## MAGNUM COMES UP BIG IN SAN ANTONIO

WinStar Farm's **Well Armed** (Tiznow) had it all his own way up front, but it was the 16-1 outsider **Magnum (Arg)** (El Compinche {Arg}) who did all the running down the lane in yesterday's GII San Antonio H. at Santa Anita, sweeping past the pacesetter to win going away by a length. Breaking from post 10, Well Armed clicked off fractions of :25 1/5, :49 2/5 and 1:13 4/5 while leading by daylight. He turned for home well clear, but Magnum, who tracked in second about five lengths off up the backstretch, closed powerfully and took command a sixteenth out. It was Magnum's first win since May of 2006. Favored **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap) was third. Winning jockey Joel Rosario said that he was confident despite the slow pace. "I could see the horse on the lead was going easy, but my horse was comfortable and I knew I had a lot of horse," he said. "I went after him [Well Armed] at the five-sixteenths pole, and he ran great. He's got a long stride and I think he'll love a mile and a quarter." Rosario was referring to the 10 furlongs of the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 7, Magnum's next stop. **Cont. p2**

## FRANKEL COOL ON SA DERBY TRY

After watching her last-to-first victory Saturday, the connections of GI Las Virgenes S. heroine **Stardom Bound** (Tapit) said that the reigning champion juvenile filly would likely be pointed toward a tilt against males in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 4. That would set up a clash with West Coast star **Pioneerof the Nile** (Empire Maker), also a winner on Saturday's card in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Following the Las Virgenes, Mike Iavarone of IEAH Stable, owner of Stardom Bound, said that he didn't know what else the filly had to prove against girls and added, "I don't see why she wouldn't go on [and face the boys in the Santa Anita Derby]." But on Sunday morning, Stardom Bound's conditioner Bobby Frankel seemed less enthusiastic about the idea of competing against males. "I don't know," Frankel said. "Cooler heads will prevail. I don't know. It's their horse." Trainer Bob Baffert, meanwhile, said that Pioneerof the Nile could have another start before the Santa Anita Derby, possibly in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 14. "We'll let the horse tell us," Baffert said. "The San Felipe could be next, but definitely the Santa Anita Derby if all goes well."

**Magnum Heads Back to Big 'Cap...**

Three years ago, **Magnum** put up a career effort to run Lava Man to 3/4 lengths in the 2006 renewal of the GI Santa Anita H. Next month, he'll get a chance to do

one better. A return trip to the Big 'Cap would represent a huge come back for the eight-year-old gelding, who missed the entirety of the 2007 season with injury. He returned from a 17-month absence in Southern California last spring, but could

do no better than fourth in his first three tries and beat home just one in the GII San Deigo H. last July. Sidelined again after that race, Magnum showed a glimmer of his old form when he ran third, beaten 1 3/4 lengths, to Cowboy Cal (Giant's Causeway) at 77-1 odds in the GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita Jan. 10.

Magnum was back on the Pro-Ride yesterday, and came through with the second graded win of his career. "It sure looked like he liked this race track," said winning trainer Darrell Vienna. "He was traveling so easily. He was just in the right spot.

Joel did a beautiful job. I thought we'd be fairly close, not exactly second, but I didn't think he'd be too far back. The kid rode him perfectly. He's a nice rider, anyway. He was in a perfect spot. When you have a horse that's a longer price, sometimes you take the wrong chances. He didn't do that. He rode him like he was on the favorite. It sure looks like he'll go on to the Big 'Cap, but you never know what's in store." Vienna explained that Magnum had been gelded a few

months before the San Pasqual in order to alleviate a complicated problem caused by an undescended testicle. "The only chance we had for him to continue running was to geld him, or to stop [racing him], because it was hurting him too much." **No Excuses...**

Eoin Harty, trainer of **Well Armed**, offered no excuses for his charge. "He just got beat," Harty said. John Shirreffs said after the race that he was happy with the effort of post-time favorite **Tiago**, who was making his five-year-old debut and his first start since running third to Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last fall. "I thought he ran great," said Shirreffs. "He made a nice run at the end and he should move forward from that." Tiago will also head for the Big 'Cap; the Moss homebred ran fourth to Heatseeker (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) in the race a year ago.

