ELUSIVE NO MORE

Long denied Classic glory, the Jean-Claude Rouget stable was celebrating a dramatic reversal of fortune yesterday as **Elusive Wave (Ire)** (Elusive City) led home **Tamazirte (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) for a landmark one-two in Longchamp's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches. With much of the focus beforehand concentrated on the 6-5 favorite and eventual third **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), the duo from Pau escaped under the radar and it was the former who made every yard of the running under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire to provide a generous return of 27-5. After watching his fillies end up separated by a half length, Rouget was understandably ecstatic. "This is a great day, to have the first and second when winning my first Classic," he said. "Just because they are from the same stable, there is nothing to say that the two fillies should not run against each other if they have the right credentials." **Cont. p3**

COOL AS YOU LIKE

While the latest renewal of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains required the intervention of the Longchamp stewards to sort out the placings, there was no disguising the superiority of John-Dawson Cotton's **Silver Frost (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}). Trainer Yves de Nicolay, welcoming a first Classic winner, said, "It is a really special moment for me, and this horse is so good and so brave. He does everything right every time and I can hardly find words to describe how I feel." **Cont. p5**

BROUHAHA HITS PREAKNESS

While **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro)'s connections have not yet confirmed their intention of running in Saturday's G1 Preakness S., it looked for a while yesterday like the filly's participation in the second leg of the Triple Crown would come down to the actions of the connections of her rivals.

Ahmed Zayat, whose **Pioneerof the Nile** (Empire Maker) was second in the G1 Kentucky Derby, made the rounds on the Sunday morning racing shows, announcing his intention to enter at least one rival to bring the field up to the 14-horse limit. As a supplemental entry, Rachel Alexandra

would be last on the preference list. But later Sunday, Zayat Stables' Sohby Sonbol confirmed that the stable would only enter Pioneerof the Nile in the race. Mark Allen, the co-owner of G1 Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone), who stands to lose the services of jockey Calvin Borel if Rachel Alexandra runs in the Preakness, has informed Pimlico officials that he intends to enter the maiden **Indy Express** (A.P. Indy) in the race. Also added to the list of possible Preakness contenders yesterday was Marylou Whitney's **Luv Gov** (Ten Most Wanted), but Whitney's husband John Hendrickson told **Blood Horse** that they would not run the maiden winner if it would exclude Rachel Alexandra from the race.

Rachel Preps for Possible Preakness Start

G1 Kentucky Oaks winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) tuned up for a possible start in next Saturday's G1 Preakness S. with a four-furlong drill in :48.40 at Churchill Downs. It was the filly's first work since being purchased by Jess Jackson's Stonestreet Farm and Harold McCormick and being transferred to the barn of trainer Steve Asmussen. **Cont. p2**

With exercise rider Dominic Terry in the irons, **Rachel Alexandra** cut out fractions of :12.40 and :24.40 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:02 over a track labeled fast. "I thought it went beautiful," Asmussen said. "She's a beautiful filly. I think she's doing extremely well. Every sight of her has been impressive and I'm just very happy to get this light move in this morning under very good conditions." Asmussen said no decision has yet been made on Rachel Alexandra's participation in the Preakness. "That's Mr. Jackson's discretion--whatever timetable he wants to be on," the trainer said. "We're just very fortunate to have her in our care and we'll just communicate what we think we're seeing."

Hull On Track...

