TO BET...OR NOT TO BET

You can't root against her...but should you bet against her? GI Kentucky Oaks heroine **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) will be the heavy favorite as she tries to become the first of her sex to win the GI Preakness S. in 85 years, and that will make for enticing odds on the colts she faces.

Pioneer of the Nile (Empire Maker), runner-up in the GI Kentucky Derby at 6-1, is likely to be longer at Pimlico today; **Friesan Fire** (A.P. Indy), the 7-2 chalk on the first Saturday in May, will be more than twice that price as he tries to rebound from his troubled 18th-place effort at Churchill. With all the question marks about the filly, it will be

hard to resist playing her rivals. Rachel Alexandra could bounce off her 20 1/4-length tour de force in the Oaks, and she will be trying to win off short rest for the first time in her career. The rivals she has beaten with such consummate ease are minor leaguers, and she now has a new trainer, exercise rider and groom. One thing remains unchanged, however--jockey Calvin Borel, and his complete faith in his filly. "She's got a lot to prove, and I've got a lot to prove for the people," Borel said. "I want to show the public why I think she's the best horse in the country right now, and this is the time to do it." Is Derby hero **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) a threat? Borel isn't worried. "He'd have to run the race of his life to beat my filly," he said. "I think all the others are going to have to run the race of their lives, or have me fall off or something stupid happen [to beat her]." The rider added, "I think I've just got to point her in the right direction and she'll get me there." **Cont. p2**

GOLD MEDAL WEEKEND?

Rachel Alexandra isn't the only daughter of sophomore sire Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}) making headlines at Pimlico this weekend. **Payton d'Oro** got a share of the attention as she picked up her fourth consecutive victory in Friday's GII Black-Eyed Susan S. The bay hit the board in two of her three starts last season for trainer Larry Jones, then opened her three-year-old campaign

with a fourth in a maiden sprint at Oaklawn Jan. 16. Stretched out to a mile two weeks later, she started her streak with a two-length graduation. Payton d'Oro added a three-length optional-claiming score Mar. 1, and was 4 3/4 lengths in front at the finish of the Apr. 11 Instant Racing S. at the Hot Springs oval. "She has just gotten better and better, ever since we've gone around two turns with her," Jones said. "She's got a great future ahead of her." Jones saddles Friesan Fire (A.P. Indy) in the GI Preakness S. today. "We've got a chance to win the Black-Eyed Susan and the Preakness double, and not a lot of people have done that," he said. **Cont. p4**

of them. He makes his first appearance in the race since running fifth with Senor Swinger in 2003, and could raise his batting average to .500 with **Pioneerof the Nile**. "The Derby didn't take anything out of him," Baffert said. "Our horse looks fantastic...it looks like he's going to run another big race." As for how he expects the race

to set up, he added, "I hope he breaks cleanly--that's the main thing. I'll probably be sitting right behind them. He likes to have a target to run at. Turning for home [in the Derby], the target disappeared and he was out there by himself. Mine That Bird went by him too fast to really engage with him. One good thing about having Rachel Alexandra in there is she is a great target. I just hope we can catch that target."

Ask has flirted with the highest level, but has fallen short in five Group 1 attempts. Successful in last term's G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown, he was out of the frame in the June 18 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot and G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. July 28. The bay was allowed time off before running sixth in the Oct. 5 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, and closed the year with a seventh in the Oct. 25 G3 St Simon S. at Newbury. He was making his seasonal bow here. Reserved in rear from the outset, the six-year-old eased into contention rounding the home turn. He surged to the front with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining and was driven clear, despite drifting left, to register a career-best win. "He did it very well and, in fact, he almost traveled too well through the race," said rider Ryan Moore. "When we got a nice split [in the straight], I thought I'd use his turn of foot, but he had a look around when he hit the front, and that's why he lugged left. We've always known he's a good horse, but he just needs a little help with the ground." Regarding future plans, owner Patrick Fahey told *PA Sport*, "We'll look at the [June 5 G1] Coronation Cup next, as I think a mile and a half suits, with the turn of foot he showed today. The G1 Irish St Leger [at The Curragh Sept. 12] is his main target for this year, and he'll then go back for the [Oct. 4 G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe again, which will be the last race of his career."

