## RACHEL ALEXANDRA TO PREAKNESS

According to a press release issued Friday by Jess Jackson's Stonestreet Stables, their new acquisition, GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro), will make her next start against males in the GI Preakness S. at Pimlico one week from tomorrow, "if she continues in perfect condition," Jackson said in the release. It was simultaneously announced that Calvin

Borel, who has ridden Rachel Alexandra to five consecutive stakes victories, will retain the mount and will take off GI Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone). It is the first time a rider has chosen another mount in the

Preakness over the Derby winner. "It came down to the facts that he knows and loves this horse, that he knows how to get the most from her and he knows how to win," Jackson explained. "We think this is a perfect match of rider and horse." *Daily Racing Form* reports that Borel has also been retained for the balance of the 2009 racing season. Jackson said a final decision on the filly's participation would be made next week. Rachel Alexandra is scheduled to work either Sunday or Monday at Churchill Downs. Jerry Hissam, the agent for Borel, expressed his appreciation to the Stonestreet team. "We thank Mr. Jackson for the opportunity to stay on her and we also thank the people associated with Mine That Bird for being so kind and generous to us. We're very grateful to [trainer] Steve [Asmussen] and the whole team that purchased Rachel for the opportunity to ride her going forward." *DRF* also reports that Mine That Bird's trainer Bennie "Chip" Woolley has been in touch with Brad Pegram, the California-based agent for Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith. However, there has been no confirmation of any arrangement, and the mount on the Derby winner, for the moment, remains open. "We're looking at a couple of people, and we'll let that out when the time comes," Woolley told TVG in a live interview. Despite the presence of the Oaks winner in the Preakness, the conditioner says it's more than a one-horse race. "She's got a ton of talent," Woolley said, referring to Rachel Alexandra. "But she's not the only one in there to beat. Pioneer of the Nile is going to run and I feel he should be favored. But I did say on Kentucky Derby day that I was glad [Rachel Alexandra] was not in there."

## GONE WEST TO BE PENSIONED

Headley Bell, the managing partner at Mill Ridge Farm in Lexington, announced yesterday that 25-year-old Gone West (Mr. Prospector--Secrettame, by Secretariat) will be pensioned at the end of the 2009 breeding season. "Regretfully, Gone West's fertility has diminished drastically this year with only five mares in foal from 27 possibilities," Bell said in a statement. "Towards the end of April, Dr. Dickson Varner, fertility specialist with Texas A & M, collected Gone West and the results indicated a significant deterioration in semen quality and sperm output in comparison with December 2008 and December 2007." He added, "We have a few mares who stayed on his book, so we are going to finish up this year and then retire him for the future. He has left his mark on the Thoroughbred breed, and it has been an honor to associate with him all these years. On behalf of my mother, Alice Chandler, and all of us at Mill Ridge, I would like to express our appreciation to all his shareholders and breeders who supported him." Cont. p11

Stepping up from a maiden second at Newbury Apr. 18, South Easter belied his inexperience to claim a thrilling victory in this traditional trial for the June 6 G1 Epsom Derby, but had to survive a steward's enquiry and objection before being confirmed as the winner. Racing in third after early scrimmaging, he was ridden along rounding the home turn and came under a power drive in the short straight to prevail in a four-way photo. "It was a good run, and I think Gitano Hernando was a bit unlucky, but he took his chance [to win]," commented winning trainer William Haggas. "He's a bit green and is going to be a nice horse. The part-owner [Bernard Kantor] is the power behind Investec, who now sponsor The Derby, so I guess we'll have a sit down and decide over a good dinner. He's a realist, so if it's right for the horse, he'd love [to] have a crack [at Epsom], but if it's not right for the horse, he wouldn't dream of it." Winning jockey Neil Callan was handed a two-day ban for careless riding in the early stages of the contest. Runner-up Gitano Hernando is slated to make his next start in the G1 Belmont S. June 6, according to Team Valor (*see related story p12*).

