### THE MAIN FEATURE

Longchamp is the centre of the European focus today, and the chief attraction looks set to be **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who heads to post for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches in the famed George Strawbridge silks. Her trainer Luca Cumani has handled some serious material throughout his illustrious career, and it is significant that he chose the route trodden by one of his past starlets Gossamer (GB) (Sadler's Wells) for his latest sensation.

After smooth successes in a Newmarket maiden at the July meeting and G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood the following month, Fantasia was second to Rainbow View (Dynaformer) in the G1 Fillies' Mile, a race her predecessor annexed in 2001. While her Ascot conqueror failed to read the script on her sophomore bow last Sunday, Fantasia could hardly have struck a finer chord with an exhilarating seven-length success in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket last time Apr. 15. "She was pretty much similar to Gossamer in being hugely talented from the beginning and a quick learner who knew what to do," said Cumani. In typically grounded fashion, he added, "The other day, she was visually very impressive, but I'm not sure what she beat there. Like Gossamer, she will never be a big filly, but she is quite lengthy and has a good shoulder and hindquarters, and is in the same category in terms of class."

### HE'S THE MAN

Mr. and Mrs. William K. Warren's **Charitable Man** (Lemon Drop Kid), winner of last term's GII Futurity S., made up for a disappointing seventh-place finish while making his sophomore debut in the Apr. 11 GI Blue Grass S. with an impressive 3 3/4-length victory over **Imperial Council** (Empire Maker) in yesterday's GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont. Sitting in second as the blinkered **Hello Broadway** (Broken Vow) was eight lengths clear through a half mile in :44 4/5, Charitable Man gained a short lead entering the stretch, and outkicked Imperial Council to take it in style. "[After the Blue Grass] he cooled out in five minutes; he disliked the Polytrack," McLaughlin offered. "We figured that, and Mr. Warren was very kind enough and patient enough not to wheel him right back in the Kentucky Derby or the Preakness." McLaughlin added, "He settled well [in the Peter Pan]. [Jockey] Alan Garcia deserves a lot of credit. He did everything right and rode a great race." The dark bay may start next in the June 6 GI Belmont S. Five horses have completed the Peter Pan/Belmont double, including A.P. Indy in 1992. "We'll talk with Mr. Warren about the possibility of the Belmont," McLaughlin continued. "We'll take a look and see how the Preakness goes. He is definitely bred to get a mile and a half, he likes this track, and he did it the right way today, so we'll look at it." Charitable Man was sidelined last fall with a knee fracture while training for the GI Champagne S. **Peter Pan cont. p6**

**For Goodness Sake...**

Jim Bolger's presence in the European Classics is almost a given at present, and the master of Coolcullen supplies another live contender in **Oh Goodness Me (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has the widest post position to contend with. Her hard-fought success in the Mar. 22 G3 Park Express S. at The Curragh on her latest outing needs improving upon, but underestimating one of the yard's contenders in the Classics is not an option. Of the outsiders, Roger Jesus's Listed Prix Isonomy winner **Entre Deux Eaux (Fr)** (Ange Gabriel {Fr}) appears to have little chance of reversing a two-length defeat by Elusive City in the G3 Prix Imprudence at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 10, while the unknown quantity **Undaunted Affair (Ire)** (Spartacus {Ire}) needs to have progressed quickly since a latest fifth in the Mar. 29 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial S.

Vocalised will break from the six stall in his bid to go one better than Creachadoir (Ire) (King's Best), whom Bolger sent here off the back of a win in the Tetrarch, only to be runner-up two years ago. "He's very well and we are expecting him to run well," Bolger told *PA Sport*. "They are saying the ground is on the good-to-soft side at the moment, but we don't mind what it is."

**Bouncing Back?...**

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's colors have yet to be carried to success here, but it is not difficult to envisage **Naaqoos (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) hoisting the renowned blue-and-white to glory this afternoon. Last year's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere hero will first need to reverse a surprise defeat at the hands of Gerard Augustin Normand's **Le Havre (Ire)** (Noverre) in the Apr. 10 Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte, and that trial has a poor recent record as a pointer to success in this. Sheikh Hamdan's Racing Manager Angus Gold told *PA Sport*, "Obviously, it was disappointing to get beaten, but I think the winner is a good horse. I think [trainer] Freddy [Head] feels he has improved a fair bit and that he may have been a little easy on him in the lead up to that race. Last year, he looked a horse with a lot of potential. He's a fine, big horse who has improved physically from two to three, so we'll see if he's got the class to win a Classic over a mile." Another with smart juvenile form who needs to rebound from a below-par comeback is **Shaweel (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), fifth behind Vocalised in the Greenham on his debut in the Godolphin colors. His win in the G2 Gimcrack S. at Newbury and second to Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G1 National S. last year suggest he has the potential to add to Godolphin's tally of three winners. "Shaweel ran a sound race on his seasonal debut and he has come on since that performance," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "We are looking for a better result on this occasion. I have been happy with his work, and the forecast good-to-soft ground will suit Shaweel well, as he likes softer ground. He deserves to take his chance in a race like the Poule d'Essai des Poulains, and I am looking to see him run a good race." **Poulains cont. p4-5**

