BITTEL, BERNIE BATTLE AT TURFWAY

They have traveled different roads, but today the paths of **Bittel Road** (Stormy Atlantic) and **West Side Bernie** (Bernstein) converge on the banks of the Ohio River for today's \$500,000 centerpiece of the winter/spring meeting at Turfway Park. Owned by Jim

Scatuorchio and John Iracane, Bittel Road made the first five starts of his career on the grass, winning a pair of stakes, including the GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland Oct. 5. That effort earned him an automatic berth to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, but the dark bay flipped in the paddock, then suffered the first defeat of his career when eighth behind Donativum (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). Runner-up as the favorite in Hollywood's GIII Generous S. Nov. 29, he

switched to the Cushion Track and finished an even fourth to Pioneerof The Nile (Empire Maker) and I Want Revenge (Stephen Got Even) in the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 20, and was most recently fourth to the former in the Feb. 7 GII Robert B. Lewis S. Bittel Road has handled any surface he's been on, and the reports emanating from Northern Kentucky are equally positive. "He went very easily," said assistant trainer Whit Beckman after watching the colt take one lap of the Polytrack. "He's loving the track. He's just cruising over the top of it." Still, it seems connections believe his future is on the infield. "Put him on the turf and he's just a different horse," Beckman explained. "He's got those nice, round feet. Turf is where he excels."

George and Lori Hall's **West Side Bernie** has also proved versatile in his young career, and returns to the scene of his victory in last year's GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile S. Sixth from an outside barrier in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 25, he returned to be runner-up in the GIII Delta Jackpot S. Dec. 5, and overcame a wide trip to be third in his seasonal debut in the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 31. Trainer Kelly Breen spoke earlier this week of a possible return to South Florida if

West Side Bernie had drawn wide for the Lane's End, but those fears were allayed when the colt pulled post position four. Of the locals, Donamire Farm's **Parade Clown** (Distorted Humor) would be the most likely to threaten the top two. Winner of the Feb. 7 WEBN S., the homebred was the 3-5 favorite for the John Battaglia Memorial S. Feb. 28, but raced wide and freely and was forced to settle for second, 1 1/4 lengths adrift of **Proceed Bee** (Bernstein).

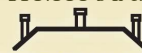

In a bit over her head when a distant fourth behind Eclipse winner Indian Blessing (Indian Charlie) in the Sept. 20 GII Gallant Bloom H., the bay capped off the season with a victory in the Oct. 11 Seton Hall University S. at the Meadowlands. She followed up with a 4 1/4-length tally in the Jan. 1 Interborough S. at Aqueduct, and makes her second start of 2009 here. The five-year-old prepped for her return with a bullet five-eighths in :59 4/5 Mar. 5. **Secret Gypsy**, also tabbed a ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★, was runner-up in the GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland in October before taking a Churchill allowance by 8 1/2 lengths Nov. 27. She was last seen posting a four-length success in the Dec. 20 Esplanade S. at Fair Grounds. **Distorted Passion** completed the hattrick when making it three in a row in the Jan. 31 Correction H. at the Big A. The bay filly battled through a half in :45 1/5 in the Feb. 27 Feel the Beat S. before giving way to be second behind **Awesome Ashley**.

Following his convincing 2 1/4-length victory in last year's GII San Luis Obispo H. in February, trainer Julio Canani could not resist the urge to send **Spring House** halfway around the world for the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. The gamble did not pay off, as the dark bay weakened after setting the early pace and came home 10th. Winner of the GII Del Mar H. in five post-Dubai appearances last season, the Dee Hubbard runner successfully defended his San Luis Obispo title Feb. 22, getting up to score by a half-length, and stays at home this time around. It has been over two years since **Artiste Royal** has been this marathon distance, and you have to go back to 2004 for his last win at the trip. A dual Grade I winner over 10 furlongs, the bay enters the San Luis Rey off a fifth-place effort in the one-mile GI F.E. Kilroe H. Mar. 7, and will appreciate the added real estate.

Triple Threats

Thompson to Ride Old Fashioned in Arkansas Derby...

