## RACHEL WORKS, NEXT START UNKNOWN

GI Preakness S. winner **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) turned in a solid six-furlong work at Churchill yesterday, covering the distance over a fast track in 1:13.80. With exercise rider Dominic Terry in the irons, the filly worked in fractions of :13, :25.60, :37.60, :49.40 and 1:01.20. She galloped out seven furlongs in 1:28. "She went a nice, smooth three quarters," trainer Steve Asmussen reported. "She went beautiful, like she always does. She's in a nice rhythm and seems very happy right now. We'll report back to [majority owner] Jess [Jackson] and the gang and see what we do next." Jackson has mentioned the GI Mother Goose S. June 27 at Belmont as a possible next start for his star filly.

## MINE THAT BIRD BACK AT CHURCHILL

GI Kentucky Derby winner **Mine That Bird** (Birdstone) returned to Churchill Downs Monday morning after his third-place finish in Saturday's GI Belmont S. "It was an uneventful flight and he handled the trip well," trainer Chip Woolley reported. "He came out of the Belmont great. he has held up well and hasn't lost any weight. I am tickled with where he is at now." Woolley said plans for the Derby winner are up in the air. "I want to watch him the next three or four days and make sure everything is well," Woolley added. "If it is, we'll come out with a plan. We have not made a decision, but there are six options we are looking at." Woolley will stay in Louisville through the weekend, when he, jockey Calvin Borel and owners Mark Allen and Dr. Leonard Blach will receive their Kentucky Derby trophies between live races Saturday at Churchill Downs.

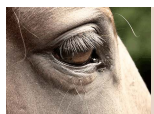

Last November, when I pointed out the promise being shown by Birdstone in a column on his daughter Livin Lovin, I had no inkling that this excellent performer was going to prove the dominant force in the 2009 Triple Crown races. Who would have thought that an unproven stallion standing at \$10,000 was destined to supply the winner of the Kentucky Derby, the runner-up in the Preakness and the first and third in the Belmont S., thanks to the efforts of Mine That Bird and Summer Bird?

Perhaps the idea wouldn't have seemed so improbable in the context of the profound influence which the Fappiano branch of the Mr. Prospector male line has exerted on the Triple Crown. Mine That Bird became the fourth consecutive generation of this male line to win a Triple Crown event when he triumphed on Derby Day, following the 2004 Belmont S. victory of Birdstone and the 1996 and 1990 Kentucky Derby successes of Grindstone and Unbridled.

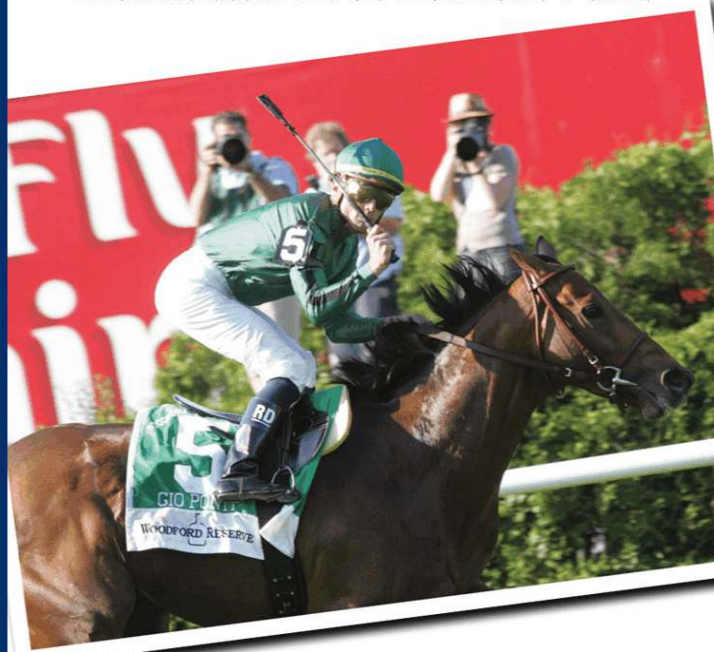

# Grade 1's back-to-back

And when Summer Bird pounced late to take the Belmont three days ago, he followed Victory Gallop, Empire Maker and Birdstone as the Fappiano line's fourth Belmont S. winner in the space of 12 years. The Belmont also highlights the scale of the dominance exerted by the Mr. Prospector male line as a whole, as no fewer than 11 of the last 15 winners have come from this line, with 13 in all.

In my Livin Lovin article, I commented: "When Birdstone retired to Gainesway, his advertisements claimed that 'no colt of his generation can match his record.' He had become only the second horse ever to take the Champagne S. at two and both the Belmont S. and Travers S. at three, and he had ended Smarty Jones's gallant bid for Triple Crown honors in the Belmont. In the process Birdstone had pushed his earnings past the \$1.5-million mark, yet his fee was set no higher than \$10,000--just one-tenth of the price charged for Smarty Jones. At two, Birdstone had ranked fourth among the colts on the Experimental Free Handicap, at 124, and only two American colts--Smarty Jones and Kitten's Joy--were weighted above him on the World Rankings for three-year-olds.

"So why was Birdstone so cheap? My guess is that his connections were keen to compensate for the fact that he is a son of Grindstone. The fee for this winner of the 1996 Kentucky Derby has been as low as \$3,500 for the last two years, with Birdstone having the unwanted distinction of being the only offspring of Grindstone to have won a race above Grade III level."