with **Vocalised** (Vindication), and that decision could be a significant factor in how the Longchamp Classic plays out. Impressive in the way he has handled his three sophomore starts so far, Jackie Bolger's blueblood registered comfortable successes in the Listed Loughbrown S. at The Curragh Apr. 5, the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury 13 days later and the G3 Tet-

rarch S. back in Kildare Monday.

**Frost Predicted...**

John-Dawson Cotton's **Silver Frost (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}) is out to prove his defeat of Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Westphalia (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the course-and-distance G3 Prix de Fontainebleau was no fluke last time Apr. 12. He took the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud in October before finishing third in the same track's G1 Criterium International the following month, but has returned in a rich vein of form with wins in the Listed Prix Omnium II back at Saint-Cloud Mar. 23 and the all-important Fontainebleau. He is ridden by Longchamp specialist Christophe Soumillon, who partnered the promoted Vahorimix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) in 2001 and Clodovil (Ire) (Danehill) two years later. Olivier Peslier, who rode Silver Frost last time, finally broke his duck in this contest 12 months ago with Falco (Pivotal {GB}), and joins up with an intriguing outsider in **Handsome Maestro (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}). An impressive winner of a course-and-distance conditions event last time Apr. 2, he breaks from the eight hole from which Landseer (GB) (Danehill) emerged en route to success seven years ago.

Downgraded in status for the first time since the pattern was introduced, this Italian Classic produced a finish worthy of Group 1 standard. Mastery made the most of it when Jakkalberry collided with the rail inside the final furlong to register a career high in the hands of Frankie Dettori. The bay colt succeeded first time out at Nottingham Oct. 8, but dropped to third in a Newmarket conditions event nine days later, and returned this year to run fourth in the Kentucky Derby Challenge S. on the all-weather at Kempton Mar. 18. Dettori rushed his mount from the gate to occupy a forward role in fourth here, and the partnership came under pressure with 3 1/2 furlongs remaining. Ridden along to challenge at the quarter-mile marker, the eventual winner looked held as Jakkalberry made his bid for glory on the inside, but that rival scuppered his chances by brushing the rail inside the closing panel. Mastery needed no second invitation, and quickened impressively late on to claim the glory as the fast-finishing Turati nabbed second from Jakkalberry on the line.

“Mastery has run a big race to win; it was a tough contest on fast ground, but he did it really well,” said winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor, who was saddling his third winner of the race for Godolphin, following Central Park (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) in 1998 and Mukhalif (Ire) (Caerleon) in 1999. He added, “I talked to Frankie Dettori before the race and asked him to keep the colt close to the leaders. We are looking at the [June 6 G1] Epsom Derby next month for Mastery, but will consult with Sheikh Mohammed before making a final decision.” Mastery’s granddam Cherokee Rose was a good sprinter for Sheikh Mohammed, winning the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest in 1995 while trained by John Hammond. **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#).**

Alan Garcia has been aboard for all four of Charitable Man’s career starts, including his eye-opening 11 1/2-length debut victory at the Spa. “He broke good today,” Garcia said. “He was on the lead, then he wanted to kind of slow [down] a little bit; I saw [Hello Broadway] run away from him and I thought, ‘Okay, let me see,’ and I thought it was going to be a clear trip. Quarter for quarter, I felt the other horse [Imperial Council] coming a little bit and then [Charitable Man] switched the lead and he started running--he took off. [When Hello Broadway was in front] I thought he was going to come back [to us]. I was sitting there, I knew it was a comfortable pace, comfortable time, but I didn’t think that horse could keep going the way he was running.”

