## KEENELAND OPENS WITH TRANSYLVANIA

Keeneland kicks off its 2009 Spring Meet this afternoon with a 10-race card, highlighted by the \$150,000 GIII Central Bank Transylvania S. With no stakes winners among the eight horses entered in the Transylvania, a 1 1/16-mile grass event for three-year-olds, the race is a wide-open



affair on paper. That's reflected by the fact that seven of the eight are 10-1 or less on the morning line, including the tepid 2-1 chalk **Stormalory** (Storm Cat), part of an uncoupled entry representing Darley. The impeccably bred Bill Mott trainee, whose granddam is the blue hen Halory, rallied from well back to take his grass debut in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 5 before completing the trifecta while beaten only a length in the GIII Palm Beach H. Mar. 14. The other Darley colt is the Kiaran McLaughlin-trained **Florentino (Jpn)** (Swept Overboard). The bay saw a complete reversal in form once switched to the grass in his fourth career start. A front-running sort, he broke his maiden at Gulfstream going long Jan. 15, was second in an allowance there Feb. 5 and looked sharp in a 2 3/4-length romp Mar. 1. He makes his stakes debut under regular rider Alan Garcia. First post today is 1:05 p.m.

## SONGANDAPRAYER COLT FLIES AT KEEAPR

A colt by Songandaprayer recorded the fastest one-furlong breeze during yesterday's under-tack preview of next week's Keeneland April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale in Lexington, blitzing the eighth of a mile over the Polytrack in :09.4 ([video](#)). The dark bay colt, consigned by Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stables, Inc. as [hip 23](#), is out of Beach Bunny (Storm Bird) and is from the family of Regal Intention, Tiffany's Secret and Carry the Crown. The two-year-old was purchased by Mike Akers's Dapple Bloodstock for \$110,000 at last fall's Fasig-Tipton Midlantic sale. "He was probably the best horse in the Maryland sale last October," said Dunne. "He was the talking horse in that sale and, fortunately for us, he's as good on the racecourse as he is on the end of a shank." The juvenile was a May 3 foal, but is a mature-looking two-year-old. "He's a May foal who looks like a January foal," Dunne said. [Hip 65](#), a son of Forestry, turned in the day's fastest two-furlong drill of :20.4. Out of Juke (Mr. Prospector), the juvenile is a half brother to Grade I placed sophomore filly Haka (Dynaformer) and is consigned by Kirkwood Stables. **Cont. p2**

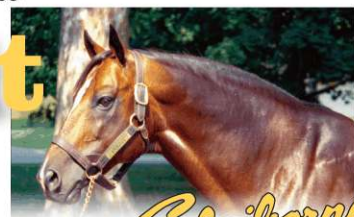

**Nice Weather, Nice Horses...**

Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell was pleased with both the turnout and the weather at yesterday's preview show and is looking forward to next week's sale. "We had a very well-attended gallop show today and beautiful weather," Russell said. "The horses performed very well, so now it's up to the buyers to decide what they're worth." The April sale takes place next Monday and Tuesday with sessions beginning each evening at 7 p.m.

**Stardom Bound Brother to Miss Keeneland...**

Buyers hoping to bring home a sibling of champion Stardom Bound (Tapit) will be disappointed at Keeneland. A two-year-old half brother to the talented gray filly, bred by Stardom Bound's breeders Fletcher and Carolyn Gray and John Youngblood, had been catalogued as [hip 194](#), but has been withdrawn from the sale. "He was just a little immature," Fletcher Gray said of the dark bay colt from the first crop of Grade I winner Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus). "He's a late May baby and he wasn't quite ready to make the sale. We're just trying to maximize what we have--if you're product is not ready, then you just don't need to be

there." Gray did not rule out a possible sale in the future. "We will go ahead and give him a little time off and put him in training and hope he does well and creates some interest," he said. "We're prepared to race him or sell him."

The colt was also catalogued and withdrawn from last year's Keeneland September sale. While the Grays and Youngblood are not opposed to racing their own stock, their focus is on selling.

"I feel like you have to be prepared to race everything you breed," Gray said. "We're primarily commercial breeders, but we're definitely not opposed to racing."

The Grays and Youngblood sold Stardom Bound's dam My White Corvette (Tarr Road) for \$825,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale. The mare's 2008 filly by Lion Heart was led out unsold in November for \$350,000. The trio still own the filly and, according to Gray, the now-yearling is doing, "Great." She is one that might race for her breeders. "We may end up keeping her," Gray said. "We're not sure yet."

Another well-related withdrawal from next week's sale is [hip 50](#), a half brother by Pleasantly Perfect to multiple graded stakes winner Justwhistledixie (Dixie Union), who was consigned by Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stables. "Unfortunately when we prepped him last week he bucked his shins," explained Dunne. "He's a horse that we think is pretty exceptional, so rather than put him through the breeze show and risk hurting him, we decided that discretion was the better part of valor and we'll either sell him privately or we'll run him. He's a horse we have a lot of faith in." The colt was purchased by Dapple Bloodstock for \$35,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale.

