## CRITICISM PROVES TO BE THE VERY ONE

Heading into Sunday's GIII The Very One S. at Gulfstream, Darley's homebred **Criticism (GB)** (Machiavellian) had everything going for her and the English miss further added to her luster with a professional 2 1/2-length score over listed winner **Dress Rehearsal (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), with GISW **Backseat Rhythm** (El Corredor) 1 3/4 lengths back in third. Allowed to dawdle through slow early splits of :24.94, :51.24, 1:17.30 and 1:41.03, the bay was 3 1/2-lengths clear turning for home and had plenty left in the tank to collect her second straight graded win. Criticism was duplicating the feat of her dam, Innuendo (Ire) (Caerleon), who captured this race in 2001. "We got in good position and that was pretty much it," said winning rider Edgar Prado. "The first quarter was slow and the second quarter was even slower, so I didn't want to take too much out of her, but it wasn't anything too tough. It was an easy ride. We galloped most of the way. ## SPRING HOUSE REPEATS IN SAN LUIS OBISPO

Still going strong at age seven, R.D. Hubbard's **Spring House** (Chester House) rocketed from off the pace to successfully defend his title in the GII San Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita Sunday. Content to track a modest early pace set by a head-strong **Kris Silver** (The Silver Move), Spring House--sandwiched between a throng of runners mid stretch--had plenty in reserve late and drew clear to score by three lengths over the fast-closing **Church Service** (Pulpit). James Scatuorchio's **Attempted Humor** (Distorted Humor), trained by Todd Pletcher, rounded out the trifecta. "He was on the bit the whole way, and when that hole opened up in the stretch, he went through it like a bullet," explained winning rider Alex Solis. "I thought there would be more pace, but I ended up in a good position and so I had no complaints." According to trainer Julio Canani, the gelding will make his next start in the 12-furlong GII San Luis Rey H. Mar. 21. **Zambezi Sun (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), making his U.S. bow as the 4-5 choice, pressed the early pace, but faded late to be sixth. "He was getting out the whole way with me," said Garrett Gomez. "Going around there the first time, he was OK, but by the time he got to the first turn, I had two hands on one rein and he was wanting to get out and just get rank all at the same time." Criticism (GB) launched her career in France, where she finished second or better in her first five starts in 2007, including a score in the 10-furlong Listed La Coupe de Marseille at Marseille-Borely. Third in the G3 Prix Baboin later that season, the bay was runner-up

in the Listed Grand Prix de Marseille before finishing a lackluster 10th in her European finale--and her final start for trainer Henri-Alex Pantall--in the Listed Prix Lyphard over the Polytrack at Deauville. Runner-up in her U.S. bow in the GIII Athenia H. at Belmont last October, she collected her first graded stakes win

in her most recent start in the 12-furlong GIII Long Island H. at the Big A Nov. 1. "She's trained well since she got here," said winning trainer Tom Albertrani. "One of her greatest assets over here is that she'll go a mile-and-a-half and a lot of the others won't." As for future plans for the mare, Albertrani added, "If all goes well, we'll bring her back here in the [GIII] Orchid H. [Mar. 22]. Hopefully, later this year we can get to win a Grade 1 with her."

Spring House collected his first graded stakes score at the ripe old age of five, scoring in the GIII Carleton F. Burke H., but came into his own at six, accounting for the GII San Luis Obispo H. in February and later added the GII Del Mar H. Aug. 23. Failing to hit the board in a pair of Grade I stakes in the fall, the gelding closed out the season with a fourth in Hollywood's nine-furlong GIII Native Diver H. over the Cushion Track Dec. 6. In his most recent start, Spring House came home fourth in the 10-furlong GII San Marcos H. Jan. 19. "I put a figure eight on him," explained Julio Canani. "He had trouble breathing, and I was thinking of giving him an operation, but I changed my mind. I checked with three different veterinarians and I decided just to put a figure eight on him, and it worked out."

**Rail Trip Unlikely for Big 'Cap; Valdivia Rides 'Champs'**

Ron Ellis has not ruled out a start in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 7 for undefeated **Rail Trip** (Jimp Start), however, the trainer indicated Sunday that a start in the 1 1/4-mile test is unlikely for the Sam and Mace Siegel color bearer. "We nominated, but we're probably not going to run," said Ellis. The gelding recorded his fourth consecutive victory against allowance foes at Santa Anita last Friday. Ellis indicated that the Apr. 4 GII Oaklawn H. might also be a possibility. "We'll see how he's doing, how the race shapes up and that kind of stuff...We're definitely on the fence. Oaklawn might be a possibility. We've still got to sit down [with the owners], and if we skip the Santa Anita H., we've got to come up with a plan of what we want to do." As for long-term plans for the four-year-old, Ellis added, "We've got to get him to win some stakes first, but obviously, our long-range thinking is the Breeders' Cup [Nov. 7] at Oak Tree." Jose Valdivia Jr., who has been for all for wins on the bay, has been engaged to ride GISW **Champs Elysees (GB)** (Danehill) in the Santa Anita showpiece for older horses, according to trainer Bobby Frankel Sunday morning. The five-year-old was seventh in his most recent start in the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 8.