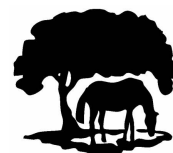

Age of Aquarius, the 2007 Arqana August saletopper, made a successful debut over a mile on Dundalk's Polytrack in September. He then went to France to contest the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November and was beaten 1 1/2 lengths when fourth to Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) there. The latest Derby hopeful off the Ballydoyle conveyor belt here, he was left in front early by reluctant rivals and gradually wound up the pace under Johnny Murtagh. After traveling sweetly down the hill, the blaze-faced bay was wide taking the sharp final bend before being tackled and briefly passed by Montaff at the quarter pole. Age of Aquarius regained the advantage while toughing it out against the fence and asserted in the final 100 yards to earn a potential slot in the line-up for the June 6 Epsom Classic. "He was a bit relaxed in front and was pricking his ears, but it was only his third run and there is plenty of improvement in him," Murtagh commented. "He's big and backward and a bit angular, but is a strong galloper and, when Darryl [Holland, aboard Montaff] came to me, he had his head in the right place and wanted to win. I like him and he has a chance in the Derby, so I hope he's there."

This vital staging post for the Epsom and Curragh Derbies was used by connections of the three colts--Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge), Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells)--who completed that Classic double from 2000 to 2002.

Unsurprisingly, this year's edition is again dominated by the John Oxx and Aidan O'Brien stables responsible for engineering those talents. Ballydoyle seek a sixth win since 2001 with a trio headed by **Fame and Glory**, who followed success in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November with a fluent defeat of the re-opposing **Mourayan** in the course-and-distance G3 Ballysax S. last time Apr. 19. He meets that rival on two pounds better terms here, and jockey Seamus Heffernan, who rode three of the stable's winners in this contest, is looking forward to deputising for the Longchamp-bound Johnny Murtagh. "He won it impressively for his first run of the year," Heffernan told *PA Sport*. "I was fourth on Hail Caesar, but he's not up to the same class as Fame and Glory. I've won this race before on some very good horses, and he seems to fit the bill so far. We think he's good, so let's hope he proves us right. It's a rematch of the Ballysax, so we'll see which has progressed the most." Mourayan, who split Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Masterofthehorse (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in what has become a highly significant renewal of the G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh in September, registered a first stakes score in this track's Listed Eyrefield S. in November, but suffered a troubled trip in the Ballysax. "He got caught in on the rail in the Ballysax S. and had to let everything get past--it was a bit frustrating watching the race, as you could see he wasn't going to get out, but we did go home happy from the race because of the way he ran to the line," trainer John Oxx commented. "There were a lot of positives to come from the race, and this will tell us more. He has to take on Fame and Glory again and needs to show up well to enter the picture for Epsom. Mourayan's a lovely horse we really like, but has a bit to prove yet."

**Mine That Bird Rider Still A Mystery...**

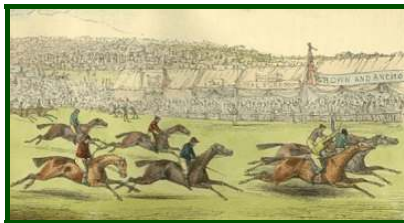

"Sea The Stars has come out of the 2000 Guineas in good

shape, and he seems fresh and well this week," Oxx said. "Everything is fine with him and we will go straight to Epsom with him now. Arazan will go for the Irish Guineas and it will be a tough, competitive race, as there are a few good horses there who didn't run at Newmarket. Rayeni might make the race, but he's a soft-ground specialist who won't go if it's on the fast side. He didn't canter in March because of a setback, but he was pretty fit before that and is coming along well now. He's going nicely at the moment and is working better than last year, so we'd like to run if the ground is soft. He doesn't look as good as Sea the Stars or Arazan, but it will be interesting to see how he gets on." Oxx also had news of Yukiko Hosokawa's Leopardstown maiden scorer **Space Telescope (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who may head to The Curragh's G3 Gallinule S. the day after the Irish 2000 Guineas. "He got a nasty foot bruise about 10 days before the Ballysax, so wasn't able to make that, and we had to give him a bit of time to get over that," Oxx continued. "He's back in work, but is lazy at home, and we hope to run in the Gallinule."

## House Set for Dante Test...

Paul Reddam's G1 Racing Post Trophy hero **Crowded House (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) is on course for his seasonal return in Thursday's G2 Dante S. at York, trainer Brian Meehan announced yesterday. He is a top-of-the-ground horse, so good-to-firm going will be fine for him."

