Already a MGISW on the spinach, **Einstein (Brz)** (Spend a Buck) further added to his resume with a determined victory over **Champs Elysees (GB)** (Danehill) in Saturday's G1 Santa Anita H. Placed in a perfect spot on the outside by Julien Leparoux tracking the pacesetting **Matto Mondo (Chi)** (Sir Cat), Einstein revved up three wide on the turn for home, hit the front entering the straight and held the rallying runner-up safe. "[Julien Leparoux] rode him absolutely beautiful," trainer Helen Pitts-Blasi said. "It certainly is an option [coming back for the Breeders' Cup at Oak Tree]." Cont. p2

I WANT REVENGE GETS HIS IN THE GOTHAM

David Lanzman's **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) brought the Southern Californian weather with him to New York, and stamped himself as a leading G1 Kentucky Derby contender in the process with an emphatic 8 1/2-length score over **Imperial Council** (Empire Maker) in the GIII Gotham S. on an unseasonably warm afternoon at the Big A. Rating kindly in second beneath Joe Talamo through fractions of :23.76 and :48.45, he blew past the pacesetter **Mr. Fantasy** (E Dubai) as if he were standing still in the stretch and won with plenty left. Mr. Fantasy just got tagged for second by a neck. According to trainer Jeff Mullins, I Want Revenge will stay in the Big Apple under the care of Anthony Dutrow and make his next start in the G1 Wood Memorial S. Apr. 4. "I had so much horse the whole way around," Talamo said. "Me and Alan [Garcia, aboard Mr. Fantasy] were going pretty slow, but at the quarter-pole, my horse just took off. There is no comparison between real dirt and synthetic--he really took to it. When we went past the three-sixteenths pole, I was smiling." Cont. p4

A Smart Play Over Any Surface...

Einstein was first or second in seven of nine starts last term, including wins in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf S. in February and the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. at Churchill Downs May 3. The dark bay also made some noise on dirt, finishing second behind Curlin in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 14 and annexing the GII Clark H. Nov. 28. He kicked off the new year with a respectable third in the Jan. 31 GI Donn H. behind G1 Dubai World Cup hopeful Albertus Maximus (Albert the Great). Einstein posted a bullet workout at Gulfstream before prepping for the Big 'Cap with a five-furlong move in 1:01 4/5 over the Pro-Ride Mar. 1. Leparoux has been aboard Einstein in his last three starts. The Big 'Cap marked the seven-year-old's first start on a synthetic surface. "I got a good trip," Leparoux said. "I got him covered up, and the race went like we expected. I expected Johnny [Velazquez on Cowboy Cal] and Rafael [Bejarano on Matto Mondo] to go. I expected to be third or fourth. I came running on the last turn, and we made a good run at the finish. Jose Valdivia's horse [Champs Elysees] came flying at the end, but we had to make a move when we did. I think if we could have waited a little longer, we would have won much easier than that. He handled the Pro-Ride surface just fine. He's a good horse on the turf; he's a good horse on the dirt. He's a good horse on anything. I guess there had been a question mark. We didn't know really about this track, but we were pretty sure he was going to handle it, and he sure did." **Blue Exit** (Pulpit), runner-up in the GII Strub S. Feb. 7, was pulled up on the turn for home and vanned off.

The WinStar Farm homebred closed out his sophomore campaign with a fourth-place finish in the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. Dec. 26. He worked four furlongs in :47 4/5 at Santa Anita on Tuesday.

Stardom Bound, acquired for \$5.7 million at last year's FTKNOV sale following a victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, made quick dividends for her new connections, rallying from last of eight to annex her sophomore bow in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 7. Assigned the one hole here, the gray was content to trail the field early. Creeping closer down the backstretch, the champion was forced extremely wide at the top of the stretch as she began to roll. With regular rider Mike Smith in the irons, Stardom Bound altered course to the outside in deep stretch as Third Dawn drifted out, but gamely fought on to get up for a narrow victory. Mike Iavarone of IEAH Stables was reluctant to confirm Stardom Bound for the GI Santa Anita Derby. "She's going to have to really prove herself to handle horses like Pioneer of the Nile. If they think they want to go forward, I'm willing to go forward, but she worked pretty hard against girls today." Gio Ponti, winner of last term's GIII Hill Prince S. at Belmont and GII Virginia Derby at Colonial, returned to turf with a career-best here. Seventh as the lukewarm 2-1 favorite in the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 30, he closed out his sophomore campaign with a win in the off-the-turf GIII Sir Beaufort S. Dec. 26. The bay was last seen finishing a close fifth in the GII Strub S. over the Pro-Ride Feb. 7. Backed as the second choice, Gio Ponti was settled near the back of the pack through fractions of :23.26 and :46.31. Beginning to roll in the stretch beneath Ramon Dominguez, Gio Ponti just got up to take it by a nostril over the favored mare Ventura.

