## 'KIP' SKIPS TO VICTORY AT GULFSTREAM

In a race that boasted three Grade I winners, including a pair of GI Breeders' Cup Turf champions, it was IEAH Stables' **Kip Deville** (Kipling) who got the job

done, collecting his fourth Grade I victory in the Gulfstream Park Turf H. Sunday. Breaking from the eight hole, the grey out-gunned **Pick Six** (Dynaformer) to take the lead heading into the first turn. Comfortably in front through splits of :24.22, :47.44 and 1:11.21, the Oklahoma-bred maintained a solid advantage

turning for home, but had to work at it late to hold off closer **Just As Well** (A.P. Indy) at the wire. **Court Vision** (Gulch), also representing IEAH, came from off the pace to place himself within striking position at the head of the stretch, but failed to sustain the bid and had to settle for third. "I knew going in we had plenty in the tank, so I just tried to relax him from the start and settle him in before asking him," said winning rider Cornelio Velasquez. Despite not having visited the winner's circle in almost a year, 13-1 shot **Lady Carlock** (Chester House), who camped out at the back of the pack early, over-

came pedestrian early splits to get up in the final strides for a head victory over **Mushka** (Empire Maker) in Sunday's GIII Suwannee River S. at Gulfstream Park. **Drop a Line** (Lemon Drop Kid) was 1 1/4 lengths back in third. "It was a slow pace, but my horse was still able to make her run," said winning jockey Jermaine Bridgmohan. Despite a jockey's objection lodged by Julien Lejaroux aboard **Long Approach** (Broad Brush), Lady Carlock remained in the top spot. "I

think [Mushka] came out more than I came in," explained Bridgmohan. "I didn't think it was my fault, and I was glad they left her up. She ran a fantastic race. **Kip Deville** was purchased by IEAH Stables in the spring of 2006 and finished second in his first start for those connections in the Colonial Turf Cup. Winner of the GIII Sir Beaufort S. that season, the grey added wins the following year in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H., GII Maker's Mark Mile and GI Breeders' Cup Mile. With only five starts in 2008, Kip Deville kicked off the campaign with a repeat win in the Apr. 11 GI Maker's Mark S. at Keeneland before landing the GIII Poker H. at Belmont July 13. Fifth over a yielding turf course in the GI Woodbine Mile Sept. 7, he ran a winning race, but found the European filly Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) too good in the BC Mile at Santa Anita Oct. 25. Sent to Hong Kong for his latest start in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 14, the six-year-old failed to fire and had to settle for ninth, beaten 6 1/2 lengths. As for what's next for the handsome grey, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said, "We'll see how the Dubai race [\$5-million G1 Dubai Duty Free, Mar. 28] shapes up. If he looks good in there, we'd just about have to go for that money. If not, we'll go back to Keeneland for the (GI Maker's Mark S.), which he's won twice before."

**PIONEEROF THE NILE 'READY' FOR LEWIS**

**Pioneerof the Nile** (Empire Maker) completed five furlongs in a sharp :59.40 at Santa Anita Sunday in preparation for Saturday's GII Robert B. Lewis S. Jockey Garrett Gomez was aboard. "We're still pretty far out [from the May 2 Kentucky Derby], so right now, we just want to maintain a level of fitness and conditioning," trainer Bob Baffert. "He's already punched his

ticket to the Derby. He's made enough [graded] money, so I don't have to worry about that. There's no urgency, so it's good that I can run him when he's ready. He looks great right now." Campaigned by Zayat Stables, the dark bay won his most recent start, the 1 1/16-mile GI CashCall Futurity S. over Hollywood's CushionTrack Dec. 20. "A mile and a sixteenth is not his best distance," said Baffert. "Once he goes further, a mile and an eighth, he's going to be a better horse. He's growing up, he looks good, and I think he's relaxing more. He'll change a lot between now and May." Looking down the road, Baffert added, "Physically, he's still a little immature. He's a late foal, but I can see a difference in him now. He's really maturing in his mind. You can't worry about how far he'll run based on his breeding. The important thing is, he handles everything well. He's got a pretty good foundation, and that's what you want: a foundation."

Lady Carlock, a close second against allowance foes over this course and trip last March, was a well-beaten seventh in the GIII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill May 3 before closing to be a much-improved third in the nine-furlong GIII Arlington Matron H. on the Polytrack May 26. Back on the turf for her next start, the bay was second in an \$80,000 optional claimer at the Louisville oval in June. She once again used her late-running style to be fourth in the restricted one-mile De LaRose S. at Saratoga July 30, and was only a half-length back in second over that course and trip in the Aug. 21 Old Red S. Favored in her latest, the mare was second while stretching back to nine panels against optional claiming company at Churchill Nov. 21 and she scored at that trip in her 2009 debut.

"He lost by exactly the amount of lengths you would expect when you start from the outside post [10], while giving up weight to the winner [Saratoga Sinner; eight pounds]. It was a learning experience. Considering that, I'd have to say I'm satisfied with his performance." Owned by John Oxley, the bay won

both starts last term, including the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 29. "I have no desire to take him out of town," said Ward, in regards to the colt's next start. "The main thing I want to see will be my horses' muscle development. I've built up his stamina. Now, I need to put more muscle on him and I need to see if I can do that through training, or if I have to go in another race before the [GI] Florida Derby [Mar. 28]."

‘COUTURIER’ GEARING UP FOR 2009 BOW

**Grand Couturier (GB)** (Grand Lodge), scheduled to work on Gulfstream’s turf course Sunday morning, bypassed the exercise while trainer Bob Ribaudo waits to catch a wet course at the South Florida oval.

The six-year-old, who was a candidate for an Eclipse Award in the older turf male division, is scheduled to make his seasonal debut in the Feb. 21 GI MacDiarmida S. “This is the first time in the last couple of years he’s been doing this good, this early in the year,” said Ribaudo. “It’s a long year, and we want to get him cranked up for the summer and fall, but he’s just doing so well, we wanted to get him started.” According to Ribaudo,

the winner of last year’s GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. and GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic will work on the dirt today due to the lack of rain in South Florida recently. The horse finished 11th in his most recent start in the GI Breeders’ Cup Turf Oct. 25. “I want to wait on some rain before putting him out there [on the grass],” he explained. “It’s been so dry that I want to keep training on the dirt until we can get a couple days of some nice rain. He runs well on any type of ground, but I don’t want to train over it until it softens a little bit.”