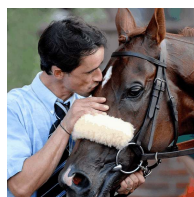

## GULF COAST SCORES FROM SEA TO SHINING SEA (Cabaret Cowboy {Speightstown} and Speight the Halo {Speightstown})

Jerry Bailey and Lance Robinson are in Southern California, preparing for Monday's Barretts May Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. The duo took a little side trip to Hollywood Park Saturday afternoon, where their **Speight the Halo** (Speightstown) figured to have a

strong chance in the second-race maiden just after 1:30 p.m. local time. But they had other business to attend to about 15 minutes earlier on the other side of the country, when **Cabaret Cowboy** (Speightstown), a \$300,000 Keeneland September purchase,

was to make his return from a six-month absence in a Belmont maiden. The latter upheld his end of the bargain, leading from flagfall to finish to graduate in style, covering six furlongs in a spritely 1:08.96 for trainer Seth Benzel.

"We had some shins last year we were dealing with, and after he ran in the race with Musket Man [a second at Belmont Park Oct. 25], he came home and his shins sure needed to be fired and cooled off," Bailey explained. "We took care of that and gave him some time and trained him up to a half-mile on the farm, and then sent him back to Seth. Judging from his performance today, I'd say those shins were bothering him quite a bit [last year]."

Being that Cabaret Cowboy is by a champion sprinter and out of a mare who won a pair of stakes going short on the turf and never tried a distance over six furlongs, Bailey is fairly sure of what he's got.

"I think he's probably a sprinter, maybe up to a mile," Bailey commented. "Judging by his pedigree, his running style and the way he looks, I think that's what he's going to do best. But you never know." He added, "I think he's a graded-stakes kind of horse, but we'll probably go through a condition or two and let him develop. That's what we normally like to do."

Speight the Halo was a little more expensive than Cabaret Cowboy, as he brought \$400,000 at last year's Barretts March Sale. It's taken a while for him to break through, but he's finally living up to his potential, according to Bailey.

"Eoin Harty has been telling us from before he started this horse that this is a good horse," Bailey related. "He ran really well at Hollywood and Santa Anita last year, but did not like Del Mar at all. I think you have to throw those two races out."

And now it looks like a trans-continental journey is in the offing.

"Eoin is planning on taking the horse to Saratoga and see how he runs there and go from there. He really think he's the kind of horse he can win graded stakes with. I think he'll possibly stretch out more than the other horse, even though they have similar running style. He has a big, stallion-type pedigree, and I think he'll go farther than the other horse."

Bailey and Robinson own Speight the Halo in partnership with Fantasy Farms Racing LLC, a group of people from the movie industry with a "couple of pretty high-profile people," said Bailey.

The obvious common denominator between the two runners is their sire, and Bailey is high on the 2003 Eclipse Award-winning sprinter.

"I think Speightstown is doing great as a sire, and I don't think he's just going to get a sprinter," Bailey commented. "The way he's bred, he doesn't just have to be a sprinter sire. We like his connections, we like Taylor Made and WinStar, and we think they do a great job with a stallion. We're seeing enough of them that we liked and he had a good-enough book of mares that we jumped in a bought a couple of them from his first crop. I think both these horses are going to be fun."



The recent exploits of Tungsten Strike (Smart Strike), Al Shemali (GB) (Medicean {GB}) and Bad Girl Runs (SAf) (Western Winter) have ensured this family remains in the spotlight, and it has Arabian Mirage (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) to run for it in today's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches.

Last year's sale was held in mid-April, but Arqana opted to move it to accompany the first French Classics. "We changed the date of the Breeze-Up Sale, which was slightly later than last year [Apr. 19], to coincide with the eve of the French Guineas," explained Olivier Delloye, Arqana's managing director. "That probably meant the sale was more happening. It was, I think, a smart move. It left vendors more time to have their horses ready for the sale.

And there was the Breeze-Up Bonus Scheme, which was launched by the breeze-up consignors in Europe." Delloye continued, "There was quite a large crowd today. Many more people than last year. More people than two years ago. Yesterday was quite a busy day [with a lot of people] inspecting horses, which is quite unusual for such a sale. Usually people just come in the morning [on the day of the sale], inspect horses and look at them breeze."

**The Tale of The Heavyweights...**

Mocklershill and Bansha House have come to represent the top end of the breeze-up market, and Browne and Con Marnane's set-up were predictably at the fore yesterday. Apart from the topper, Mocklershill were also responsible for another gem with hip 78, a half-brother by Azamour (Ire) to the good Canadian performer Muntej (GB) (Muhtarram {GB}). It was Oceanic Bloodstock who snapped up the grandson of the champion Brave Raj (Rajab) for €160,000 on behalf of Riviera Equine. Five lots later, Bansha House's Nayef colt sold to Richard O'Gorman Bloodstock for €165,000, providing a smart return on the €80,000 paid at this venue in August. From the family of the top-class On the Acorn (GB) (Inchinar {GB}), Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil) and Las Meninas (Ire) (Glenstal), he had been led out unsold at 45,000 guineas at last month's Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up.

