CAT FIGHT IN SANTA ANA

She was let go at 9-1 in the GII Santa Ana H., but **Belmont Cat (NZ)** (Felix the Cat) fought her way to a head victory at Santa Anita yesterday. A Listed winner in New Zealand, the rangy chestnut made her U.S. bow after a seven-month layoff and was ready for the test, winning a Hollywood allowance Dec. 3. The five-year-old weakened late to be a respectable fifth in the Jan. 4 GII San Gorgonio H., but had plenty of gas left at the

finish here. Rated in third off moderate fractions, Belmont Cat found running room between horses in the lane and outfinished **Bel Air Sizzle** (Unusual Heat) and odds-on **Visit (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) to prevail in a four-way photo. RUSSIAN SAGE TO SHEEMA CLASSIC

Team Valor International's MG1SW **Russian Sage**

(SAf) (Jallad), originally scheduled to compete in Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free S. at nine furlongs, will instead be entered in the 12-panel G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, it was announced yesterday. Twice a Group 1 winner in his native land last year, the bay will be trying the extended route of the Sheema Classic for the first time, but his connections are confident he will handle the trip.

"It's a gamble, but I think a very good one," said Justin Snaith, who conditioned Russian Sage in South Africa. "The way the course plays at Nad Al Sheba, I don't know if it suits Russian Sage going 1800 meters. The run in is very long and demanding. Justin Snaith added, "We trained his dam, you know, and she got every step of 2000 meters for us. She won five races, and two of them were over 2000 meters. I always thought she would have gotten farther, too. Mike Sharkey [farm manager of Highlands Stud], who bred him, says he comes from a staying family, and on paper should see out the 2400 meters. His two best races last year came over 10 furlongs and he was certainly not stopping in either of those races. He relaxes and settles well, so this should help him see out the distance as well."

Russian Sage, out of Sage Blue (SAf) (Badger Land), is now in the hands of trainer Mike de Kock, who captured last year's Sheema Classic with Sun Classique (Aus). The Southern Hemisphere four-year-old has started twice at Nad Al Sheba this year, finishing second in a handicap Feb. 6 and dead-heated for the runner-up spot in the G3 Jebel Hatta Mar. 5.

"If Russian Sage runs back to his last race, it could be good enough to win the Sheema," Team Valor International owner Barry Irwin said. "If he improves, he would be difficult to peg back."

Jim Bolger's team have hit the 2009 season running, and Oh Goodness Me led the way on this opener to the Irish turf season. A maiden winner at Gowran Park in September, the bay was second in both the Listed Lanwades and Staffordstown Stud S. at Fairyhouse in October and Listed Eyrefield S. at Leopardstown the following month. She was 12-1 in her return. Settled in second early as Firey Red took on the donkey work for stable companion and hot favorite Mad About You, Oh Goodness Me looked booked for third when that duo asserted inside the final quarter. But the winner proved game as the top two tired, and took the race with the final bob of her head. "She could be anything and she'll improve for a trip," rider Davy Moran remarked. Bolger added, "The trip is maybe a little on the sharp side, and I was worried about the ground beforehand, but she will be a big improver. I now have to make up my mind between the G3 Musidora S. [May 13], G1 Irish [May 24] and G1 English 1000 Guineas [May 3]; and the [July 12] G1 Irish and [June 5] G1 English Oaks." Derby Still a Possibility for Square Eddie?

After watching the colt breeze three furlongs in :37.40 at Hollywood Sunday, trainer Doug O’Neill said, “We still have the [GI Kentucky] Derby in mind,” for GI Lane’s End Breeders’ Futurity hero **Square Eddie** (Smart Strike). The chestnut colt, runner-up in the Oct. 25 GI Breeders’ Cup Juvenile, was sidelined with sore shins after finishing second in the Jan. 17 GII San Rafael S. Yesterday’s work was his first since a bullet five-eighths in :58.80 Feb. 2.

Theregoesjojo Readies for Florida Derby

After missing an intended work Saturday due to inclement weather, Samotowka Stables’ **Theregoesjojo** (Brahms) had his final major work at Gulfstream yesterday ahead of this weekend’s GI Florida Derby. Sent out shortly before the break, the Ken McPeek-trained colt carved out fractions of :25 2/5, :37 4/5 and 1:03 around the ‘dogs’ before completing six furlongs in 1:15 1/5.

Listed among nominees for the G1 Epsom Oaks in June, the chestnut, who was a close-up second in the one-mile Caressing S. on the Churchill Downs turf last November, worked five furlongs in 1:01 1/5 at Palm Meadows Mar. 13.



