## PERFECT VISION

Last year's G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) kept the G1 Prix Ganay Grand Prix Air Mauritius at home yesterday with a smooth success. A respectable third under a penalty in his return in the Apr. 5 G2 Prix d'Harcourt over 10 furlongs of this circuit, the bay stripped sharper here and justified 7-5 favoritism with a surge of acceleration that sealed victory approaching the eighth pole. Kept up to his work late on by lortiz Mendizabal, he was beyond recall as **Loup Breton (Ire)** (Anabaa) closed to within 3/4 of a length at the line. Cont. p2

## ZENYATTA TO DEBUT IN LOUISVILLE

Reigning champion distaffer **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) will make her 2009 debut in the 1 1/16-mile GII Louisville Distaff at Churchill Downs May 1, John Shirreffs confirmed Sunday. "She looks like she's getting ready right now, and I didn't want to particularly train her for a couple more weeks," Shirreffs told *Daily Racing Form*. Winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff over a synthetic surface last October, the powerful mare is scheduled to be shipped from her Hollywood Park base to Louisville today. Owned by Jerry and Ann Moss, Zenyatta--who is undefeated in nine lifetime starts--won her only prior start on the dirt, and that was in Oaklawn's GI Apple Blossom H. last April. In her final work before leaving California, Zenyatta covered five furlongs in :59 flat at Hollywood Sunday. Despite shipping a long way for her next start, the mare's connections revealed that their superstar would only line up if the ship goes off without a hitch. "Everything has to be perfect," emphasized Jerry Moss. "We won't run her unless she's 100 percent."

Under the radar before the French Derby last June, Vision d'Etat emerged from that Classic with his perfect record intact, and went straight to the G2 Prix Niel over the Arc course and distance in September. Capturing that vital trial with relative comfort, he faced Zarkava

(Ire) and company at the top of his game in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, but could only manage a fifth placing behind the star filly after a troubled trip. His comeback third behind Trincot (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) in the d'Harcourt set him up for this test, and his subsequent homework suggested he was

continuing to come forward. Vision d'Etat was keen in third early while trapped behind the steady Prix Ganay tempo set by Thewayyouare (Kingmambo), who was pressed by his stable companion Red Rock Canyon (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). A gap appeared when Red Rock Canyon started to tire at the quarter pole and, after receiving a bump from his stablemate there, Vision d'Etat was extricated by Ioritz Mendizabal and soon had Thewayyouare's measure, sealing the result as Loup Breton and Adlerflug finished strongly to fill the places. "He is a typical mile-and-a-quarter horse who loves some pace and rhythm in his races; that was not the case today, but he still managed to come through," trainer and half-owner Eric Libaud commented. "He quickened nicely and fully deserved that." Libaud has Royal Ascot in mind for the winner. "He will run in the [June 17] G1 Prince of Wales's S. next, and the pace should be faster there, which will certainly suit him," he said. Loup Breton will sidestep the Royal meeting, according to conditioner Elie Lellouche. "He ran a super race and I can't complain," Lellouche commented. "I took him to Royal Ascot for the Prince of Wales's last year and things didn't work out, so I did not enter him this time, and he will instead come back here for the [May 17] G1 Prix d'Ispahan." 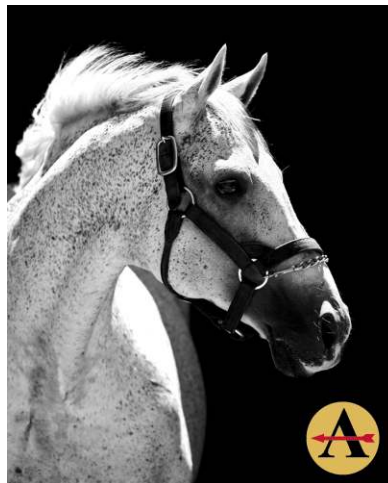