### More Success for Saubouas...

Paul Basquin's Haras du Saubouas, who was responsible for last year's topper, enjoyed another high-profile day's selling and edged out Mocklershill and Bانشa House as leading vendor. Their top sale resulted in a handsome profit on the Mizzen Mast colt consigned as hip 64. Bought for €52,000 at Deauville last year, the half-brother to Philip Newton's listed-placed duo Maramba (Hussonet) and Minnesota (Silver Hawk) was knocked down to Jean-Claude Rouget for €170,000. The grey colt hails from the family of today's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains contender Shaweel (GB) (Dansili {GB}). Saubouas were also responsible for the top-priced filly, who was sold to Andre Fabre for €120,000. Consigned as hip 79, the February-foaled daughter of Elusive City is out of a half to the smart Suborneuse (Diesis {GB}) from the extended family of Knoosh (Storm Bird). Fresh from celebrating the success of his recent acquisition San Sicharia (Ire) (Daggers Drawn) in the G3 Chartwell Fillies' S. at Lingfield, Paddy Twomey's day kept on improving as his Hawthorn Villa Stud sold a son of the soon-to-be-pensioned Gone West to the Marc-Antoine Berghgracht's MAB Agency for €100,000. Hip 51 is a grandson of Ivy (Sir Ivor), whose dynasty includes the 1992 G1 Oaks d'Italia heroine Ivyanna (Ire) (Reference Point {GB}), that year's G1 Fillies' Mile third Iviza (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and the dam of the top-class stayer Distinction (Ire) (Danehill). Anthony Stroud later paid €85,000 for The Bloodstock Connection's hip 87, a well-connected daughter of Dalakhani (Ire). Her second dam is the 1996 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third My Branch (GB) (Distant Relative {Ire}), whose progeny include the 2004 G1 Haydock Sprint Cup heroine Tante Rose (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) and GSP Bay Tree (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}). That price was later matched by Will Edmeades Bloodstock for a High Chaparral half-brother to last year's Goffs Fillies Million heroine Minor Vamp (Ire) (Hawk Wing), consigned by Brendan Holland's Grove Stud as hip 132. The sire's fortunes have taken a recent upturn, thanks to the exploits of the G3 Sandown Classic Trial scorer Above Average (Ire) and Listed Feilden S. winner Redwood (GB), as well as Golden Sword (GB) and Magadan (Ire), who made the headlines this week in the G3 Chester Vase and G3 Prix d'Hedouville, respectively.

### Numbers Game...

The clearance rate stood at a highly respectable 76 percent, while the average and median improved on last year's records. The former of €41,649 was up by 20 percent, while the €30,000 median increased by seven percent. Given that nearly every breeze-up sale held thus far in the Northern Hemisphere had lagged behind 2008 returns due to the economic downturn, yesterday's figures were well-received by Arqana's management. "Obviously when you see all of the sales around the world going down 30 percent, we could not expect such an increase," said Olivier Delloye. "We had been hoping to consolidate last year's aggregate behind a stronger catalogue." Delloye added, "We had many French trainers and owners quite active, mostly due to the good economy we have in France and the owner's premiums, which is probably a fantastic incentive to push owners to buy some young horses. We had some foreign owners who race in France. We had Michel Zerolo from Oceanic Bloodstock buying some two-year-olds at the sale with Martin Schwartz. I'm not sure if he bought for Martin Schwartz today, but it's something that was quite possible. Martin Schwartz has been quite successful with his fillies bought in France and racing in France, and he has Elusive Wave [Elusive City] running in the [1000] Guineas tomorrow. Some horses will be exported to Dubai and smaller countries like Greece. And, of course, [some will be sent to] England and Ireland. So it's quite a large group of international buyers." Delloye also noted, "We'll probably stick to this date, which looks quite good. We'll continue to grow as the horses we have on offer continue to improve. We definitely hope all of the breeze-up consignors across Europe will put more good individuals into the sale. I do believe they've been quite pleased with what happened today. I think that will be the main driver to continue to improve." Full results can be found on [arqana.com](http://arqana.com).
