## WIDE OPEN SHADWELL MET MILE

On paper, it looks like it's anybody's race in this afternoon's G1 Shadwell Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park. Looking to add to his victory in the Mar. 14

GII Gulfstream Park H. is Mount Joy Stable's **Smooth Air** (Smooth Jazz). Trained by Bennie Stutts Jr., the four-year-old breezed five furlongs in 1:02.40 at Calder May 18 before shipping to New York. "This will be the eighth racetrack that Smooth Air has raced at," said Stutts. "This race is one that we've been looking at for a long time." **Mr. Sidney** (Storm Cat) comes into this off a career-high victory in the G1 Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 10, but makes his first start on the dirt since a third-place finish in a Gulfstream maiden in March of 2007. Trainer Todd Pletcher sends a pair postward in **Ready's Echo** (More Than Ready) and **The Roundhouse** (Fusaichi Pegasus). Campaigned by Let's Go Stable, the former drew off to score by 3 1/4 lengths in a Keeneland allowance over the Polytrack Apr. 18, and tries the dirt for the first time since a third in the G1 Belmont S. last June. Second and third, respectively, in the GII Saratoga Special S. and GII Sanford S. in 2007, The Roundhouse closed to be third in his latest start in the mud in the GII Churchill Downs S. Again was introduced in a seven-furlong maiden at Roscommon in early July and failed to feature, but learned quickly from that experience when recording her first success in a maiden over this track and trip 20 days later. Dropped back a panel for the G2 Debutante S. staged at Leopardstown the following month, she dominated that contest and was out again a fortnight later to best Shimah (Storm Cat) by a half-length in the Moyglare over seven furlongs here. Drawn widest of all in the Marcel Boussac on Arc day, she never landed a blow there and beat only two rivals, but connections kept the faith and it was only quick ground which ruled her out of Newmarket's G1 1000 Guineas earlier this month. Settled in the group racing in the center of the straight, she was staying on well, but still adrift of Lahaleeb as that rival cruised to the front at the quarter pole. Veering right soon after, Again was straightened to deliver her stamina-packed challenge and gradually cut into her advantage as they neared the line. "My biggest worry was that she hadn't had a run, whereas most of the others had, and with those conditions, the race would turn into a real test," David Wachman said. "We didn't run her at Newmarket because of the very quick ground, and we've ended up with very slow ground at The Curragh. I thought the lack of a run showed in the last 100 yards, but Johnny [Murtagh] always thought she was going to win from a furlong and a half out. Epsom is only 12 days away, but she is tough and she stays. There is also the [June 27] G1 Pretty Polly S., the [July 12] G1 Irish Oaks and the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 19] to consider, but it is up to her owners where she goes and it will depend how she is." Lahaleeb's trainer Mick Channon told *PA Sport*, "We've got beat, but that is racing. The ground was too quick for her in the Newmarket Guineas, but she has proved she is a high-class filly, and when we get the ground, we will go well again. 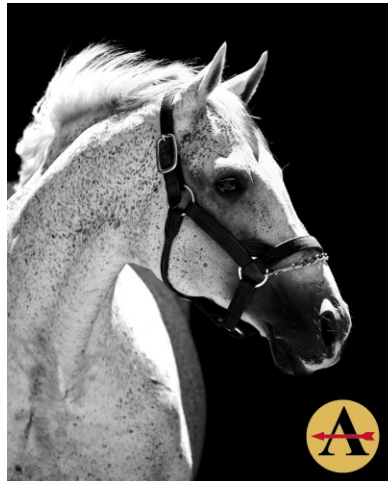
**Shadwell Met Mile cont. from p1**

Smooth Air, seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita last October, was given some time off following that lackluster effort and returned with a second-place finish while trying the turf in Gulfstream's Tallahassee S. against state-bred foes Feb. 7. Following a victory in the GII Gulfstream Park H., Stutts sent the bay to Lone Star for the Apr. 25 GIII Texas Mile, but the four-year-old failed to make it to the starting gate. "The race in California was tough on his feet--he didn't like that synthetic track," explained Stutts. "So we gave him time and brought him back the right way. The race in Texas seemed perfect for him: it was a \$300,000 race and everyone picked him on top. But two days before the race, he got the colic. We were lucky that there was a hospital close by and he didn't need surgery. But he had a bad bellyache and it was pretty scary. So, that turned out to be a wasted trip, but we have healthy horse now and he's a fit horse."