## Square Eddie Team Still Hope to Make Derby...

Trainer Doug O'Neill and his team are still hoping that J. Paul Reddam's **Square Eddie** (Smart Strike) can make the GI Kentucky Derby May 3. Winner of last year's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the Ontario-bred breezed four furlongs Monday at Santa Anita in :50.80 as he progresses from shin problems. "We're moving along," said Dennis O'Neill, Doug's brother and associate. "He'll work again Sunday, five-eighths and [gallop] out three-quarters. He came out of the work really good, but we're just

kind of going week to week." Square Eddie hasn't raced since finishing second to The Pamplemousse (Kafwain) in the Jan. 17 GIII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita.

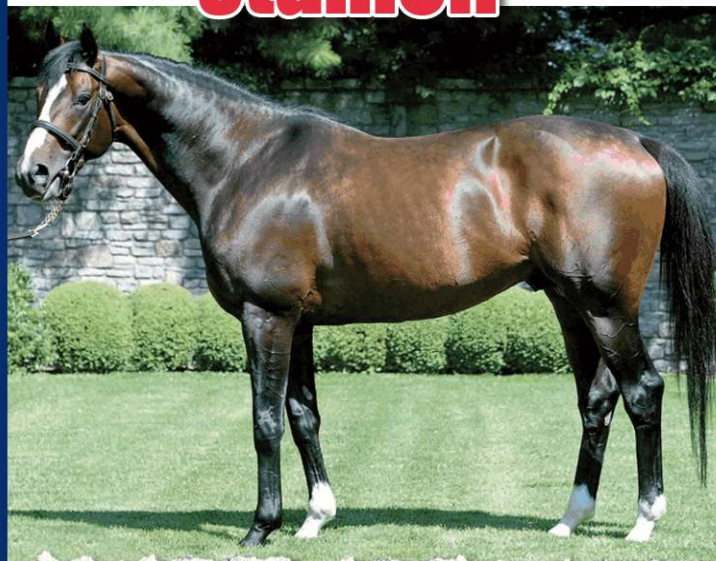
## Allowance, or Blue Grass, for Hello Broadway...

**After Big Allowance Win, Hull Goes to Coolmore Lex...**

Team Valor International, Gary Barber and Heiligbrodt Racing Stable's **Hull** (Holy Bull), a recent late nomination to the Triple Crown, was tabbed **"TDN Rising Star"** after an impressive 7 3/4-length allowance win at Turfway Park yesterday ([video](#)), stopping the clock in 1:16 1/5--just four ticks off the track record--despite being geared down in the final eighth. The colt is now two- for-two for trainer Dale Romans, having captured his debut at Fair Grounds Feb. 7 ([video](#)). Connections said in a release last night that the colt will wheel right back in 16 days GII \$300,000 GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland on Apr. 18, and will then set his sights on either the GI Kentucky Derby or the GI Preakness S. Team Valor, Barber and Heiligbrodt have campaigned several Grade I winners in partnership, including Golden Ballet and Cashier's Dream.

**'Evita' Will Reappear Next in Beaumont...**

Halo Farms and Three Sisters Thoroughbreds' **Evita Argentina** (Candy Ride {Arg}) will return to face her own sex in next Wednesday's GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland after beating the boys in the GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita Feb. 16. Trainer John Sadler said a strong effort in the about-seven-furlong Beaumont could extend her stay in the Bluegrass. "If she runs big in the Beaumont, we may stay for the big one," Sadler said, referring to the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2. "It would

be a being-in-the-neighborhood kind of thing." Evita Argentina breezed six furlongs at Keeneland on Wednesday under exercise rider Dana Barnes. She stopped the clock in 1:13 2/5. "I'm very happy with it; it was a good work," said Sadler. "I got her in 1:13 4/5."

Before his Gotham romp, I Want Revenge was nosed-out by Pioneerof the Nile (Empire Maker) in the GI CashCall Futurity over Hollywood Park's Cushion Track Dec. 20, then was third to that rival and Papa Clem (Smart Strike) in the Gil Robert B. Lewis

S. on Pro-Ride at Santa Anita Feb. 7 in his first start wearing blinkers. Mullins attributed the colt's improvement in the Gotham to the switch in surfaces.

"His stride is a lot more fluid [over dirt]," Mullins said in a teleconference Thursday. "It seems like he strides further. He carries his head a little higher. On synthetics he kinda has a lot of knee action. He carries his head really low. He just moves a lot more efficiently over the dirt."

I Want Revenge's dirt debut impressed IEAH Stables, owner of last year's Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness winner Big Brown (Boundary), and the syndicate decided to buy a 50-percent stake in I Want Revenge at a price owner/breeder David Lanzman described to the *Daily Racing Form* as a 'life-changing score.'

Mullins was never concerned his Derby hopeful would be transferred to another trainer.