With the handicap of Grindstone dragging him down, Birdstone hasn't found things easy in his first few years at stud. His first crop numbers roughly 64 named foals, and he is credited with only 46 live foals in his second, of which 37 have been named. His fortunes revived somewhat in his third year, but his 2008 book comprised 63 mares.

The size of his first crop makes his achievements all the more laudable. In addition to Mine That Bird and Summer Bird, the 64 named foals also include Livin Lovin (Gill Tempted S.), Stone Legacy (second in the GI Kentucky Oaks) and the dual stakes winner Texas Birdstone.

As the dams of the foals in Birdstone's first two crops have a fairly run-of-the-mill Comparable Index of 1.23, it is also worth looking at the mares which produced Birdstone's good winners. Mine That Bird's dam Mining My Own never raced and was sold for only \$8,000 in January 2008, while Summer Bird's dam

Hong Kong Squall failed to win in nine attempts after selling for \$22,000 as a yearling. Livin Lovin's dam Nurse Margaret, a \$28,000 yearling, won only one of her 11 starts and less than \$18,000. And Texas Birdstone is out of an unraced daughter of Ray's Pegasus. Stone Legacy is the exception, as her dam Gulch Legacy earned \$145,000 (without earning black type).

So Birdstone just might be one of those rare stallions capable of turning base metal into gold. But do his powers of alchemy need any help? Mine That Bird is inbred 4x4 to Northern Dancer, 5x3 to Mr. Prospector and 5x5 to Nashua, whereas Summer Bird is inbred 3x3 to Storm Bird and 4x4x5 to Northern Dancer. Livin Lovin is inbred 4x5 to Northern Dancer, and the inbreeding in Stone Legacy's pedigree is 5x3 to Mr. Prospector, 4x5 to Raise A Native and 5x5 to Nashua.

The choice of Birdstone as a mate for Hong Kong Squall no doubt owed something to the fact that Hong Kong Squall's dam Hong Kong Jade is a half-sister to two stakes winners by Fappiano-line stallions. Fappiano himself sired one of them, the champion sprinter Rubiano, and Unbridled sired the other, Tap Your Heels. Tap Your Heels, of course, has now found fame as the dam of Gainesway's other star young stallion, Tapit.

But the 3x3 inbreeding to Storm Bird must also have been a deliberate attempt to help revive the family's considerable ability, which had largely skipped Hong Kong Squall and Hong Kong Jade and their foals.

The strategy seems to have worked very well, but I must admit that I would normally be wary of inbreeding so closely to Storm Bird. On the plus side, he was an exceptional racehorse who was undefeated in five juvenile starts, and he was also a very talented stallion, whose achievements including siring the champion sire Storm Cat. On a less positive note, Storm Bird's name was also sometimes linked to an aggressive nature, a tendency to wind problems and, eventually, to questionable fertility. This lack of fertility showed in Summer Bird's broodmare sire Summer Squall.

Perhaps I am wrong to doubt Storm Bird, as 3x3 inbreeding to him also helped the very disappointing stallion High Yield sire one of his best winners in Magic America (G3 Prix Miesque and second in the G1 Prix Morny). Storm Cat's Irish Group 3 winner Plan is inbred 2x4 to Storm Bird, but the inbreeding may have had little to do with the colt's talent, as he is out of the record earner Spain. So too is the Giant's Causeway filly Dreamtheimpossible, last year's G1 Fillies' Mile third who is inbred 3x4 to Storm Bird.

It is also worth mentioning that the second and third generations of Summer Bird's pedigree feature Dear Birdie and Weekend Surprise, two winners of the Kentucky Broodmare of the Year title. Summer Bird's link to Tapit also makes him particularly interesting for a colt produced for a fee of \$10,000 and it is going to be fascinating to see how this progressive colt's career develops.

**Borel to Supports Slots at Kentucky Tracks:**

Jockey Calvin Borel, who rode Mine That Bird (Birdstone) to win the GI Kentucky Derby and Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) to win the GI Preakness S., has teamed up with the Kentucky Equine Education Project to support legislation to allow installation of video lottery terminals at Kentucky's racetracks. Borel is featured in a radio commercial and in a mailing promoting the gaming legislation. In a statement released by KEEP, Borel said, "I moved to Kentucky 12 years ago to be in the middle of the horse capital of the world, and now all I see are horses, trainers and jobs leaving to go to other states. If we don't do something soon, our industry will disappear." Last week, Gov. Steve Beshear called a special session of the legislature to balance the state's budget. Beshear amended the call to include the VLT's proposal. The special session will convene June 15.

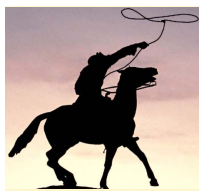

## BIG DRAMA TO CHARLES TOWN

**Big Drama** (Montbrook), coming off a fifth-place effort in the May 16 GI Preakness S., will make his next start in the \$250,000 seven-furlong Red Legend S. at Charles Town June 20, according to *Daily Racing Form*. In the colt's first breeze since the Preakness, he went five furlongs at Monmouth Park Sunday in 1:00.40. Big Drama has won five of eight starts, including last year's GIII Boyd Gaming's Delta Jackpot S. He was disqualified from a first-place finish and placed second in the GI Swale S. in March.
