straight victories, including the 2007 Joe O'Farrell Juvenile Fillies S. at Calder, but was placed on sidelines following a win in the Princess S. at Bay Meadows last February. She resurfaced to finish third behind stablemate Victorina (Delaware Township) in a Bay Meadows Fair allowance in August, then rebounded to annex Stockton's Sweepida S. Sept. 13. Testing the waters in Southern California, High Resolve placed second in both the Cascapedia S. Oct. 26 and the Kalookan Queen H. last time Dec. 31. Taking advantage of her inside post here, the gray shot out to the lead from the rail, rattled off fractions of :22.08 and :45.22 and drew clear in the stretch. "I was confident," Gilchrist said. "Her last two races at Santa Anita are probably better than most people realize. She kept getting hooked on the lead. I knew [trainer] Bobby [Frankel] would probably try to press me a little more today with Lovely Isle, knowing it was a shorter distance. Dunkirk was bred in Kentucky by a partnership of Lane's End's Will Farish, James Elkins & W.T. Webber, Jr., and was sold through Lane's End's consignment when he topped the 2007 September sale.

"He really was a standout from the start," Farish said yesterday. "He was an outstanding individual--a big, grey colt with a lot of bone. He was the pick of our consignment and sold very well."

Farish's involvement with Dunkirk's family dates back to the 1980s, when he acquired both Miss Brio (Chi

(Semenenko), winner of the 1987 Chilean 1000 Guineas, and her dam Miss Eva (Arg) (*Con Brio II). Farish scored on both purchases. Brought to the U.S., Miss Brio won the GI Maskette S. and a pair of Californian

Grade II's, while Miss Eva produced the Alydar filly Private Status. Bred by Farish and racing for Farish, Elkins and Webber, Private Status banked nearly \$150,000 with a victory in Turfway's Bourbonette S. and a third to Inside Information in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland in 2004.

But Private Status's real value was as a broodmare. Her first foal was Secret Status, by Lane's End's A.P. Indy. Secret Status won the GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Mother Goose S. in 2000 and earned in excess of \$1 million. Private Status also produced MGSW and young sire Alumni Hall (A.P. Indy) and SW Private Gift (Unbridled). All three horses raced for Farish and partners. At the most recent renewal of the Fasig-Tipton November sale, Lane's End sold Private Gift to Mt. Brilliant Broodmares for \$2.3 million.


As a source of profitable sales horses, however, it has been Secret Status who has been nearly unmatched in recent years. Secret Status's second foal, the colt Objectivity (Storm Cat), was hammered down to John Ferguson for \$6.3 million at the 2005 September sale, two years before Dunkirk topped the event. Last September, Secret Status was represented by a Ghostzapper colt, named Grand Gift, who was purchased by Mark Stanley for \$350,000. Secret Status had a Dynaformer colt last spring who will likely sell at the 2009 September sale, and is due any day now carrying an Unbridled's Song full-sibling to Dunkirk. Farish said that breeding plans for the 2009 hadn't been set in stone, but added with a laugh, "Today's victory made the decision a little easier."

Farish and his partners own Code Book (Giant's Causeway), a six-year-old half-sister to Dunkirk who was bought back for \$450,000 at the 2008 Keeneland November sale while in foal to Smart Strike. Farish reports that she will likely visit Unbridled's Song in 2009, as well.

Talking about the Unbridled's Song--Secret Status mating that resulted in Dunkirk, Farish commented, "She's a big, stoutly made mare. It is interesting, because Unbridled's Song actually refined her. It was what you hope for when you make that sort of a mating. He did a great job with her, and we ended up with a great individual."

Farish said he was impressed both by Dunkirk's debut performance, and with Todd Pletcher's training job.

"The horse looked like he stumbled a little bit at the start and was blocked in behind horses, then to pull him out like that and have him accelerate the way he did was just what you always hope for," he said. "Todd's really done an outstanding job with him. He's really trimmed down and really looks racy. Back then, he was a big, attractive yearling. But he looks like a race horse." -LM