Hull (Holy Bull), unbeaten winner of the Apr. 25 GIII Derby Trial, worked a bullet five furlongs at Churchill Downs yesterday in :59.40 in preparation for a possible start in the GI Preakness S. The Dale Romans trainee went the distance in fractions of :23.30 and :35.20 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:12.80. "He worked really good--I had him in :59 flat," Romans said. "It looked like he was doing it easy." Romans said a decision on a Preakness start was still to be made and could be affected by the participation of Rachel Alexandra. "[Rachel Alexandra] makes it a tougher decision to go," he said. "We're going to sit down and talk about it Tuesday and see if we want to go up there and run against her. Right now, I think we're still going to go, but we'll see what happens. She changes the dynamics of the whole race." Also working towards the Preakness, **Terrain** (Sky Mesa) went five furlongs in company in 1:02.60. **Luv Gov** (Ten Most Wanted), a maiden winner on the Derby undercard, went four furlongs at Churchill yesterday in :48.20. "We think he's our GI Belmont S. horse and we are looking for another spot to get a good one in," Lukas said of the decision to run in the Preakness. "He ran a huge race on Derby day. He actually ran better than most of the horses in the Derby. We're going to give him a shot to go." **Take the Points** (Even the Score) worked five furlongs over the Belmont Park training track yesterday in 1:00.09.

Belmont Could be Next for Charitable Man...

Charitable Man (Lemon Drop Kid) came out of his win in Saturday's GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont in fine shape and could make his next start in the June 6 GI Belmont S. "He came out of the race great," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin confirmed. "I will be corresponding with [owner] Mr. [William] Warren today and tomorrow, and we are looking at the Belmont S. or the [July 4] GII Dwyer, with the [Aug. 29] GI Shadwell Travers as the main objective." McLaughlin added that West Point Thoroughbreds GIII Withers S. winner **Mr. Fantasy** (E Dubai) would start next in either the May 25 GI Shadwell Metropolitan H. or in the June 6 GII Woody Stephens S. Trainer Barclay Tagg reported that **Hello Broadway** (Broken Vow), who tired to fourth after setting fast splits in the Peter Pan, was "fine" Sunday. Equipped with blinkers, the colt opened a clear lead through fractions of :44.89 and 1:08.93. "Who would have thought he would run off like that?" Tagg asked. "We'll get inside his head and figure him out one of these days. In every race, it's always something with him."

Elusive Wave has taken an unorthodox path to this highlight, having started out with the Richard Hannon stable, under whose auspices she recorded an impressive success in a six-furlong Goodwood maiden in May. Purchased privately shortly afterwards by her trainer for Marc de Chambure and Maurice Lagasse, the bay duly stretched her unbeaten tally to three via the seven-furlong stepping stones of the Listed Prix Roland de Chambure here in July and G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville in August. Elusive Wave, bought by Martin Schwartz at the Arqana Arc Sale the night before her date in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, showed that a mile held no fears when second behind Proportional (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}) on the undercard of the autumn feature.

Handed a straightforward assignment to return to winning ways on her seasonal bow in the Apr. 10 G3 Prix Imprudence, she became the first to follow success in that Maisons-Laffitte contest with victory here since Ravinella (Mr. Prospector) in 1988. Christophe-Patrice Lemaire had things in control in front and it was apparent early in the straight that Fantasia and Frankie Dettori had a fight on their hands as Elusive Wave maintained the pressure. With that rival subdued passing the furlong pole, it was only the G3 Prix de la Grotte scorer Tamazirte's late presence which forced Lemaire to issue some cracks, but she had already inflicted the damage. "We have seen by today's two Classics that the trials are very important and it is nice to see them work out like that," Rouget continued. "Tamazirte finished nicely, but I think extra credit goes to Elusive Wave as it is difficult to make all in such a race. We will have to decide whether to go to Royal Ascot with the winner [for the June 19 G1 Coronation S.] or go to Chantilly for the [June 14] G1 Prix de Diane." Martin Schwartz was in ebullient mood when adding, "I didn't have time to go to see her on Arc day after I had bought her, so sent my two sons in my place and when she was beaten I decided that was not good enough and needed to make the trip myself today! It is a great result and as it is Mothers' Day in America, this is a beautiful present to my wife."