RACING Round-Up

Unbridled Express Returns Thursday

Unraced since running third to Circular Quay (Thunder Gulch) in the 2006 edition of the GI Hopeful S., **Unbridled Express** (Unbridled’s Song--Skye Castles, by Sky Classic) will make his return in the second race at Oaklawn Park Thursday. Now five, the Conway and Hillerich homebred bested subsequent GI Kentucky Derby hero Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}) by four lengths when breaking his maiden at Churchill Downs in July of his juvenile season. “He suffered a small crack in his pastern in his last race, so we turned him out to heal,” trainer Bernie Flint explained. “It should have only taken two to three months to heal, but he kicked a fence and battled infections. He then had some other issues come up and we had to take care of those.” Unbridled Express drew the rail against five rivals in his return, a 5 1/2-furlong allowance test. “I own 25 percent of him, and I know the rest of the owners are pumped about getting him back to the races,” said Flint. “I have never trained a horse coming off such a long layoff like him, but he looks amazing. He looks like a multimillion dollar horse should.”

Partnered by Johnny Murtagh in the first of three groups to gallop, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G1 2000 Guineas-bound chestnut worked over seven furlongs along with the G2 Champagne S. winner and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf runner-up **Westphalia (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). "[Mastercraftsman] got a little tired, but he was entitled to," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "It was tacky ground and Westphalia was the same too, but at the same time they swung along. Westphalia could be aimed at the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [French 2000 Guineas at Longchamp May 10] and could have a trial for that, but he is still very much in the Newmarket picture." In the second group of potential Derby contenders, Murtagh was on the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud fourth **Age of Aquarius (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and he finished in behind High Chaparral's brother ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Black Bear Island (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). O'Brien said of the latter, "You would have to be very impressed with him. They could be a fair bunch of horses." Also in the second group was last year's G1 Irish Derby winner **Frozen Fire (Ger)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who is set for a comeback run over 10 furlongs at The Curragh and the G1 Coronation Cup-bound **Septimus (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Last to appear was G3 Tyros S. scorer **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Murtagh was on board to steer him in a pack that included triple G1 Gold Cup hero **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). The Ballydoyle conditioner revealed that Rip Van Winkle, who was last seen when seventh in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October, had suffered a recent setback. "He missed a good bit of time," he said. "Johnny said he was very fresh, but I'd be happy with that. He got a bad over-reach and missed six weeks, but I'd still be happy. We've plenty of time between now and Newmarket."

COLLECTION TAKES HONG KONG DERBY

Collection (Ire) (Peintre Celebre--Lasting Chance, by American Chance), winner of the Listed Hampton Court S. at Ascot in June before he was sold to Hong Kong interests, lived up to the billing as the 2-5 favorite to take the G1-HK Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby over 2000 meters at Sha Tin Sunday. The four-year-old raced in 12th in the opening salvos behind a slow pace before jockey Darren Beadman asked the gelding to engage the leaders early. Despite moving into second with a half mile left, the bay had plenty in reserve in the stretch and was never threatened, defeating runner-up Thumbs Up (NZ) (Shinko King {Ire}) by 1 1/2 lengths, with an additional three lengths back to Mr Medici (Ire) (Medicean {GB}) in third.

The final time, over a turf labeled good, was 2:02.50. "I had to play the cards that were dealt to me," Beadman said of the decision to move early. "The pace was very muddling, but he is quite a seasoned horse given that he raced over this sort of ground in Europe at a high level."

Following a fifth in the G2-Tur Topkapi Trophy in September, the gelding was purchased by trainer John Moore's ownership syndicate from previous owner Highclere Thoroughbred Racing Ltd. "I had my eyes on [Collection] for months in the hope that the Highclere would sell him, and eventually we were able to get him," Moore said. "I first saw him in July, and I had to convince the members of my trainer syndicate that this was the horse we had to get, and it's wonderful that it has all paid off." Moore has opted to point Collection towards the G1 Champions Mile Apr. 26 in order to keep him separate from stablemate Viva Pataca (GB) (Marju {Ire}), who is aiming for the 2000-meter G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup on the same card. "I don't think it would be a good idea to have them bumping into each other at this stage, because Viva Pataca has been unlucky not to win more of these international Group 1 races, and I want to give him his fair chance to win another one at his age while Collection is still improving," the conditioner explained. Both Moore trainees could meet in the G1-HK Champions at Chater Cup over 2400 meters May 31.