**Leparoux to Ride Nownownow Big 'Cap Day**

Jockey Joe Talamo will head east to ride GII Robert B. Lewis S. third-place finisher **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 7, opening the door for Julien Leparoux to partner with GII San Fernando S. winner **Nownownow** (Whywhywhy) in either the GI Frank Kilroe Mile or the GI Santa Anita H. at Santa Anita the same afternoon. "We have a lot to consider before the races," trainer Patrick Biancone said when asked which race Nownownow would run in. "Nothing is ruled out. Each race is a handicap, so we will look at the weights, who is running, and go from there."

**Einstein Works Ahead of Big 'Cap**

MGISW **Einstein (Brz)** (Spend a Buck), set to contest the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 7, recorded his first work yesterday morning since a third-place finish behind

Albertus Maximus (Albert the Great) in the GI Donn H. Jan. 31. The seven-year-old, accompanied by Julien Leparoux, negotiated five furlongs in 1:00 3/5, the fastest of 27 moves at the distance Sunday. "He was super and really ready to work today," said trainer Helen Pitts-Blasi. "His last race took a lot out of

him, but he's come out of it good and Julien said that he was great today." A Grade I winner on the turf who has also accounted for a graded stakes victory on the dirt, the bay will be making his first start over a synthetic surface. "It should be very interesting because [people say] that grass horses should like it," said Pitts. "I've got a horse that is probably more of a grass horse than a dirt horse, but he does deal with both very well. A million dollars is enough of a reason to find out." Einstein, who is scheduled to depart for California Wednesday, will work over the surface once before the 1 1/4-mile test.

Harold Queen's homebred **Big Drama** (Montbrook) breezed an easy half-mile in :50 flat at Calder Sunday morning, his first workout since Jan. 18. The colt's training schedule was interrupted by a bone bruise that required surgery after kicking himself in a shin while in his stall. "I was very pleased with his work this morning," said trainer David Fawkes. "It's a good start, but I don't have anything in particular in mind just yet until he gets further along. The good thing about him is that he'll come along quickly, so I wouldn't rule anything out at this point." The Florida-bred won five of six starts last year, including a sweep of the three 'open' divisions of the Florida Stallion S. series at Calder and the GIII Delta Jackpot S. at Delta Downs Dec. 5.

## Rachel Alexandra to Fair Grounds Oaks

**Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) will make her next start in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 14, trainer Hal Wiggins told *Daily Racing Form*. The sophomore filly was an impressive eight-length winner in her 2009 bow in Oaklawn's Martha Washington S. Feb. 15. "She galloped back for the first time [Sunday] morning and galloped fine, nice and relaxed," Wiggins told *DRF*. Owned by Dolph Morrison and Mike Lauffer, the winner of the GII Golden Rod S. will work once more at Oaklawn Mar. 9 before shipping to New Orleans Mar. 10 or 11 for the 8 1/2-furlong event.

## Ventana to Run Back in Sham; 'Pioneer' Works

**Ventana** (Toccet) will make his next start in Saturday's GIII Sham S., according to trainer Bob Baffert yesterday. The \$410,000 BESMAR juvenile, who broke his maiden by 5 1/2 lengths at Belmont Sept. 5, was fourth behind winner Evita Argentina (Candy Ride {Arg}) in his latest start in the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 16. "He actually ran better (in the San Vicente)," Baffert said of Ventana. "He didn't give it up. He was right there; he was steady the whole way. He just got beat." Baffert also sent out fellow Triple Crown hopeful **Pioneer of the Nile** (Empire Maker) at Santa Anita Sunday morning. The Zayat Stable star, who was partnered by Garrett Gomez, covered five furlongs in 1:00.60 in preparation for a start in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 14. "He broke behind a group of horses and it worked out perfect," said Baffert. "He's right on schedule. He went out three-quarters in like 12 and four [1:12 4/5]. He did it the right way." The colt is also scheduled to start in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 4. "I thought he worked really well," added Gomez. "He accelerated very nicely and galloped out really strong. He looked very happy."

Success Brocken, a dominant winner on dirt in his first four races, reported home last of 18 when trying turf and stakes competition for the first time in the Japanese Derby June 1. Returning to dirt in his next start, the dark bay scored by 3 1/2 lengths in the Japanese Dirt Derby July 9, then was edged a quarter-length by Vermilion (Jpn) in the JBC Classic Nov. 3 in his first start against older opponents. Success Brocken was eighth of 15 in the 1800-meter G1 Japan Cup Dirt Dec. 7 in his next out, defeated four lengths by Kane Hekili (Jpn). Making his first start since that effort and facing four of his Japan Cup Dirt opponents here, Success Brocken made a determined run in the four path to get up in the shadow of the wire. Casino Drive, winner of the 2008 GII Peter Pan S. and sixth in the Japan Cup Dirt two starts back, forged to a narrow lead with 40 yards to go, but could not turn back the winner's rally. Kane Hekili, who won this race in 2006, closed steadily along the inside to just miss for second in his first start since his Japan Cup Dirt triumph.

Stanley Ho Hung-sun, who owns the seven-year-old gelding, was coy when asked about the prospect of taking another shot at the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, where Viva Pataca was second last

"[The blinkers] have done the trick; they made him more focused," Moore said. The Chairman's Sprint Prize was James Winks' third victory since he made his debut in the territory a month ago.
