

**A GODOLPHIN PARTY IN UAE GUINEAS**

No one had Thursday's G3 UAE 2000 Guineas handicapped any better than trainer Saeed bin Suroor, who saddled three sophomore colts for Godolphin. The 1600-meter event was to feature the return to action of dual Grade I winner **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}),

making his first start for Sheikh Mohammed's operation and first since annexing the GI Champagne S. last October. Bin Suroor was anything but ebullient about the former Bobby Frankel inmate pre-race, stating flatly that Vineyard Haven had failed to impress

in his morning work and suggesting he might be in need of the run. His words proved prescient, as in-form **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}) followed in the footsteps of his sire--the 2001 Guineas hero--scoring by a convincing 4 3/4 lengths. **Regal Ransom** (Distorted Humor) was runner-up, duplicating the results of a Jan. 22 conditions event. **UAE Guineas cont. p2**

One of the top sprinters in the U.S. in the last two seasons, Walter Downey's **Fabulous Strike** (Smart Strike) headlines a field of just six short-track specialists in Monday's GII General George H. at Laurel. Should he emerge victorious, the six-year-old would carry the most weight (127 pounds) since Senor Speedy won and established the stakes record (1:21.96) under 126 pounds in 1992. **Eternal Star** (Five Star Day) is the top local hope. A four-time stakes winner in the Midlantic last season, he is two-for-three at seven furlongs with one runner-up effort in the GIII Sport Page H. at Belmont last October. "This has been on our calendar for awhile," said trainer Michael Trombetta. "Facing Fabulous Strike is a tough task, but it is our home track at a distance he likes." **General George field pxx**

***Undefeated in the Desert...***

Conditioned in the U.S. by Eoin Harty, Desert Party debuted victoriously over the Arlington Polytrack June 22, then successfully transferred his form to a conventional dirt surface, defeating three rivals, including Vineyard Haven, in the GII Sanford S. in the Saratoga mud July 24. The bay appeared next in the Sept. 1 GI Hopeful S. at the Spa, but the race was

essentially lost at the start, when the colt stumbled, was bumped and pinched back and weakened to finish sixth. Given a bit of a breather, he resumed training in late November with three breezes at Keeneland prior to his arrival in Dubai. He came from just off the pace to outfinish Regal Ransom by 3/4 of a

length in the Jan. 22 conditions test. The pick of Frankie Dettori among the three Godolphin hopefuls, Desert Party broke well and settle in behind the pace-setting **Redding Colliery** (Mineshaft), as Vineyard Haven, never looking completely comfortable over the strip, was trapped out three wide, but not far away. The pacesetter led into the stretch tracked by Regal Ransom, while Desert Party looked a bit flat-footed for a few strides while blocked a bit approaching the quarter-mile marker. But asked for his best effort by Dettori shortly thereafter, Desert Party raced past a one-paced Vineyard Haven, took aim on Regal Ransom inside the final furlong and pulled well clear. The first two home were both purchased out of last year's Fasig-Tipton Calder sale. "We knew he had come out of his last race very well and improved from that run," bin Suroor said of Desert Party. "This extra distance was never going to be a concern and, all being well, he will be [G2] UAE Derby bound," he added, referring to the \$2-million test on the Dubai World Cup undercard. It is uncertain whether Desert Party would take in the Listed Al Bastakiya, a course-and-distance prep for the Derby on Super Thursday Mar. 5. That event is set to attract Sheikh Mohammed's reigning American two-year-old champ and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Midshipman (Unbridled's Song).

"Besides the bad performance, everything has gone fine," reported trainer John Kimmel. "He looks well. He's trained well. He just didn't run well. I thought today's breeze was

great." Break Water Edison, working in company with Freedom Bay (Forestry), was ridden by former jockey George Martens. Kimmel caught the colt in :23 1/5 for his final quarter. "I really liked the last quarter," said Kimmel. "He even had to go wide at one point because the two of them came up on another horse, and Georgie had to take him pretty well out there on the track." The conditioner is chalking up the Hutcheson disappointment to the colt's inside post. "Every time he's drawn inside he hasn't run really well," said Kimmel. "Georgie used to gallop Lemon Drop Kid, and he said he was always an inconsistent horse until they put blinkers on him and he hated to be down inside. If I drew the rail again I'd have to look at other options." The Fountain of Youth will mark the bay's first attempt at two turns. The pace scenario should be pretty good," said Kimmel. "The main thing I want to see in this race is for him to keep his focus, finish up and stay tuned to what we're trying to do."

