They sounded the call for **General Quarters** (Sky Mesa) at Keeneland yesterday afternoon, and the colt responded, powering down the lane to take the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. by 1 1/2 lengths. It was an emotional victory for owner/trainer Tom McCarthy, a Louisville resident who claimed the grey for \$20,000 after a maiden score at Churchill Downs last May. COME TO PAPA

Sent off the even-money favorite in yesterday's GII Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Park, **Old Fashioned** (Unbridled's Song) tried gamely to go gate to wire, but he couldn't hold off the hard-charging **Papa Clem** (Smart Strike). The bay came into the race with only a Dec. 29 maiden win at Santa Anita to his credit, but he was second by a half-length behind Pioneerof the Nile (Empire Maker) in the Feb. 7 GII Robert B. Lewis S. Trying a conventional dirt track for the first time in the Mar. 14 GII Louisiana Derby, Papa Clem had to contend with a sloppy surface and finished a distant runner-up to Friesan Fire (A.P. Indy). But the Bo Hirsch homebred had no trouble with the Oaklawn strip, driving past a grudging Old Fashioned to get to the wire a half-length in front. "I think the big difference was that we only shipped in for the Louisiana Derby two days before the race," trainer Gary Stute explained. "He's never been on a regular dirt track, and he never got to work over it. This time we shipped in three weeks early, and he had trained super ever since we got here." The colt had three works in Hot Springs, including a bullet five-eighths in :58 4/5 Apr. 5. **Old Fashioned Injured**, p3

General Quarters had an inauspicious beginning to his career. A \$20,000 KESEEP yearling purchase for Ken and Sarah Ramsey, he didn't show a lot during his

morning trials and debuted for a \$20,000 tag at Churchill at the end of May. The grey battled his way to a neck victory as the 4-5 chalk and was haltered by Tom McCarthy. Off the board in the GIII Bashford Manor

S. July 5 and, after a short break, in a Keeneland allowance test Oct. 4, he came right back to be second in Lexington two weeks later. General Quarters tried the turf in an allowance at Churchill Nov. 8, but faded to eighth. He improved to be third on the dirt in Louisville Nov. 29 before heading south for the winter. McCarthy shipped his former claimer to trainer Mark Miller at Tampa, and filled only the role of owner when the colt ran second in the Dec. 27 Inaugural S. and Jan. 17 Pasco S. Miller also tightened the girth before the Feb. 14 GIII Sam F. Davis S., but after General Quarters drove home a 3 1/2-length winner, McCarthy took charge once again. He was the trainer of record for a troubled fifth-place showing in the Mar. 14 GIII Tampa Bay Derby, and again in his final prep for the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby. "He trained like a champion all week, and...I knew I had him right where I wanted him," McCarthy said.

Let go at 14-1 in the Blue Grass, General Quarters was in hand just off the leaders as an eager Join in the Dance (Sky Mesa) took them through a half in :49.06 and three-quarters in 1:13.31. Jockey Eibar Coa eased General Quarters to the outside as they approached the final bend, collaring the leader as they entered the stretch. Coa manned the battle stations and General Quarters was ready to fire, pulling away to a decisive score. "He was very professional," Coa said. "In the straight, when I asked him, he gave me what he had. He showed up today, and he's definitely going to be one of the horses to beat in the Derby." GII Lane's End S. hero Hold Me Back, a rallying second as the 2-1 choice, also punched his ticket to the "Run for the Roses." Trainer Bill Mott remarked, "If you look at the upside, it's a good thing he gave an honest and hard race. He'll have a little more pace down the road; that can't hurt him. The camp is anxious to go to Churchill." Jockey Kent Desormeaux added, "He handled the crowd and the parade, all the horses around him—he did all of that really well. I think he's been fine-tuned today, and the next one is the one we shoot for. I would have liked to have won today, of course, but it was a very encouraging effort."  'em the slip on the far turn,
 and dug in when joined by
 Papa Clem in the stretch,
 but gave way grudgingly.
 Unfortunately, Old Fash-

ioned suffered a non-displaced slab fracture of his right
 knee in the race and will miss the GI Kentucky Derby at
 a minimum, *Daily Racing Form* reports. He will be sent
 to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington Monday
 to be evaluated further. "It's not life-threatening, it
 should be okay," trainer Larry Jones told the publica-
 tion. "Career-ending is a possibility just because of the