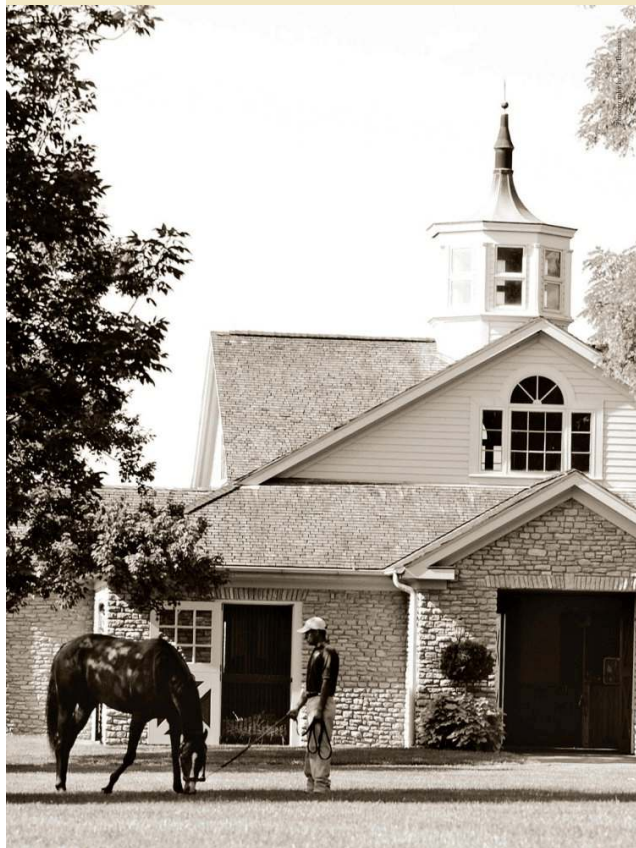

This contest threatened to descend into farce with five of the eight declared runners scratched, and that scenario unfolded as the early pace was undertaken at no more than a trot before Buccellati stepped forward to register a third stakes score with an ultimately dominant display. Last term's G3 St Simon S. victor closed 2008 with a sixth in the Dec. 14 G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin, and lined up for this coming back from a third in the Apr. 25 G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown. Leading at a crawl after facile early strides, he initiated racing pace after halfway and was ideally placed at the head of affairs for the sprint to secure a ridden-out score. "I didn't want to make the running under any circumstances and I thought that Johnny Murtagh [on Frozen Fire] might make it, but he didn't," explained winning rider William Buick. "We were just trotting for the first furlong, so I thought I may as well go on, as he's an honest type of horse. When there's only three runners you can control the race from the front and quicken when you want to, so that's what I did." Of future plans, trainer Andrew Balding added, "He's in the G1 Coronation Cup [at Epsom June 5], so I think that is where he will go. He's improved a lot since last year, and he's a handy horse to have."

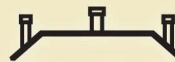

Successful in the Sept. 20 G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp, Calvados Blues dropped to fifth in the Nov. 2 G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud, and opened his sophomore account with a third in the Listed Prix Omnium II back there Mar. 23. He lined up for this G1 Prix du Jockey Club trial off a sixth in the Apr. 5 G2 Prix Noailles back at Longchamp, and registered a second pattern-race win with a decisive late swoop. Restrained in rear through the early fractions, he was angled outside for his bid with 350 meters to go and produced an unrelenting final-furlong surge to overhaul Dovil Boy in the shades of the post. "It's always been the plan to go for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [back here] and to build him up progressively for that race," revealed winning trainer Philippe Demercastel. "He really needed his first two runs this season, but he's coming into form at just the right time, so, hopefully, we will turn up on June 7 with a good chance." George Strawbridge's **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) yesterday received a two draw as she bids to make her mark on the Classic scene in tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. Frankie Dettori has the opportunity to steer his and trainer Luca Cumani's first winner of this prestigious prize, which has left France only three times since 1997, despite the constant bombardment from overseas. "She's in good form, she's been working well and we're very happy with her," Cumani told *PA Sport*. "She's drawn two, which is excellent. It's a good race; the best French fillies are there, so it's not going to be easy, but we are going to give it our best shot. I think a mile will suit her well. They say the ground is good at the moment, but there is rain forecast, so it depends how much rain comes. Good ground would be good for everybody." Post position is a major factor on this circuit, and has been 11 years since a double-figure stall was overcome by Zalaiyka (Fr) (Royal Academy), although the disqualified Price Tag (GB) (Dansili {GB}) finished first past the post from the 10 hole three years ago. Khalid Abdullah's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine **Proportional (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) and June Judd and Jackie Bolger's G3 Park Express S. victress **Oh Goodness Me (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) will have that burden on their shoulders in the latest edition, drawn 10 and 11, respectively.

