VINEYARD HAVEN TOPS UAE GUINEAS FIELD

Unraced since taking the Oct. 4 GI Champagne S. at Belmont Park, **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Arg}) is one of three Godolphin horses entered in Thursday's

G3 UAE 2000 Guineas at Nad Al Sheba. The Florida-bred was acquired by Godolphin following his Champagne score. After starting his career with a maiden win at Calder, he was purchased privately by trainer Bobby Frankel. Vineyard Haven suffered his only loss when third behind stablemate **Desert Party** (Street Cry

{Ire}) in the GIII Sanford S. at Saratoga in July, but turned the tables when taking the Sept. 1 GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S., where Desert Party finished sixth. Desert Party kicked off his UAE campaign with a win in a seven-furlong conditions event Jan. 22. The two will renew rivalries in the 1600-meter UAE Guineas, which has drawn a field of 12 three-year-olds. Also slated to sport Godolphin blue in the race is **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor), runner-up behind Desert Party last month. Another UAE 2000 Guineas hopeful boasting a three-for-four record is **Naval Officer** (Tale of the Cat). The bay captured his first two career starts, then was second in the G3 Prix des Chenes. He capped off his French campaign with a win in the Oct. 19 G3 Prix de Conde, and makes his UAE bow for Prince Sultan Mohammed Saud Al Kabeer and trainer Jerry Barton.

Body Soguero (Arg) (Body Glove {Arg}) returned to his best form after two disappointing efforts to score a redeeming victory in the G1 Gran Premio Miguel Alfredo Martinez De Hozat San Isidro Saturday. The classy

four-year-old bay colt finished strongest in the stretch to post a 3/4-length victory over late-closing group winner **Ibope** (Arg) (Lode) and Kentucky-bred **Al Kadir** (Aljabr), who

was making his first start since finishing seventh in the G1 Carlos Pellegrini nearly two months ago. **Cont. p4**

As a wholehearted admirer of the World Thoroughbred Rankings concept, I wonder how long it will be before the international panel of handicappers start to publish their two-year-old ratings?

Of course, compiling an international table for two-year-olds is no easy task, in view of the limited evidence available and the different racing surfaces involved. However, all the main racing areas issue individual two-year-old Free Handicaps, so all that remains to be done is to decide how the standard of each country's form compares with the others.

Looking at the European, American and Japanese figures for last year's juveniles, it looks as though the best European two-year-old colt, **Mastercraftsman** (Danhill Dancer {Ire}), was considered slightly superior to his American counterpart, **Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song). Of the colts that were weighted on both the European and the Experimental lists, **Square Eddie** was ranked six pounds below **Mastercraftsman**, but only three pounds below **Midshipman**; **Donativum** was ranked seven pounds below **Mastercraftsman**, but six pounds below **Midshipman**; and **Westphalia** was considered eight pounds inferior to **Mastercraftsman**, but only seven pounds below **Midshipman**. **Cont. p2**

As the horses on the three- and four-year-old Japanese classifications appear on exactly the same marks as in the World Thoroughbred Rankings, I think it is safe to assume that the Japanese two-year-olds can be slotted into the European rankings at the same level. This would put Logi Universe (Neo Universe {Jpn}) and Seiun Wonder (Grass Wonder) in at 112, 10 pounds below

Mastercraftsman, with Fifth Petal (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) on 111 and Smart Strike's son Break Run Out on 110.

Break Run Out owed his rating to his close third behind Seiun Wonder and First Petal in the G1 Asahi Hai Futurity last December. This Shadai-bred colt had started favorite on that occasion, and he went a long way to restoring his reputation two days ago, when he recorded a clear-cut victory over a field which included colts rated 105, 104 and 103.

With Square Eddie, Break Run Out and the GII Robert B. Lewis S. runner-up Papa Clem to his credit, it looks as though Smart Strike is destined to have another good year with his three-year-olds. You could be forgiven for thinking that every crop by a stallion who currently commands a fee of \$125,000 should be good, but Smart Strike's fee was still no higher than \$35,000 when his 2006 crop was conceived. It was only in 2008, after Curlin's Horse of the Year exploits and English Channel's turf championship, that his fee finally reached six figures.

There is an interesting link between Curlin and Break Run Out. Whereas Curlin is one of four stakes winners among Smart Strike's 26 foals out of Deputy Minister mares, Break Run Out is out of Queue, a Grade II-winning granddaughter of Deputy Minister.

Those four stakes winners out of Deputy Minister mares also include the Grade II winner Tenpins and the Grade III turf winner Super Freaky, and Smart Stike also sired the champion Canadian filly Eye of the Sphynx from a mare by Deputy Minister's sire Vice Regent. Smart N Classy, another Grade III turf winner, is out of a mare by another son of Vice Regent, so Lane's End's champion sire has been very well served by mares from this line.