Fox Hill Farm's **Old Fashioned** (Unbridled's Song), who suffered his first career defeat when second in last Saturday's GII Rebel S., will have a new pilot for the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 11. Jockey Terry Thompson will replace Ramon Dominguez in the irons for the \$1-million test. "It's a one-race commitment," trainer Larry Jones told *Daily Racing Form*. "I don't know who will ride in the Kentucky Derby." While Dominguez told *DRF* that he was disappointed in his ride aboard Old Fashioned in the Rebel, Jones said that was not the reason for the switch. Thompson was aboard the grey colt for his first two career starts before Dominguez took over in the GII Remsen S., owing to his familiarity of the Aqueduct oval. Thompson is the regular work rider for Old Fashioned and is the current leading rider at Oaklawn Park. "He is an easy colt to ride, there is nothing tricky about him," mentioned Thompson before Friday's races. "The first time I worked this horse, I knew he was a prospect. There is a presence about him. When I am on Old Fashioned, I have the feeling of being on something special."

Stardom Bound Ready to Breeze at Keeneland...

Having arrived at Keeneland this past Wednesday to begin preparations for the GI Ashland S. Apr. 4, champion **Stardom Bound** (Tapit) is scheduled to have her first breeze over the Polytrack this morning. "That's what we're here for," said trainer Richard Dutrow Jr., referring to the Ashland. The conditioner will saddle Stardom Bound for the first time in the 8 1/2-furlong event. Now owned by a partnership including IEAH Stables, Paul Pompa Jr., Michael Dubb and Golden Goose Enterprises, the grey filly was saddled to wins in the GI Las Virgenes S. and the GI Santa Anita Oaks by trainer Bobby Frankel. Also expected to represent the Dutrow stable at Keeneland is **Patena** (Seeking the Gold). Most recently eighth to Friesan Fire (A.P. Indy) in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 14, he is being pointed towards a start in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 11.

Breeders' Cup Marathon Distance Extended...

Officials at Breeders' Cup Ltd. have announced their decision to lengthen the distance of the \$500,000 Breeders' Cup Marathon from 12 to 14 furlongs. "In furthering our commitment for a high caliber extended distance race in the World Championships, the Racing and Nominations Committee strongly recommended the lengthening of the Marathon to 14 furlongs to bring the race in line with the category standards of the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities," said Robert T. Manfuso, chairman of the Breeders' Cup Racing and Nominations Committee. The Committee also reasoned that the new distance will allow the race to begin near the six-furlong chute at Santa Anita, allowing for a longer run into the first of three turns. The inaugural Breeders' Cup Marathon was won last year by **Muhannak (Ire)** (Chester House).

Fantasia Has Nell Gwyn Target...

George Strawbridge's recent acquisition **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) looks set to run in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket Apr. 15 as she prepares for a possible tilt at that track's G1 1000 Guineas. While the May 3 mile Classic is not a definite target for the Luca Cumani-trained G3 Prestige S. winner and G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up, her conditioner is keen to prep her in the seven-furlong trial. "Fantasia looks well and the plan would be to run in the Nell Gwyn," Cumani told *PA Sport*. "We will then discuss with the owner where she runs next, and he will monitor the progress of Rainbow View and Fantasia and make a decision. It is possible they could run against each other if that was decided, but a Guineas is a Guineas and if she went to France for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches [at Longchamp May 10], then so be it."

Jumped forward last summer, and stayed at that level the rest of the year. In his four-year-old debut he moved forward slightly to a new top, and is now likely to run that well again or better, as the Thoro-Pattern shows. Five pounds is worth 1 point on the Thoro-Graph scale, or 2 1/2 lengths at today's distance, and this colt gets a huge break in the weight. He also gets the rail going three turns, and overall has a big shot here even if he doesn't improve on his last.

Improved dramatically when he got to Attfield's barn, before tailing off late in the year. He did have some trouble in his last, but we're not convinced it made a huge difference in his figure, so while he is the best horse on his best race, he has not run well enough in his last three to win this under high weight. Note that Attfield's record at Gulfstream is not nearly as good as overall (trainer profile).