Only Ecurie la Vallee Martigny and Lydia Rabineau's **Tamazirte** proved too strong in the G3 Prix de la Grotte over this track and trip last time Apr. 12, and trainer Yves de Nicolay is hoping she can find more improvement to provide him with a first Classic success. "I was surprised she acted up in the paddock before the G3 Prix de la Grotte, but I'll take the correct measures on Sunday to ensure it doesn't happen again," de Nicolay said. "She is in very good form and it looks a wide open race with not too many runners. She deserves to take her chance, and I think she will run very well." Alain de Royer-Dupre has annexed four renewals since 1984, and is looking to make it three in a row following the exploits of Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar) and Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar). His representative this time is Ecurie la Perrigne's **Doriana**, who has far less obvious claims than those two high-class performers. Successful in the Listed Criterium de Vitesse over five furlongs here in October and Listed Prix Zeddaan over a panel further at Fontainebleau the following month, she returns to a mile after a latest third in the six-furlong Listed Prix Sigy at Chantilly Apr. 28.

As with the Pouliches, this contest has also come to hinge largely on post position, with the 1998 hero Victory Note (Fairy King) the last to exit from a double-figure stall. Those out of favor this time are **Diablieside** and **Born to Be King**. The barrier draw, however, is not an issue for Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Naaqos**, who drew post one, the stall from which Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) exited en route to glory in 2005. Last year's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner will have to reverse placings from the Apr. 10 Listed Prix Djebel with Gerard Augustin Normand's **Le Havre**, one of two representatives from the Jean-Claude Rouget barn alongside Bernard Weill's **Oiseau de Feu**. The latter was third behind John-Dawson Cotton's **Silver Frost** and Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Westphalia** in the course-and-distance G3 Prix de Fontainebleau last time Apr. 12. That prep has proved vital in recent years, with Clodovil (Ire) (Danehill) and American Post (GB) (Bering {GB}) completing the double in 2003 and 2004, respectively. Intriguingly, Ballydoyle's three Poulains winners Landseer (GB) (Danehill), Aussie Rules (Danehill) and Astronomer Royal (Danzig) finished third, fifth and sixth, respectively, in the Fontainebleau. Westphalia, who is joined by Susan Magnier and Roisin Henry's Mar. 29 G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. third Born to Be King, proved himself a high-class juvenile with success in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster in September and half-length second to Donativum (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita the following month. He has a half-length to make up on Silver Frost from his last outing, but jockey Johnny Murtagh is hoping he can add to the stable's honor roll here. "He's a tricky ride, but also a horse you cannot say anything about as he's very consistent and very brave," he said. "He has won a Group 2 and just got beat at the Breeders' Cup, so the form is there, and I was very happy with his run the last time. We think he has improved on his last run, so I'm looking forward to a great ride. He has great character and answers all the calls."

Facing downgraded status for the first time since the pattern was introduced, this Classic is still the country's most valuable prize and is keenly contested again. Godolphin sent across Central Park (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) and Mukhalif (Ire) (Caerleon) to win this in 1998 and 1999 and put forward **Mastery**, who was fourth in the Mar. 18 Kentucky Derby Challenge S. at Kempton for former trainer Mark Johnston. Of the others, **Abaton** warrants respect on the basis of his impressive 6 1/2-length defeat of **Blue Black Jack** in the Listed Premio Emanuele Filiberto at the San Siro last time Apr. 18.

**Gone West Pensioned cont. from p1**

Purchased for \$1.9 million out of the 1985 Keeneland July sale, Gone West was the first foal of graded stakes placed Secrettame (Secretariat) and a full brother to multiple graded stakes winner Lion Cavern.

Among the leaders of the three-year-old division of 1987, Gone West was second in the GIII Hutcheson S. and third in the GII Fountain of Youth S. before winning the GII Gotham S. and coming up just a nose second to Gulch in the GI Wood Memorial S. for trainer Woody Stephens and Hickory Tree Stable. He also won the GII Withers S. and GI Dwyer S. On the board in 12 of 17 starts, Gone West retired to stud after the 1987 racing season with six wins and earnings of \$682,251.