Break Run Out's dam Queue was already in foal to Smart Strike when she was offered for sale at Keeneland's 2005 November Sale.

Remarkably, Nobou Tsunoda was able to buy this eight-year-old Grade II winner for no more than \$180,000. It's hard to guess why she attracted comparatively little interest in a year when 16 broodmares sold for \$2 million or more.

The problem certainly can't have been with her Smart Strike covering, as the stallion was heading towards his third consecutive top-10 finish on the sires' list. Perhaps would-be buyers didn't like the fact that Queue had gained six of her seven successes on turf, or that her best win, in the GII Long Island H., had come over a mile and a half. But Queue didn't lack speed, as she showed by winning three races at two, including a minor stake over five furlongs in Florida.

I suspect the main problem was that she was the only graded winner on her catalogue page, her dam being the Florida-bred stakes winner P J Floral. However, Queue's fourth dam Kingman Reef was a half-sister to Proud Clarion, winner of the Kentucky Derby, and to Knightly Dawn, winner of the GI Jersey Derby.

There was always a chance that a daughter of French Deputy would prove more attractive to a Japanese buyer. Although this winner of the GII Jerome H. was responsible for such as Left Bank, Mayo on the Side, House Party, Bella Bellucci, Latour and Queue during his years in America, his reputation was arguably higher in Japan. French Deputy's American-bred son Kurofune had dazzled in Japan in 2001, when he took the title of champion dirt horse, and another son, Nobo Jack, also became a Japanese Group 1 winner on dirt in 2001.

French Deputy's Japanese stock include the Group 1-winning colts Admire Jupiter (G1 Tenno Sho Spring in 2008) and Eishin Deputy (G1 Takarazuka Kinen in 2008), as well as Reginetta (Japanese 1000 Guineas in 2008), Friendship (Japan Dirt Derby) and Pink Cameo (NHK Mile Cup). French Deputy and Kurofune both finished among the top 10 stallions in Japan in 2007 and 2008, so this male line is well placed to become increasingly popular in an industry saturated with Sunday Silence blood.

The future also looks bright for Break Run Out, who has a two-year-old three-parts sister in Japan by Fusaichi Pegasus. He'll need to be suited by a mile and a quarter or more to shine in the Japanese Classics, but stamina shouldn't be a problem--in addition to having a dam who was suited by a mile and a half, the bottom half of his pedigree contains the likes of Nijinsky and Stage Door Johnny.

