## POMPA SELLS INTEREST IN 'PHIL'

Paul Pompa Jr. has sold a 45-percent interest in GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. starter **This Ones for Phil** (Untuttable--Heaven's Gate, by Septieme Ciel) to owners Jack Mandato and Michael Dubb, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Pompa purchased the three-year-old gelding privately following his third-place finish in the Arthur I. Appleton Juvenile Turf S. Nov. 8. Transferred to trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. for the six-furlong Sunshine Millions Dash S. Jan. 24, **This Ones for Phil** provided instant dividends for Pompa, running off with an eye-catching 2 1/4-length victory. He earned a 116 Beyer for that effort, the highest of any three-year-old this term. "I've had lots of inquiries about the horse, but I wanted to make it simple and go with the right kind of people," Pompa told *DRF*. "Jack Mandato is a philanthropist who wants to be in it for the action. Michael Dubb is always one of the leading owners in New York, and we have a relationship since we both own a piece of Stardom Bound." Pompa also told *DRF* that he purchased **This Ones for Phil** for \$150,000 from owner/breeder Gilbert Campbell, and that he sold the minority interest to Mandato and Dubb for "good money."

## Quality Road Steps Up in Class...

**Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) heads to the big leagues following a second-place finish behind **Theregoesjojo** (Brahms) in a salty Gulfstream allowance Jan. 10. The Evans homebred previously stamped himself as one to watch following an impressive debut win at the Big A in November. "He rushed up after breaking slow, and that might have taken something out of him," trainer Jimmy Jerkens said of his charge's latest start. "Plus a lot of my horses didn't do too well when they first got down here." The bay worked a five-furlong bullet in :58 2/5 at Palm Meadows Feb. 22. "He's been good, and he worked awfully good on Sunday," Jerkens said.

## DEVOTEE TAKES UAE OAKS

**Devotee** (Elusive Quality), third in last year's GI Darley Alcibiades S., rebounded from a dull effort in her sophomore debut to take yesterday's Listed UAE Oaks at Nad Al Sheba. Looking to atone for her last-place effort in the Feb. 6 UAE 1000 Guineas and match her dam's victory in the 2003 UAE Oaks, **Devotee** led early, but settled into



second after ceding the top spot to Guineas winner **So Shiny** (Arg) (Indygo Shiner). Always within striking distance, the Godolphin colorbearer reclaimed the advantage with 600 meters left. **Earth Living** (Yonaguska) launched a stern challenge to the outside, but **Devotee** dug in and turned back that bid to post a hard-fought score. "Devotee was obviously a disappointment last time, but we knew she was a good filly and her work has been good," said winning jockey Frankie Dettori. "She was brave when the other filly came to her and ran on strongly." Also at Nad Al Sheba yesterday, **Archipenko** (Kingmambo) won the G3 Zabeel Mile in his first outing since last August. "Archipenko's class prevailed, as he will have needed the run with the G1 Duty Free still four weeks away [Mar. 28]," said winning trainer Mike de Kock. The five-year-old was third in last year's Duty Free before winning the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong. **Full results p2-3**

**AL QUOZ SPRINT-G3 results cont.**

J J the Jet Plane commenced a five-race winning streak by taking the Mar. 24 G2 Senor Santa H. at Vaal, then captured Tuffrontein's G3 Man O'War Sprint Apr. 12 and G1 Computaform Sprint May 3. The gelding was shut down for 2008 following scores in the G1 Golden Horse Casino Sprint at Scottsville May 31 and G1 Mercury Sprint at Clairwood July 20. Racing outside his native country for the first time, South Africa's 2008 champion sprinter set the pace in a 1100-meter Nad Al Sheba conditions event on dirt Feb. 12, but was headed with 600 meters to go and faded to finish sixth, defeated 10 3/4 lengths. After breaking on top here, J J the Jet Plane raced in second along the rail after Instant Recall sprinted to the lead. He assumed command while racing in-hand with 400 meters to go and was never threatened by a late-running Hatta Fort. Devotee was a debut winner at Saratoga Aug. 31, leading from gate to wire to prevail by 2 1/4 lengths under a drive. Moved to the Polytrack and stretched out to 1 1/16 miles in the G1 Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 3, the bay made a bid with four furlongs to go, but tired to finish a distant third. The former Darley colorbearer and Thomas Albertrani trainee was taken to Dubai following that effort, joining Saeed bin Suroor's Godolphin string. **TAKE THE POINTS SHAM BOUND** Take the Points (Even the Score), cross-entered in the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream and the GIII Sham S. at Santa Anita Saturday, will go postward in the Sham after overcoming travel difficulties. The Todd Pletcher trainee had been expected to arrive in California from Florida Wednesday, but plane problems delayed his arrival. "The plane broke down yesterday, so he'll be here today," Pletcher assistant Mike McCarthy said yesterday. Take the Points will be making his stakes bow in the Sham and is looking for his third straight win after breaking his maiden at Belmont last September and adding a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 31. "The Sham should be a good test for him," McCarthy said. "He deserves a chance. On numbers, he fits with those horses, so we'll take our best swing."