Gone West proved to be a versatile stallion. Among his 98 stakes winners are 2004 Eclipse sprint champion Speightstown, as well as European juvenile champion Zafonic and German champion Royal Abjar. He is also the sire of two-time GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Da Hoss, GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Johar. Gone West was also represented on the track by juvenile Grade I winners Came Home, hero of the 2001 GI Hopeful S., and Grand Slam, victorious in the 1997 GI Champagne S. and GI Futurity. Came Home went on to win the 2002 GI Santa Anita Derby and GI Pacific Classic, while Grand Slam added wins in the 1998 GII Peter Pan S. Gone West's lone U.S. Classic winner came in 2000 when Commendable captured the GI Belmont S., but his Proud Citizen was second in the GI Kentucky Derby and third in the GI Preakness S. in 2002. Other Grade I winners sired by Gone West include: Marsh Side, Lassigny, West By West, Changeintheweather and Zaftig.

Gone West has earned a reputation as a sire of sires. His successful sons at stud include Mr. Greeley, Elusive Quality, Grand Slam, Zafonic and Zamindar. His offspring were greatly appreciated in the sales ring, where he was responsible for 30 yearlings and weanlings selling for \$1 million or more. Hashimiya, out of Touch of Greatness (Hero's Honor), was Gone West's highest-priced yearling, bringing \$3.8 million at the 2003 Keeneland September Sale. He was also represented by three horses to bring over \$2 million, with Gone to the Moon bringing \$2.8 million, Partners Choice selling for \$2.5 million, and Speightstown attracting a final bid of \$2 million.

## Triple Threats

### Gitano Hernando to Belmont...

Team Valor's **Gitano Hernando (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}), a troubled second in yesterday's G3 Dee S. at Chester, will make his next appearance in the G1 Belmont S. June 6, according to the operation's president Barry Irwin. "[In today's race, Gitano Hernando] was sawed off going into the first turn and our rider lodged an objection, which was not allowed," Irwin explained.

"However, the winning rider [Neil Callan] was handed a two-day suspension for careless riding and a two-day suspension for improper use of the whip." The Dee seems an interesting springboard to an American Classic, but there is a method to the madness. "We chose the

Dee because it was used by My Memoirs (GB) (Don't Forget Me {Ire}) before he ran second to [eventual Horse of the Year] A. P. Indy in the 1992 Belmont," Irwin commented. "[Gitano Hernando] has never run on dirt, but he will breeze at least twice in the next three weeks on the sand at Lingfield Race Course outside of London." Gitano Hernando raced as a homebred for the Jacobs Family's Newsells Park Stud in his first three career starts, breaking his maiden over the all-weather at Wolverhampton Nov. 15. In his first appearance for Team Valor, the chestnut son of GSW Gino's Spirits (GB) (Perugino) returned to the turf to annex a Doncaster handicap over 1 5/16 miles Mar. 29.

### Weather Woes Affecting Preakness Foes...

If it seems like it's been raining forever in Louisville, that's probably because it has. Persistent rain showers, which yesterday afternoon delayed the start of the fourth race by several minutes and ultimately claimed the second half of the program (*see ATW p1*), wreaked havoc on those handful of horses and their connections which will press on to next weekend's G1 Preakness S. Tom McCarthy, owner and trainer of **General Quarters** (Sky Mesa) was awakened early Friday morning by a thunderstorm and kept his G1 Blue Grass S. hero in the barn. "I woke up at 2 [a.m.] and saw all the lightning and then the rain," McCarthy said. "The first thing I did when I got here was check the track and it looked terrible. I would rather be safe than sorry." In light of a forecast for additional inclement weather overnight Friday into Saturday, McCarthy sees his hand as being forced.

"I will have to gallop him or do something in the morning." General Quarters exits a 10th-place effort in the G1 Kentucky Derby. The underfoot conditions may postpone the final major pre-race work for GIII Derby Trial hero **Hull** (Holy Bull). Owned by Heiligbrodt Racing Stable, Team Valor and Gary Barber, Hull is supposed to drill five furlongs this morning beneath Miguel Mena. "If I have to I can wait," said trainer Dale Romans. Hull, who galloped a mile and a half yesterday morning, may pass the Preakness if Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) is supplemented, as expected. Should he not run in the Preakness, the colt could start instead in the seven-furlong GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont June 6.