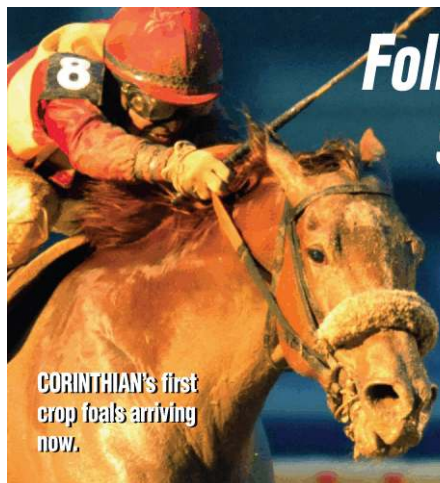

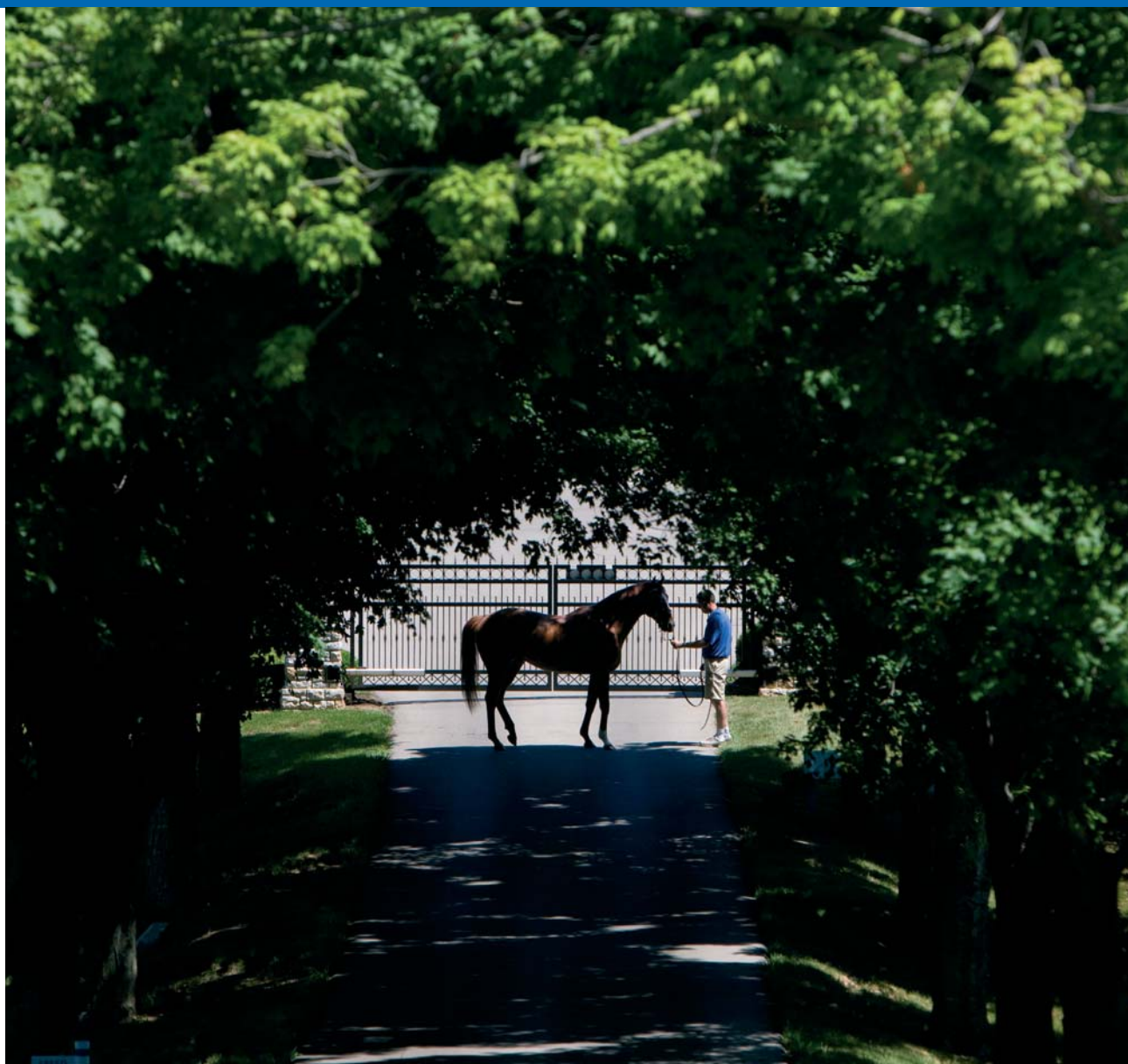

SOLARANA TOPS FASIG WINTER MIXED SALE

Solarana (Arg) (Mutakddim), a group winner in Argentina, attracted a final bid of \$130,000 to top yesterday's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale in Lexington. The six-year-old, who sold as a racing or broodmare prospect, was consigned by Bluewater Sales LLC, Agent LV, and was purchased by Naveed M. Chowhan. Solarana was unbeaten in three starts in Argentina in 2006, including a victory in the G2 Premio Venezuela. Sent to the United States in 2007, she hit the board in six North American stakes, including a runner-up effort in last year's Regret S. at Monmouth Park. She was recently third in the Feb. 7 Likely Exchange S. at Turfway Park. Solarana was reported not sold at \$110,000 at last year's Keeneland November Sale. **Hip 278**, a son of Speightstown out of Procession (Private Terms), was the day's top-priced yearling. The dark bay colt was consigned by Hunter Valley Farm, agent, and was purchased for \$82,000 by MJO. During the one-session sale, Fasig-Tipton sold 206 horses for a total of \$2,392,900 and an average of \$11,616. The median was \$5,000. Thirty-eight horses were reported not sold for a buy-back rate of 15.6 percent. During two days last year, 318 horses sold for \$6,452,400 and an average of \$20,291. The 2008 median was \$7,000 and the buy-back rate was 24.5 percent.



CLEARANCE RATE FALLS ON INGLIS DAY 2

The second session of the Inglis Sydney Classic Yearling Sale demonstrated a resiliency for the top of the market, but also showed the weakness of the lower end. While eight of the 248 yearlings offered sold for A\$100,000 or more, the clearance rate dropped to 66.9 percent from last year's second session level of 76.9 percent. After two days of selling, 249 yearlings have averaged A\$28,614, down 10 percent compared to the first two sessions in 2008. "It is very pleasing to see the average only down 10 percent from last year's figures, which underlines the strength of the buying bench for the more sought-after horses," said Mark Webster, managing director for Inglis. "But it was harder going at the bottom end of the market today, which is clearly more evident throughout the marketplace this year more so than ever, given the current economic climate and the sheer volume of yearlings in the marketplace." Topping session was lot [374](#), a General Nediym (Aus) half-sister to Phelan Ready (Aus) (More Than Ready), winner of the A\$2-million Magic Millions 2YO Classic last month. Patinack Farm, the sale's leading buyer by aggregate, bought the filly out of the GSW Blevic (Aus) mare Nancy Eleanor (Aus) for A\$240,000 from consignor Kitchwin Hills. The third and final session begins today at 11 a.m.