## Friesan Fire Highlights Big Day for Jones Barn...

It was a big day for the Larry Jones barn at Fair Grounds on Saturday. Vinery Stable and Fox Hill Farms' **Friesan Fire** (A.P. Indy) established himself as a prominent contender on the Kentucky Derby trail with a smart victory in the GIII Risen Star S., while Fox Hill Farms' five-year-old **Honest Man** (Unbridled's Song) was a 4 1/4-length winner of the GIII Mineshaft H. Both of the barn's winners came out of the Louisiana Derby Preview Day program in good order. "We're very proud of both of them," said Cindy Jones, wife of the trainer, Sunday morning. Friesan Fire will be one of the favorites for Fair Grounds' centerpiece race, the \$600,000 GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 14.

## Sam F. Davis Probables Put in Final Works...

Some of the probable contenders for Saturday's GIII Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay posted their final works over the weekend. On Saturday, the undefeated **Musket Man** (Yonaguska), winner of Tampa's Pasco S. Jan. 17, drilled five furlongs in 1:00 flat for trainer Derek Ryan. GII Remsen S. runner-up **Atomic Rain** (Smart Strike) also worked Saturday, clocking four furlongs in :49.08 over the Oldsmar oval, while **A. P. Cardinal** (A.P. Indy) worked four furlongs at Palm Meadows in :49.85. **Free Country** (Big Country), who beat Atomic Rain in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 8, traveled five furlongs in 1:02 1/5 at Gulfstream Saturday.

## 'Pegasus' Possible for Louisiana Derby...

A day after saddling **Flying Pegasus** (Fusaichi Pegasus) to a runner-up finish in Saturday's GIII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, trainer Ralph Nicks was in high spirits as he accepted congratulations from Fair Grounds' assistant racing secretary Jon Anthony Martin. "If you hadn't thrown me on the outside like that [referring to Flying Pegasus' draw of post 12 in the 13-horse field], we might have won the whole thing," Nicks said with a wink at Martin. Flying Pegasus was making his first start since completing the exacta under Charitable Man (Lemon Drop Kid) in the GII Futurity S. at Belmont last Sept. 13 and could go next in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 14. "We'll let him tell us that," said Nicks. "We'll see what he says after a few days. That's one of the plans. He came back good."

## Block's Horse Blocked Again...

Virginia Tarra Trust's **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway), post-time favorite for Saturday's Grade III Risen Star S., closed belatedly to get up for fifth after multiple traffic problems. "It appears he came out of the race all right," trainer Chris Block related by telephone Sunday morning. "But he had a nightmare trip yesterday. It was just what I was afraid of with a big field like that." Giant Oak, who was forced five wide around the field in his previous start when second to Beethoven (Sky Mesa) in Churchill's GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. last Nov. 29, encountered more serious traffic problems Saturday. "We were just building momentum when they started coming back to us yesterday," Block said. "That's when we started having trouble. We ran into a logjam. It was frustrating. I don't feel bad for myself. I feel bad for the horse. But I'm proud of him. He finally got to run at about the eighth pole or maybe inside of that, but he closed very well after that." Block said he was unsure about returning to Fair Grounds for a tilt at the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 14. "I don't know right now," he said. "I love the surface here, but it's a narrow track, and with another large field we might run into the same kinds of problems. If there's a smaller field likely for the Louisiana Derby, it would help us make a decision to come back. I want to run right here."

Luckily, Mr. Scharbauer has the other horse [Oaklawn's GIII Southwest S.-bound Silver City (Unbridled's Song)] to keep his hopes alive this spring."

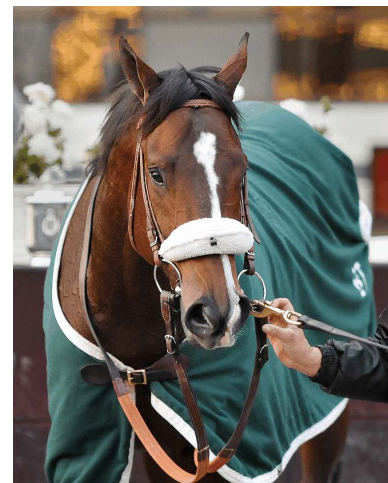

**'EKATI' TUNES UP FOR RICHTER SCALE**

Charles Fipke's **Tale of Ekati** (Tale of the Cat) turned the screws in advance of his 2009 debut with a five-furlong drill Sunday morning at Gulfstream Park. The four-year-old, who is scheduled to race in Saturday's seven-furlong GII Richter Scale S. at Gulfstream, stopped the clock in 1:00 3/5. Trained by Barclay Tagg, Tale of Ekati has been on vacation since being placed first via disqualification in the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 29.

Tale of Ekati will be the second major star from Tagg's barn to make his seasonal debut at Gulfstream at seven furlong this year. Elizabeth Valando's three-year-old colt **Hello Broadway** (Broken Vow) finished second in the GII Hutcheson S. Jan. 29. While the distances may be the same, the expectations for both are different.

