## JOHNNY ON THE SPOT

**Johnny Eves** (Skimming) was eased after contesting an opening half in :44 flat in the Jan. 1 GIII El Conejo H., but he got away with splits of :22.23 and :45.03 in the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita yesterday, with much different results. The blaze-faced bay hugged the rail into the stretch and, with just a wave of the whip, held off **Devoted Magic** (Muqtarib) to score by 1 3/4 lengths. "He was traveling better today than the last time," said jockey Garrett Gomez. "He was in more of a comfort zone. He's very fast from the gate, but he really doesn't want to go :21, :44. To-day, the pace was better

for him." The winner of the GI Malibu S. in his sophomore finale, Johnny Eves rebounded from five consecutive off-the-board efforts to be second in the Oct. 5 Cal Cup Sprint. He capped off 2008 with a victory in the Nov. 22 GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood. Asked what's next, trainer Jay Robbins said, "We'll just relish this one." ## KARAKA PREMIER SALE BEGINS TODAY

New Zealand Bloodstock's National Yearling Sales Series gets underway today with the first session of the two-day Premier Sale in Karaka. Among the 24 stallions represented by their first crop of yearlings in the catalogue are Castledale (Ire), Dubawi (Ire), Oratorio (Ire), Starcraft (NZ), Storming Home (GB) and Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn). Pins (Aus) is the most well-represented sire in the catalogue, with 42 colts and 26 fillies on offer. From six crops to race, Pins has sired Group 1 winners El Segundo (NZ), Econsul (NZ), Legs (NZ) and Porotene Gem (NZ), as well as New Zealand's leading juvenile filly Katie Lee (Aus). His offerings at the Premier Sale include [hip 236](#), a filly out of a half-sister to stellar broodmare Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister). Encosta de Lago (Aus), leading sire by earnings in Australia last season, will be represented by 11 colts and three fillies in the Premier Sale. Included in the offering is [lot 7](#), a colt out of MG1SW Giovana (NZ) (Blues Traveller {Ire}). Redoute's Choice (Aus) has proven very popular in the sales ring, and the stallion will be represented by five colts and three fillies in Karaka. Among his offerings are [hip 85](#), a son of GSW La Sizeranne (NZ) (Stravinsky). A total of 23 Group 1-winning dams have progeny in the sale, as well 42 siblings of Group 1 winners. Bidding begins at 11 a.m. The sales series continues with the three-day Select Sale, which begins Wednesday, and concludes with the Feb. 1-2 Festival Sale. The sale will be streamed live on [www.nzb.co.nz](http://www.nzb.co.nz).

The chestnut picked up checks in her first three starts of 2008, then got up to take the Apr. 19 GII Santa Barbara H. by a nose. On vacation for a couple of months after that score, she was through for the year after running sixth in the June 29 GII Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood and fourth in the Aug. 3 GI John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar. Foxysox made her return in an allowance at Santa Anita Jan. 1 and was sixth behind Charming Legacy, but beaten just 1 3/4 lengths. Rated off the pace as that rival took them along through fractions of :24.02, :48.10 and 1:12.12, the British-bred hit the gas when they straightened for home and ran down Gotta Have Her for the narrow score. In more recent times, the gray was runner-up in a pair of \$75,000 optional claiming events at the Big A last fall, including his seasonal finale Nov. 22. **New York Handicapper takes DRF/NTRA Contest:**

John Conte, 68, of Oceanside, New York, captured the 10th annual \$1-million *Daily Racing Form*/National Thoroughbred Racing Association National Handicapping Championship, held Friday and Saturday at the Red Rock Casino in Las Vegas. Conte, a former handicapper for the *New York Post*, was in 11th place going into the final race, the off-the-turf 11th at Santa Anita Saturday, but was the only contestant to wager on the winner, 22-1 shot Raiding Party. His final tally was \$228, earning him the first-place prize of \$500,000. "I looked at Raiding Party and decided to go for it," Conte said. "I've been an 'all-in' guy my whole life. She ran on Polytrack at a cheap track in Britain and showed speed, and won two of her three starts. I don't know if everyone overlooked the horse, or they didn't have the guts to play it. She probably didn't have a chance on turf, but the racing gods took it off the turf." He added, "If I win five more of these contests, I might be even!" Dennis Decauwer of Rancho Cucamonga, California, was second with \$221.50 to take home \$150,000, and Paul Sherman of Dix Hills, New York, was third with \$219, getting \$100,000.