**BREEDERS' CUP DROPS TICKET PRICES** The Breeders' Cup and Oak Tree Racing Association yesterday announced that ticket prices for the 2009 World Thoroughbred Championships at Santa Anita have been reduced across the board. Seats for Friday's Breeders' Cup races, which were \$200 in 2008, will now be as low as \$40, going up to \$235; seat prices for Saturday, which were also \$200, will start at \$55, and top out at \$335. Single-day tickets will be available; last year, only two-day packages were offered. Fans will be able to select and buy seats using a new on-line system, as well as by contacting the Breeders' Cup Customer Service Call Center. "The online ticketing system gives our fans greater flexibility and immediate access to better Breeders' Cup tickets than they ever had before," said Breeders' Cup President and CEO Greg Avioli. "We also felt it was important to recognize the current economic environment both in Southern California and around the world by reducing ticket prices from 2008 levels." Breeders' Cup nominators can begin placing their orders May 15, with tickets going on sale to the general public June 5. The prices for general admission and single and two-day ticket options will be announced in early June.

**LOOK HERE ON COMEBACK TRAIL** Julian Richmond-Watson's G1 Epsom Oaks heroine **Look Here (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) is set to have a racecourse gallop in preparation for a tilt at the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 5. The four-year-old has not been seen since running third in the Sept. 13 G1 St Leger at Doncaster and will continue with regular homework before making a trip to Salisbury's track at the end of this month. "The Coronation Cup is still the aim, and she will go for a racecourse gallop at Salisbury at the end of May and we'll go from there," trainer Ralph Beckett told *PA Sport*. "I'm happy with her, her weight is good, she looks well and she's done a couple of pieces of work. She'll work again [Saturday] and we're all set."

**DELAWARE SPORTS BILL PASSES** Just days after it narrowly missed getting the three-fifths majority needed to go on to the Senate, the bill which will pave the way for a sports betting lottery in Delaware passed the Delaware House after midnight Thursday night by a vote of 30-4. The bill was two shy of the needed 25-vote majority when it went before the House Tuesday, but Gov. Jack Markell, who backed the measure, went to work. A revised version was presented Thursday and, after eight hours of debate, it got the votes required. Under the new bill, the state will receive a five-percent increase in revenue from gaming, but the raise was smaller than the one originally sought. According to the Harness Tracks of America's *Executive Newsletter*, the state's three racetracks were also able to get a proposal put on the back burner for three new casinos and 10 new non-casinos that could offer the sports lottery; have the licensing fee for the right to offer the sports lottery dropped from \$4.5 million to \$4 million; and will begin discussions for adding tables games at the tracks this summer. "I don't think anybody's totally happy with what we have before us, but the fact of the matter is we have, I think, a better bill," said Republican Minority Leader Richard Cathcart, who served as the liaison between the governor's office and Republican members of the Delaware House during the debate over the bill. A federal ban on sports betting was enacted in 1992, but Delaware is one of four states, along with Montana, Nevada and Oregon, that is exempt from the ban because it offered a sports lottery before the ban went into effect. The bill now goes before the state Senate, and it could also face opposition from sports leagues.

**REAL QUIET TO URUGUAY** Champion and dual Classic winner **Real Quiet** (Quiet American--Really Blue, by Believe It) will head to Uruguay for the Southern Hemisphere breeding season, it was announced yesterday. Under a two-year agreement, the 14-year-old stallion will stand at Pablo Salomone's Haras Cuatro Piedras. Real Quiet stood the 2009 Northern Hemisphere season at Michael Jester's Penn Ridge Farm in Pennsylvania for a fee of \$7,500. From seven crops to race, the bay has 15 stakes winners, including two-time GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero and Eclipse winner Midnight Lute and MGISW Pussycat Doll. His progeny have earned more than \$14.75 million to date. The deal was brokered by Nicoma Bloodstock in the U.S., Azumbullo Bloodstock in Uruguay and TBS Agency in Brazil. No Southern Hemisphere stud fee was announced.

**CHURCHILL DOWNS CANCELS** The second half of the twilight card at Churchill Downs Friday had to be called off due to severe weather. Heavy rains and thunderstorms hit the area, causing the fourth race to be delayed. The fifth race went off as scheduled, but the skies opened up again as the horses were in the paddock for the sixth race, and the sixth through 10th events were canceled. "The safety of the equine and human participants in our sport is the top priority at Churchill Downs' every day, and we felt that the cancellation of those races was the best move in light of the extreme weather conditions," said Kevin Flanery, senior vice president of National Public Affairs for Churchill Downs. Charles Town was also the victim of the storms. The West Virginia track, forced to scrap its Thursday night card, was out of action for the second straight night Friday. Both Churchill and Charles Town were expected to be open Saturday.