The dark bay broke through with a maiden tally when stretched to 8 1/2 furlongs at Hollywood Oct. 29, and stepped up to the big leagues in his next attempt, coming within a nose of defeating Pioneerof the Nile (Empire Maker) in the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 20. I Want Revenge kicked off his sophomore campaign with a third-place finish behind that aforementioned rival in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Niconero scored an upset in the G1 Futurity S. last week and repeated the dose with his first win beyond 1800 meters here. The five-time Group 1 winner has lined up no less than 29 times in Group 1 races and has more to come, as trainer David Hayes plans a Sydney autumn campaign that will encompass the G1 Ranvet S. and G1 BMW next month. Niconero cruised along among the tail-enders, while the favorite Theseo shadowed the leader Pre Eminence (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}). Theseo took control at the top of the straight and appeared to have the race in his keeping until Niconero edged clear on the line. "We thought he might have just got beat, and we were wildly excited when we won," said Hayes. "The favorite, I thought, had every chance, and it was great to see Niconero stick his neck out. It's his fifth Group 1 now, and we love him." Theseo narrowly missed clinching a trip to race in England, but trainer Gai Waterhouse looked on the bright side. "That means we can win the Cox Plate instead," she said. "It would have been impossible to go to England and then come back for the Cox Plate, but we can focus on the Cox Plate next spring. Everything happens for a reason." Danny O'Brien has abandoned plans to take Master O'Reilly (O'Reilly {NZ}) to Dubai for the G1 Sheema Classic Mar. 28 after he finished eighth of 12 runners.

The Virginia H. Tarra Trust's **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway) tuned up for next Saturday's GII Louisiana Derby by breezing five-eighths of a mile in 1:00.80 yesterday morning at the Fair Grounds. It was the second-fastest of 36 moves at the distance. "It could not have gone any better," said Neil Pessin, who has been overseeing the training of the Illinois-bred colt for the Chicago-based Chris Block. With jockey James Graham up, Giant Oak broke off about six lengths behind the Pessin-trained stakes winner You Dancing Devil (Joyeux Danseur) before moving to within two lengths at the three-eighths pole.

Steered out from behind his workmate in upper stretch, Giant Oak pulled alongside at the furlong marker and opened up while covering his final panel in :11 3/5. "He did it very much in hand, very easily and wasn't breathing hard afterwards," Pessin said, adding that Giant Oak galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 2/5. Graham will replace Edgar Prado for the Louisiana Derby. "James gets along very well with him," Pessin explained. "He gets him to relax, and the horse responds nicely when he asks him." Runner-up to Beethoven (Sky Mesa) in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 29, Giant Oak endured a nightmarish trip in the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 7, where he was blocked at nearly every critical moment in the running and did well to be fifth behind Friesan Fire (A.P. Indy). A work scheduled for last weekend was postponed after the chestnut was found to be suffering from an injury to his mouth.

Danger to Society Works for Wood...

Lansdon Robbins and partners' **Danger to Society** (Harlan's Holiday), a disappointing seventh as the 9-5 chalk in the GIII Holy Bull S. Jan. 31, worked six furlongs in 1:12.40 at Gulfstream Saturday in preparation of the Apr. 4 GI Wood Memorial S. Formerly campaigned by Ken McPeck, the \$300,000 FTKJUL yearling was transferred to Rick Dutrow Jr. following the Holy Bull. "We were looking for a good, easy six-furlong breeze and it looks like we got it," Dutrow said. "We're looking at the Wood because the Florida Derby looks like it's coming up really tough. If some of the major players in there were to fall out, we'd be ready to go."

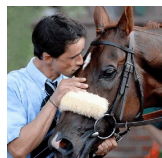