RIDING THE WAVE

No stranger to International racing success, Martin S. Schwartz has already campaigned a host of top-class fillies, including Gorella (Fr) (Grape Tree Road {GB}), who scored at the Grade I level in the U.S. after collecting a Group 3 win in France; Maids Causeway (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), a Group 1 winner in England; and Lady of Venice (Fr) (Loup Solitaire), who accounted for three graded stakes victories stateside. In Paris yesterday, Schwartz--accompanied by his wife Audrey and two children Stacy and Parker--watched yet another femme fatale, **Elusive Wave (Ire)** (Elusive City), triumph in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. "The British press has such great expectations for their horses," dead-panned Schwartz. "I read the *The Racing Post* before I headed to Longchamp, and they had basically already conceded the race to Fantasia. I guess we had the last word today."

Undeniable Talent...

Purchased privately by Haras d'Etreham's Marc de Chambure following her maiden score at Goodwood last May, the daughter of Multicolor Wave (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) scored for her new owner in the Prix de Roland de Chambure at Longchamp in July before adding another success in Deauville's G3 Prix Calvados Aug. 23. Slated to be sold at Arqana's Arc Sale on the eve of the Oct. 5 G1 Prix Marcel de Boussac, Schwartz's French bloodstock agent Michel Zerolo--a long-time friend of de Chambure--brought the filly to the attention of Schwartz's U.S. advisor Mike Levy. "Michel had seen her run and had seen her physically many times," explained Levy. "He was very keen on her, even though her pedigree wasn't 'purple,' so to speak." With Zerolo bidding on behalf of Schwartz, who was in Florida at the time of Elusive Wave's purchase, the filly was secured for €660,000. "I thought she would be close to \$1-million, but the stock market had fallen apart three weeks before, so it wasn't until I got to Keeneland in November that I realized that the end of the world had come," said Schwartz, whose children deputized for the Wall Street trader at the following afternoon's showpiece for juvenile fillies. "We were thrilled with her performance in the Boussac," he said. "You never know what to expect when you buy a horse, but she ran really well and finished second to a superb filly, Proportional (GB)."

Exclusively Elusive...

Owners in the racing game often leave the selection process entirely up to their advisors, but that certainly does not apply to Schwartz. "Marty does his own research, using his own numbers and her numbers just stacked up to his specifications," said Levy. "Marty is very hands-on in all decisions." And Schwartz had plenty to like about Elusive Wave, despite being from the first crop of her relatively unproven sire, Elusive City. "This filly is by a very young stallion, but he is by Elusive Quality, which I love," confirmed Schwartz. Schwartz's enthusiasm in regard to the Darley stallion appears justified given the presence of yet another talented filly, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Elusive Heat, currently campaigning under the Schwartz banner in the United States. "She seems to be so fast that she runs out of her skin," Schwartz said of the daughter of MGISW Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat). "I think she's the best three-year-old filly sprinter in the country, we just have to keep her on the track. When she gets to the track, I don't think they beat her." Schwartz indicated that the filly, runner-up by a nose in the Jan. 4 GIII Old Hat S., would make her next start in the July 4 G1 Prioress S. at Belmont.

Royal Ascension...

Elusive Wave is expected to make her next start in either the June 19 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot or the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly June 14, and according to Schwartz, the family will return for the fillies' next racecourse appearance. "We won the Coronation in 2005 with Maid's Causeway," he said, adding, "It was fun then and I hope it's fun again if we can do it." Looking even further down the road, Schwartz's filly--who will follow the regular stable protocol and head to the U.S. for a fall campaign--will target Keeneland's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. in October. But in a game that can offer the highest of highs as well as the lowest of lows, Schwartz tries to assume a more cautionary position and let cooler heads prevail. "Enjoy the victory today because you never know what tomorrow is going to bring," he said. "I've paid for all these lessons I've learnt over the years. Now I just try to take it one day at a time."--Christina Bossinakis

No Fun For Fantasia...