Sight Winner ran second to Egyptian Ra in the Hong Kong Mile Trial back November, but had been off the board in his five subsequent starts. Fourth behind the Trial winner in the Mar. 15 Queen's Silver Jubilee, he most recently finished fifth at 23-1 in the Apr. 5 Chairman's Trophy, and was given little chance by the Sha Tin bettors here. Off at 64-1, Sight Winner pressured pacesetter Egyptian Ra early and grabbed a narrow lead 200 meters from the wire. The bay was all out in the closing yards, holding on as that determined rival rallied and Australian invader Dao Dao came charging to nearly make it a triple dead heat. "It's a nice surprise, but [trainer John Size] seemed quietly confident in the paddock beforehand, so that got my confidence up a little," jockey Brett Prebble said. "We had a game plan to sit outside Egyptian Ra... and, at the top of straight, I went past him. I knew he'd give me more because he can stay 1800 meters and 2000 meters. Trainer Luca Cumani has had to settle for second in no less than five international races around the world over the last 18 months, but he finally got his win at Sha Tin Sunday. Cumani sent out second choice Presvis in Hong Kong's premier spring event, and watched as the gelding charged from last to first to take it by a length over local hero and favorite Viva Pataca. A handicap winner at Sandown and Newbury last season, Presvis opened his 2009 campaign with a pair of handicap victories at Nad Al Sheba Jan. 22 and Feb. 26. The bay was sent off at 20-1 in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Duty Free S., but belied those odds to run second, 3 1/4 lengths behind loose-on-the-lead winner Gladiatorus (Silic {Fr}).

**Going One Better...**

Better backed this time, Presvis was settled at the tail end of the field early and still had them all to beat 300 meters from home. But jockey Ryan Moore sent the five-year-old up the rail in the stretch, and the two charged to a decisive score. Viva Pataca had taken over in the stretch, but was no match for the winner late. "That went perfectly." Moore said. "I was happy to sit in last, as the gallop was honest on that ground. I was never worried, as he was handling the ground well, and when I asked him once he picked up one horse and I knew he'd pick them all up." An elated Cumani added, "Presvis showed in Dubai that he belonged in Group 1 company and he's proved himself today." Jockey Darren Beadman was pleased with the effort of the runner-up. "He's run his usual honest race," Beadman said. "I thought he'd win half way up the straight, but then along came Presvis, and that was that." **MGISW Niconero Injured...**

Seven-year-old **Niconero (Aus)** (Danzero {Aus}), winner of five Group 1 events in Australia, including the MRC Futurity and VRC Australian Cup in 2009, crossed the line in eighth, but was not persevered with late. Jockey Craig Williams explained, "I eased him out of the race because he felt that he'd broken down in the near foreleg." Indeed, the QEII will be the gelding's last race. "It's confirmed that he's bowed a tendon in that leg and it's probably career ending," trainer David Hayes said. "I can't believe it, because he's been such a good horse to us and, incredibly, I'd say he's the soundest horse I've ever trained." Owned by P B Devitt, L C Gordon and D A Hayes, Niconero retires with a record of 55-13-5-5 and earnings of \$2,557,687.

# FIRST STARTER FIRST WINNER

**MIDST**, a 2YO from the first-crop of Kentucky Derby runner-up and Graded Stakes winner **Closing Argument** (\$986,984), inherits her sire's precocity as she posts an impressive 4 1/4 length maiden win at Keeneland on April 24th.



**Hold Me Back Gets Final Major Tuneup...**

WinStar Farm's **Hold Me Back** (Giant's Causeway) received his final serious work ahead of Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs yesterday. Working in company with stablemate Flying Warrior (Fusaichi Pegasus), the dark bay--accompanied by Kent Desormeaux--covered five furlongs in 1:01.60. Sent out before 7 a.m., Hold Me Back reeled off fractions of :13, :25.20 and :37.20 before rounding out six furlongs in 1:14.80. The move was the 13th-fastest of 24 at the distance over a track rated as fast. The GII Lane's End S. winner broke off about a length and half behind Flying Warrior at the five-eighths pole, caught his workmate at the head of the stretch and moved by before the eighth pole. "I thought the work was very good," trainer Bill Mott said. "He was under a hold the whole way and finished well on his own. He appeared to handle the track very well and that is a good sign. Kent said he still wanted to gallop out after a mile."