"I was pretty much guaranteed that the horse was not going to leave the barn at any point during any type of sale, unless the horse was sold 100 percent," he said.

The trainer initially considered keeping the Gotham winner in New York, but decided to return him to his base at Hollywood Park.

"We figured we had plenty of time--we had four weeks [between the Gotham and the Wood]," Mullins explained. "He'd probably be a lot happier at home. The weather was a lot nicer at home."

If the big effort and cross-country trips took anything out of I Want Revenge, he hasn't showed it in his workouts. The dark bay sports three quick drills since the Gotham, including a :59 4/5 breeze at Hollywood Park Mar. 29 most recently.

"I couldn't ask for him to be any better right now," the trainer said. Mullins was reluctant to compare I Want Revenge to his previous Derby contenders, but did admit "at this stage of the game, this horse is probably the best shot I've ever had." -JF

The versatility of **Kelly Leak** (Runaway Groom) was on display once again when the sophomore drove to a professional 1 1/4-length score under jockey Mike Smith in last Sunday's \$800,000 Sunland Derby in New Mexico. Victorious on the dirt, turf and the synthetic, the bay was good enough to cross the wire first in the 6 1/2-furlong GII Best Pal S. at

Del Mar last August, but was later demoted to fourth after drifting in the lane. A close-up second behind the talented Flashmans Papers (GB) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in the one-mile Eddie Logan S. on the lawn at Santa

Anita Dec. 27, the Florida-bred was third behind winner This Ones for Phil--recent winner of the GII Swale S.--in the Sunshine Millions Dash for statebreds Jan. 24. Kelly Leak added a score in a one-mile allowance on the grass at Santa Anita Feb. 22 before taking Sunland Park's nine-furlong crown jewel.

Trainer Mike Machowsky, who was fueled by earlier success at the juvenile sales after having purchased three-time Grade I winner Southern Image (Halos Image) for \$300,000 at OBSMAR in 2002, didn't have an owner already lined up for the handsome son of Runaway Groom, but the conditioner thought enough of the colt to go to \$110,000 at last year's OBS March Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale.

"There were a few people that I knew would probably take a piece of the horse, but we had to just wait and see," explained Machowsky.

Ultimately, Machowsky formed a partnership consisting of six shareholders to campaign the colt, including Don Blahut, who holds a majority interest in the colt with 30 percent; Dennis Avila and David Johnson.

Blahut, who was also a major share holder in Southern Image, has had horses under the care of Machowsky ever since the horseman took out his training license 17 years ago.

Machowsky, who attends many of the season's juvenile sales, admits that he doesn't show up with an order to fill, rather relies on the quality of stock available, and his trained eye, to decide whether he will make the investment. According to Machowsky, Kelly Leak was easy to spot.

"He's a very racy-looking individual," said Machowsky, explaining the colt's allure. "He was really a very attractive horse and I really liked the way he moved. In general, I'm a pretty critical person when it comes to conformation. As a trainer, I guess I have come to the point that I know what I can and what I can't accept in a horse in terms of conformation."

After having frequented the sales for years, Machowsky has relied on a system of selecting young horses that has served him well, and which was once again in evidence with the purchase of Kelly Leak.

"I am very particular in buying a well-balanced and racy-looking individual," he explained. "Whether it's a yearling or two-year-old sale, I'm very particular on mechanics on a horse. I want a good moving horse whether he's on the track or watching him walk up and down the shedrow. I don't like buying them too young because they are changing all the time, so I tend to gravitate towards buying them older which is why I like the two-year-old sales. I've had pretty good luck with that, so I think I'll stick with it."

In retrospect, Machowsky felt that Kelly Leak brought approximately what he thought the juvenile would bring, given that he was by an older stallion. In the end, that probably turned out to mean a better deal for Machowsky.

"People were probably a little bit down on Runaway Groom because he's a older stallion," he said. "Often at these sales, people are into the younger more fashionable stallions and they forget about a quality older stallion like Runaway Groom. Sometimes you can get some real value with these older stallions"

According to Machowsky, Kelly Leak, who will remain on the dirt and compete at distances ranging between a mile and a mile and an eighth, could make his next start in either the GIII Lone Star Derby or the GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont, both scheduled for May 9. Although based on the West Coast, Machowsky indicated that shipping the colt east for his next start was more of a function of necessity than choice.

"There aren't a whole lot of races out here in California until about July, so we figured we'd just have to ship him a time or two," explained Machowsky. "But he has shown that he can handle it well, so I'm not worried about that."

While Kelly Leak's next start is expected to be on a traditional dirt surface, Machowsky indicated that he wouldn't rule out another go on either the turf or a synthetic surface later in the season.

"I think he just has better opportunities right now on the dirt, but that doesn't mean I won't run him back on the grass at a later date," he added. "He could run in the GI Del Mar Derby [nine furlongs, Aug. 31], which is on the grass, later this summer, but for now he'll probably stay on the dirt."-CB