Trainer Luca Cumani admitted to being “disappointed” by the defeat of George Strawbridge’s **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler’s Wells), who appeared to have no excuses. After a tardy start, she was soon in the ideal spot racing in the leader’s slipstream, but could not find the necessary acceleration in the straight to go past and was 1 1/2 lengths behind the stable companions at the line. “We decided to ride up with the pace due to the way most French races are run,” her trainer told *PA Sport*. “The winner has made all and we were still second two furlongs out, but have finished pretty much where we started. Frankie said the ground was good and only blamed the way the race was run. I would say we would look at the G1 Prix de Diane for her, as I am reluctant to go from a mile to a mile and a half at Epsom and would rather take incremental steps. I am disappointed, as she was favourite.” Owner George Strawbridge added that she would be kept apart from last Sunday’s G1 1000 Guineas fifth Rainbow View (Dynaformer), who would head to the June 5 Epsom Classic. “I couldn’t stand for one to beat the other, so they will go their separate ways,” he explained. “They both want different distances and they will avoid each other that way. It is distinctly possible Rainbow View will run at Epsom and I don’t see the distance being a problem. We will discuss options for this filly with Luca. She is still a very good filly and has been beaten by two very good fillies today. It is a very competitive game over here.” Proportional’s connections may also head to Chantilly following her staying-on fourth. “She had a good trip in a good position, so there are no excuses and no complaints,” Khalid Abdullah’s Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe commented. “We might bring her back for the Diane, as she might need further.” [Click for the Racing Post chart](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#).

Fresh from his defeat of Westphalia in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over this track and trip Apr. 12, Silver Frost confirmed that form with a sweeping wide move under Christophe Soumillon to take control at the furlong pole. Clear of the scrimmaging near the rail which saw the subsequent disqualification of the 29-10 favorite Naaqoos (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) from third, the 43-10 second choice was comfortably on top when two lengths clear of Le Havre at the line. His success was made all the more meritorious by the fact that he returned having lost a shoe from his off-fore. Owned by the British-based John-Dawson Cotton, Silver Frost showed precocity and speed when capturing the G3 Prix de Cabourg over six furlongs at Deauville in early August, but was out of his comfort zone when seventh in the G1 Prix Morny over the same trip and track three weeks later. **Cont. p6**

Stepped up to a mile for the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud in October, he annexed that contest before returning there the next month to be third in the G1 Criterium International. His smooth comeback win in the Listed Prix Omnium II back at Saint-Cloud Mar. 23 proved he had not stopped progressing, and after confirming that impression in the Fontainebleau he was looking to emulate Clodovil (Ire) (Danehill) and American Post (GB) (Bering {GB}) in following up here. Christophe Soumillon, who had partnered the former after being awarded the 2001 renewal on Vahorimix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), was always in cruise control looking for the treble before making his move when still in rear early in the straight. Keeping it simple, he delivered Silver Frost away from the inner traffic that hindered Westphalia and Handsome Maestro (Ire) (Dansili {GB}), whose rider Olivier Peslier launched the objection which resulted in the demotion of Naaqoos. That rival had raced keenly during the first quarter mile before the strong pace was established and ultimately paid the price after enjoying a brief lead before being swamped by the winner at the furlong marker. Yves de Nicolay added, "I probably made a mistake last year running him in the Prix Morny, but it was tempting after the Cabourg. He is best at a mile and has really done nothing wrong since." For Cotton, it was a case of praising the uncomplicated ride from Longchamp specialist Soumillon. "It was a brilliant ride from Christophe and he thinks he could be a horse for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 7]," he commented. Beaten Fair and Square...

Trainer Jean-Claude Rouget was offering no hard-luck stories for the defeat of Le Havre, who had beaten Naaqoos by a head in the Apr. 10 Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte and confirmed that form. Westphalia's conditioner Aidan O'Brien also told *PA Sport*, "He's run a good race and was coming home well. It is always good to see horses finishing strongly in their races and he won't mind going further."

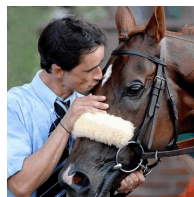