**Quality Road Gets New Patch...**

Derby hopeful **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) was fitted with a new patch to secure the colt's latest quarter crack prior to a mile and three-quarter gallop Sunday morning at Churchill Downs. Despite exiting the routine gallop with a 'tinge of blood' seeping from the newest crack, the colt's connections remain hopeful that the bay would make it to the starting gate for the "Run for the Roses". "He's well on the mend," said hoof specialist Ian McKinlay, but added, "This is live tissue--we're not changing a flat tire, so there are a lot of judgement calls." McKinlay replaced a set of wires, inserted a drain, and then put a fresh acrylic patch on the crack, located on the inside of the Edward Evan homebred's right front hoof. "Everything had been stabilized, and, when I changed the wires today, the crack opened up," he said. "There was a bit of sensitive tissue aggravated during the process. Hopefully, there won't be a tinge of blood [Monday] when he breezes." Trainer Jimmy Jerkens said he would treat the hoof with a drying agent and a poultice yesterday. "He's got 24 hours to get better," added Jerkens. "He has to work to our liking and come out of it perfect. "If he takes one bad step anywhere, forget it. I would have liked to have seen no blood, but it didn't surprise me because he was still tender."

Shortly after the 8:30 a.m. renovation break, **Square Eddie** (Smart Strike), accompanied by exercise rider Tony Romero, drilled four furlongs in :50.20 at Churchill

Downs Sunday. The three-year-old broke off at the three-eighths pole, set internal splits of :12.80, :25 and :37.60, and finished up at the seven-eighths. He galloped out five panels in 1:03.20. "I thought it was an awesome work," said trainer Doug O'Neill. "We're very pleased with it. We know we're asking

a lot of this horse, but we think he's up to it." The Canadian-bred colt was runner-up to The Pamplemousse (Kafwain) in the GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita Jan. 17 before finishing third in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 18. "Obviously, when you want a horse to come back in two weeks following a three-month break in his racing schedule to run in a race as tough as the Kentucky Derby, you're asking a lot," added O'Neill. "The only way you could do that is to think you've got a 'super' horse. And in our minds that's what he is--a 'super' horse." According to O'Neill, who arrived in Kentucky Saturday, the chestnut is expected to jog Tuesday and gallop Wednesday and Thursday before rounding out preparations with jogging sessions Friday and Saturday.

**Mr. Hot Stuff Preps at Santa Anita...**

**Mr. Hot Stuff** (Tiznow) received his final major work at Santa Anita Sunday morning before boarding a plane and shipping to Churchill Downs today. The handsome dark bay completed five furlongs in 1:00.40 over Santa Anita's Pro-Ride surface. "We didn't ask him to do too much," said Eoin Harty. "He just went about it in good fashion and finished up well." Harty, who was scheduled to arrive in Louisville yesterday, said rider plans still have not been finalized for the WinStar-owned colt. "We're still working on it," he said. "We'll have one by Wednesday morning."

**Pletcher Team to Work Monday...**

While still in South Florida, trainer Todd Pletcher was well-represented Sunday as a pair of his Kentucky Derby-bound colts stretched their legs over Churchill

Downs' main track. **Join in the Dance** (Sky Mesa), runner-up to Musket Man (Yonaguska) in the Mar. 14 Gill Tampa Bay Derby and fifth in the Apr. 11 GI Blue Grass S., went out with the first set, shortly after the track opened at 6 a.m, and galloped a mile and three-eighths tour of oval. At about 6:30, **Ad-**