**KENTUCKY VLT BILL PASSES COMMITTEE WITH INCREASE IN LICENSE FEES**

A bill that would allow racetracks in the commonwealth of Kentucky to operate video lottery terminals unanimously passed the Kentucky House Licensing and Occupations Committee on Thursday, but has also been revised to significantly increase the license fees tracks would have to pay for the privilege of being able to conduct casino gambling. Sponsored by Speaker of the House Greg Stumbo (D-Prestonsburg), HP 158 would grant the right to operate VLTs to state's eight existing racetracks and a potential ninth licensed racino. The bill initially required a flat licensing fee of \$25,000, but tracks would now have to pay a much steeper price following criticism from House Speaker Pro Tem Larry Clark (D-Louisville), who believed the initial fee was too low. Following Thursday's revisions, Turfway Park would have to pay \$125 million, Churchill Downs \$100 million, Kentucky Downs \$75 million and Ellis Park \$50 million. The Red Mile, a harness track in Lexington, and Keeneland would jointly owe \$100 million. Harness tracks Players Bluegrass Downs and Thunder Ridge Raceway would have to pay \$35 million and \$25 million, respectively. Stumbo is not confident the bill will pass both chambers of the General Assembly before the session ends. The state's constitution requires the bicameral body to meet for 30 days and conclude its session no later than March 30 during odd-numbered years. "At this time, on this day, I doubt [HP 158] has enough support to pass this chamber," Stumbo told the radio station WFPL. "That may change." The state's economic impact report estimates HP 158, if passed, would generate \$676 million in annual net terminal income.

**WIND FORCES AQUEDUCT CANCELLATION**

High winds have forced Aqueduct to cancel today's card, the New York Racing Association has announced. The national Weather Service has issued a high wind warning for Ozone Park, New York, with sustained winds of 30 to 40 miles per hour and gusts up to 60 mph. Today's races will be brought back as extras this week. NYRA expects to resume racing at 12:30 p.m. tomorrow with a nine-race card.

**Maryland Commission Denies Magna VLT Application:**

Magna Entertainment Corp., parent company of Maryland's Laurel Park, has announced that the Maryland VLT Facility Location Commission (the "Commission") has not accepted for consideration the application a Video Lottery Operation License to operate Video Lottery Terminals at the facility. The Commission has stated that the application did not meet certain minimum requirements set out in the bidding process. Another bid submitted by New York-based Empire Resorts for a casino near Rocky Gap State Park was also rejected. According to the Baltimore Sun, the Commission took the vote when a letter from the attorney general's office advised that the Commission "does not have discretion to consider a proposal for a...license if the proposal was submitted without the requisite...fee." Bidders for up to 15,000 slot machines were required to submit an up-front fee of \$3 million for every 500 slot machines. Laurel submitted its application Feb. 2, 2009, without payment of the specified initial license fee of \$28.5 million, one which was non-refundable and one which was "protested and challenged" by Magna. In a release, officials from MEC are reportedly considering all of its legal options with respect to this matter, and has filed various legal actions to protect its interests in the appropriate forums in the State of Maryland.

Task Forces Report to RMTC Board:

At a Feb. 6 meeting in Las Vegas, representatives of the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium received important updates from their Scientific Advisory Committee and Drug Testing Initiatives Task Force. Dr. Rick Sams, an advisor to the RMTC, presented on anabolic steroid administration studies recently completed at the University of Florida and funded by RMTC. The information collected will assist the RMTC in recommending plasma thresholds for inclusion in the RMTC-recommended model rule on anabolic steroids, which has been adopted in 35 of the 38 states which conduct pari-mutuel horseracing. Accurate withdrawal times will be provided to horsemen and veterinarians based on those plasma thresholds. "The magnitude of this study is without precedent in equine drug testing anywhere in the world," said RMTC research consultant Dr. Bill Muir. "The scientists involved are to be commended for developing analytic procedures and methods that are applicable to trained horses in racing condition. They have set the qualitative and quantitative standard regarding the testing procedures, experimental design and analytical techniques used for the identification of anabolic steroids in racehorses." The RMTC also heard from the Drug Initiatives Task Force on issues ranging from laboratory standards to sample collection and frozen sample retrospective testing strategies. "The amount of work that our Drug Testing Initiatives Task Force has accomplished since its inception in September is truly remarkable," said RMTC Executive Director Dr. Scot Waterman. "There is a tremendous amount of excitement that we are on the path toward changing drug testing for the better in this country. We are appreciative of the efforts of the task force members and the sponsorship of The Jockey Club in this endeavor."

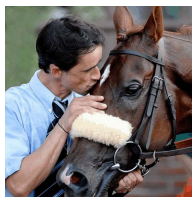