3 South Handyman (Arg) Southern Halo Bravo 12-1
 Has decent Southern Hemisphere form that is hard to quantify, but would have to improve dramatically on his American debut to threaten here.

4 Quasicobra Wild Rush Garcia 4-1
 Has always had a very erratic pattern, which is unusual for a grass horse. He ran two good figures early as a three-year-old, but it took him almost two years to improve on them, which he finally did last time. That is not a healthy sign, and while pairing that figure would put him in this at the weights, he's more likely to bounce.

5 Presious Passion Royal Anthem Trujillo 3-1
 Has always run a high percentage of tops, and gotten significantly better with age. His last three efforts matched the best of his life and, with good rest, he might well run that figure again. The problem here is that he spots eight pounds to Sligovitz, so running that well again may not be good enough. Note that this gelding has saved ground on the turns in a lot of races--there are a lot of 1w's, upper left.


6 Buddy's Humor Distorted Humor Lezcano 6-1
 Got good at Monmouth last summer with the rest of Levine's horses, but hasn't been quite as good since. His only try in a marathon was actually the best of his life, so distance should not be an issue, but there really is no reason to expect this colt to run his best now, especially given Levine's record at Gulfstream (see profile).

7 Nergal (Fr) Simon du Desert (Fr) Douglas 6-1
 Is a typical stake-level grass horse, in that he runs his top or close to it in every start. But he's never run fast enough to win this, and there is no reason to expect him to improve at age six.

Bottom Line: Sligovitz has a lot of things going for him, and will be a square price.

Agent Vic Gilardi Dies:

Vic Gilardi, a successful jockey's agent for several generations of New York riders, passed away Mar. 19 at Long Island Jewish Hospital. He was 78 years old. The Staten Island, New York, native, a U.S. Marine Corps veteran, started out booking mounts for his brother-in-law Tony Russo, and also represented jockeys Karl Korte, Tommy Lee, Kenny Church, Richard Migliore, Jorge Chavez and Shaun Bridgmohan. It was his 23-year relationship with jockey Jorge Velasquez that defined the career of Gilardi. "The best thing that ever happened to me was meeting Victor Gilardi and having him as my agent," said Velasquez, who retired in 1997 with 6,795 wins. "I was 19 in 1965 and I came to this country under contract to [owner] Fred Hooper. I was riding the last two weeks in Atlantic City without an agent when we hooked up." He continued, "Because of Vic, I am in the Hall of Fame and I won just about every major race in this country. Vic was a workaholic and knew everything about the game. His dedication was amazing, and everybody respected him. He was one of a kind and we always remained close. I learned a lot from him." Preceded in death by his wife of 55 years, Jean, who died Mar. 12, 2008, Gilardi is survived by three children and several grandchildren. Viewing will be held Tuesday and Wednesday, Mar. 24 and 25, at Bordentown Home for Funerals, 40 Crosswicks St., Bordentown, New Jersey. A funeral mass is set for Thursday, Mar. 26, at Saint Mary's Roman Catholic Church, 45 Crosswicks St., Bordentown.