**vice** (Chapel Royal), victorious in the GII Lexington S., negotiated roughly the same distance as his stablemate. Pletcher, who was scheduled to arrive in Kentucky Sunday, will be on hand to oversee Derby preparations for both colts, which will include works for each today. Advice is slated to work a half-mile and Join in the Dance will breeze five furlongs. At Palm Meadows training center in Florida, another Pletcher charge--\$3.7-million yearling **Dunkirk** (Unbridled's Song)--returned to the track for a light jog following his five-furlong drill in 1:01.05 Saturday. "He came out of that work in great shape," Pletcher confirmed. "His energy level was good [Sunday] morning and we're pleased with where he is." Dunkirk is expected to ship to Louisville by air today. Also possible for the Derby is **Take the Points** (Even the Score), who is scheduled to work five furlongs after the break Monday. The Starlight Partners-owned colt has \$85,000 in graded-stakes earnings and would need a couple of defections from the list of Derby probables to secure a starting gate slot.

**Flat Out Injured...**

**Flat Out** (Flatter), winner of Oaklawn's Smarty Jones S. Jan. 19, was injured and is off the Kentucky Derby trail. A closing fourth in the GIII Southwest S. and sixth in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 11, the bay was diagnosed with a stress fracture in his shoulder following a precautionary exam performed at the Hagyard-Davidson-McGee Equine Clinic in Lexington Saturday. According to trainer Charles Dickey, the colt is expected to be sidelined for about "four months."

**Be Fair Readies for Kentucky Oaks...**

G1 Kentucky Oaks hopeful Thomas Van Meter and Charles Kidder's **Be Fair** (Exchange Rate) worked five furlongs in 1:00.20 under exercise rider Omar Golon Sunday. The move, taking place shortly after the track opened, was the fourth-fastest of 24 at the distance over a fast track. "She went just perfect," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who has taken the event on four prior occasions. "Have you ever heard a trainer not like a horse's work?" Marylou Whitney Stables' **Tweeter** (Birdstone) galloped shortly after the track opened at 6 a.m. Lukas indicated that he would have her final major work today or tomorrow.

**Gabby's Golden Gal Going for Gold...**

In her final major work prior to Friday's G1 Kentucky Oaks, Sunland Park Oaks heroine **Gabby's Golden Gal** (Medaglia d'Oro) completed five furlongs in 1:00.40 shortly after the renovation break at Churchill Downs yesterday. Trainer Bob Baffert, who watched the filly from the track's grandstand, had former rider Joe Steiner in the saddle for the drill. "She just cruised around there for me," said Steiner. "She galloped out strong. I said 'OK, that's good,' when we finished up." While small in stature, Steiner added that the filly measures up in other ways. "She's just a little thing, but she feels big under you," he said. "She's coming up to it right; doing all she can do. She'll be hooking into a tough one [favorite Rachel Alexandra], but she's going to be ready to do her part. Sometimes it's just a matter of being ready and getting lucky." Southern California jockey Victor Espinoza has the call on Gabby's Golden Gal for the nine-furlong Oaks.

Following Classic glory in the July 6 G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg, Kamsin was awarded the G1 Rheinland-Pokal--on the disqualification of **Oriental Tiger (Ger)** (**Tiger Hill {Ire}**)--over this course and distance Aug. 17. He continued the win streak in the Sept. 7 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden before finishing off the radar in the Oct. 5 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp last time. Winning trainer Peter Schiergen commented, "That was extremely exciting, but I never worried about Kamsin winning. He is great stayer and a very good horse, whereas **Dwilano** is a true 10-furlong horse who is currently in the form of his life." 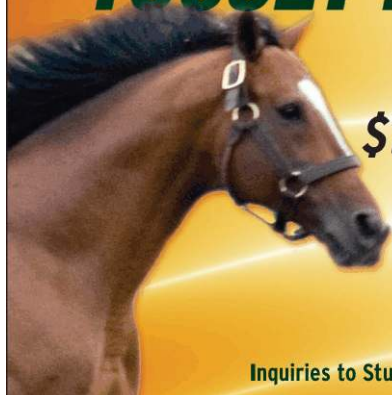