"With Hello Broadway, we were hoping he would settle off the pace more than he did," said Tagg. "There's a progression we want to build him up to. With Tale of Ekati, I expect they might run away from him early in that race, but he will close. I have less to worry about with him because he's experienced." Tale of Ekati won the GI Wood Memorial last spring and was put up over Harlem Rocker (Macho Uno) in the Cigar.

**COUNTRY STAR TO SANTA MARIA** Darley Stable's **Country Star** (Empire Maker) will run in Saturday's \$300,000 GI Santa Maria H. at 1 1/16 miles, and not the \$200,000 GII La Canada S. at 1 1/8 miles on Sunday, confirmed trainer Bobby Frankel. The four-year-old was nominated to both races. Country Star was second as the 6-5 favorite in her 2009 debut, behind **Life Is Sweet** (Storm Cat) in the GII El Encino S.

Jan. 18. It was Country Star's first race since winning an optional claimer at Saratoga last Aug. 18.

"I would think so," Frankel answered when asked if he felt Country Star would benefit from her first start in five months. "I thought she was a little close to a quick pace the other day."

Country Star stalked in third place past the half-mile marker in the 1 1/16-mile El Encino, took a short lead into the stretch, but was outfinished by Life Is Sweet through the lane. Country Star won the GI Alcibiades S. and the GI Hollywood Starlet as a juvenile in 2007.

Also probable for the Santa Maria are **Santa Teresita** (Lemon Drop Kid) and **Visit (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}). Probable for the La Canada are Life Is Sweet and **Miss Singhsix (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}). Miss Singhsix worked six furlongs at Santa Anita Sunday in 1:14 for Paddy Gallagher.

**'STYLE' MAKES COMEBACK THURSDAY**

Glenn Bromagen's **Wicked Style** (Macho Uno), winner of the 2007 renewal of the GI Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland, will make his first start in nearly seven months this Thursday at Gulfstream. The four-year-old hasn't raced since finishing sixth in an Arlington Park allowance last July.

Wicked Style was undefeated when he beat Slew's Tiznow (Tiznow) in the Futurity, but he emerged from a 41-length drubbing in War Pass's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile that year with a condylar fracture in his front leg that kept him on the shelf for seven months. He returned at three to be fifth as the favorite in a grassy Churchill allowance in May, was fifth again in the GII Jefferson Cup in June, then missed the board for the third straight time at Arlington.

"When we got him back, he didn't come with the races we expected from him," explained trainer Rusty Arnold. "We sent him to Dr. [Larry] Bramlage, and he found a stress fracture in his other leg. It was one of those days where you're actually kind of glad to hear there was something, because the other option was that he wasn't going to get back to what he was before the injury.

"We gave him the time to get over that," he said. "Doc described it as something that wouldn't show up right away, but it was bugging him when he ran and it would have eventually given him problems. We could have given him 90 days, but instead I just said take the year. We've lost it anyway. Now we've got him back and we're ready to go."

Wicked Style has drawn the five hole in Thursday's fifth race, a one-mile \$100,000 optional claimer on the main track. 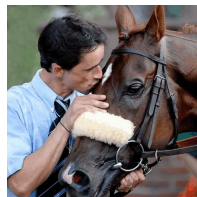

**SECOND YEAR OF DECLINES FOR INGLIS**

**SESSION 1** The Inglis Classic Yearling Sale opened with a 13.4-percent decline in average, outperforming other auctions in year-to-year comparisons, but falling further from the record levels attained in 2007. Session 1, which had its start pushed back to 4:30 p.m. from 11:00 a.m. because of a heatwave that has struck southern Australia, saw 83 yearlings sold for a total of A\$2,104,500. The average of A\$25,355 compared fairly to the first-session mark of A\$29,602 at last year's sale, which was delayed until late April as a result of the equine influenza outbreak. This year's figure, however, remained far from the 2007 day-one average of A\$43,926. "In percentage terms, it's ahead of other sales we've seen so far this year, and the buyers are very happy with the value they are getting from this sale, which continually yields results on the track," said Inglis Managing Director Mark Webster. The session was led by lot [102](#), a Flying Spur (Aus)--Cloudwing (Aus) colt who went to Patinack Farm for A\$80,000. Out of a winning Lujain mare, the colt was consigned by Widden Stud. The clearance rate of 77.6 percent was a slight decline from last year's day-one level of 81.5 percent. Hips 121-397 will be offered Monday, while lots 398-607 will go through the ring Tuesday on the final day of the sale.