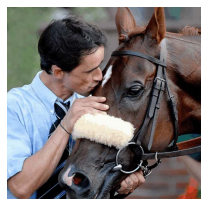

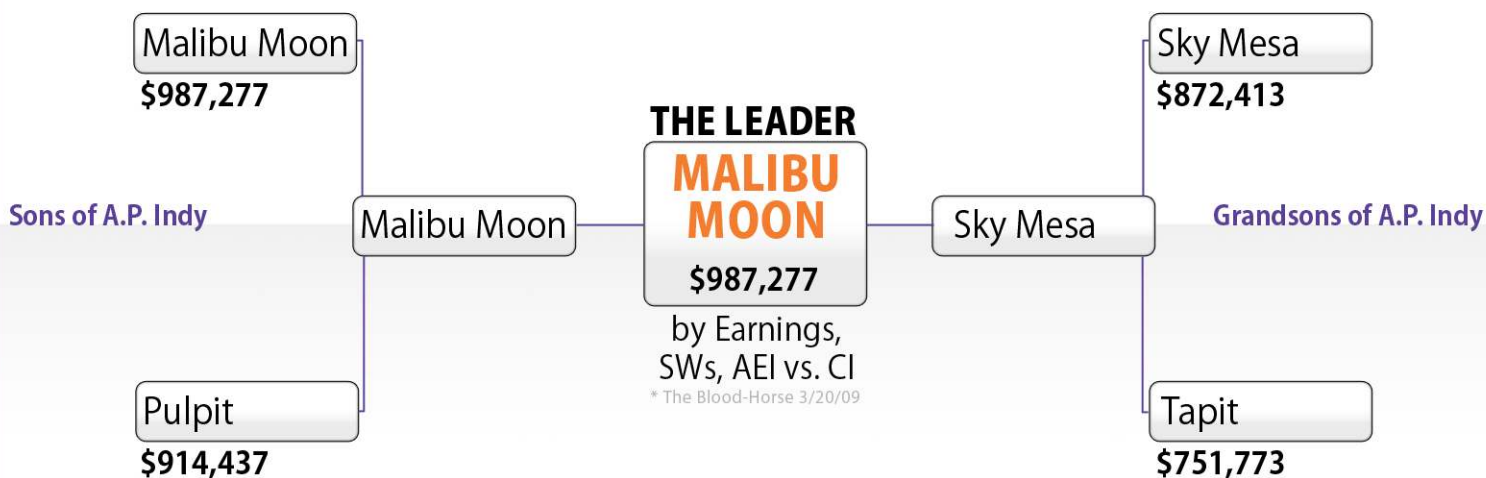

THE YEAR OF THE OXX? Trainer John Oxx revealed yesterday that ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Sea the Stars (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) has met with a setback. Christopher Tsui's homebred G2 Beresford S. winner had been touted as a potential Guineas contender in recent weeks, and his conditioner is hoping a slight fever will not affect the blueprint for the son of the recently deceased Urban Sea (Miswaki). "He has a 2000 Guineas entry at Newmarket [May 2], and the plan was to make up our minds through April whether or not we were going to go for that," Oxx explained. "It was probably never likely he would run in a trial before that and, while [the 2000 Guineas] is still the plan, unfortunately he had a little temperature last Tuesday. He's going to be without a canter for a week or so, so that is going to hold us up for 2 1/2 weeks, and we will have to see then what effect that has on our plans. It's still a possibility, as it's six weeks away, that he could be trained for the Guineas, but we're just going to have to monitor the situation now and play it by ear. He was ahead of schedule up to that point and working very nicely, so he's ahead of where we need to be, which is a help."

A Derby Candidate?

Oxx is looking at the June 6 G1 Epsom Derby for Sea the Stars, but has raised fears about the colt's staying power. "That race is the major consideration at the end of the day, but there is a question mark about his stamina, being by Cape Cross," he remarked. "I know he got an Oaks winner in Ouija Board, but we're looking at him as a possible influence for speed rather than stamina. We're unsure as to how far [Sea the Stars] is going to stay, and that is why we want to keep the option of the English and Irish Guineas open."

More News from the Land of Oxx...

Oxx also had news of another ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ in His Highness the Aga Khan's G2 Futurity S. winner **Arazan (Ire)** (Anabaa), who was last seen when third in the G1 National S. at The Curragh in September. "In the Futurity, he looked high class and the ground was bottomless for the National S.--it was the worst I've seen at The Curragh--so I'm inclined to excuse him, and Mick [Kinane] didn't punish him when he was a little adrift of the first two," he added. "The plan with him is to run in the 2000 Guineas first time out, but there is a little question mark about firm ground for him--he might not have liked it as heavy as it was in the National S., but we certainly don't want it very firm either. We'll make a late decision on that, but he's had a good winter and his work is pleasing us."

Oxx also stated that the Aga Khan's G3 Killavullan S. scorer **Rayeni (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) would be aimed at the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 23. "He's a potentially smart colt who has done nothing wrong, and it is more likely we will be aiming at the Irish 2000 Guineas," he continued, adding that Yukiko Hosokawa's Leopardstown maiden winner **Space Telescope (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and the Aga Khan's Listed Eyrefield S. scorer **Mourayan (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) would be aimed at the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 19.