Dream Play is at her best when she can get to the
 early lead. The dark bay went gate to wire to break her
 maiden in her May 15 debut at Belmont Park, then was
 sidelined for the remainder of the season. Making her comeback in
 an optional claimer Jan. 11, the Stewart Armstrong colorbearer
 had to settle for fourth after get-
 ting checked at the break. She
 turned it around to romp by
 8 1/4 lengths in the Dearly Pre-
 cious S. on Valentine's Day. The
 odds-on chalk in the Mar. 14 GIII Cicada S., Dream Play
 had to concede the lead to Heart Ashley (Lion Heart)
 after getting off to a slow start and ran second all the
 way around, missing by 2 1/2 lengths. There were no
 troubles at the gate this time. Sent right to the front by

 half in :48.16 over the sloppy track. She had daylight

A troubled third behind Ventura (Chester House) in the June 7 GI Just a Game S. at Belmont, she rebounded with a win in the July 26 GI Diana S. Third again in the Sept. 7 GII Canadian S., she made amends when taking the Oct. 3 GI First Lady S. at Keeneland, and sealed the Eclipse envelope when she ran down Sealy Hill (Point Given) and Wait a While (Maria's Mon) in the Oct. 24 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Trainer Jonathan Sheppard had the mare sitting on ready for her five-year-old bow. Content to gallop along at the back of the pack as I Lost My Choo (Western Expression) set the pace, Forever Together was fanned five wide at the top of the lane and rolled down the lane to win handily. A three-time stakes winner last year, Eternal Star followed a neck win in the James Marvin S. at Saratoga with a fourth in the Aug. 30 GI Forego S. The chestnut was freshened off that effort, returning to be second in the Oct. 25 GIII Sport Page H. at Belmont Park. An optional-claiming score at Laurel Nov. 27 polished off the campaign. Eternal Star opened 2009 with a second in similar company Jan. 8, and wasn't quite up to the task when fourth in the GII General George H. Feb. 16. He was last seen closing to be second by a head in the Mar. 7 GIII Toboggan S. on the Big A inner track. A little more early foot resulted in a trip to the winner's circle here. Ravalo (Mutakddim) and My Pal Charlie duked it out on the front end through a half in :46.12 and were still one-two when they turned for home. But Eternal Star, a stalking third through the opening exchanges, hit the gas to catch the leaders inside the final furlong and had enough left to quash Rebellion. Heros Reward was first or second in nine of his 10 starts in 2007, and reeled off three straight stakes victories last season, including the June 22 GIII Highlander S. at Woodbine and the Aug. 1 Pennsylvania Governor's Cup H. at Penn National. Second in the Sept. 1 Turf Monster H. at Philly Park, the peripatetic gelding concluded the campaign with a fourth in the Oct. 4 GII Nearctic H. in Toronto and a respectable fifth in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Santa Anita three weeks later. He was making his 2009 bow here. Defending Shakertown champ Mr. Nightlinger (Indian Charlie), who faded to 11th in the BC Turf Sprint last time out, went to the head of affairs at the start and cut out splits of :22.25 and :45.87 over the rain-dampened course. Mr. Nightlinger tried to kick away from the field when they straightened for home, but the closers were winding up on the wide outside, and it was Heros Reward who had the most to offer, getting past Cannonball in the final stride to take the photo.

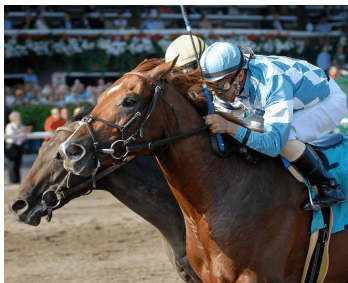

Hello Preakness?

Elizabeth Valando's homebred **Hello Broadway** (Broken Vow), a disappointing seventh in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 14, is under consideration for the GI Preakness S. after recording a Keeneland allowance win Friday. Trainer Barclay Tagg had also considered the GI Blue Grass S. for the GIII Nashua S. and GII Hutcheson S. runner-up, but opted for the easier spot. "I didn't want to throw him to the wolves," Tagg revealed. "He's had enough tough races. He broke his maiden first time out and has had nothing but tough

races since." As for what's next Tagg said, "I'm not sure, maybe the Preakness. I'll take a good look at the Preakness and maybe some races in New York. I haven't had a chance to look anything up yet. We'll make some A, B and C plans." Valando and Tagg also campaigned Hello Broadway's half-brother, GISW Nobiz Like Shobiz (Albert the Great). "They're both big; they're both very good-looking," Tagg said of the duo. "I think [Hello Broadway] is as good a horse as Nobiz; I hope he is. I think this is a very nice horse. I don't know what happens to him in his races, but he trains well and I don't think he's a morning glory. I think he's a very special horse. I just don't think he's as mature right at this stage in his three-year-old year as Nobiz was."

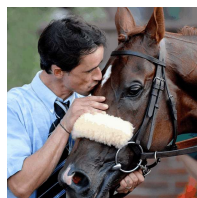