I was able to stay on the rail and sit until we hit the top of the stretch, and then I hit the gas. She gave me what she had and ran

Paco Boy bids to stake his claim to top miling honors after a victorious European return in the G2 Sandown Mile Apr. 25. Undisputed leader of the seven-furlong category last term with a successful campaign highlighted by success in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in October, the blaze-faced bay appears to be as effective at this distance in three previous tries. Along with last year's G2 Sandown Mile winner and G1 Sussex S. and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois third Major Cadeaux, he provides trainer Richard Hannon with a string chance of a second renewal following the exploits of Swing Low (GB) (Swing Easy) when it was a Group 2 in 1993. "Paco Boy and Major Cadeaux worked together on Wednesday, along with Soul City (Ire) (Elusive City), and the Lockinge pair came through their final gallop as well as I could have wished," Hannon said. "Paco Boy deserves to be favourite. What he achieved at Sandown, just 26 days after he got off the plane back from Dubai, was fantastic and I couldn't be happier with him. He gets the mile no problem and goes into the race at the top of his game. Similarly, Major Cadeaux is capable of running a big race." Henry Cecil won this for the first time in 1980 with the high-class Kris (GB) (Sharpen Up {GB}) and, after adding two more, has not been successful in the last 24 years.

Twice Over may put Cecil back in the winner's circle here if he can return to the form of his G3 Craven S. defeat of Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) and third behind Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo) and that rival in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot last year. Runner-up in the G1 Champion S. on his final three-year-old start over 10 furlongs at Newmarket in October, he disappointed when third as the 4-6 pick in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. over a furlong less back at that venue last time Apr. 16. Connections are waiting on how he recovers from a minor setback. Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "Twice Over is due to run in the Lockinge, but Henry Cecil reported the horse had a corn in his foot. It was dealt with overnight and it seems to be responding very well. The intention is still to run, but a final decision will be made in the morning. Henry is very happy with the horse--he didn't really handle the fast ground at Newmarket, so I don't think he will be too disappointed to see some rain at Newbury this time. He did well over the winter, and we are hoping for a big run."

Darley is represented by a pair of fillies acquired in last year's Stonerside deal. **Sea Chanter** made the first 13 starts of her career on the grass, winning the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood and the Epitome BC S. at Monmouth Park at two, but managed just an optional-claiming score in five outings last term. Second by a neck in her 2009 opener, the Jan. 11 Marshua's River S. at Gulfstream, she was hard to hold early in the Feb. 22 GIII The Very One H. over that course and faded to eighth. BARATHEA EUTHANIZED Barathea (Ire) (Sadler's Wells--Brocade {GB}, by Habitat), hero of the 1993 G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and 1994 G1 Breeders' Cup Mile, was euthanized Wednesday due to complications of laminitis, according to *Racing Post*. He was 19.

Rathbarry Stud owner Liam Cashman told the publication, "It is with deep regret that I have to announce that, due to acute deterioration of Barathea's laminated condition, we were advised on veterinary grounds, and for humane reasons, to have him euthanised. Barathea was a wonderful servant to everyone that has been lucky to have been associated with him. He was truly one in a million and the likes of him

very rarely come along." Bred by Gerald Leigh, the son of G1 Prix de la Foret heroine Brocade was campaigned by Leigh and Sheikh Mohammed, and captured his first two outings at two for trainer Luca Cumani. He ran second to Zafonic in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, then captured the Irish equivalent at The Curragh. Fifth in the G1 Epsom Derby, Barathea later ran second in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot before closing out his sophomore campaign with a fifth in the Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita. He started 1994 with a win in the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot and later posted runner-up efforts in the G1 Sussex S. and Queen Elizabeth S. before capping his career with a three-length score in the Breeders' Cup Mile ([video](#)) at Churchill. He retired to Ireland's Rathbarry Stud with a record of 16-5-4-0 and earnings of \$1,236,367.

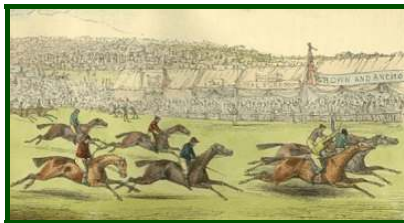

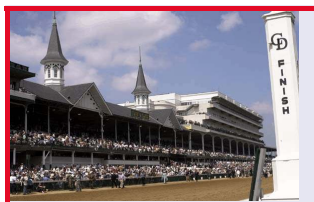

Bill Passmore, a retired jockey and steward, has died at the age of 76. The native of Pennsylvania won 3,531 races and earned nearly \$23 million during his riding career, which began in 1948 and ended in 1986. Upon retirement, Passmore became a steward for the Maryland Racing Commission, overseeing racing at Pimlico, Laurel and Timonium. He retired from that position in 2007. "Billy was one of my best friends," said Mike Hopkins, executive director of the MRC. "He was kind to everybody and would offer his time to young riders, teaching them what a rider should and shouldn't do. But he was also quite the prankster, playing good-natured tricks on people." 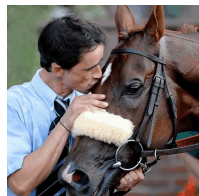