**KELLY LEAK POSSIBLE FOR SANTA ANITA DERBY** Trainer Mike Machowsky said **Kelly Leak** (Runaway Groom) may make his next start in the Apr. 4 GI Santa Anita Derby. The bay colt, disqualified from a first-place finish in last summer's GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar, was third behind This Ones for Phil in the Jan. 24 Sunshine Millions Dash at Gulfstream before returning to the winner's circle with an allowance victory over the Santa Anita turf Feb. 22 (video). "He's won on turf and synthetic," Machowsky said. "He had some bad luck in earlier races, but he can do anything. He broke his maiden at Hollywood [on Cushion Track], and was DQ'd at Del Mar. He runs on anything, and he came out of Sunday's race really good. The timing [to run in the Santa Anita Derby] is good, too, so that's what I'm thinking right now." Machowsky added that **Majormotionpicture** (Action This Day), unraced since earning ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ status in his debut last August at Del Mar, is almost ready to resume training.

**STRIKING DANCER TO BONNIE MISS** Striking Dancer (Smart Strike), winner of a turf allowance at Gulfstream Wednesday (video), will likely make her next start in the Mar. 27 GII Bonnie Miss S. "I really wanted to bring her back in a race on the main track," explained trainer Ken McPeck. "But we couldn't get a race to go. That's all right. She's pretty special and could be a [Kentucky] Oaks filly. She's never run on dirt, but I'm not really worried that she won't handle it, and the Bonnie Miss fits her schedule." Striking Dancer graduated impressively over the Churchill lawn last November before ending her juvenile campaign with a runner-up effort in the Nov. 29 Caressing S. McPeck's loaded sophomore bench also includes **Dream Empress** (Bernstein), winner of last year's GI Darley Alcibiades S. and allowance winner **Our Dahlia** (Belong to Me). Both fillies are being pointed towards the Mar. 15 GIII Hercomesthebride S. over the Gulfstream turf. Dream Empress broke her maiden over the Saratoga turf last August before winning the Alcibiades and running second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies over synthetic surfaces. She has been off since running fourth over conventional dirt in the Nov. 29 GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill Downs.

IEAH Stables head Michael Iavarone announced that champion sprinter **Benny the Bull** (Lucky Lionel) would be coming out of retirement shortly after accepting the hardware at the Eclipse Awards in January.

The Florida-bred, originally retired after suffering an ankle chip while preparing for Saratoga's GI Forego S. in August, has recently resumed training at Four Roses Training Center in Florida. He had surgery to have the chip removed.

"He's coming back to New York any day now," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. reported. "He just started back in very light training. I would have to say we will get a real good idea what's happening after he breezes five-eighths three times, then we'll start looking for a race somewhere."

Benny the Bull, acquired privately by IEAH in the summer of 2007, closed out his four-year-old season with a win in the GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash S. at Laurel. He ventured to the desert with a game tally in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in March, and resurfaced on Belmont Stakes day with a determined score in the GII True North H. The son of Comet Cat (Birdonthewire) closed out the year with a two-length win in Calder's GII Smile Sprint H. July 12.

"His Sunshine Millions race was an awesome race," Dutrow recalled. "That has to be on top of my list. That automatically sent us to Dubai, because he ran so big in that race."

Iavarone added, "We're obviously excited to bring 'Benny' back to the races as the defending sprint champion. We've all enjoyed his racing career to this point, and we are hopeful he can add to his success in 2009." --S.S.

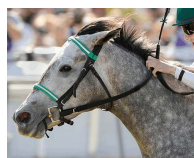

"He just wasn't right for the race," Dutrow continued. "Edgar [Prado] said he didn't feel like the same horse in the post parade and during the race. I just didn't understand what was happening, so we scanned him everywhere, and found [the tear]."

When asked what he thought of Dunkirk's performance, Dutrow added, "I was disappointed with the race. Our horse didn't run any good. That's really all I'm interested in." --S.S.