Casual Conquest registered a six-length success in Leopardstown's G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial last May to book his spot in the line-up for the G1 Epsom Derby and was far from disgraced when third on the first Saturday in June. Runner-up to Frozen Fire (Ger) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Irish Derby here later that month, the homebred was on the shelf before reappearing with a runner-up finish behind the previously listed-placed Bronze Cannon (Lemon Drop Kid) in a badly cut-up renewal of the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket

last time out May 2. Firm ground was the excuse for that reversal, and the imposing bay was met with vastly contrasting conditions this time. Sent straight to the lead by Pat Smullen, he shrugged off the first challenge of Moiqen (Ire) (Red Ransom) in early straight and had lengthened into the clear by the time his stable companion Famous Name emerged from the pack. "He deserved that, as he is a very good horse who was just beaten in two Derbies," winning trainer Dermot Weld said of the winner. "The very firm ground wasn't for him on his reappearance at Newmarket, and my concern today was whether he would handle the other extreme, but he did it well. The G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4] is the one race [Moyglare Stud owner] Mr. Haefner would love to win, and that will be his second-part-of-the-year target. Famous Name is a very good horse as well and had been working extremely well, but I wonder whether that mile-and-a-quarter is too far. Zaftig (Gone West) in the Gill Nassau City H. over this track in May. In two prior starts this term, the chestnut was fourth behind By the Light (Malibu Moon) in the six-furlong Missy's Mirage S. Mar. 27 and came home second behind that rival most recently in the Elizabeth Bay S. here May 6.

Up to take a short early lead, Carolyn's Cat held a solid advantage turning for home and proved best to score by 3 1/4 lengths. "It was a very easy trip, she broke good and then I decided I would take advantage of my break and take the lead, and my filly just kept going," said winning jockey Alan Garcia. "Her owner, Mr. [William] Warren, has been very patient with this filly," said Artie Magnuson, assistant to winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "Last year, it was the same thing, she had time off over the winter. She seems to run herself into shape. She likes some time between her races." Magnuson indicated that the four-year-old will be aimed at the Aug. 29 GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga, and will have one prep race prior to the seven-furlong event for fillies and mares. Favored Game Face (Menifee) showed little late and came home fifth.

Ambassador began his career in the United States, winning twice from 13 starts, and started his European tour of duty with a conditions score at Krefeld last November before dropping to fifth in the Dec. 11 Listed Prix Lyphard at Deauville. Runner-up in the Apr. 5 G3 Grand Prix Aufgalopp at Cologne on seasonal return, he ran fourth in the Apr. 26 G2 Gerling-Preis back by the Rhine last time and was awarded this career high in the stewards' room. Ambassador was positioned in fifth early and eased into fourth going down the backstraight. Pushed along off the home turn to challenge in early stretch, he was hampered twice by the errant **Tres Rapide** inside the final furlong, but ran on strongly nonetheless to finish a close second. "Everything was going well; I was behind **Kamsin** and I am sure we would have won if the filly [**Tres Rapide**] didn't hang into us, as it still was very close on the line," commented winning rider **Terence Hellier**.

**Tres Rapide's** jockey **Gerald Mosse** held a different perspective on the situation. "I think my filly was the best horse in the race, but she did not deserve to be disqualified," said **Mosse**. "There was a lot of movement in the field and I drifted to the side a bit, but the decision is wrong." Last term's G1 **Deutsches Derby** hero **Kamsin (Ger)** (**Samum {Ger}**) was another hampered in the closing stages, but could not dominate once asked for his bid off the home turn. 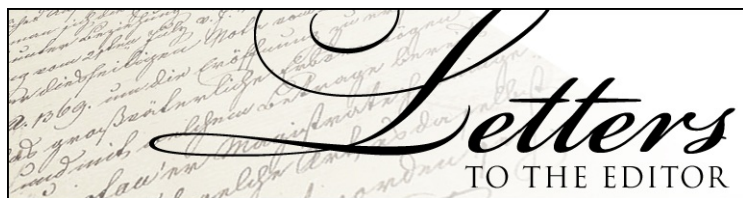
